The ornamental design for a packaging carton, as shown and described.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a packaging carton showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof.

FIG. 4 is an end view thereof.


FIG. 5 is a section therethrough taken at line 5—5 in


FIG. 2 and viewed in the direction of the arrows.

The dotted line represents a perforation, the material being cardboard.












