[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined clock and desk holder for note paper and writing instruments, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a combined clock and desk holder for note paper and writing instruments showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.
