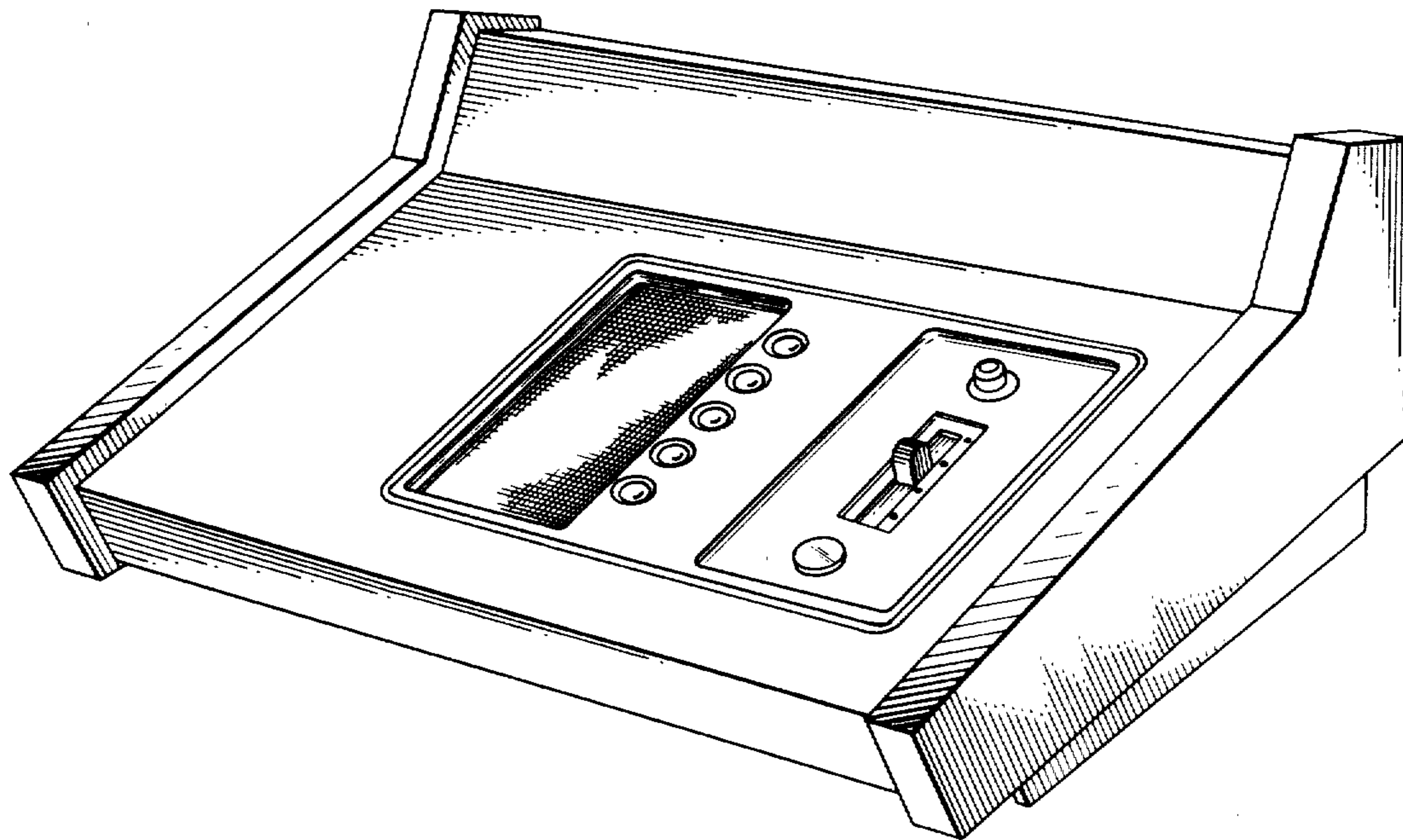

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a security system console incorporating the features of the present invention; FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the security system console; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the security system console; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the security system console; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the security system console.



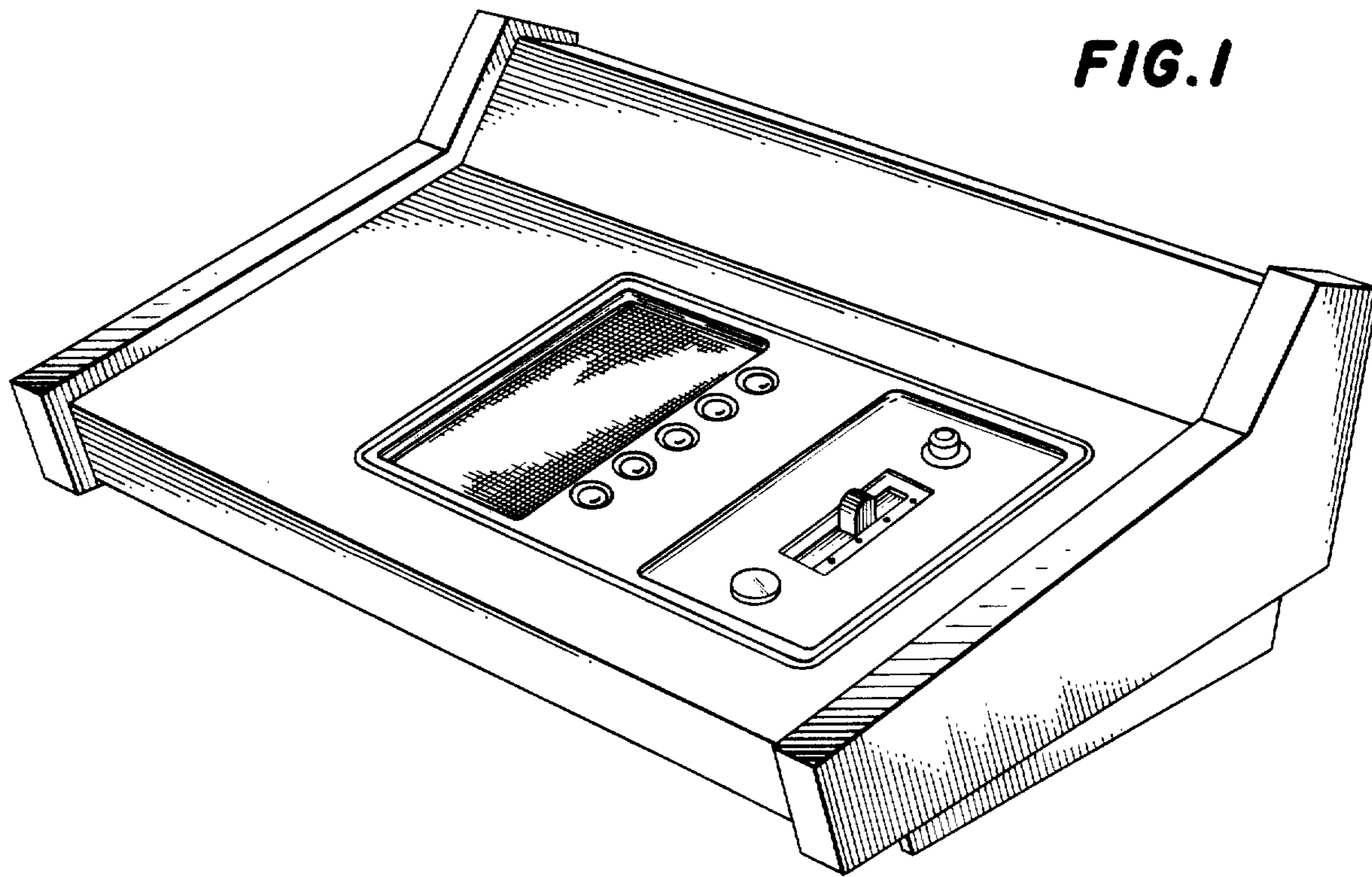

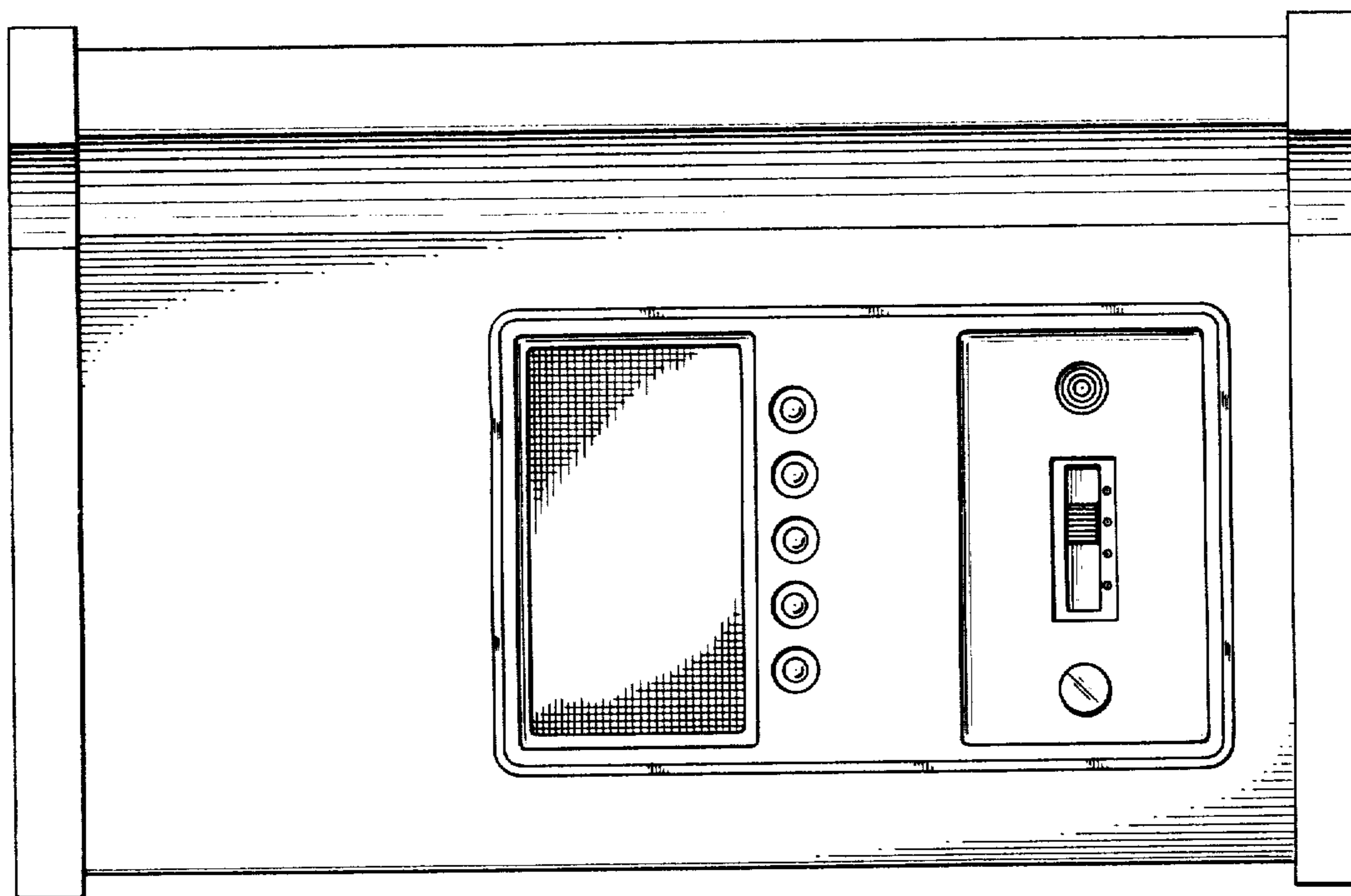

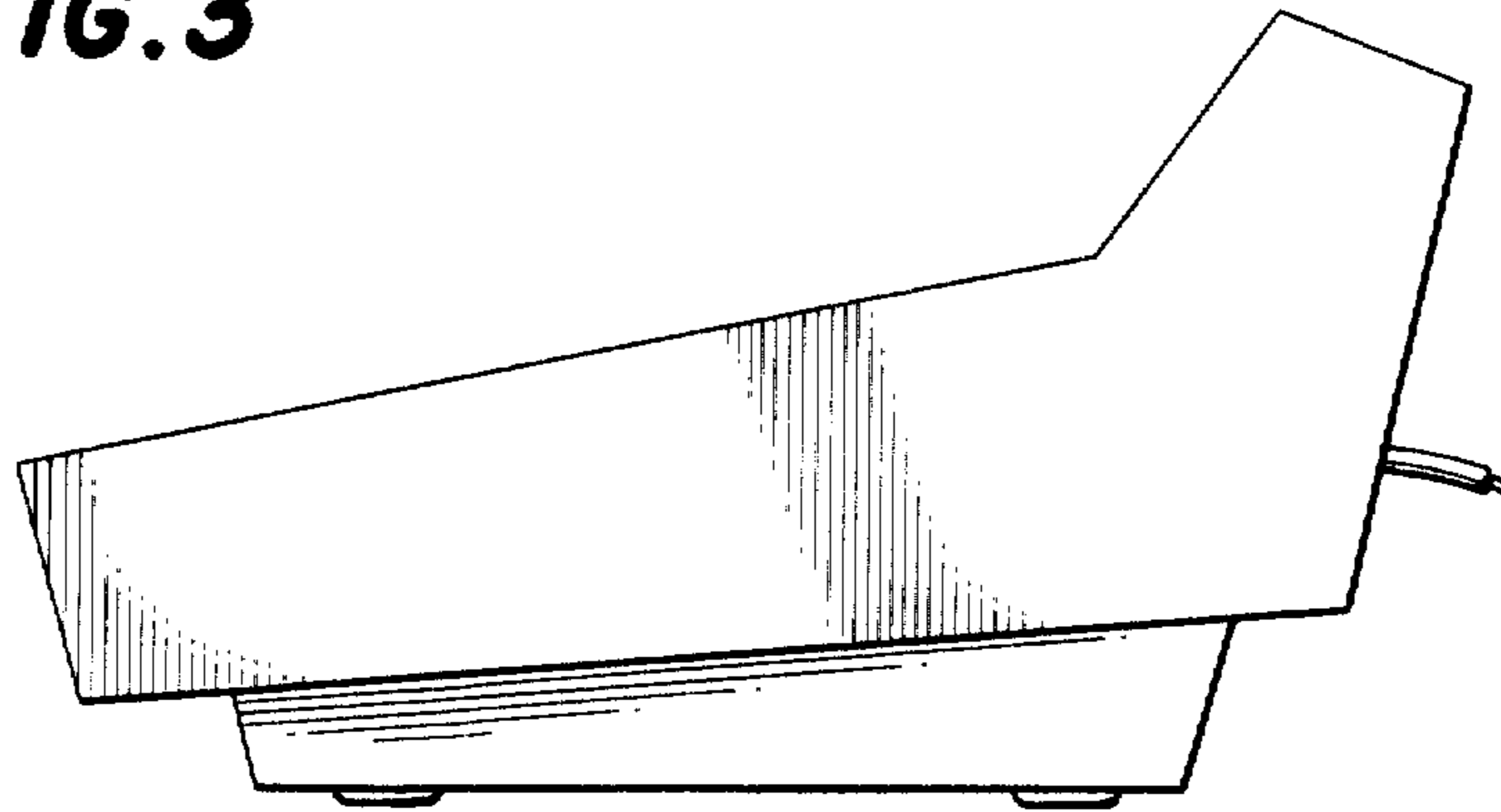

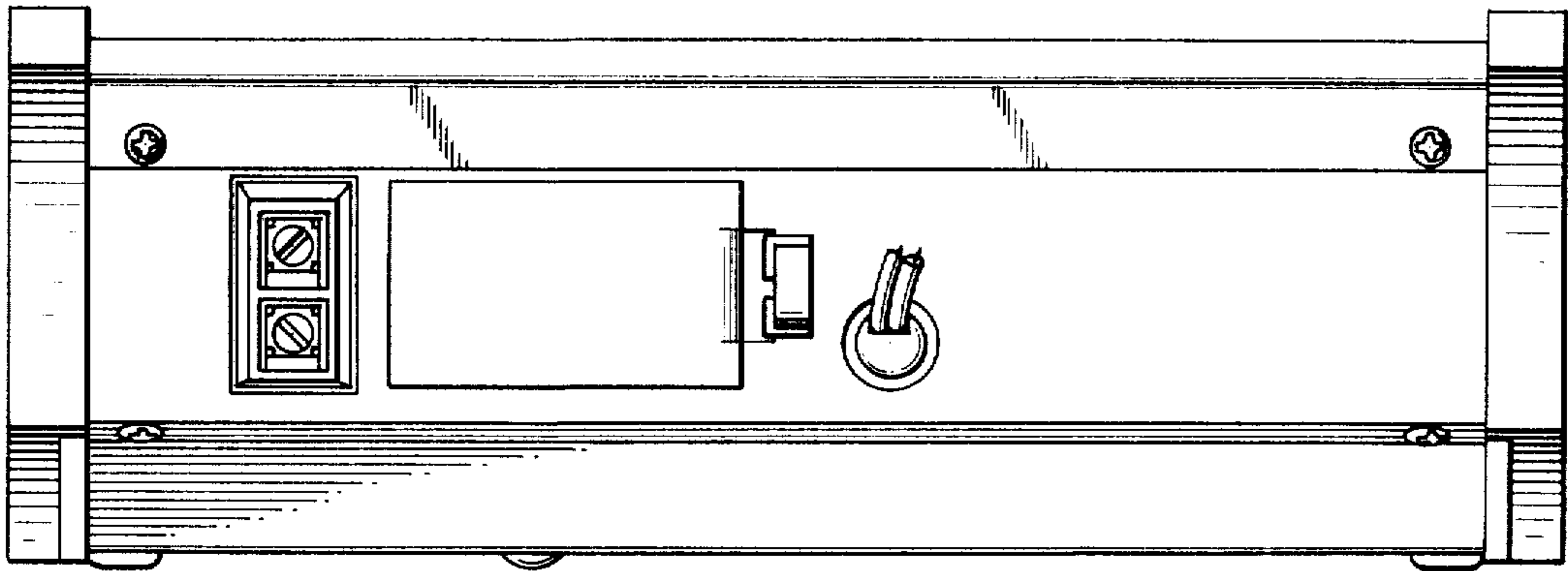
