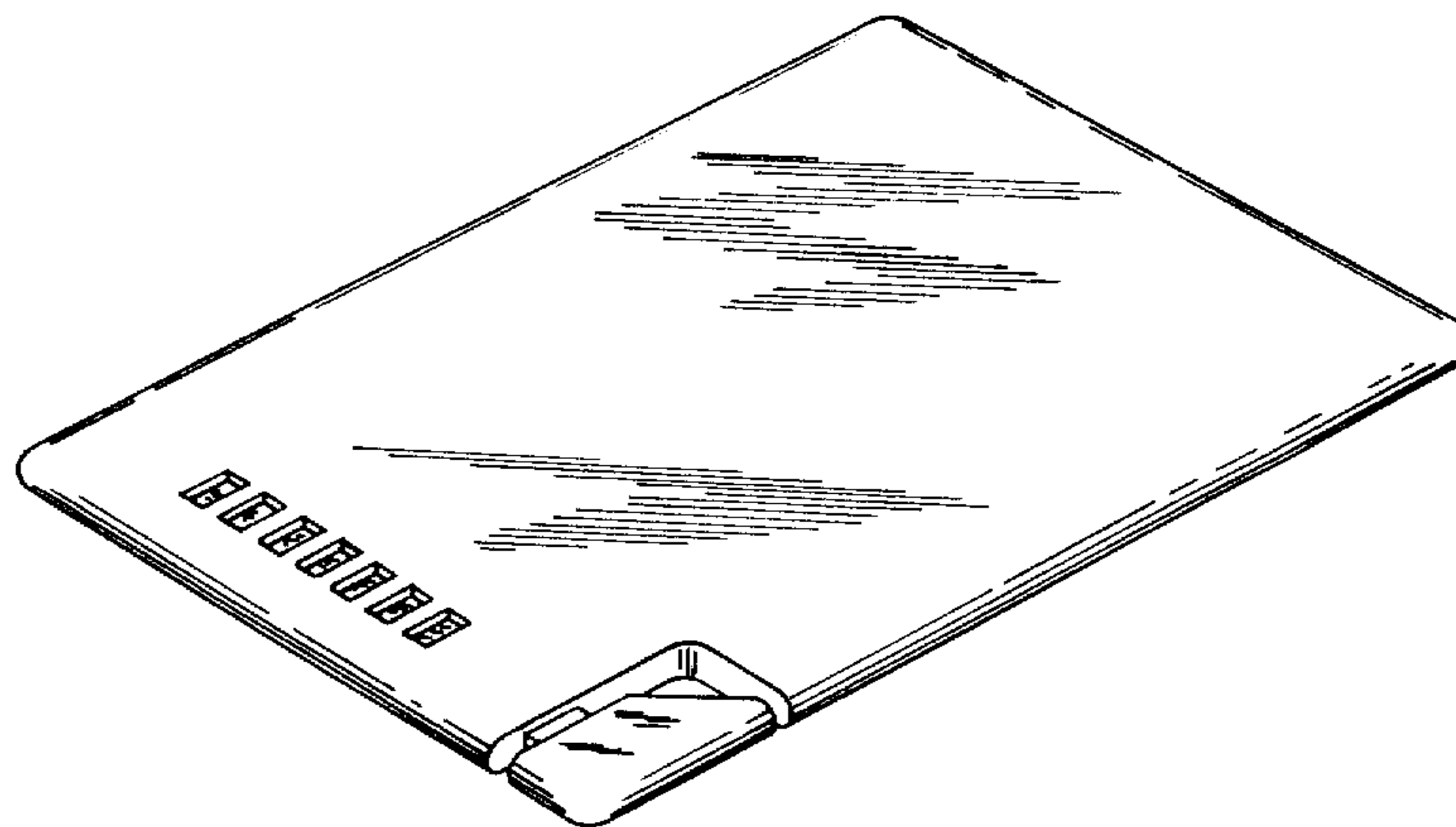
The ornamental design for an electronic memory credit card with frangible portion, as shown.

FIG. 3 is a left-hand elevational view.



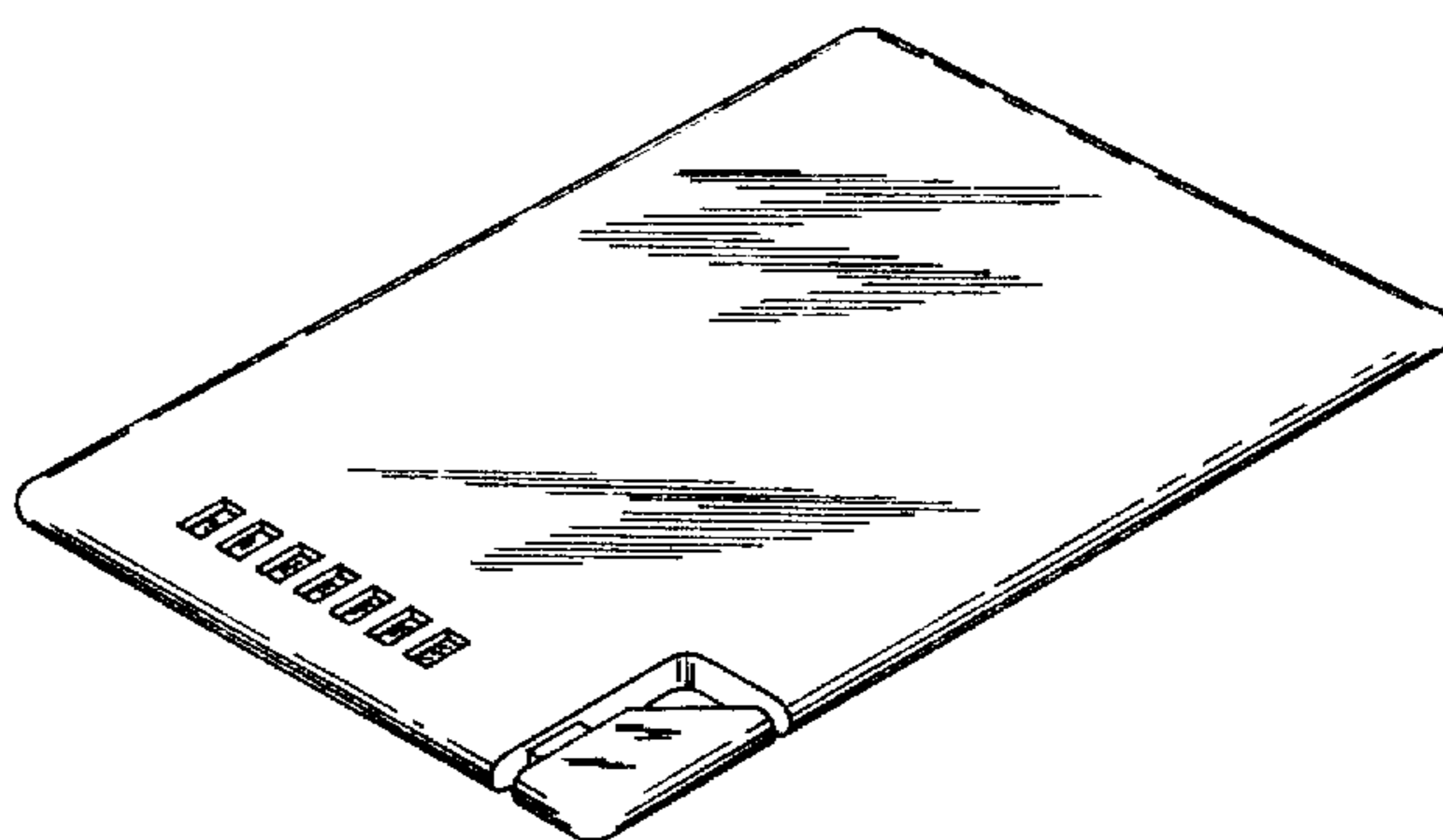

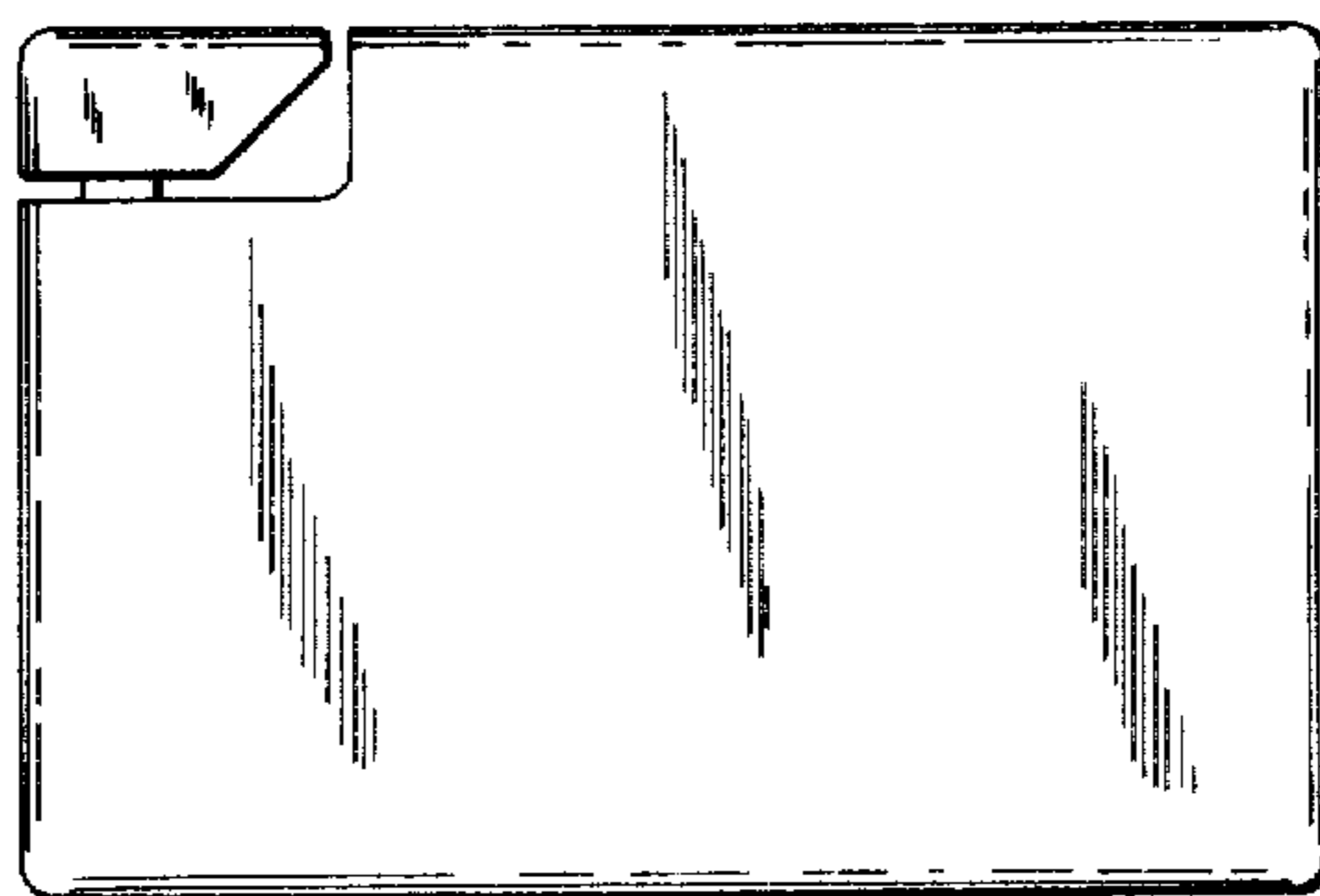

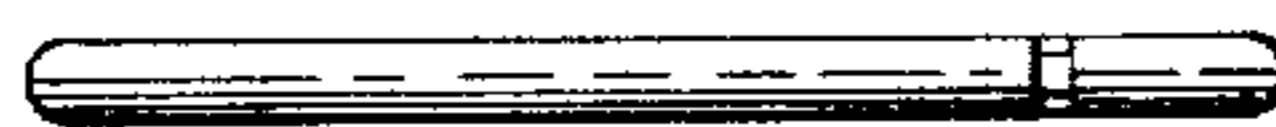
