The ornamental design for a combined display hanger and mailing package or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, perspective view of a combined display hanger and mailing package or similar article showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view in an unfolded condition.
