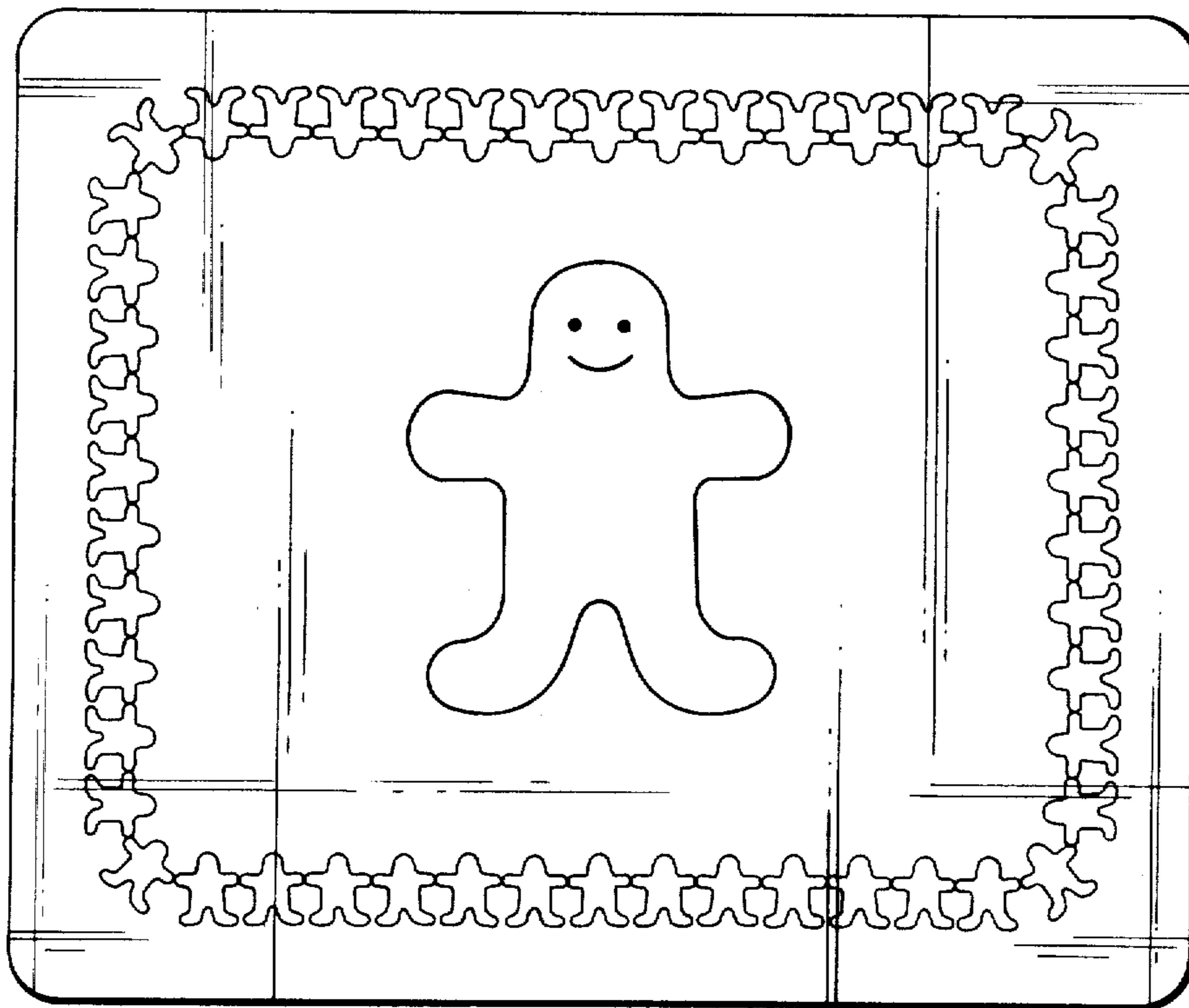
CLAIM

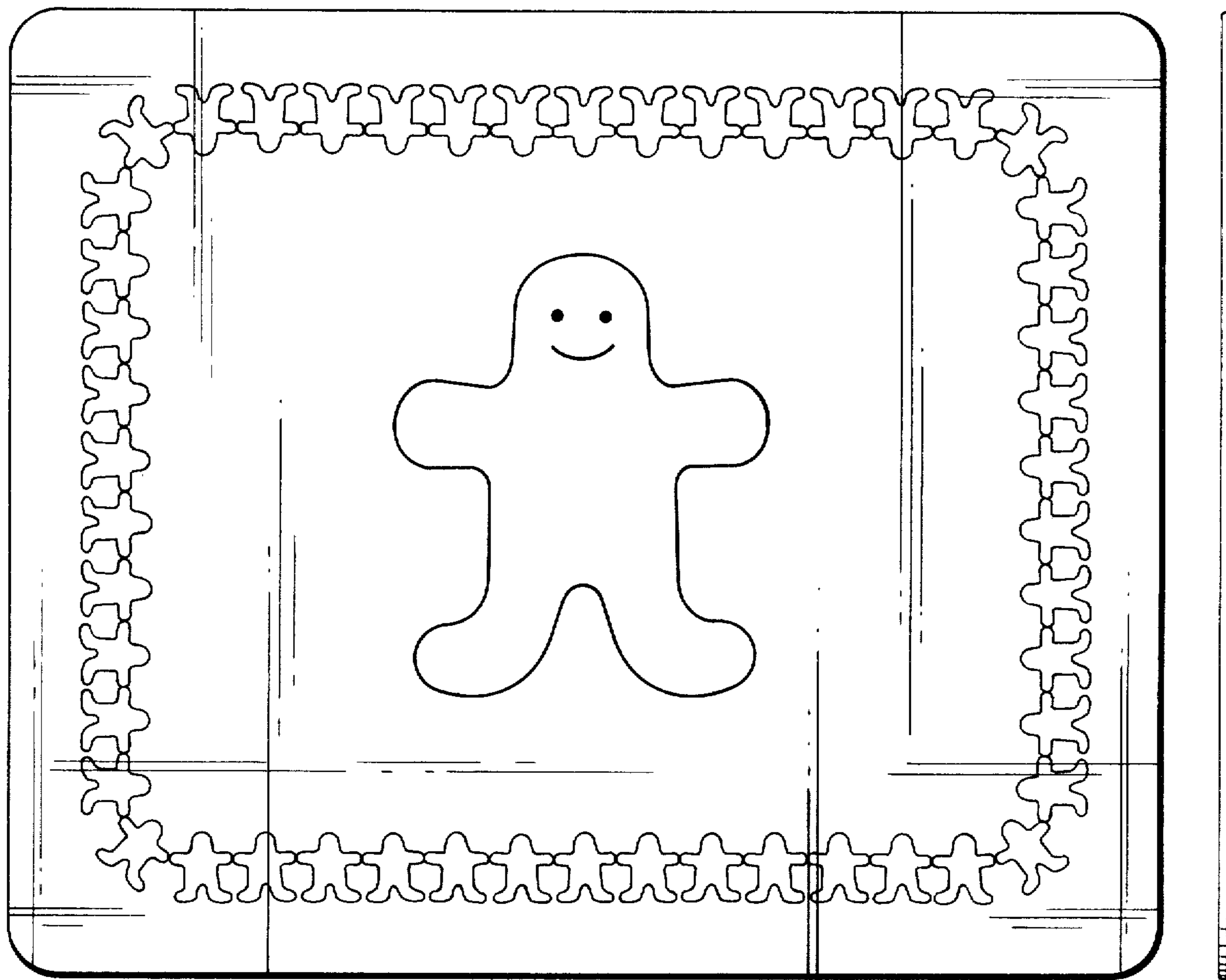
