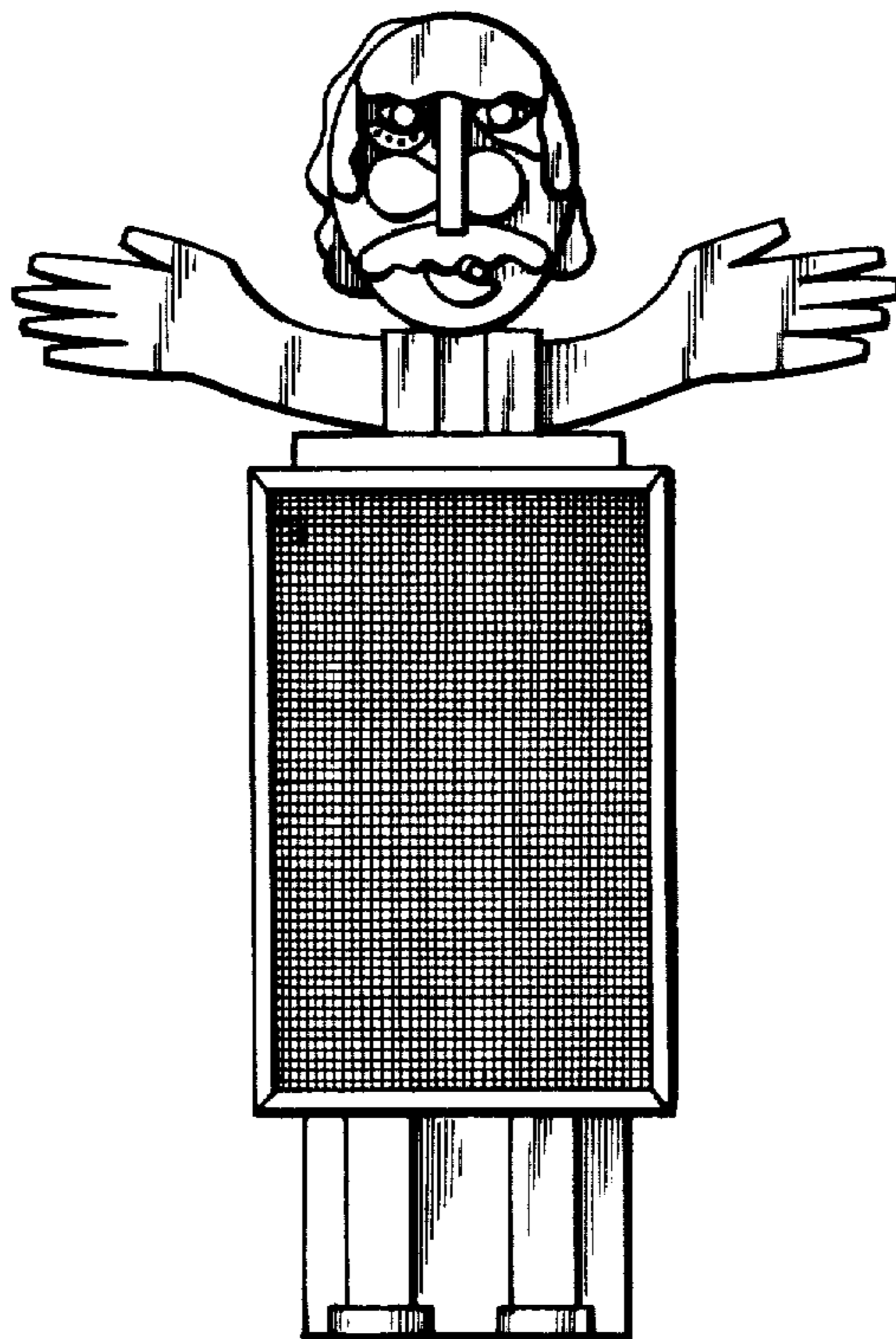

The ornamental design for a loud speaker cabinet, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view.



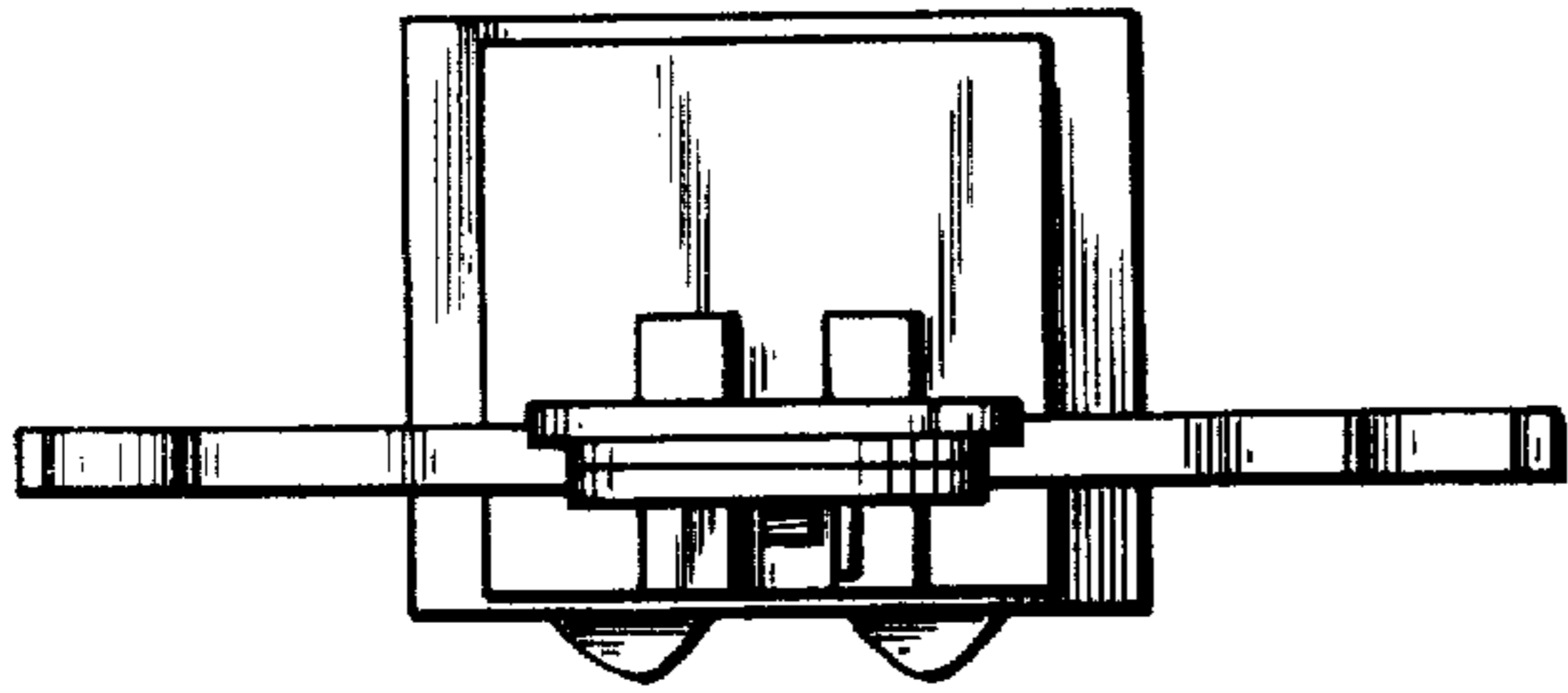

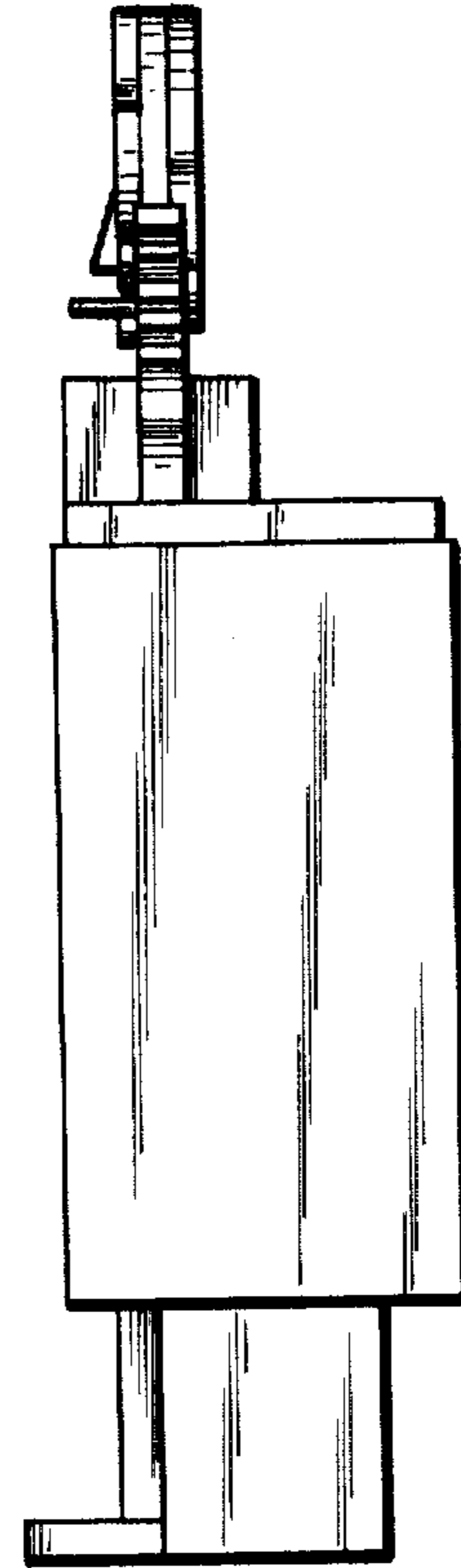

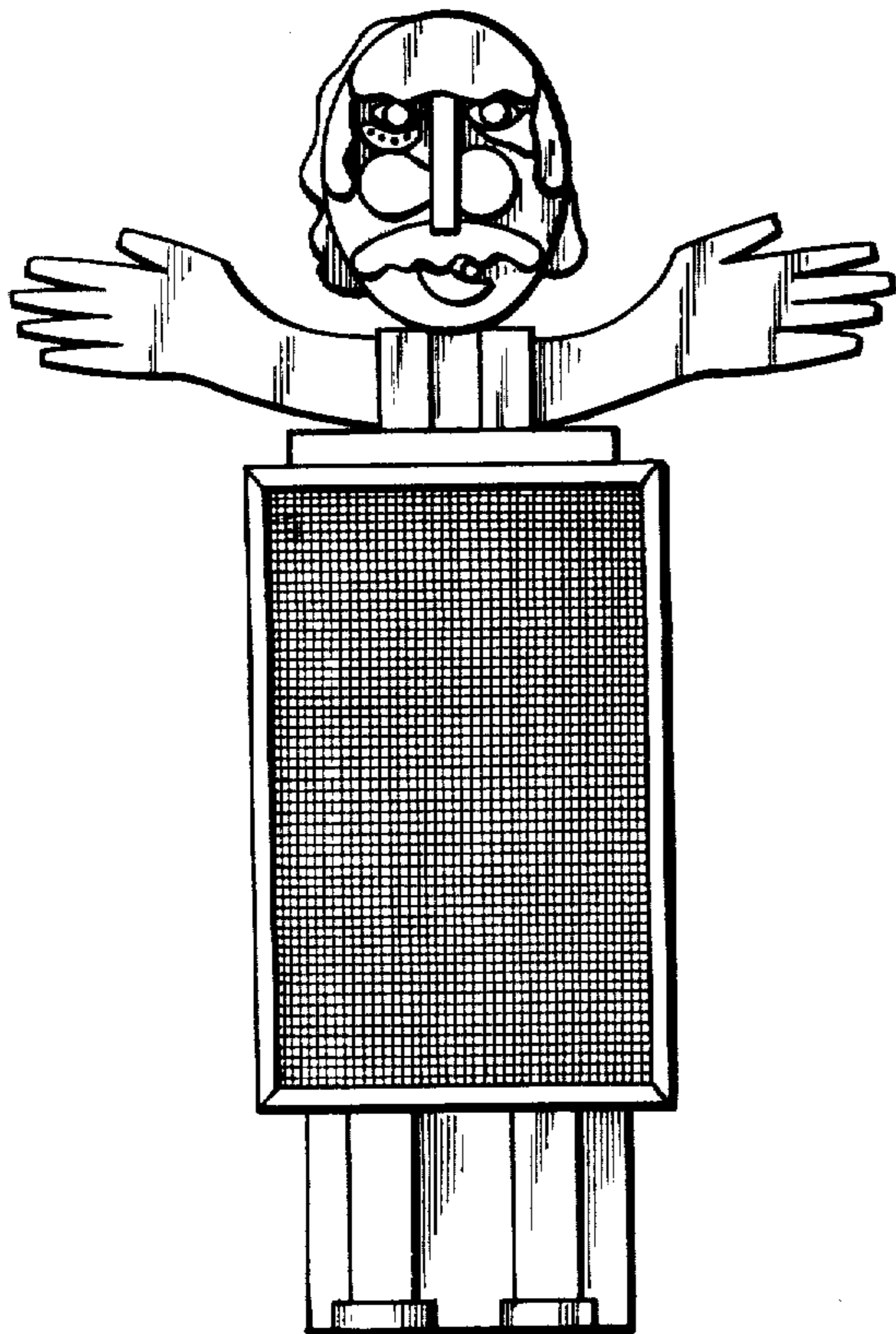

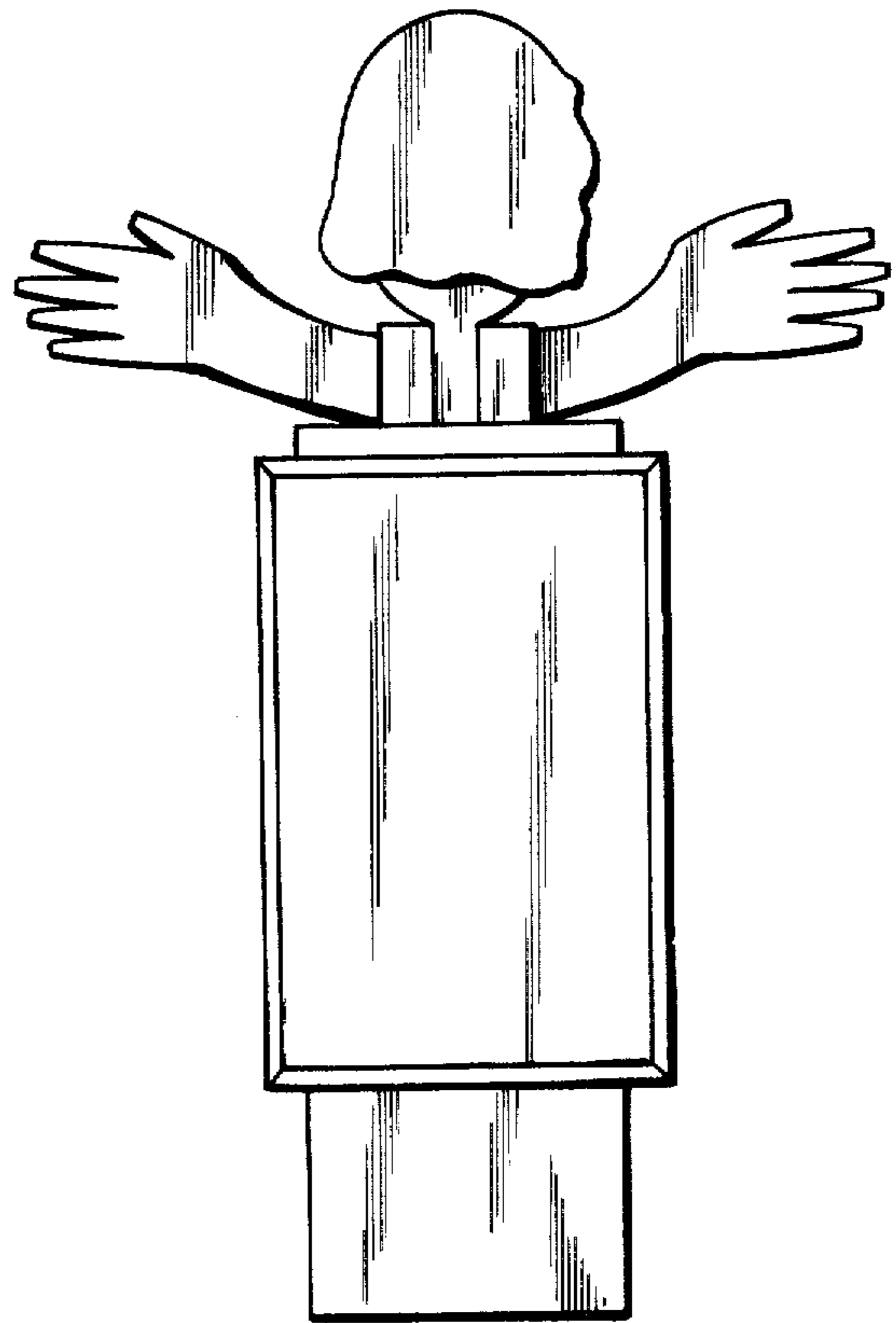
