FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of another embodiment, all other views being the same as the first shown embodiment;


FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a third embodiment, all other views being the same as the first shown embodiment.








