[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a video cassette storage container, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a video cassette storage container showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an exploded left side elevational view with the front closure partly rotated, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is an elevational view thereof viewed from the side indicated by the line 3—3 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view thereof viewed from the side indicated by the line 4—4 of FIG. 2;


FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof with the closure shown exploded away from the container body;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof with the closure shown exploded away from the container body;


FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of the closure portion shown in FIG. 2;

FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of the closure portion shown in FIG. 2; and


FIG. 9 is an elevational view of an alternative configuration of the container body viewed from the side indicated by the line 4—4 in FIG. 2. Except for the vertical dimension, all exterior views of the container and corresponding closure are the same as previously illustrated.




Fig. 9
