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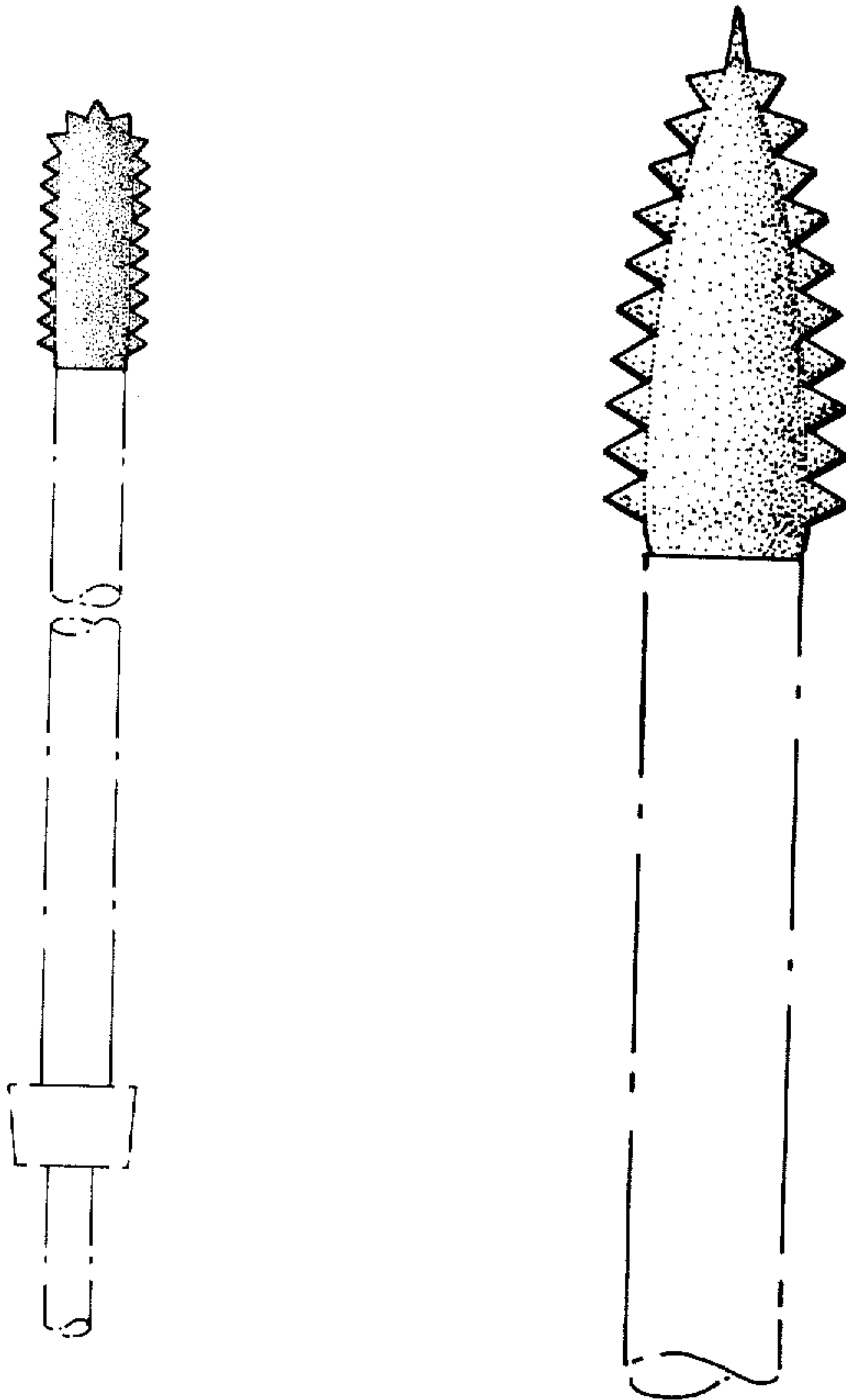

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a mascara applicator showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is an end elevational view thereof; and

A handle is shown in broken lines for illustration of the environment in which the applicator is intended to be used.



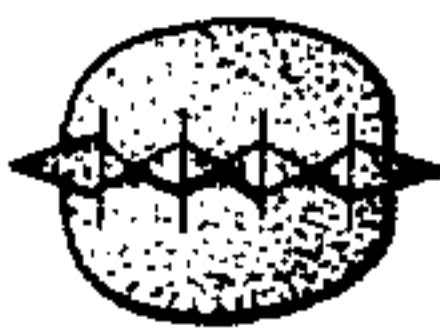

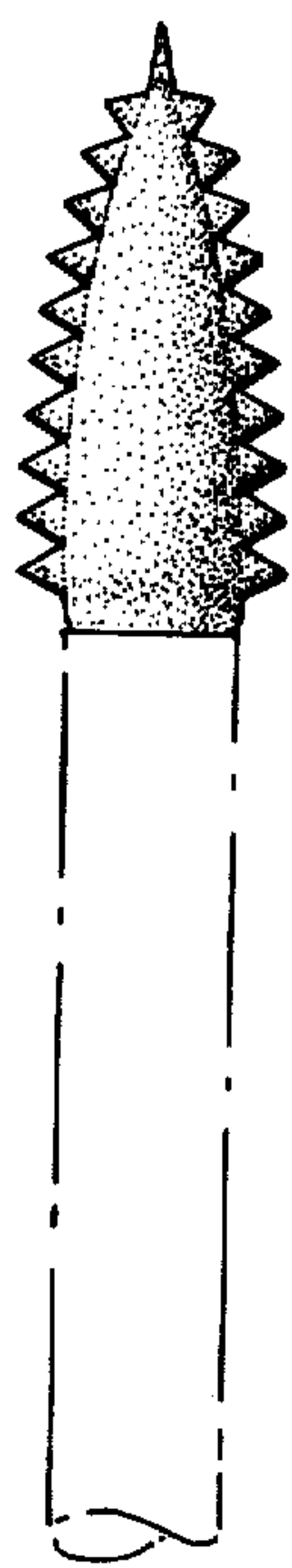

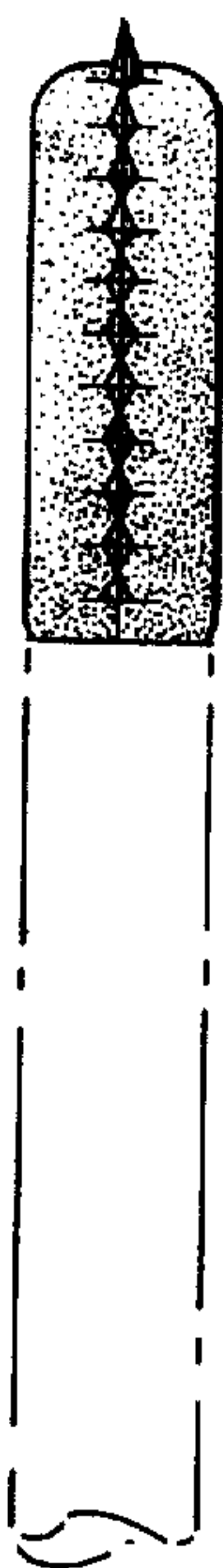

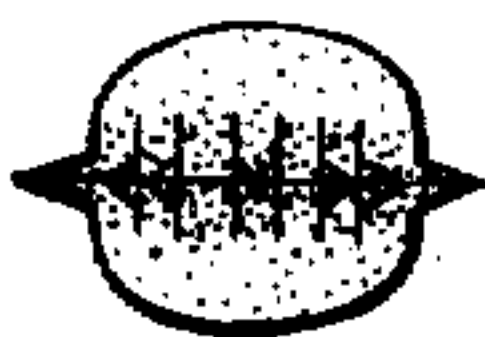
