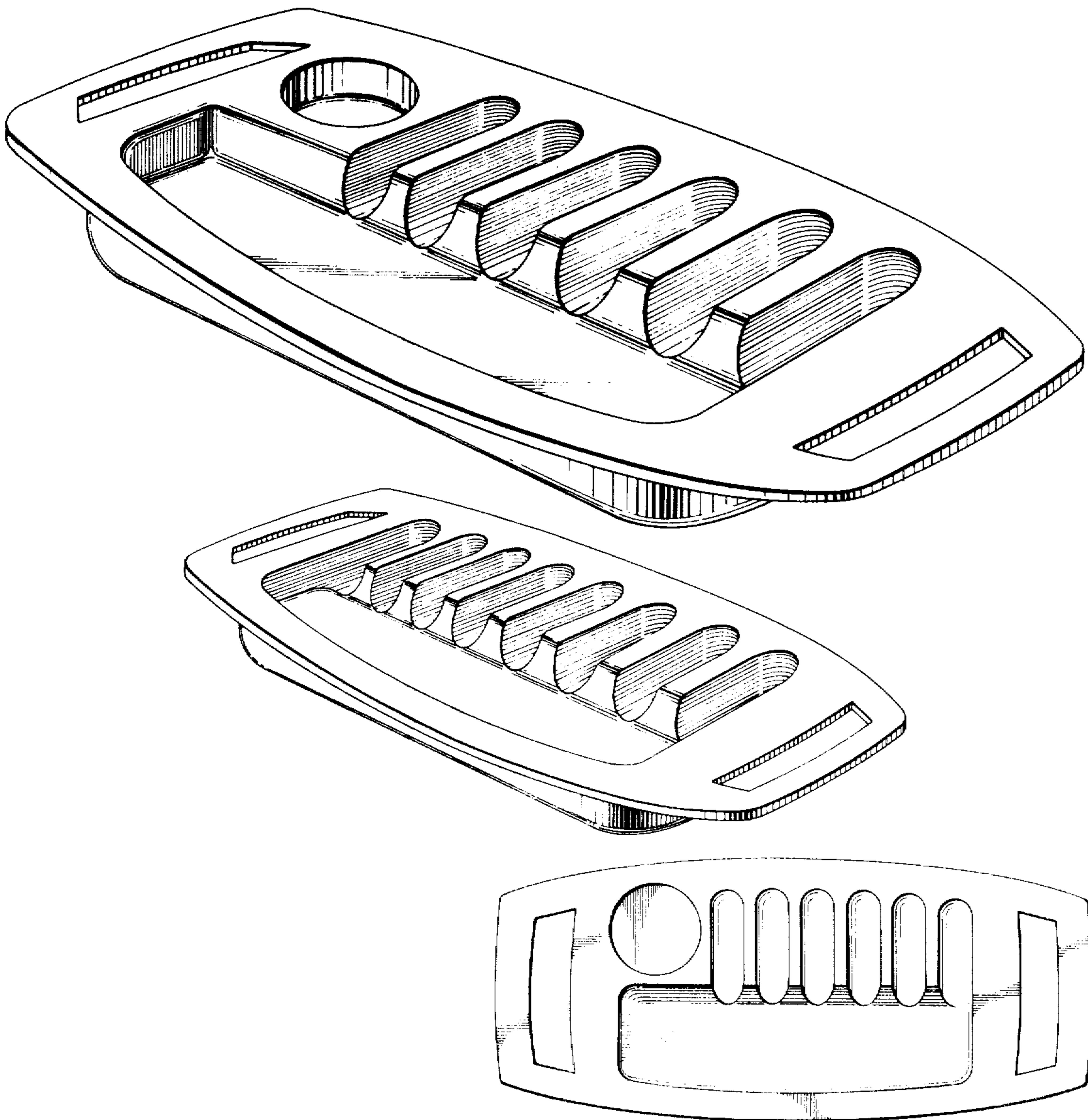

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a taco server showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a front or rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a left or right side elevational view thereof; and
 FIG. 5 is a top perspective view of a taco server showing a modification of our new design.
 The bottom is flat and unornamented.



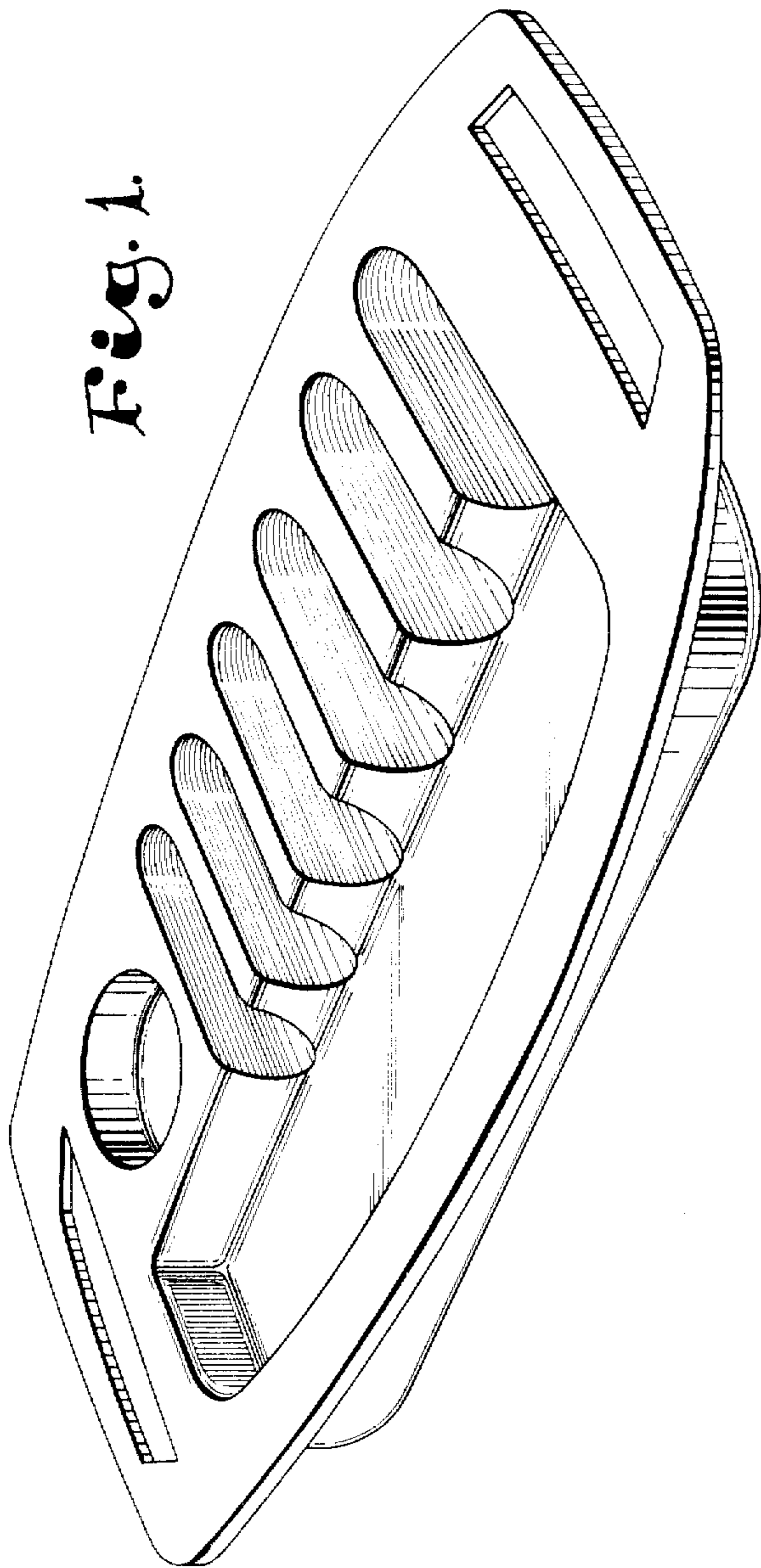

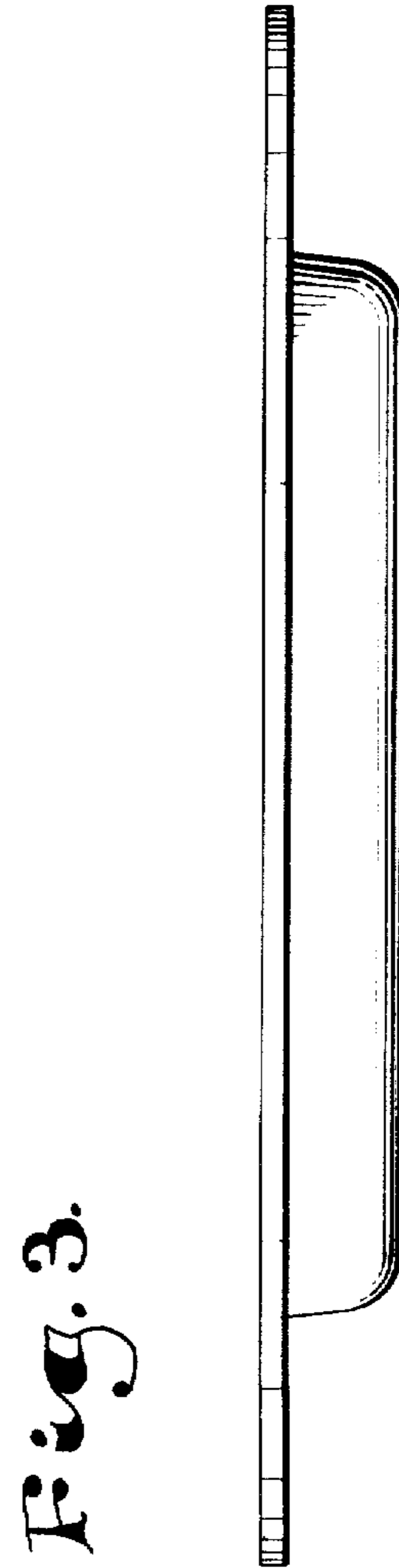

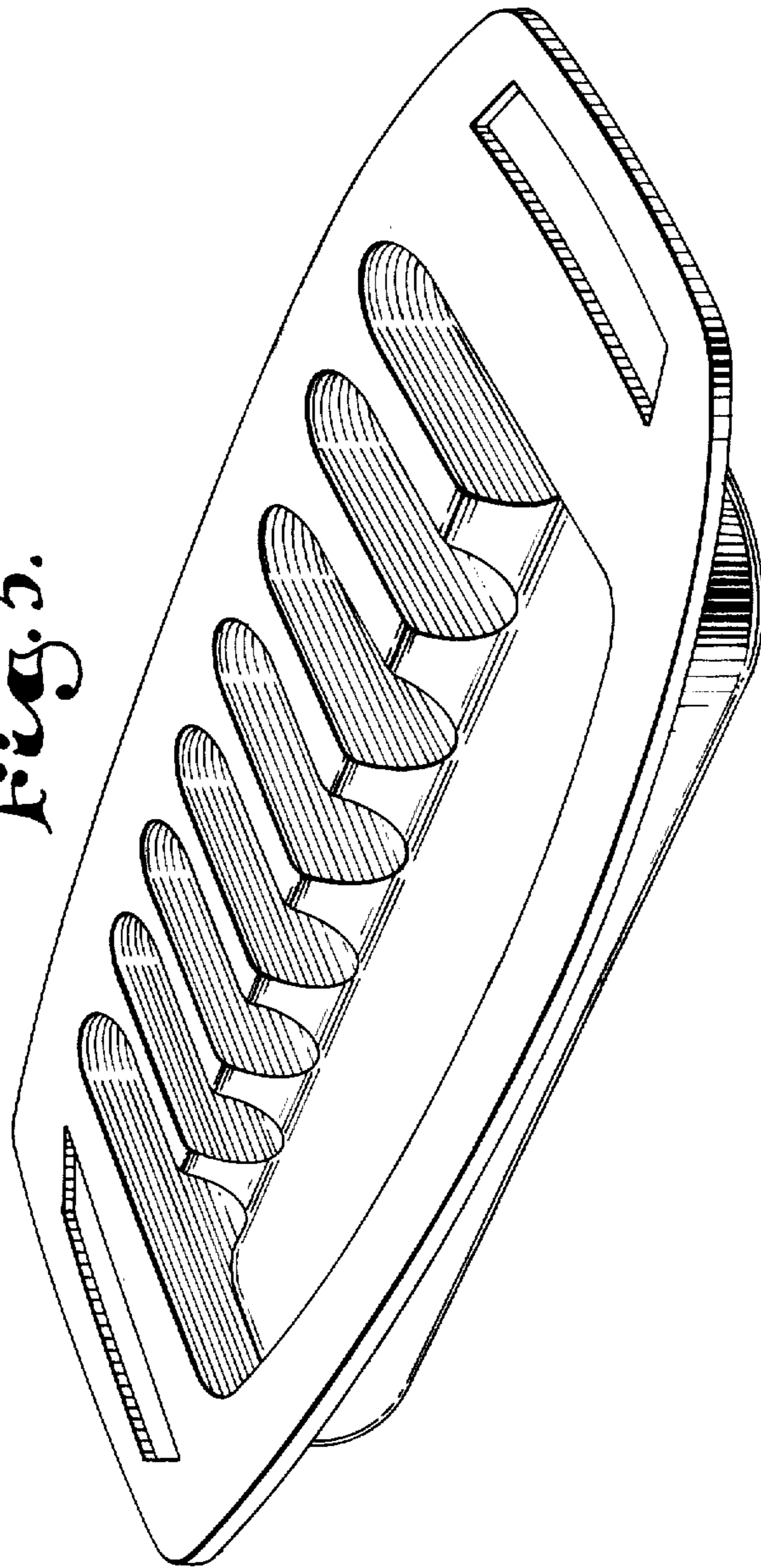
