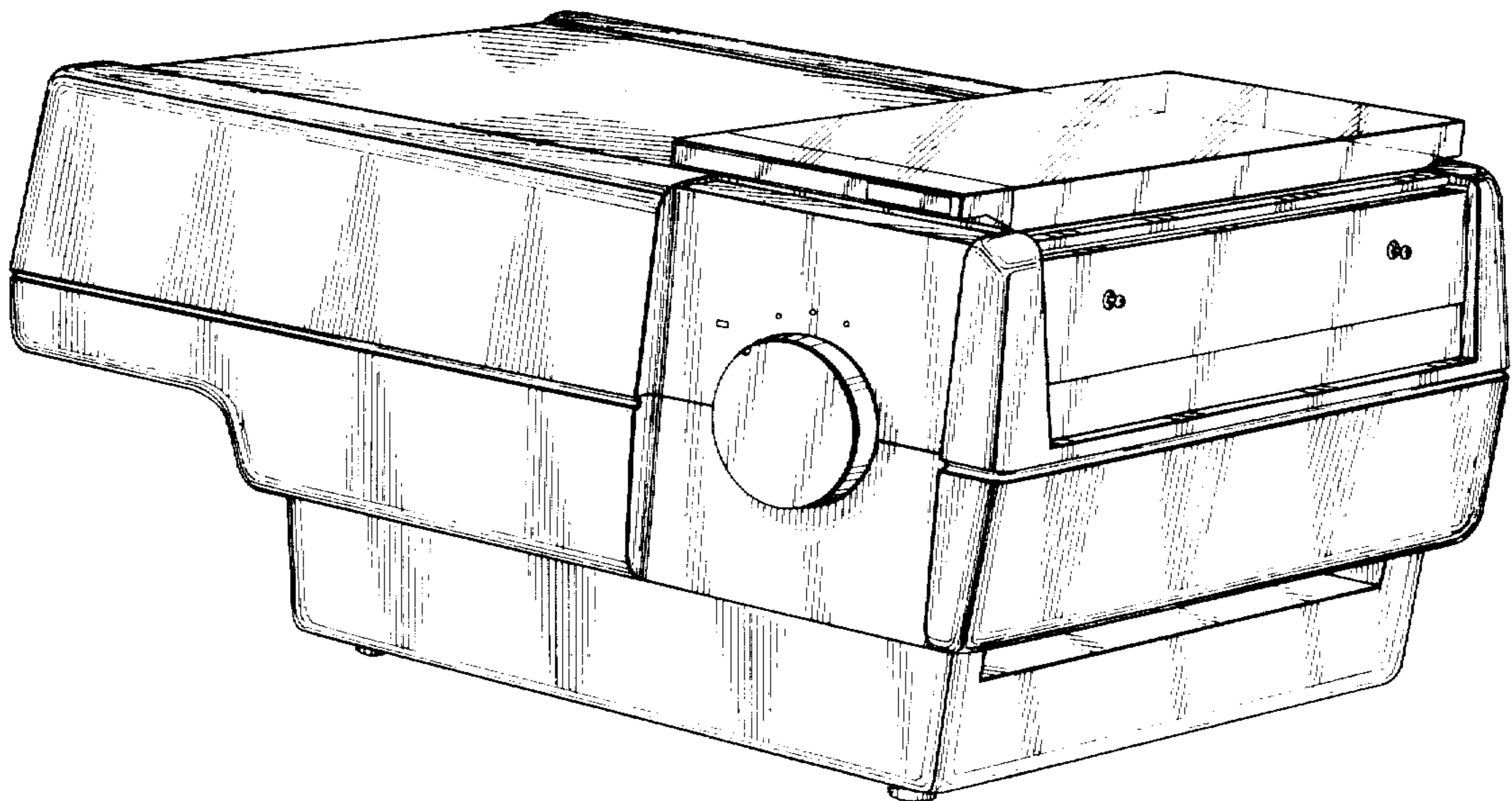

The ornamental design for an electronic copying machine or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an electronic copying machine showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.



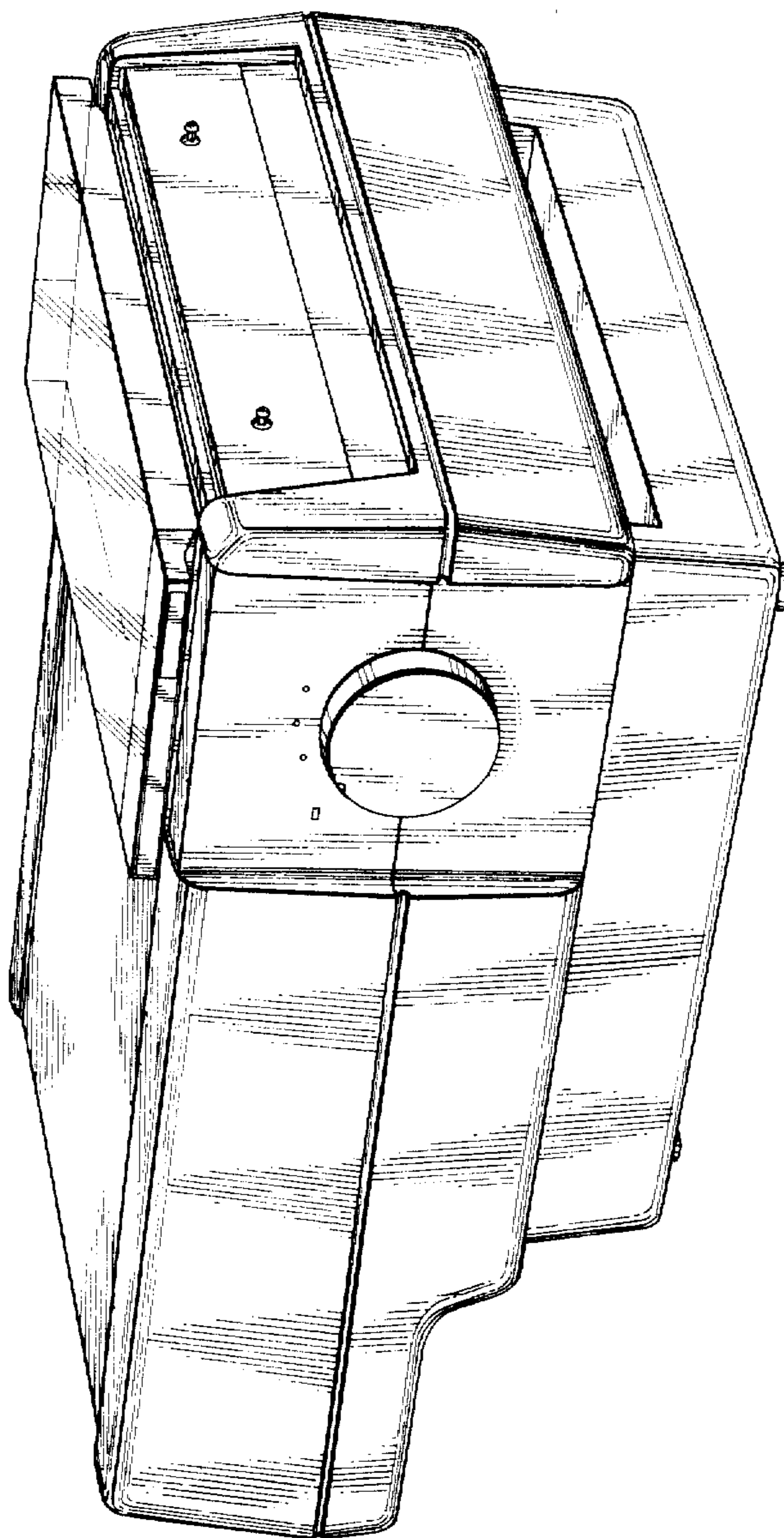

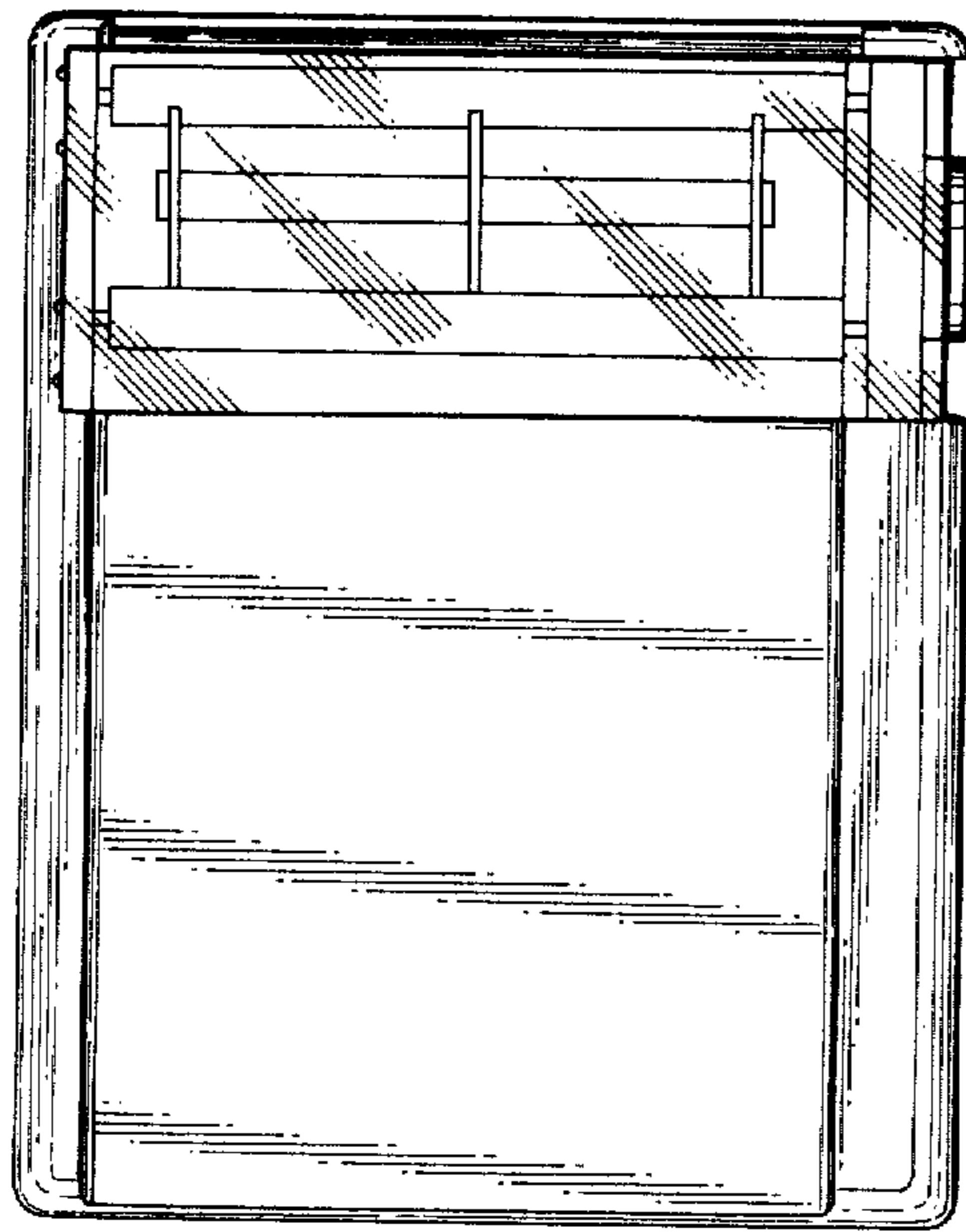

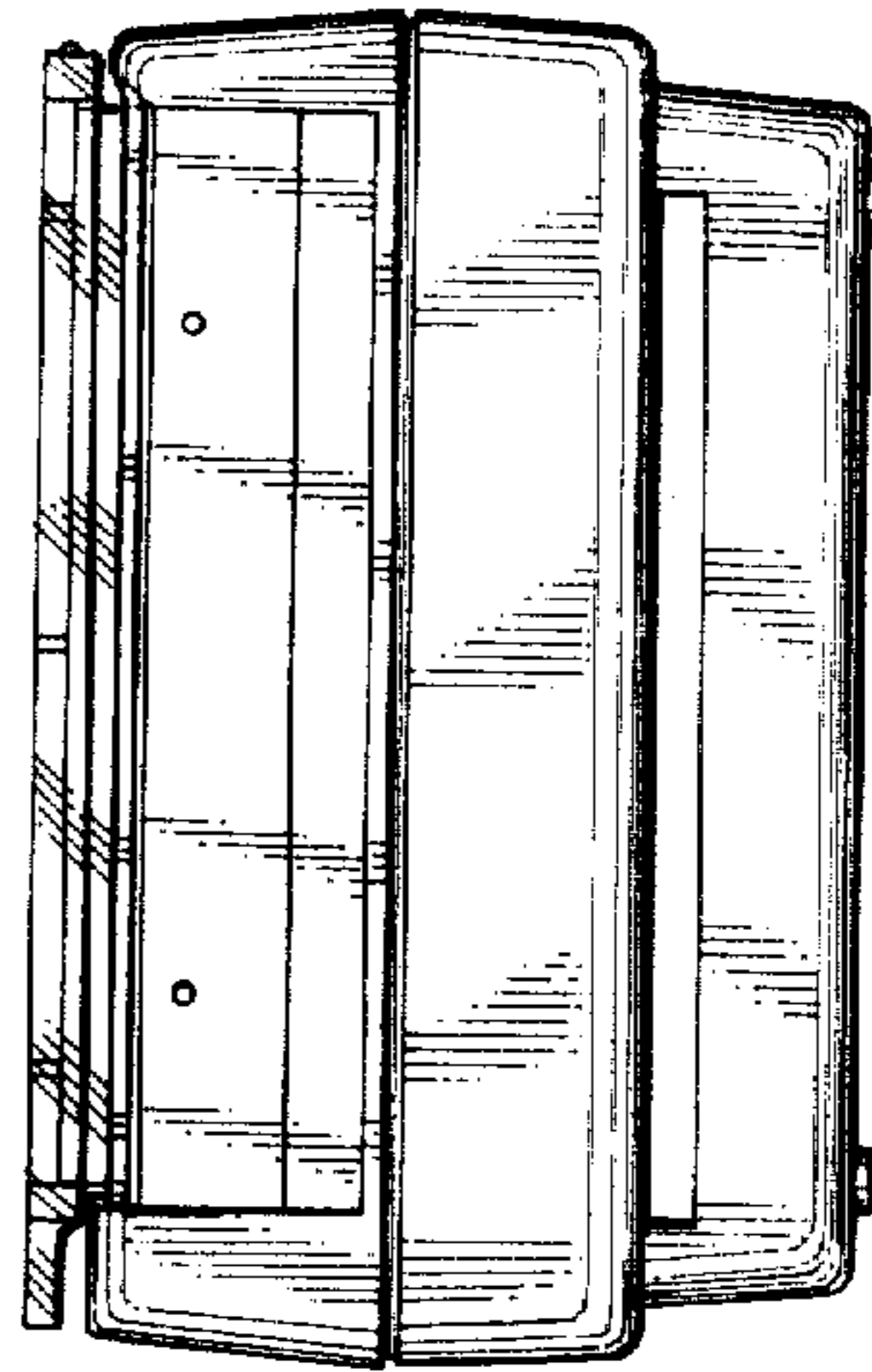

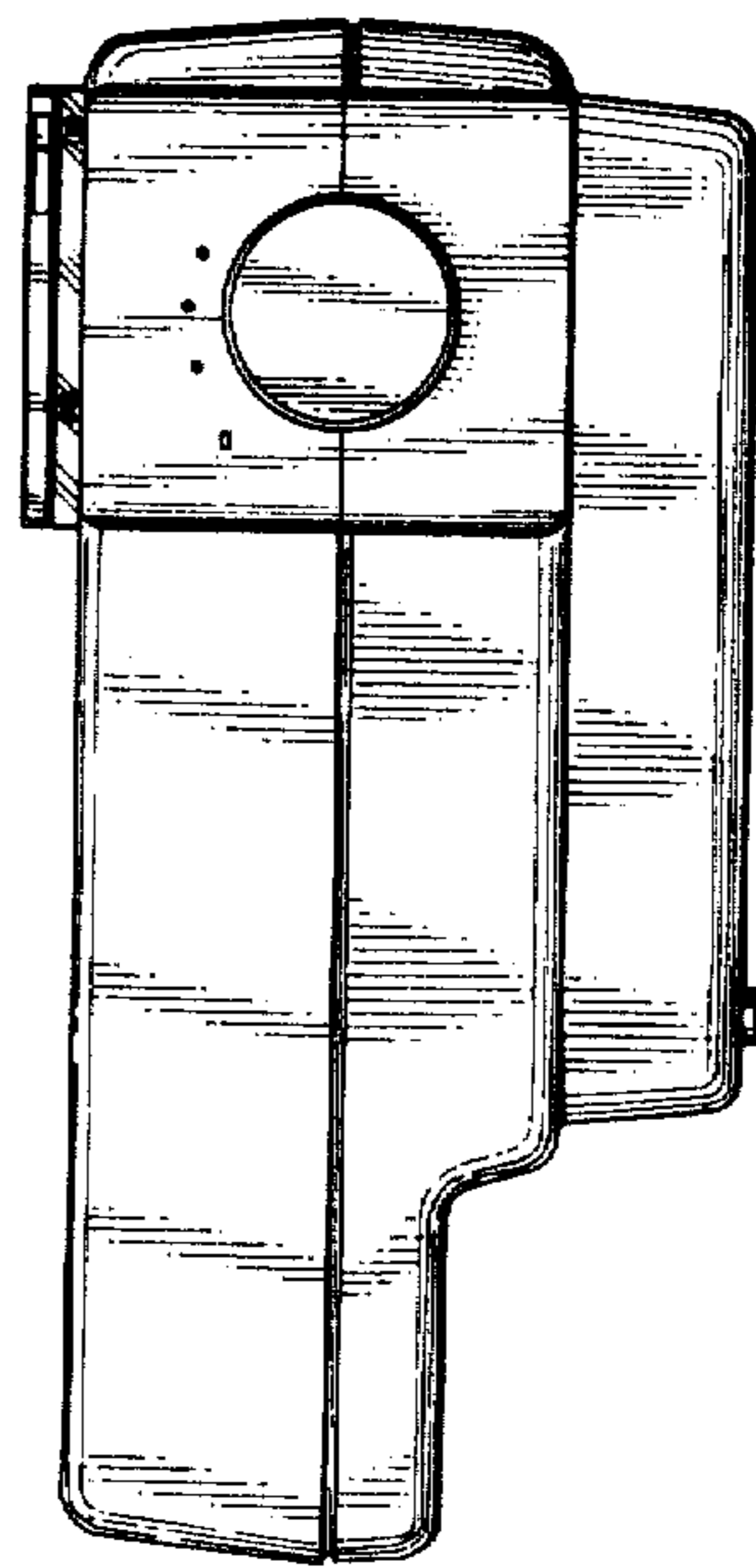

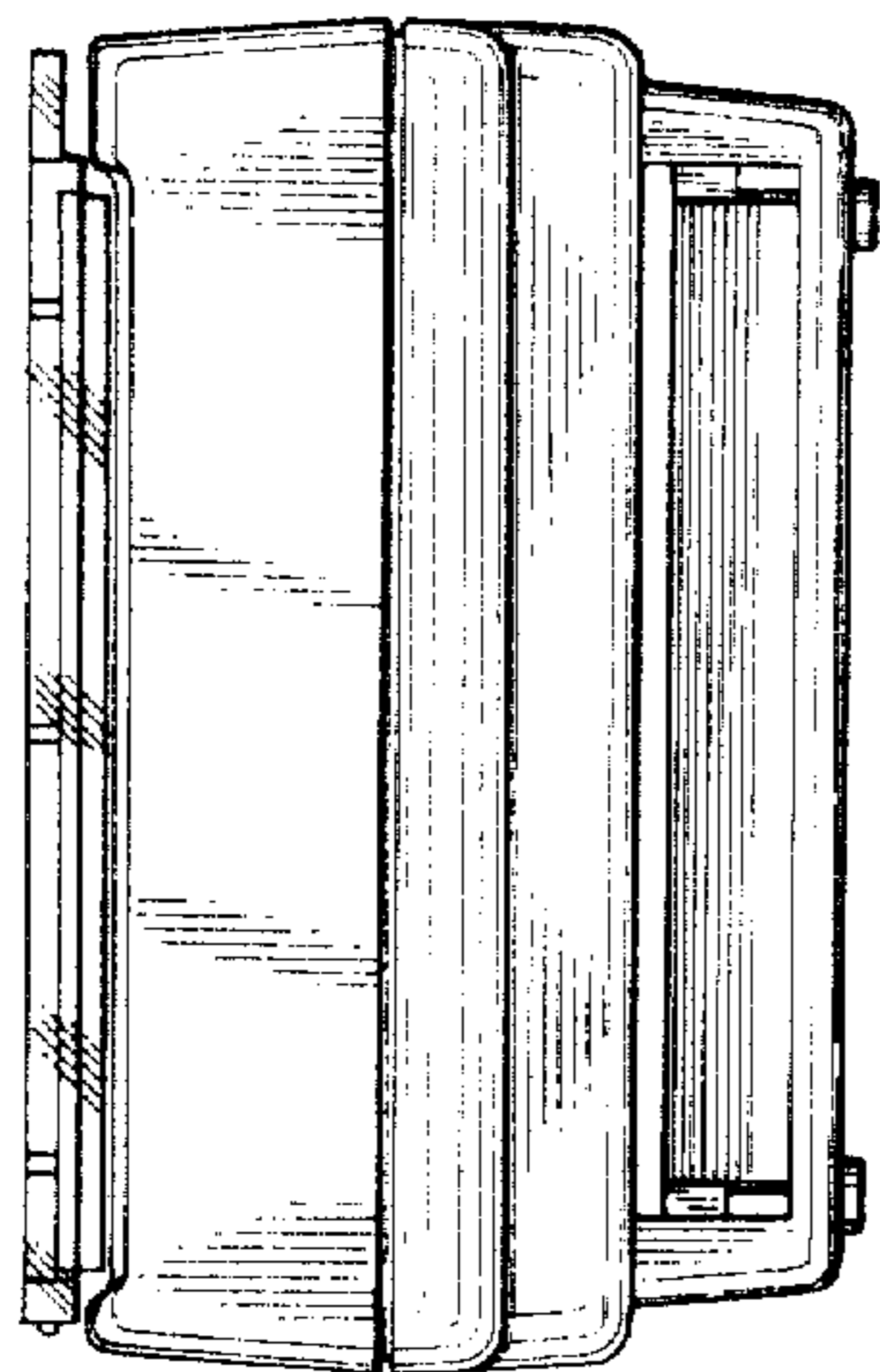

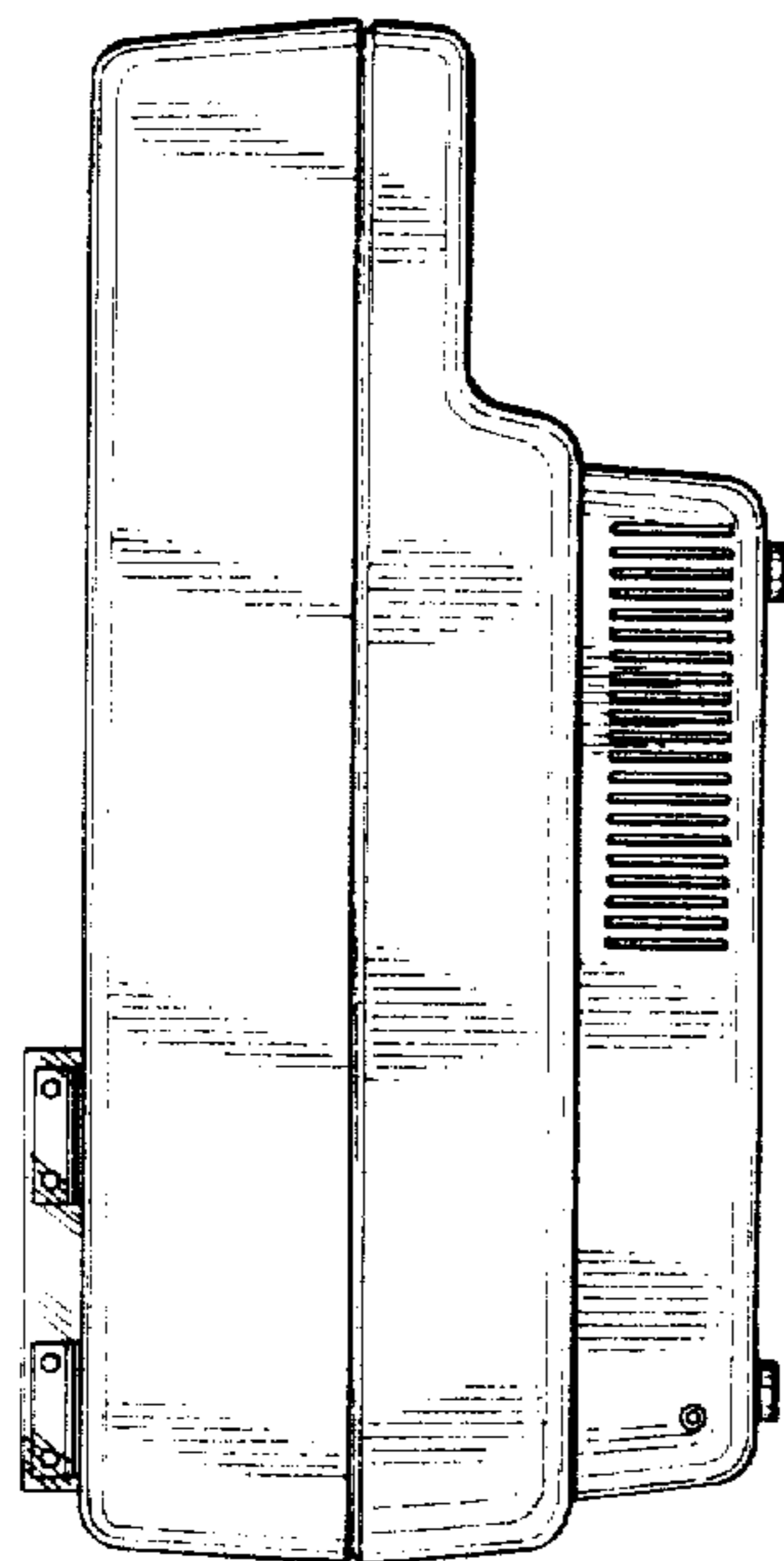
