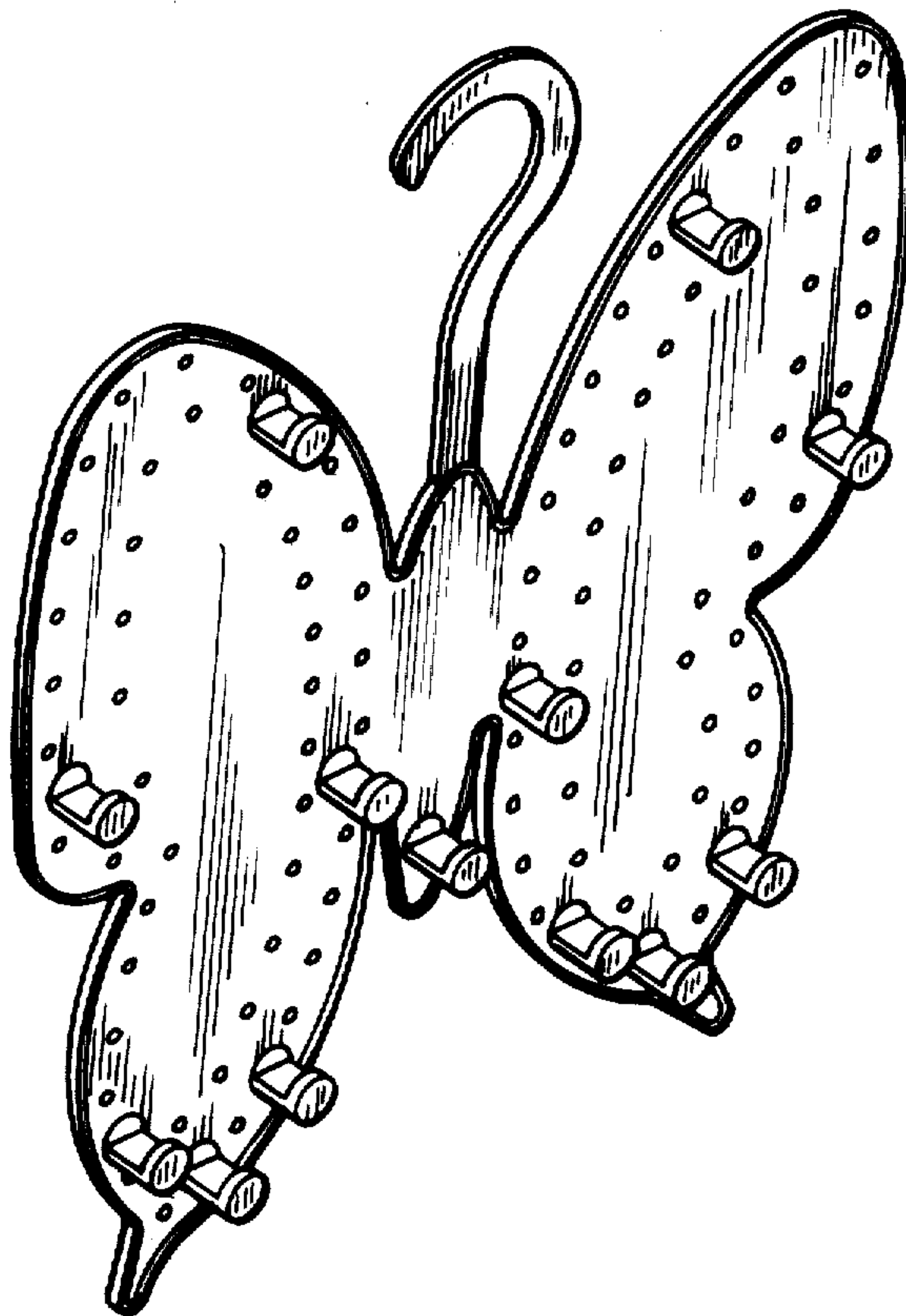

 FIG. 7 is a side view taken from the right of FIG. 1.



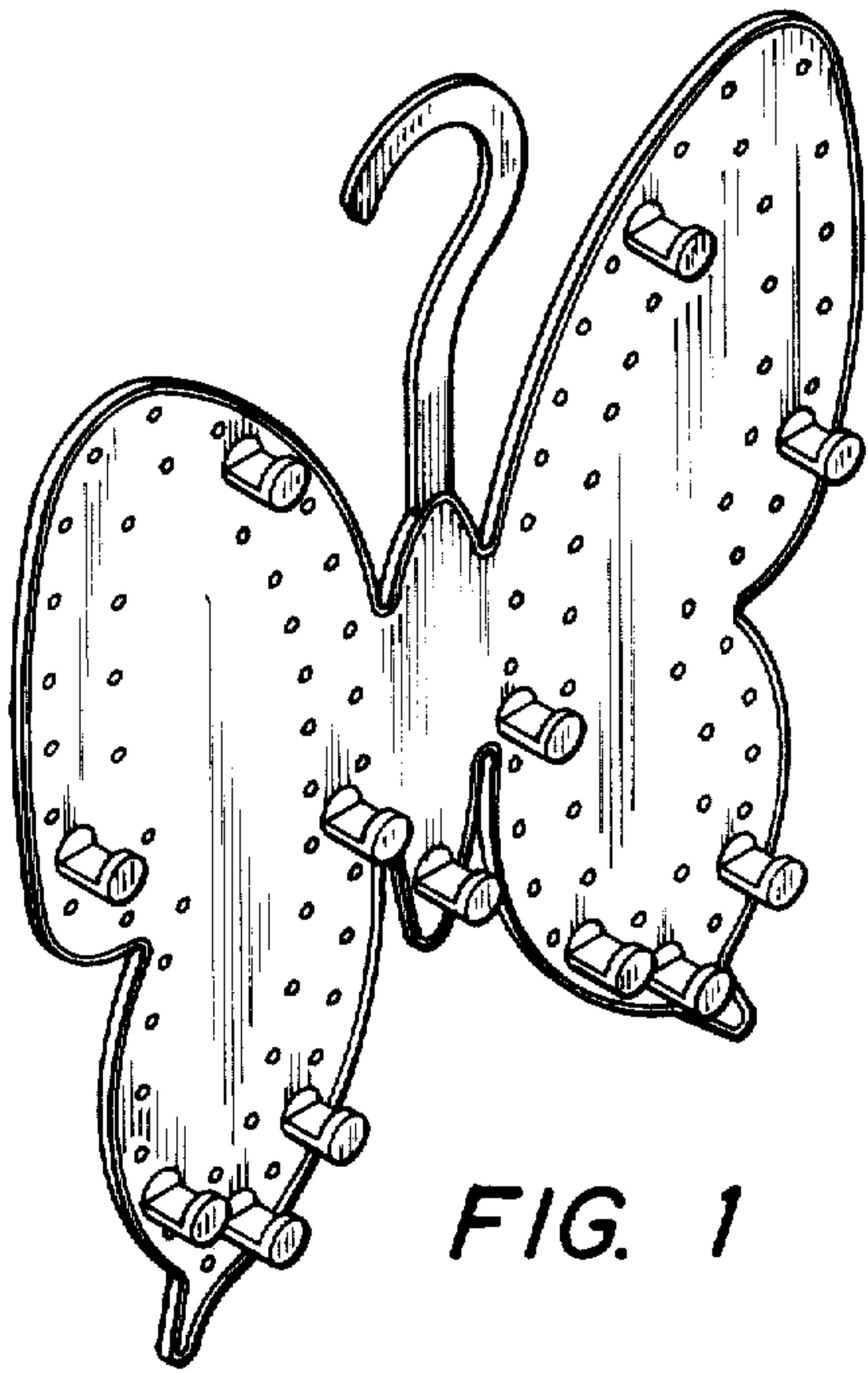

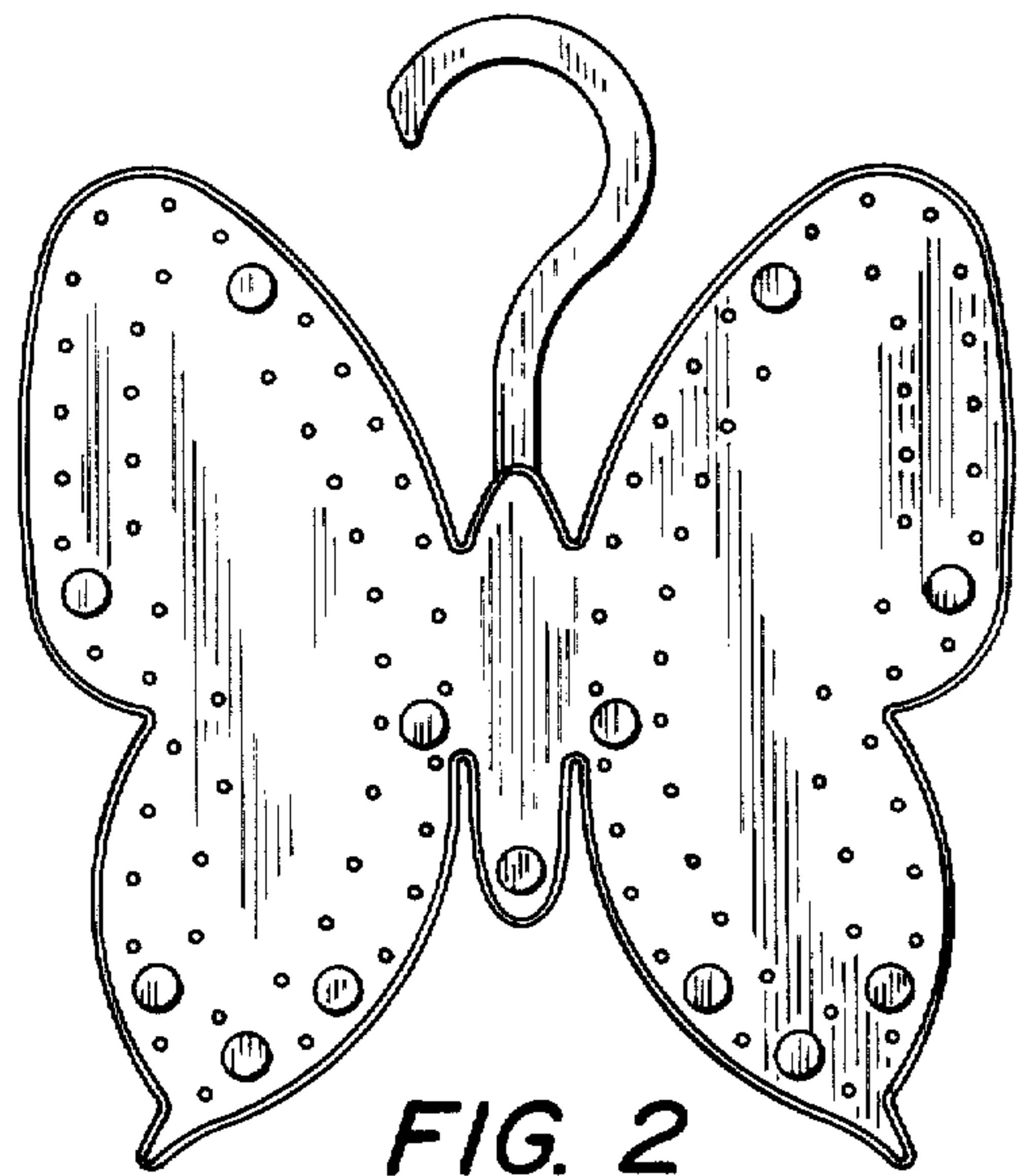

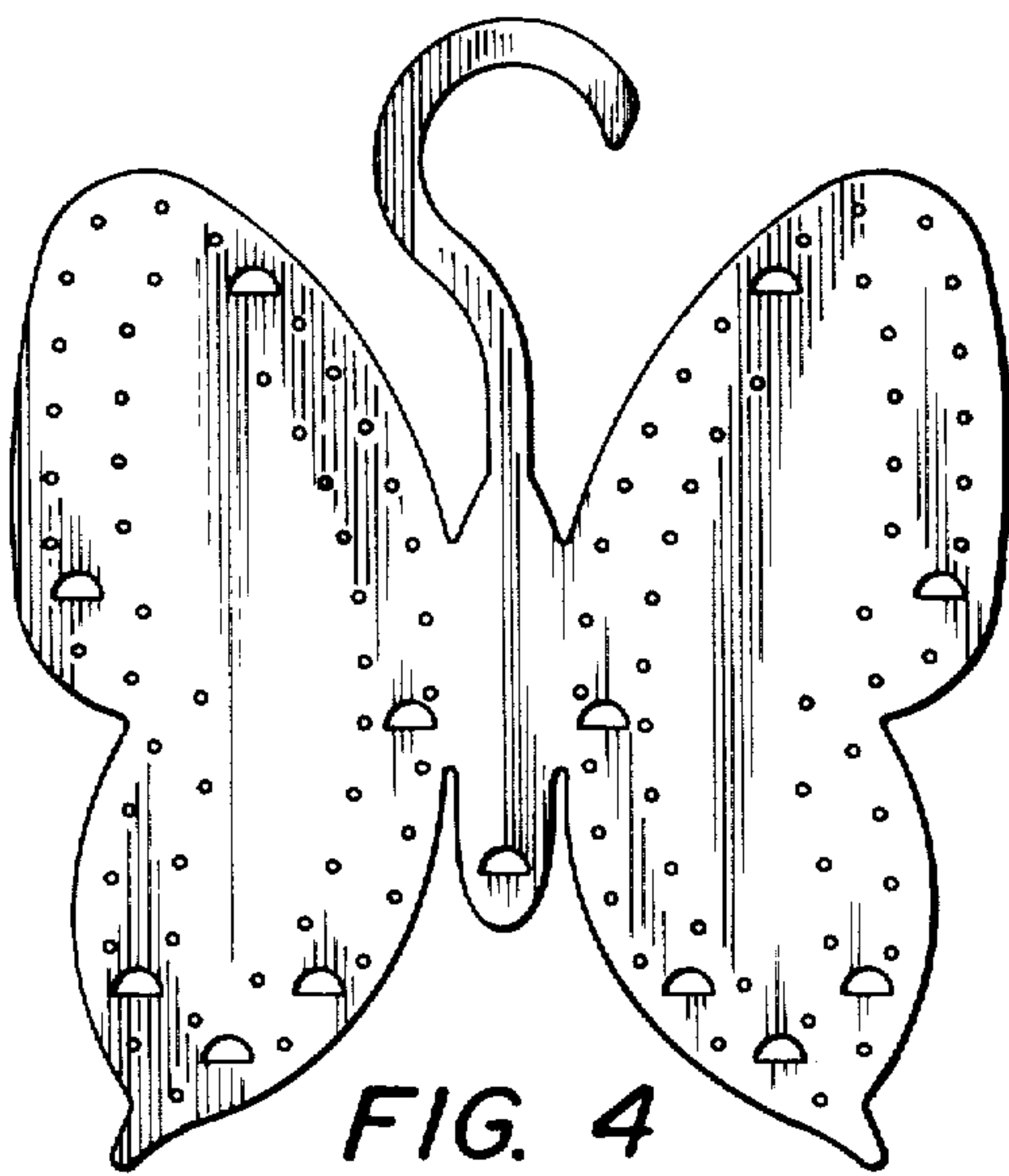

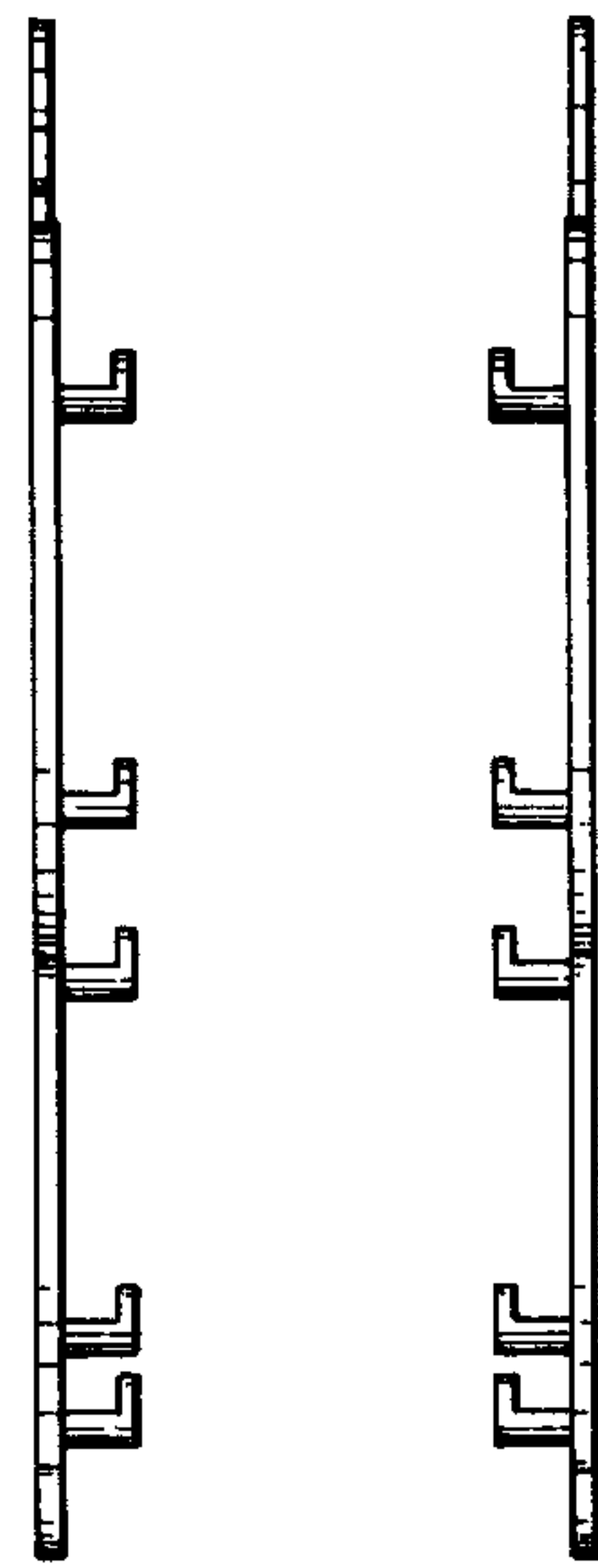
