The ornamental design for a phonograph cartridge box,
substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a phonograph
cartridge box showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side view thereof, the opposite side view
being identical;
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is an exploded view thereof showing the upper
lid displaced from the bottom of the box.

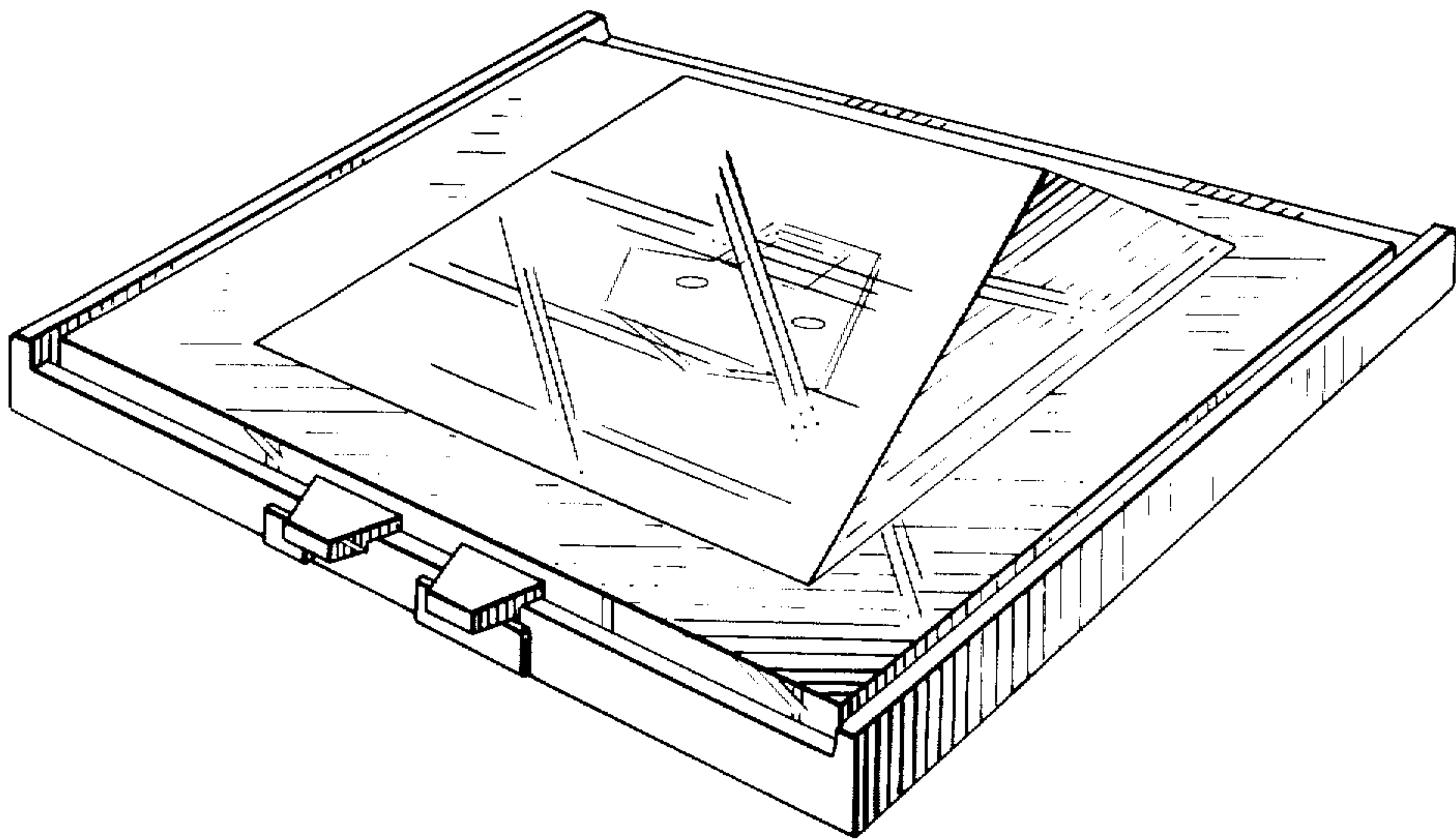

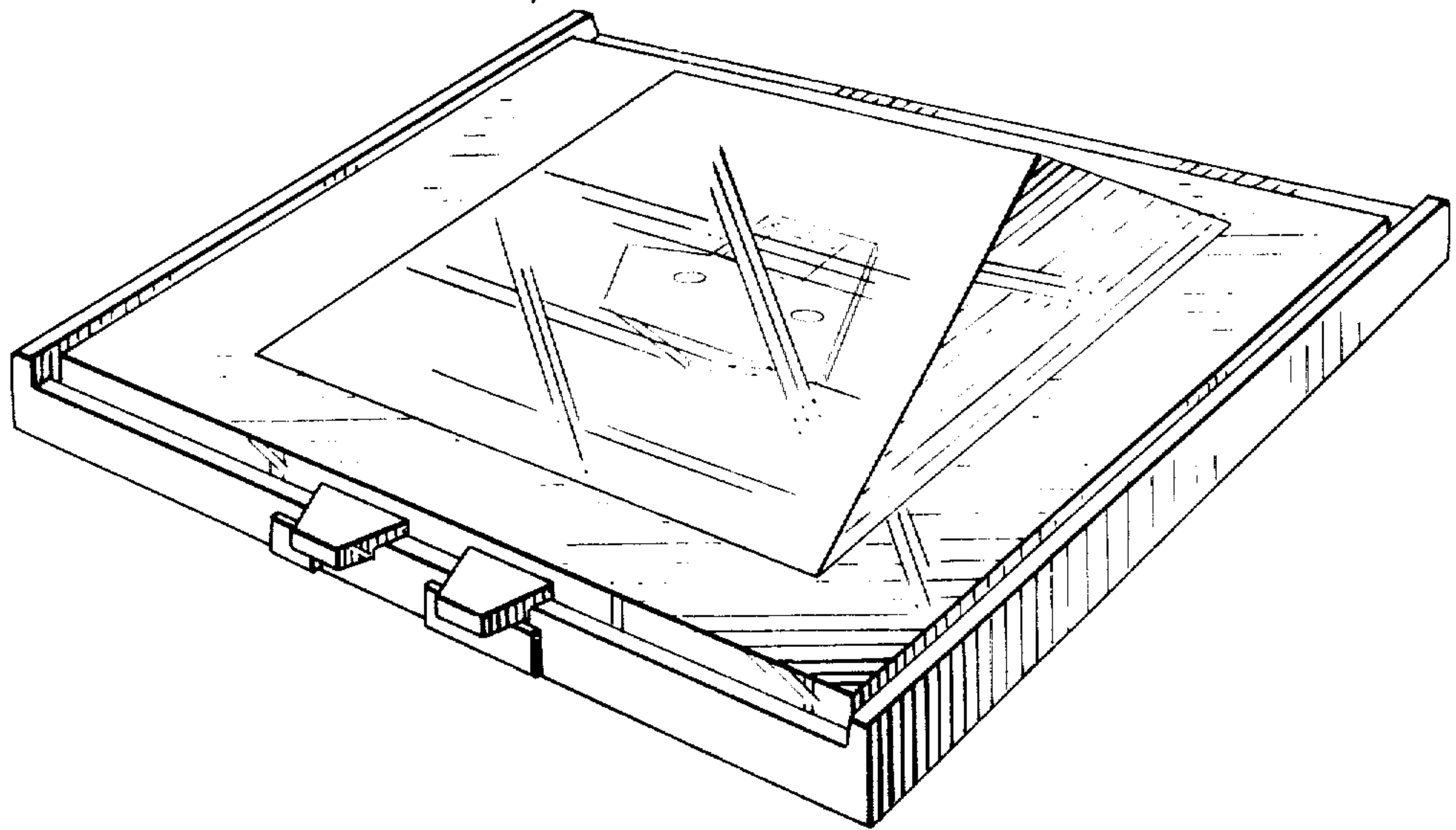

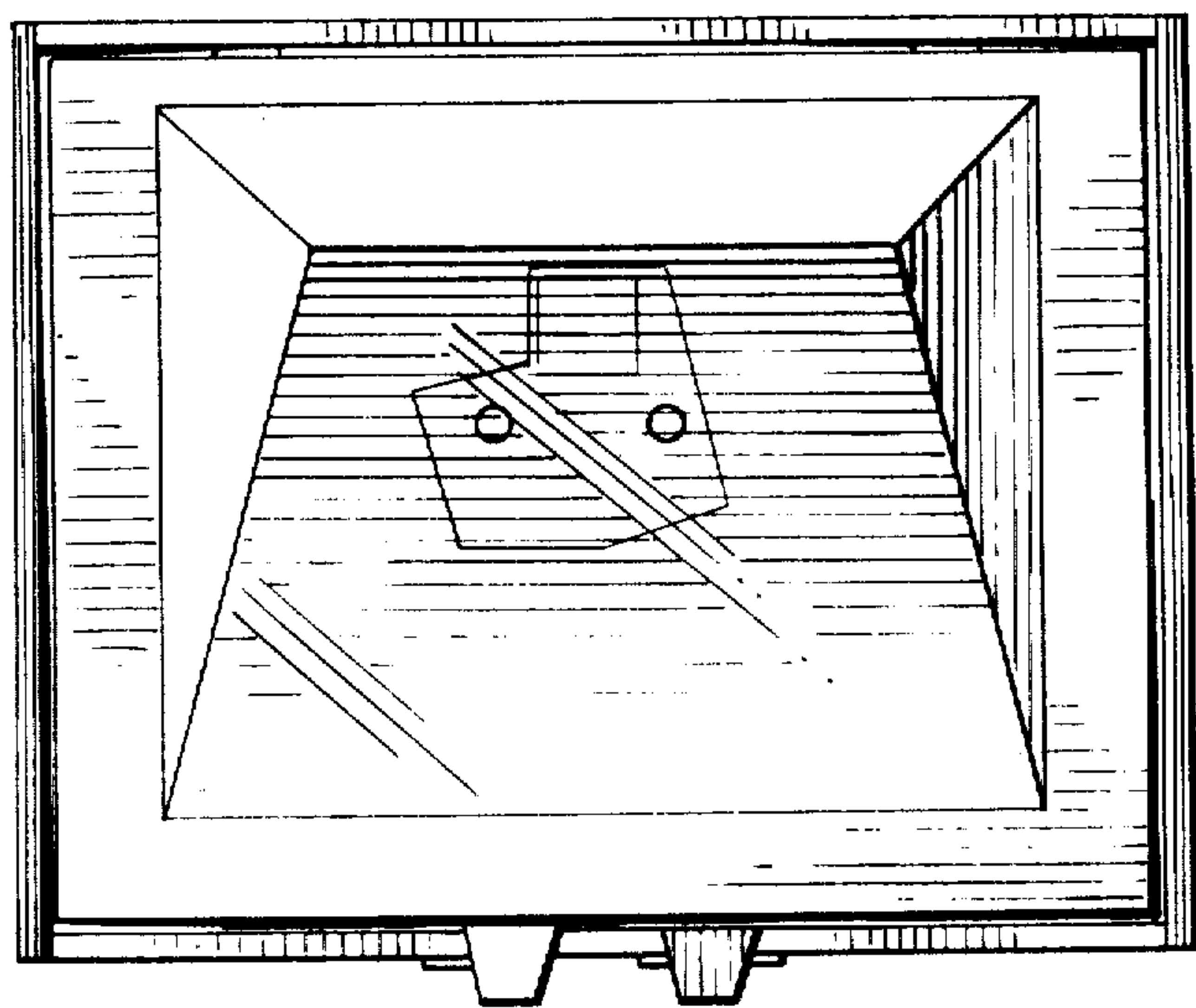

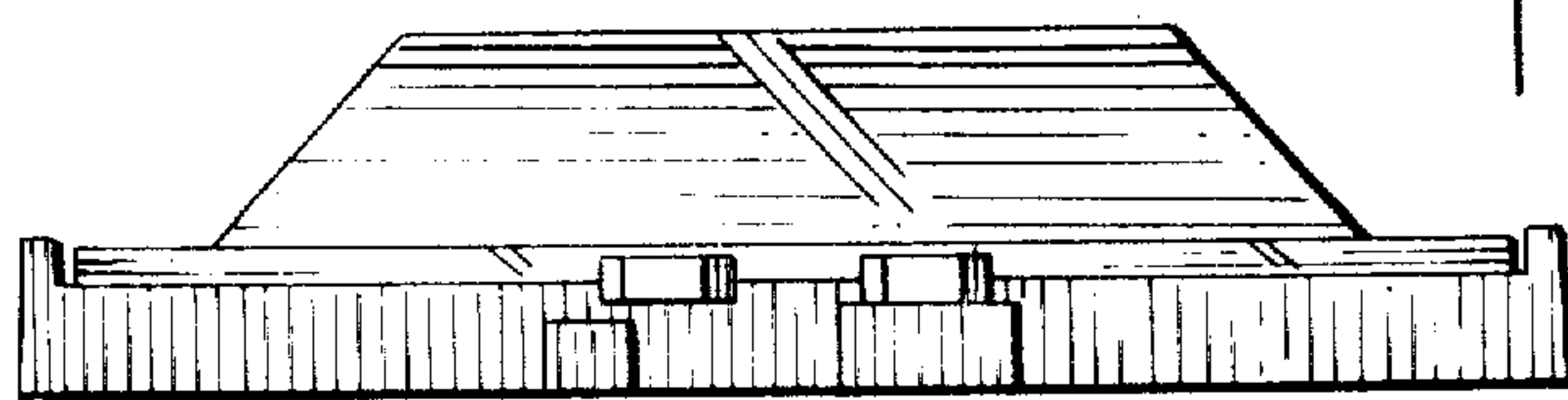

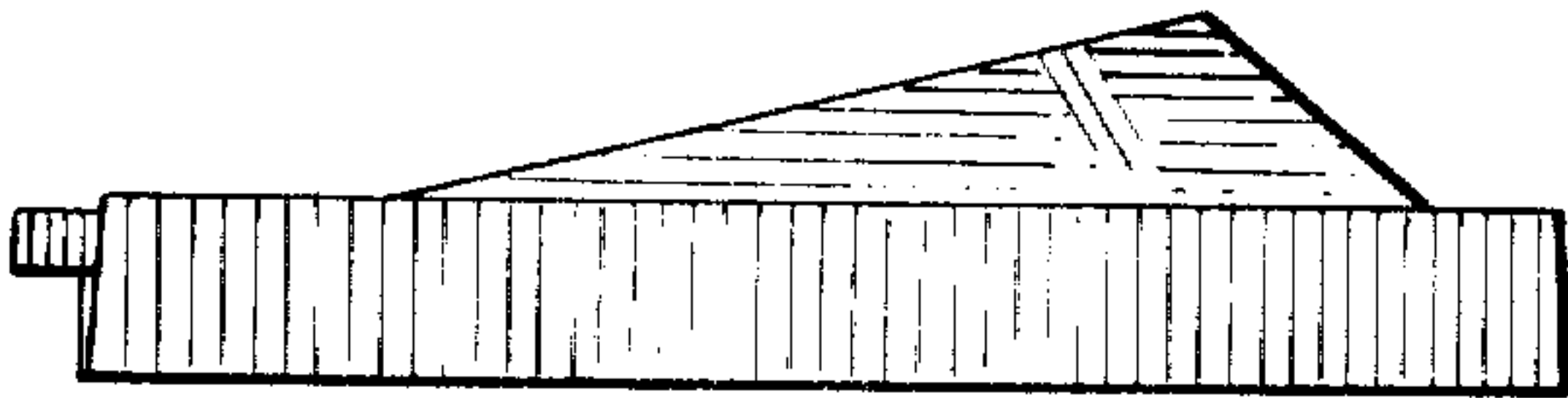

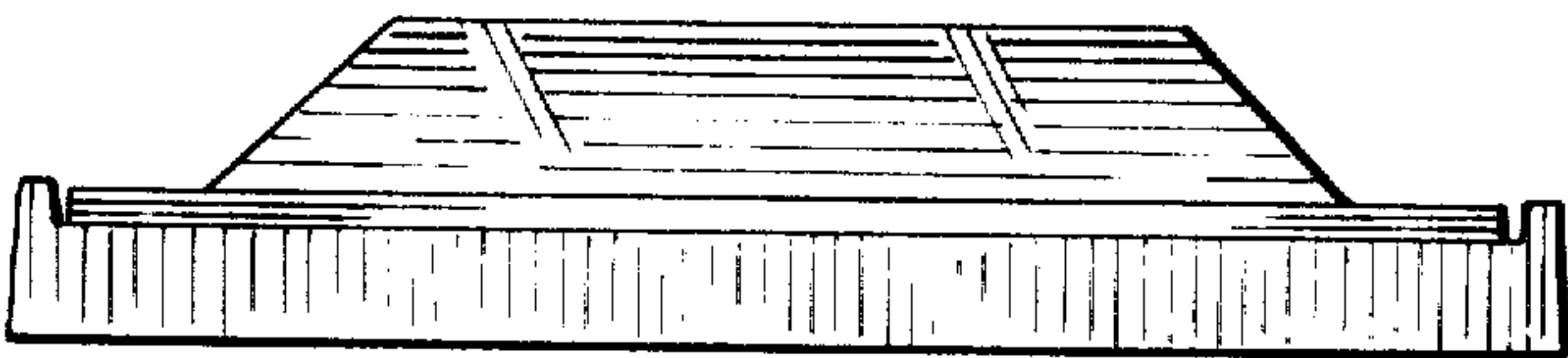
