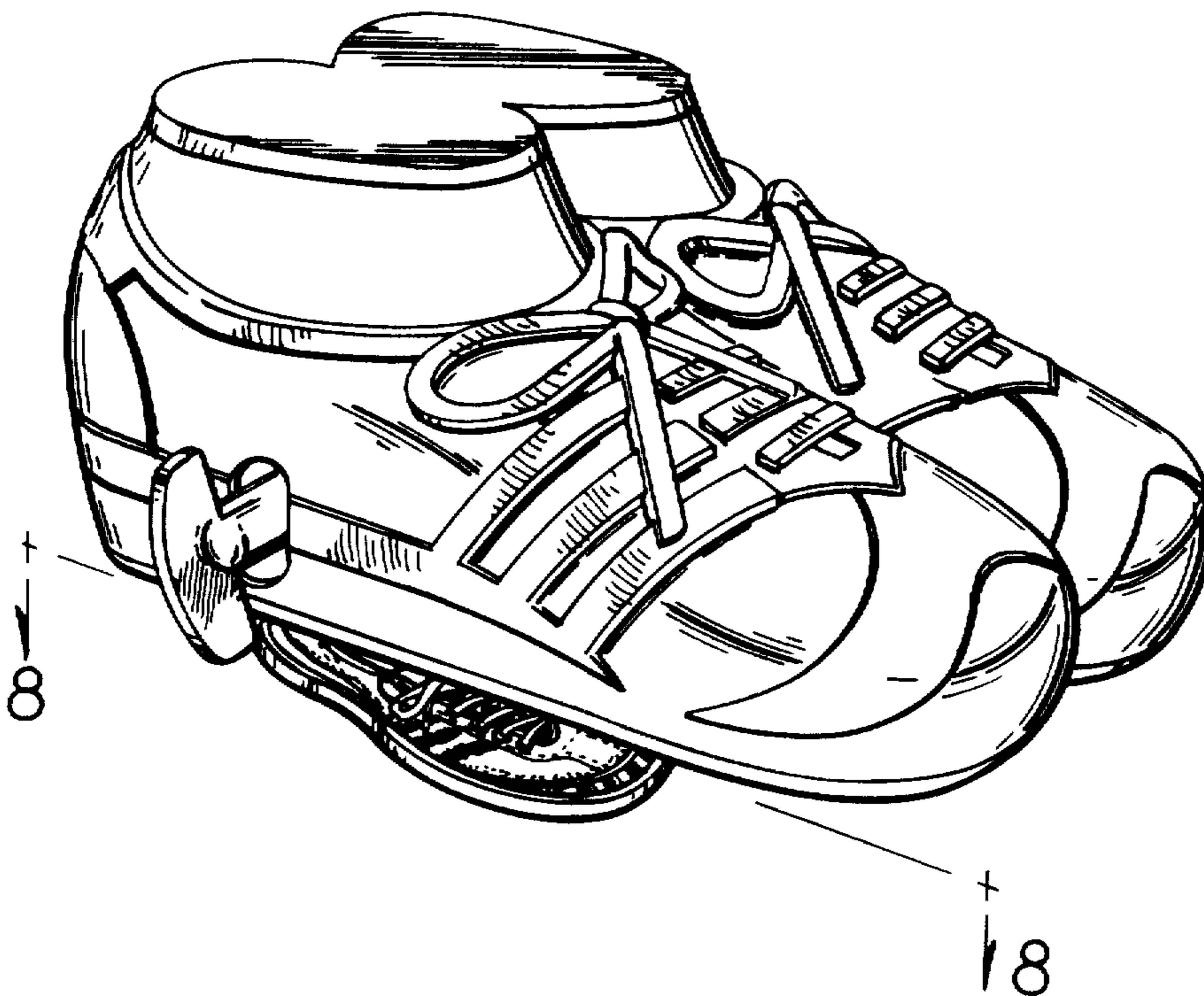

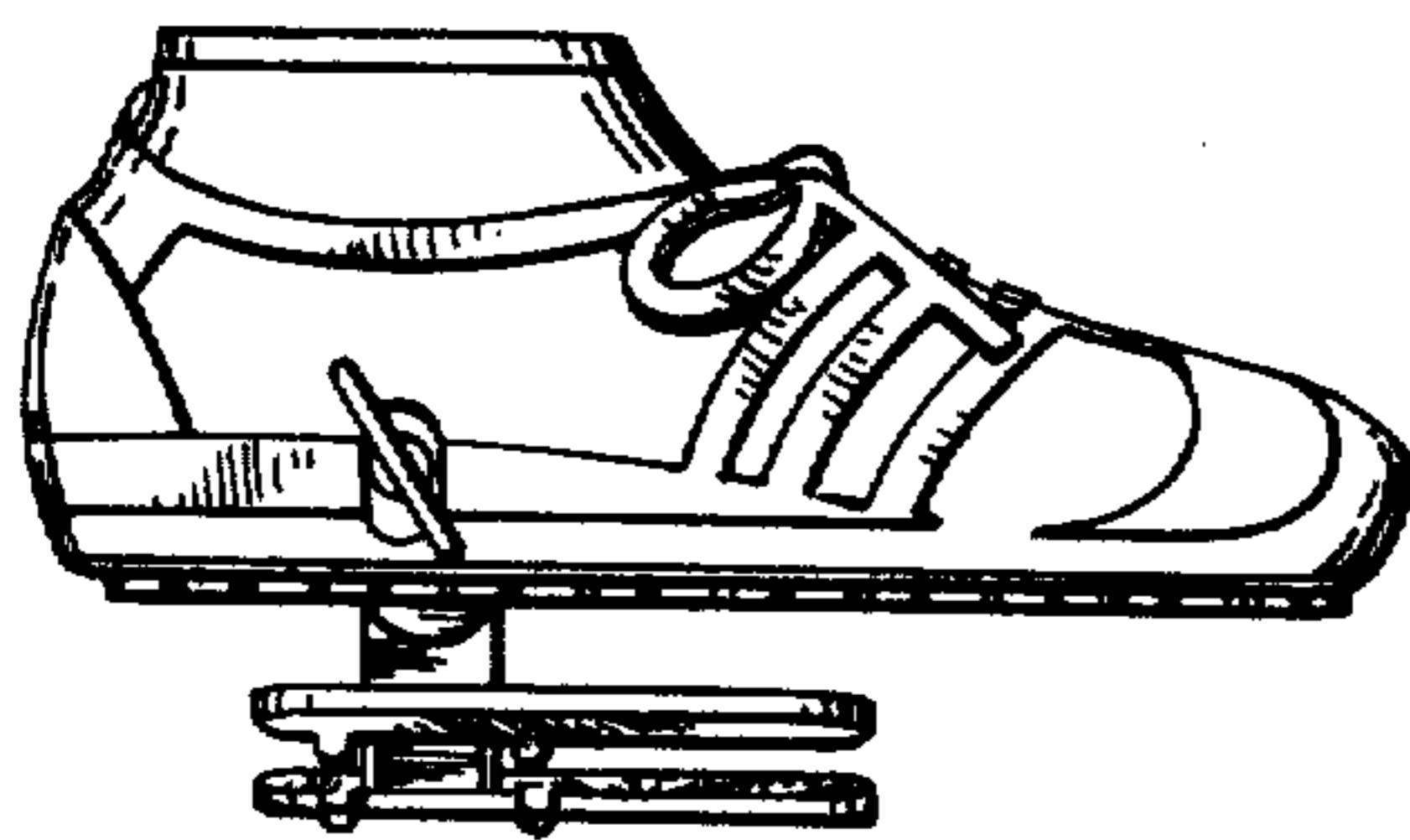
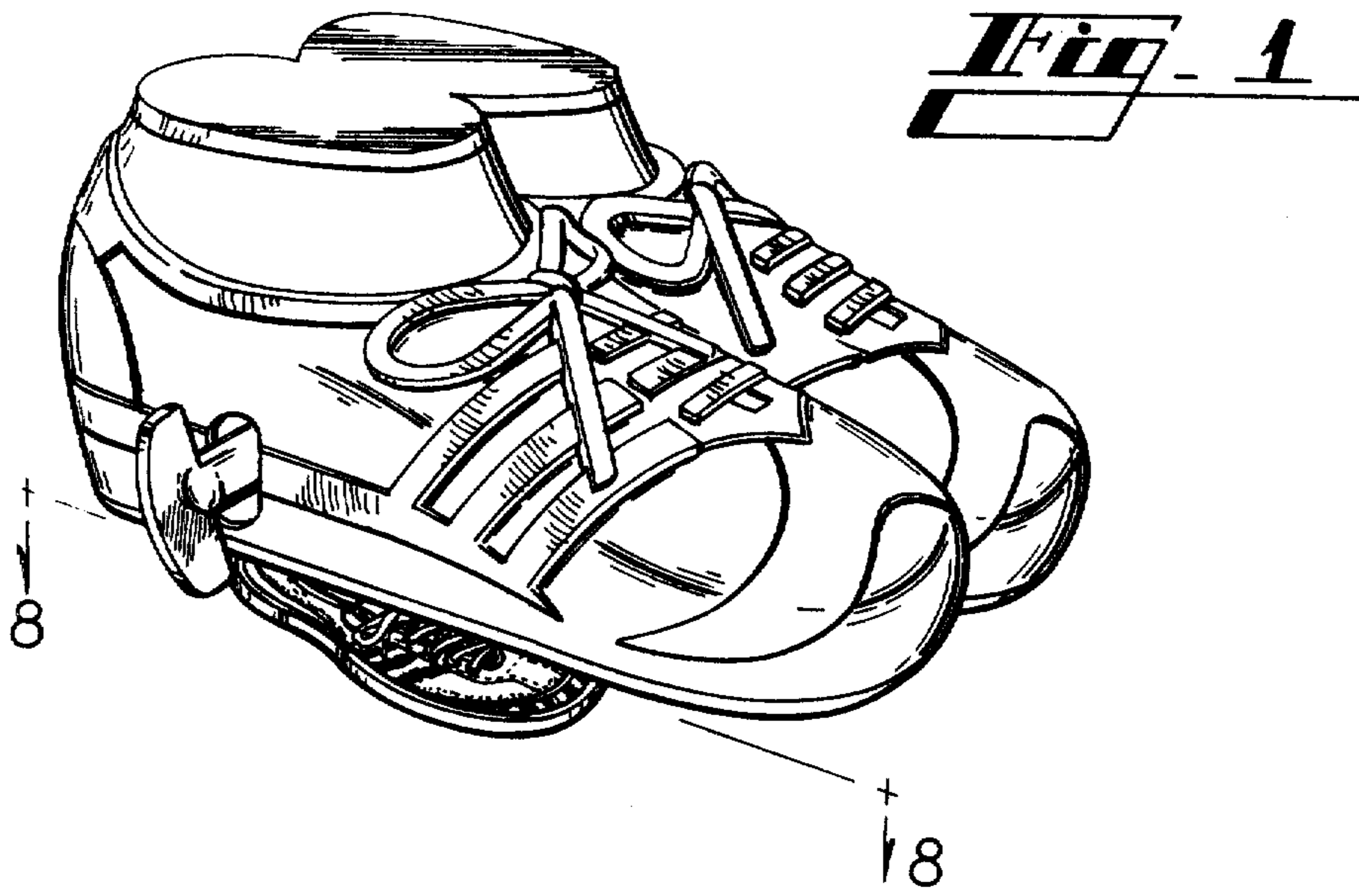
[57] **CLAIM**

as shown and described.

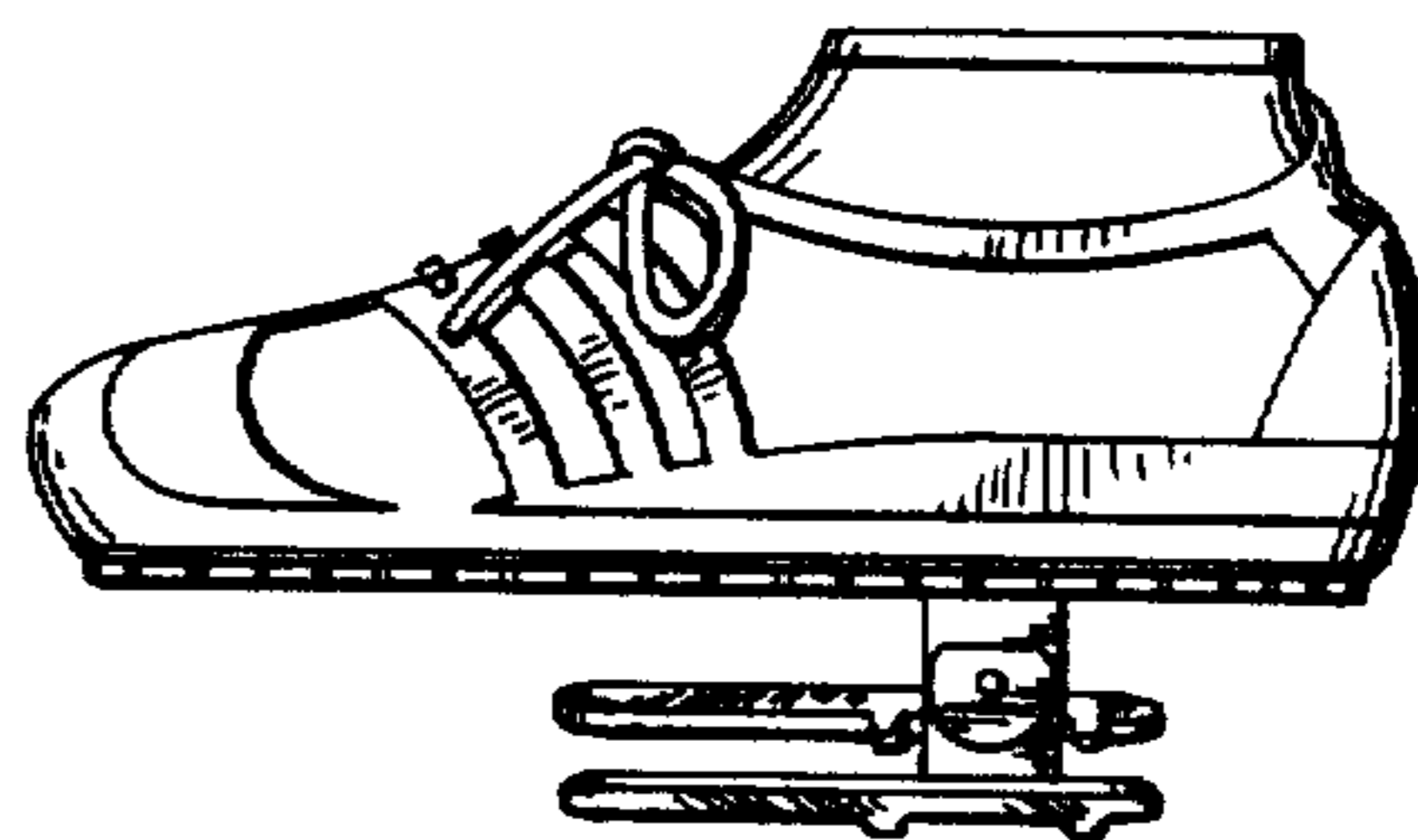
**DESCRIPTION**

8-8 in FIG. 1 shown on an enlarged scale.

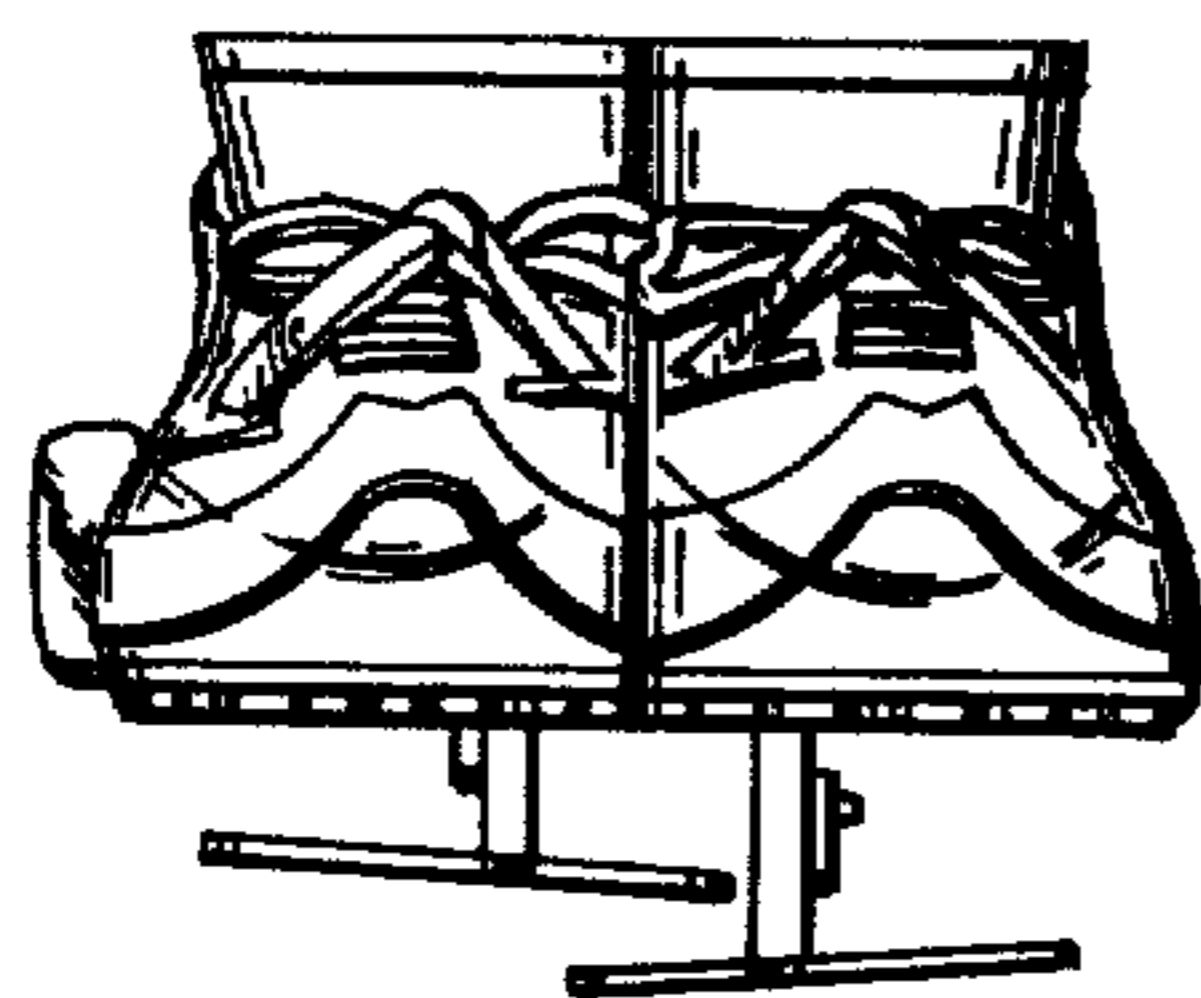




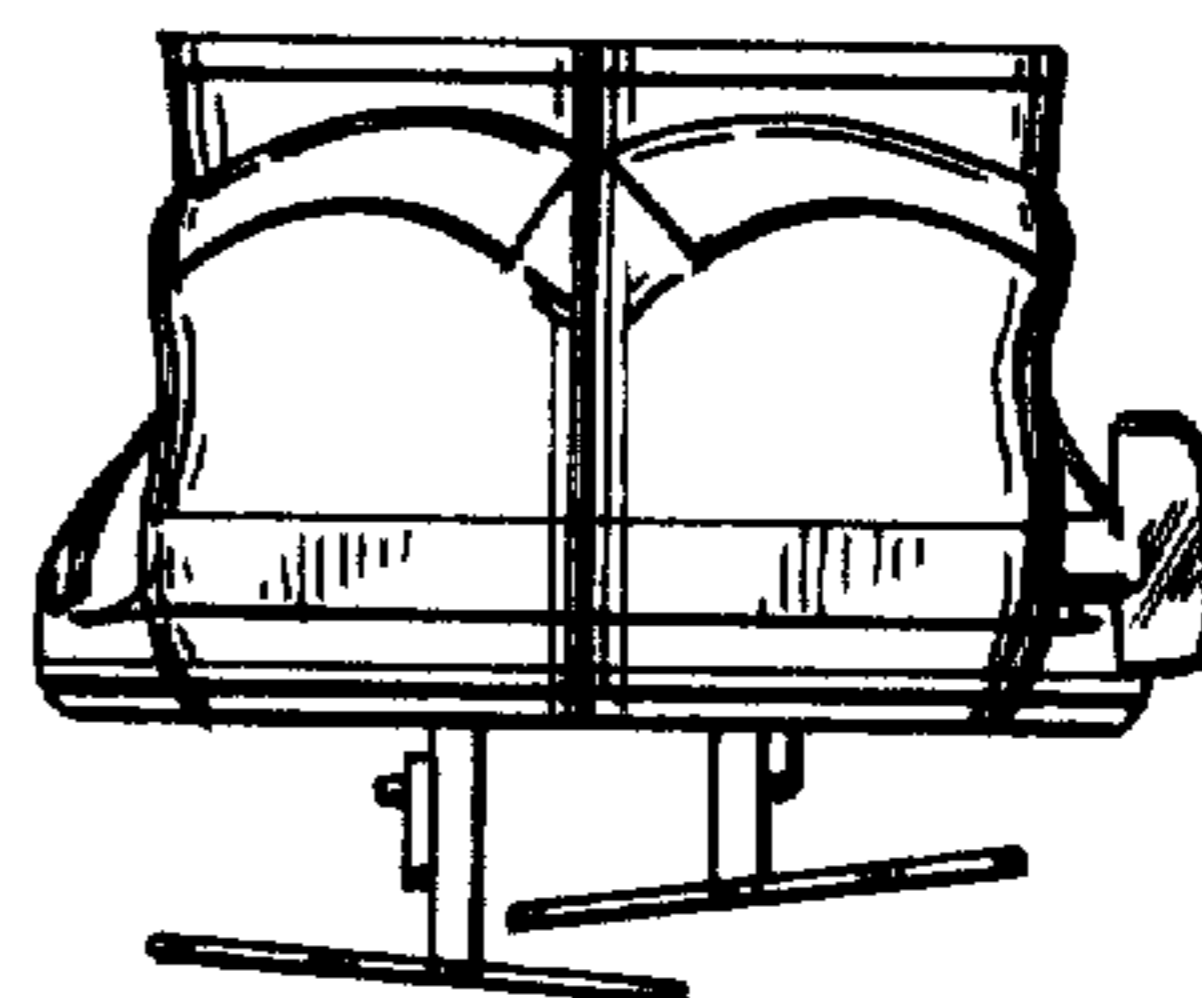

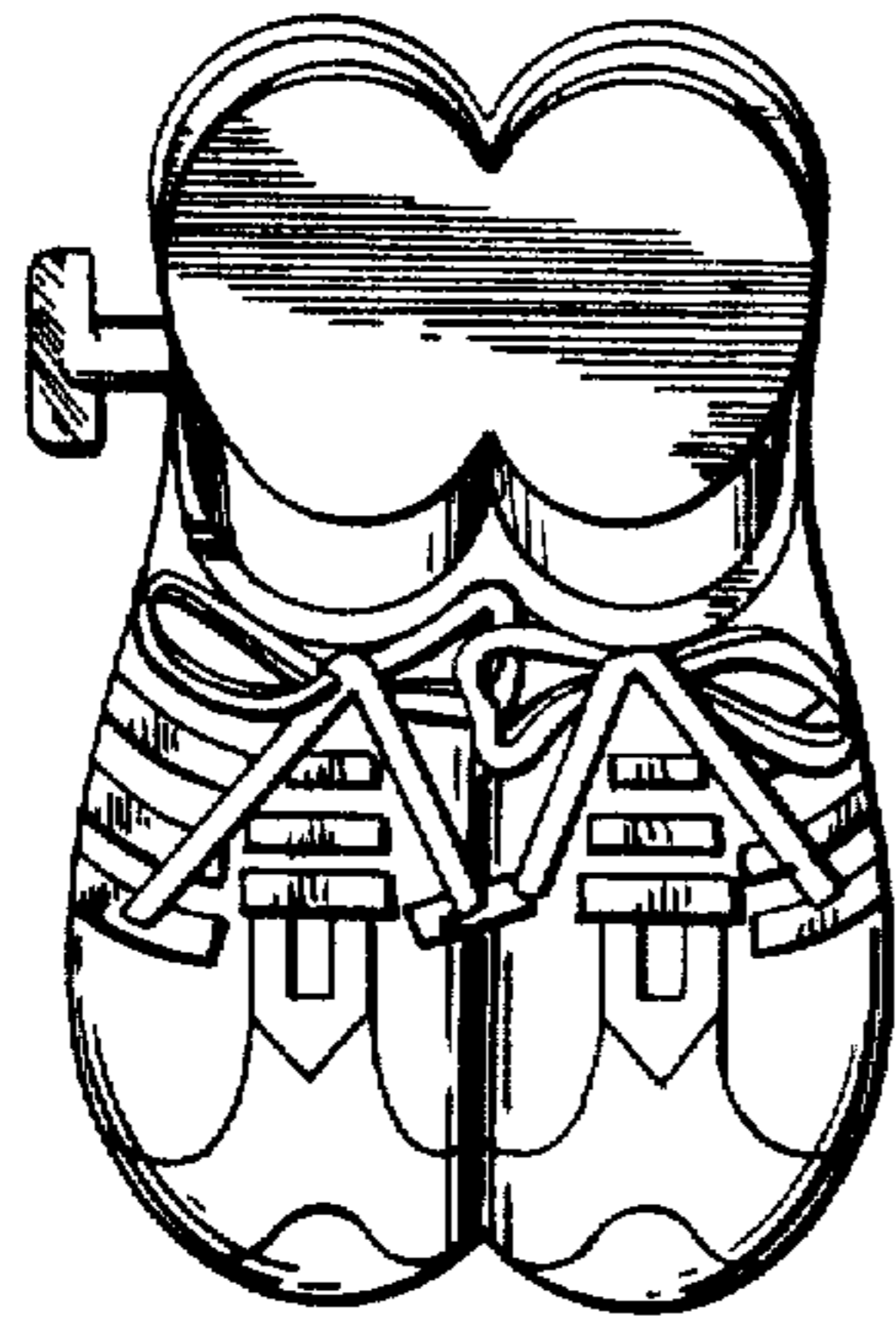

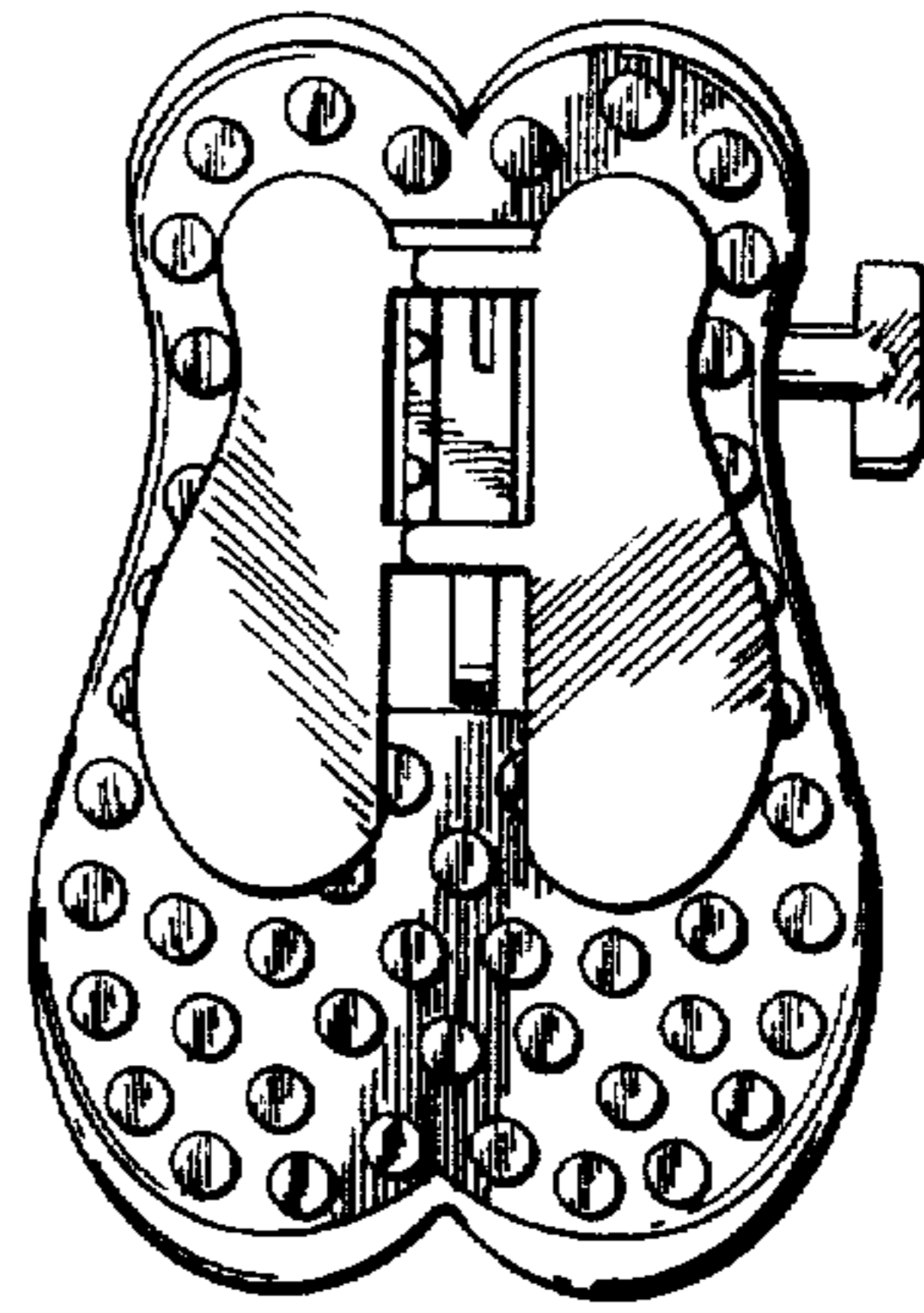
