sign;

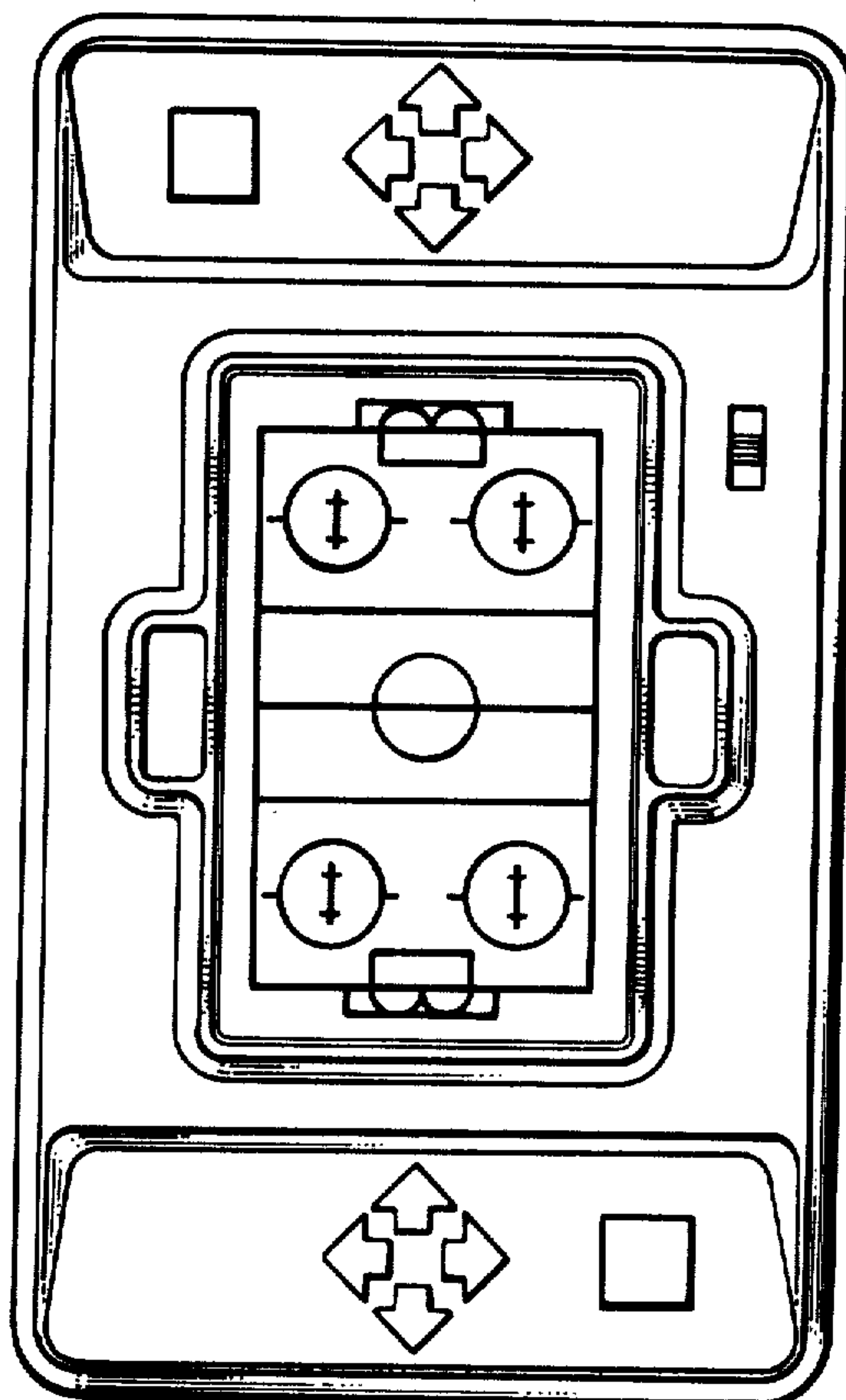
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear edge view thereof.



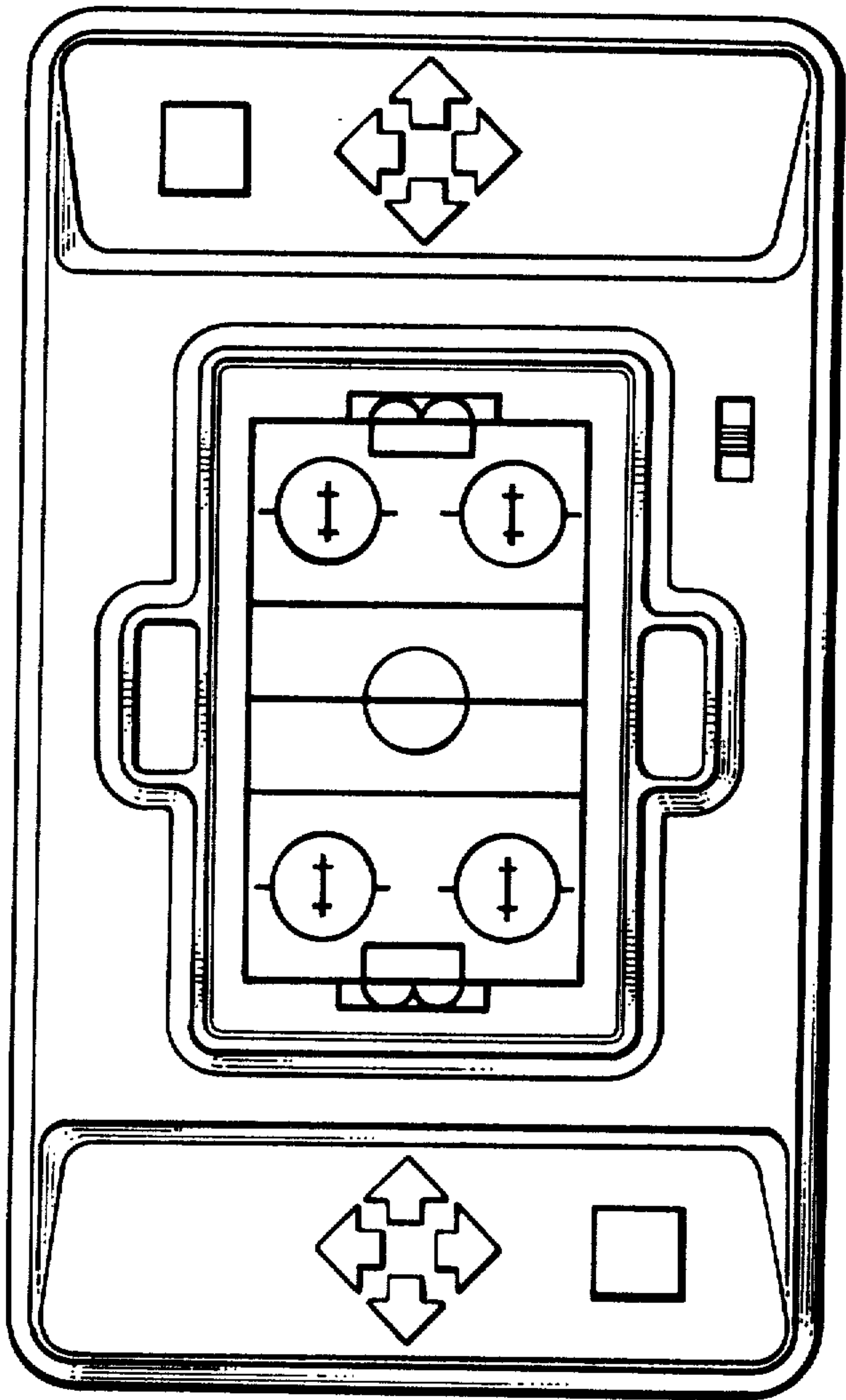

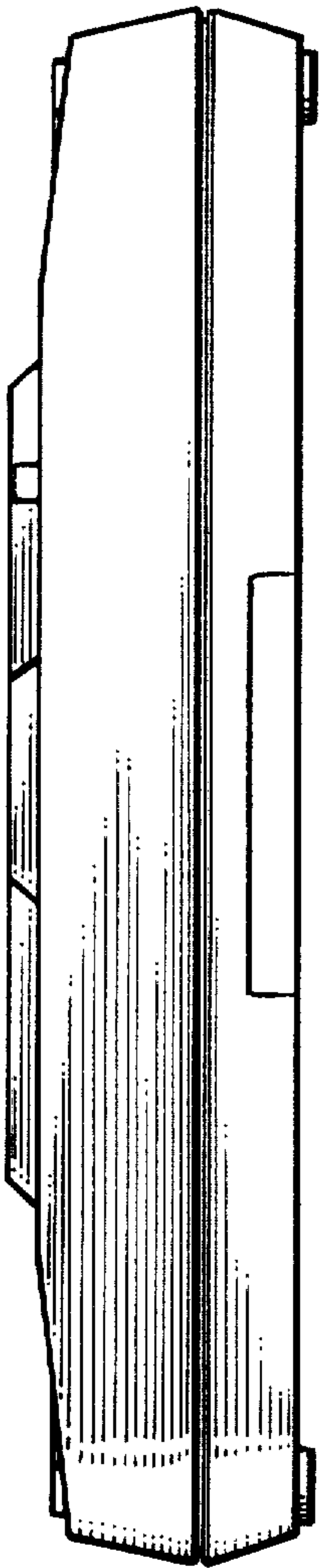

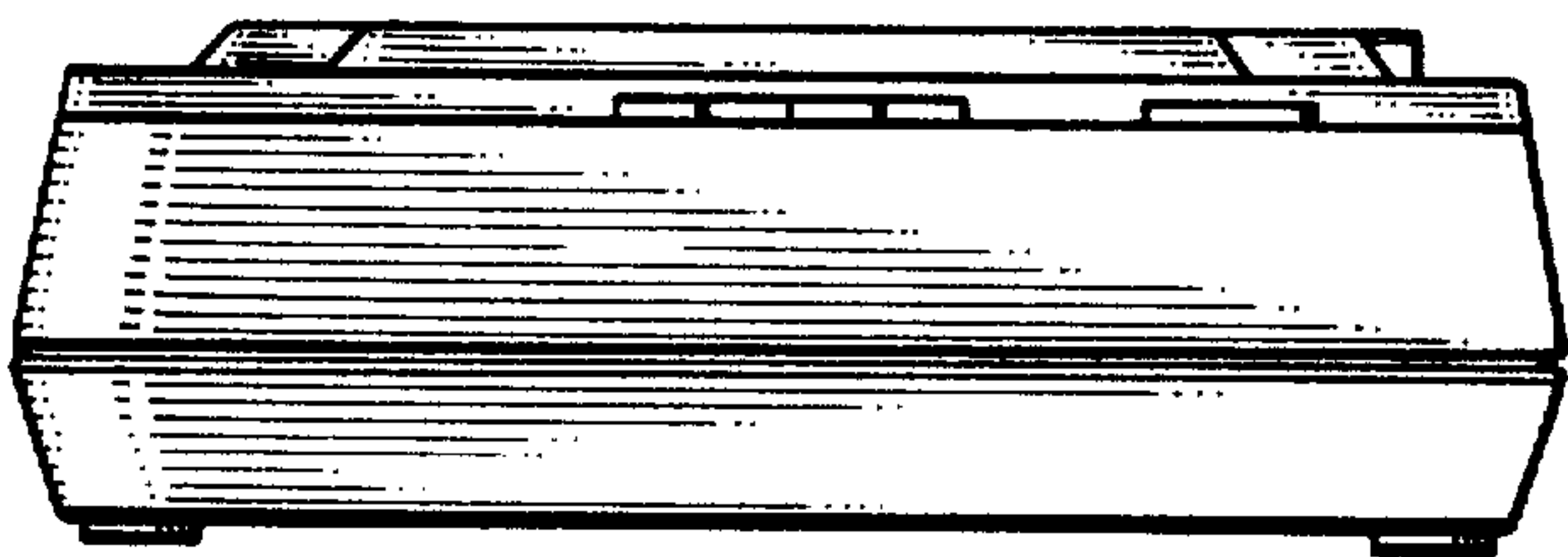

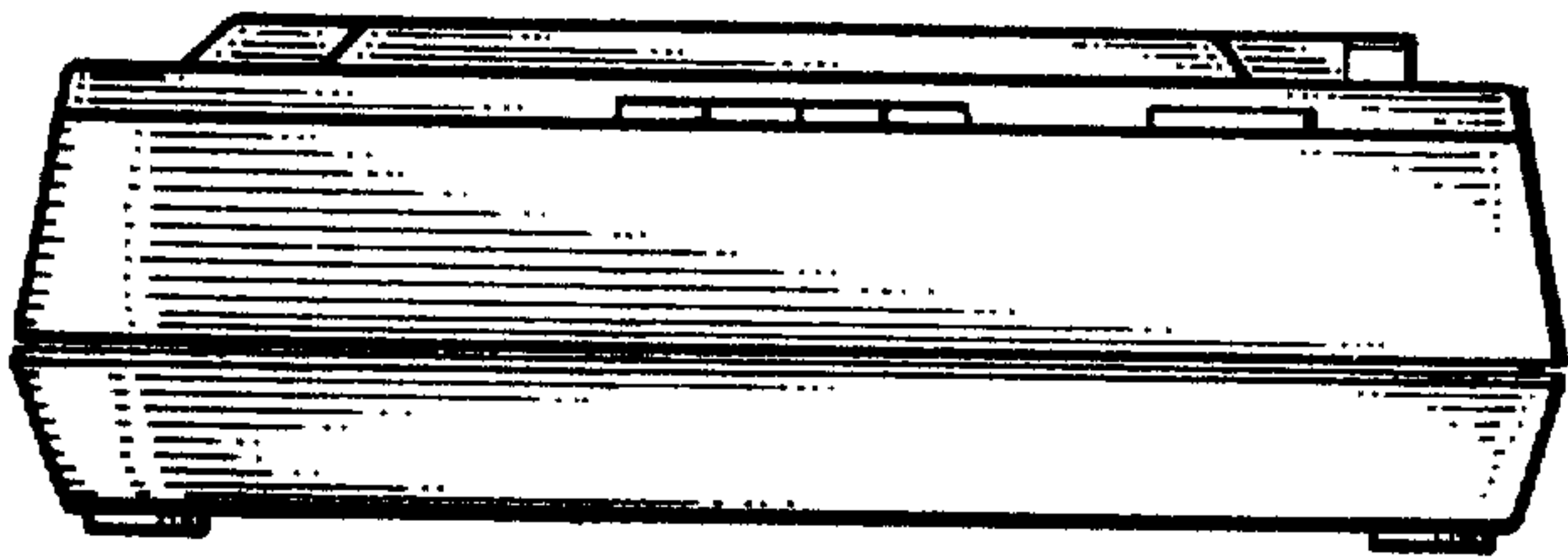

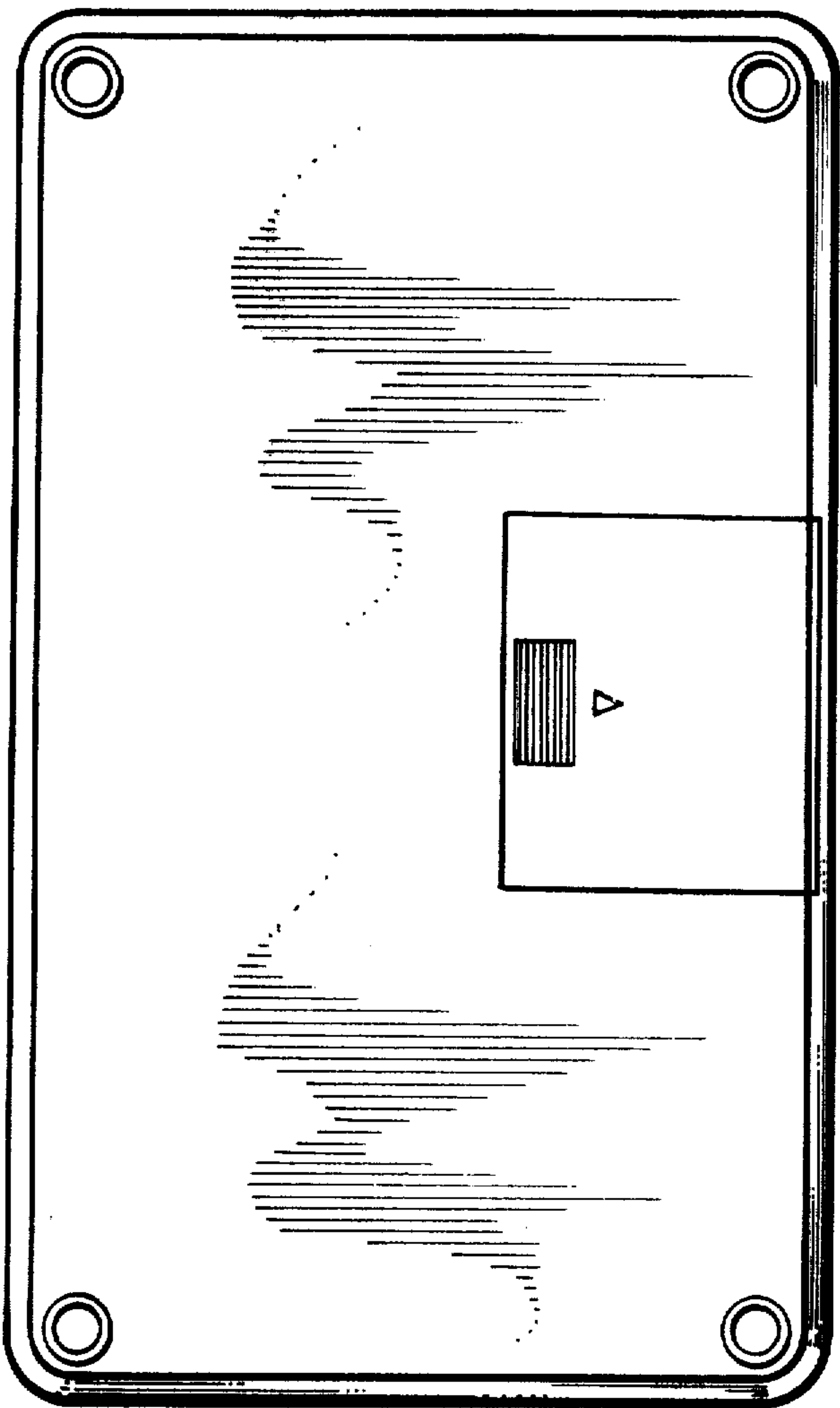

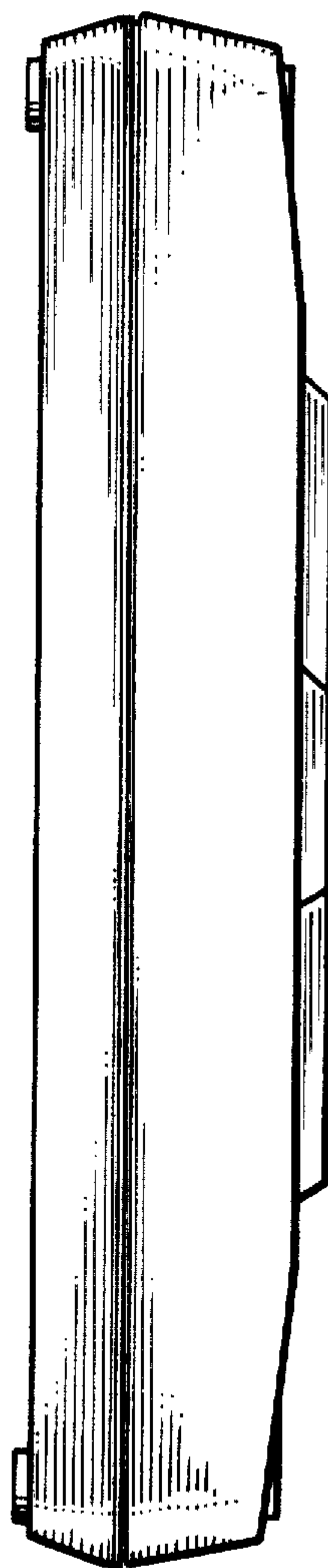
