#### [57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a kicking-practice football, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the kicking-practice football showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a view of one end of the football shown in

FIG. 1, both ends having the same appearance;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the football, both sides having the same appearance;


FIG. 4 is a transverse cross-sectional view, taken on the line 4-4 of FIG. 1, looking in the direction of the arrows;

FIG. 5 is a longitudinal cross-sectional view, taken on the line 5—5 of FIG. 1, looking in the direction of the arrows;

FIG. 6 is a longitudinal cross-sectional view, taken on the line 6—6 of FIG. 3, looking in the direction of the arrows;

FIG. 7 is a transverse cross-sectional view, taken on the line 7—7 of FIG. 1, looking in the direction of the arrows; and

FIG. 8 is a transverse cross-sectional view, taken on the line 8-8 of FIG. 1, looking in the direction of the arrows.
