[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a coil exerciser, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a coil exerciser showing my new design, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image; and, FIG. 2 is an end elevational view thereof, the end opposite being substantially a mirror image.

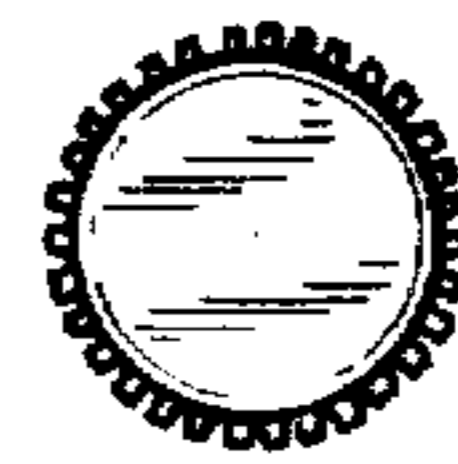
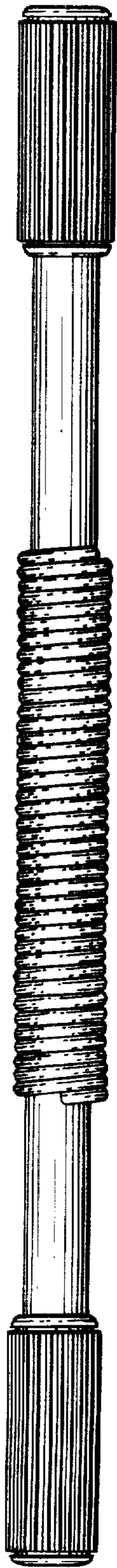
