DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of the hockey stick showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front view of FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a rear view of FIG. 1.

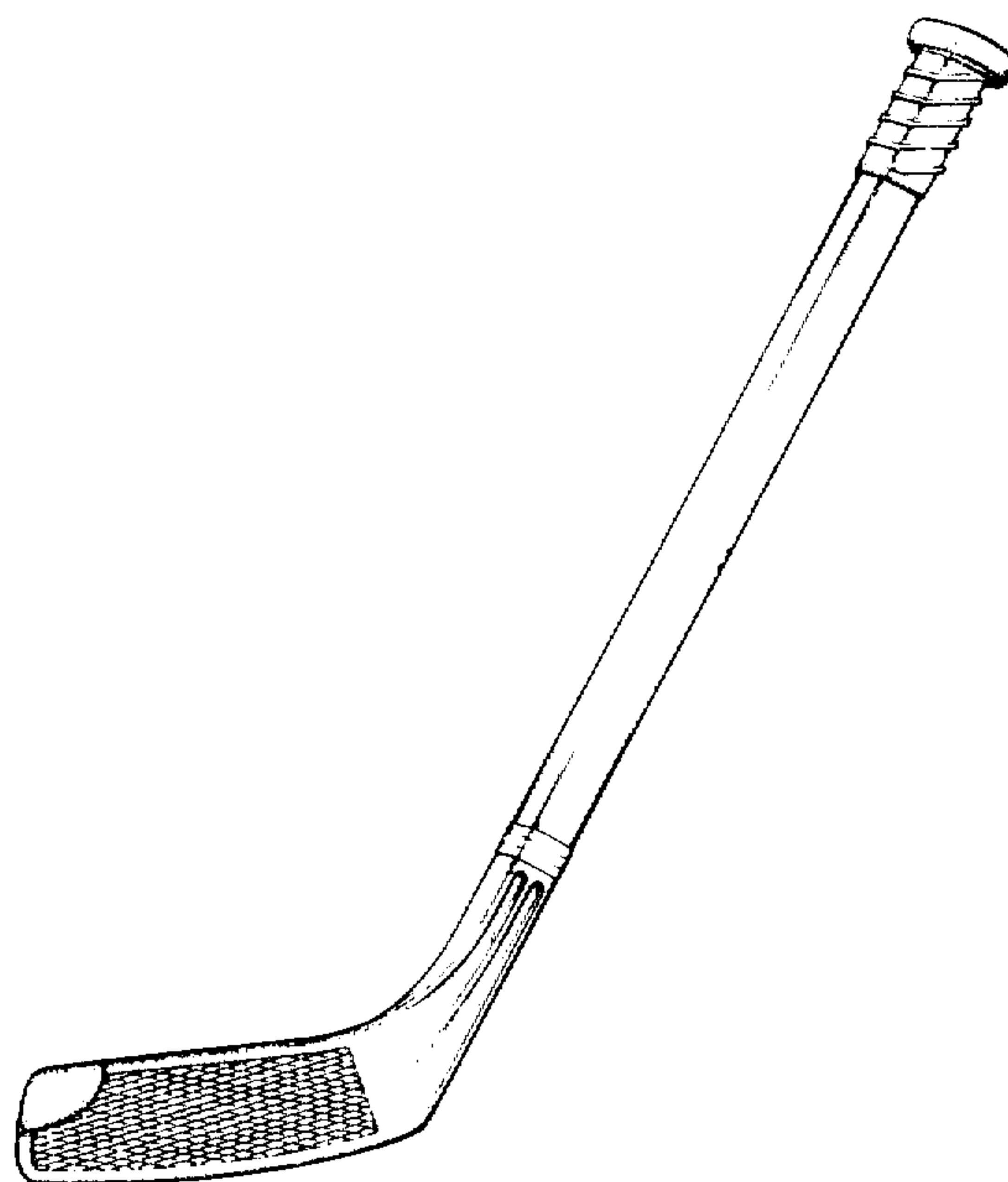
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of FIG. 2.

FIG. 7 is an end section from the right hand side.



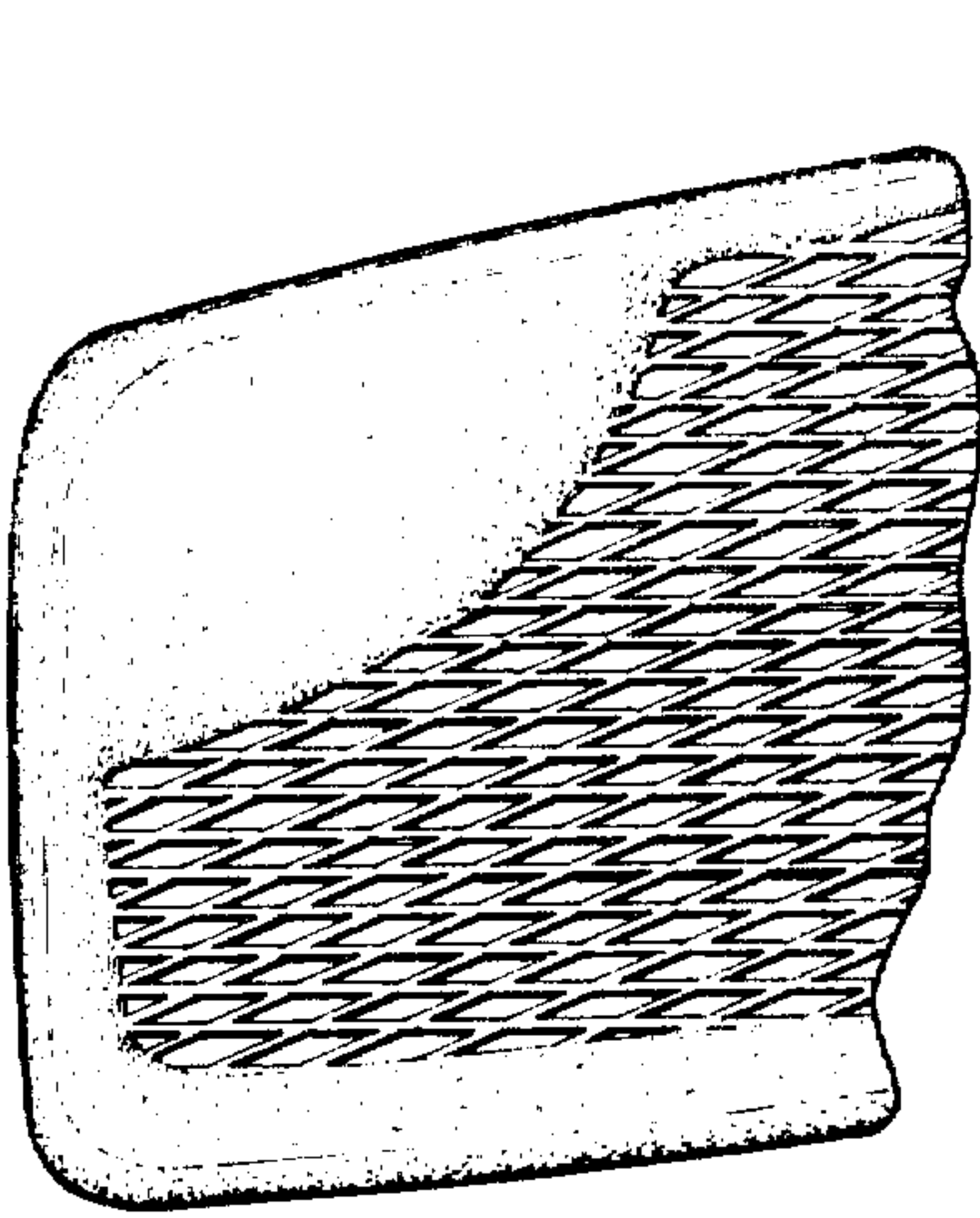

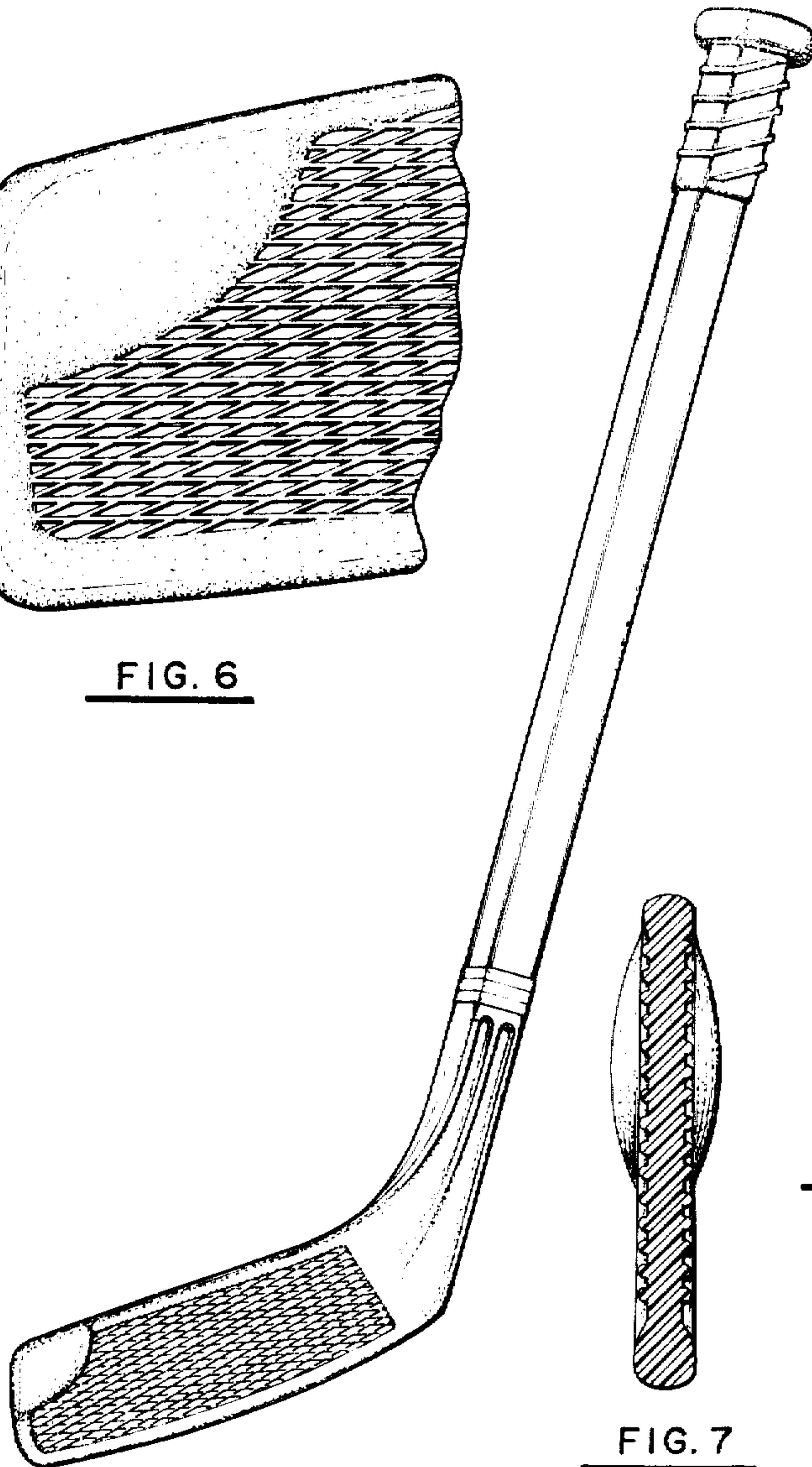

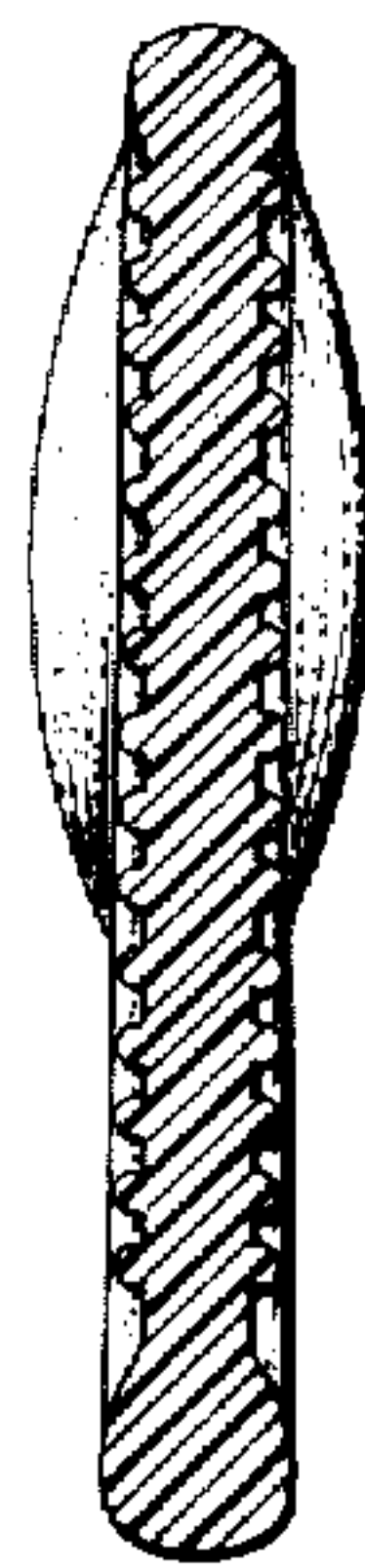

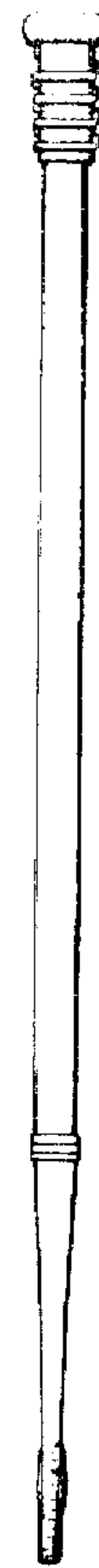

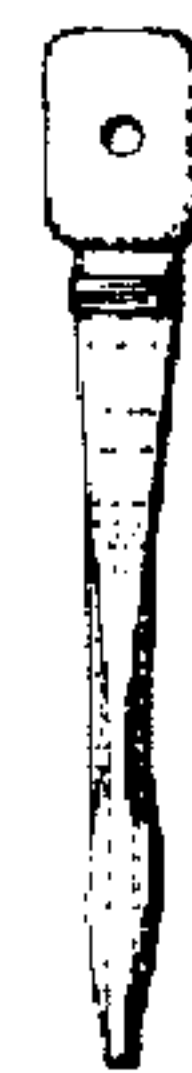
