[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a figurine of a koala bear, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front end elevational view of a figurine of a koala bear showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear end perspective view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side perspective view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is an opposite side perspective view showing a mirror image thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.

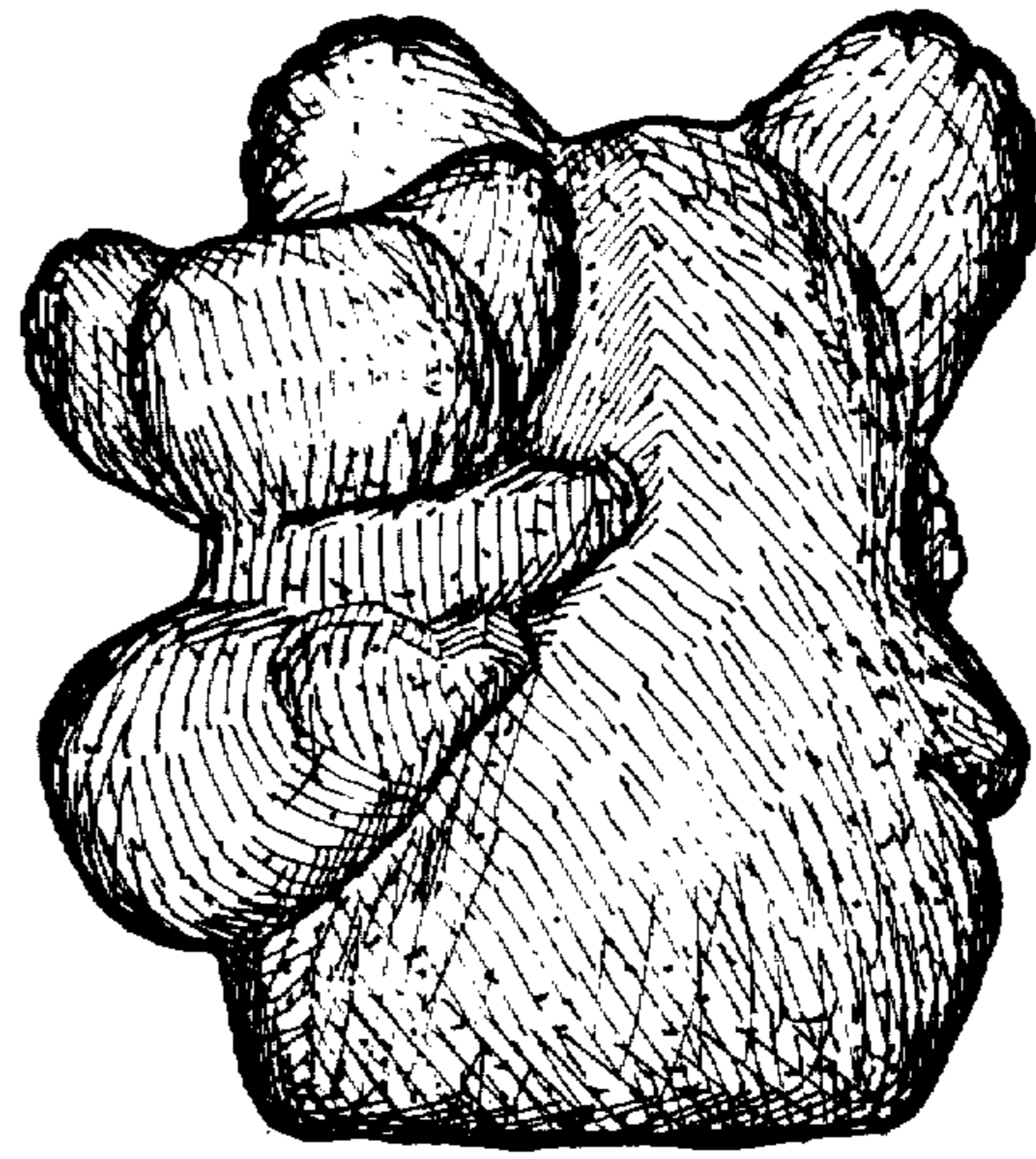

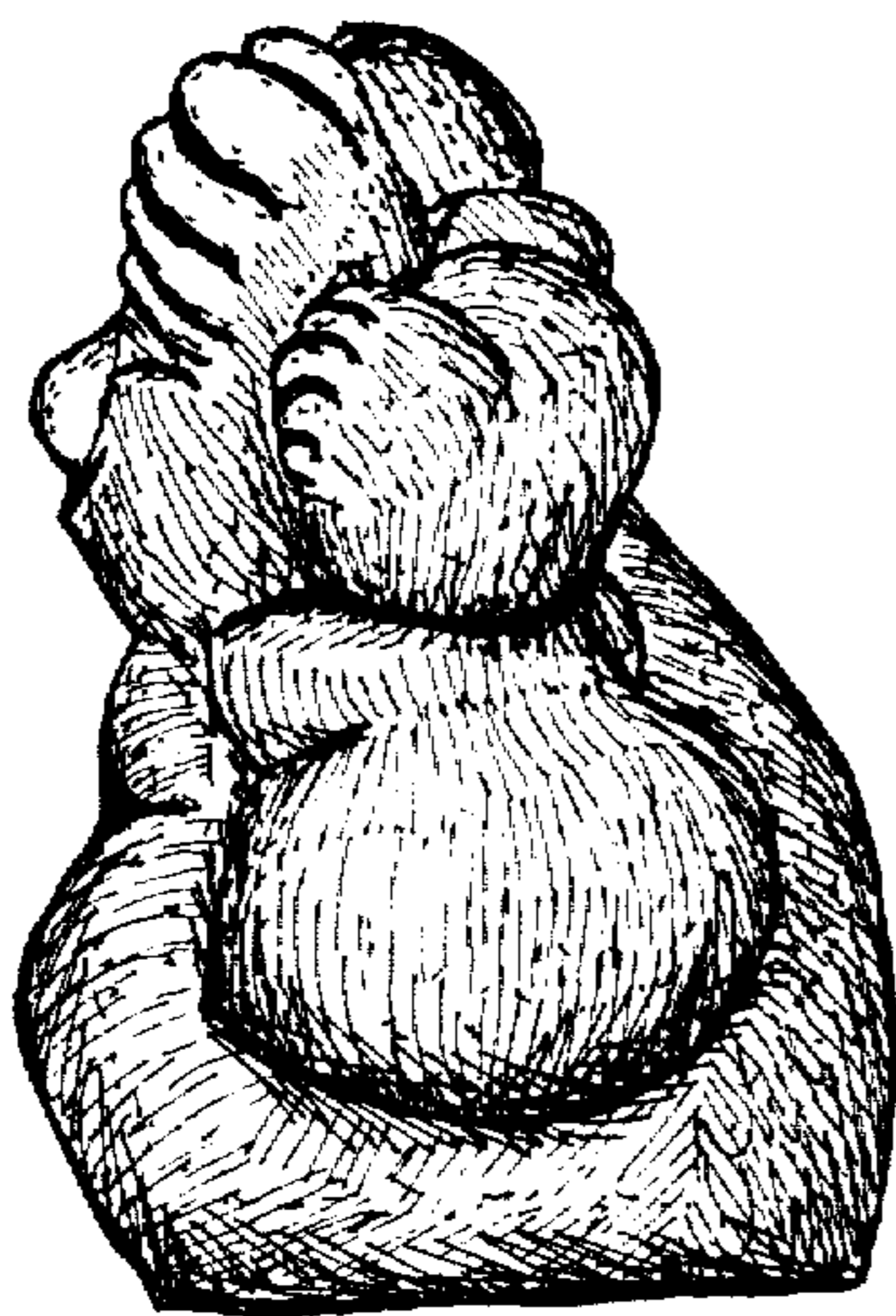

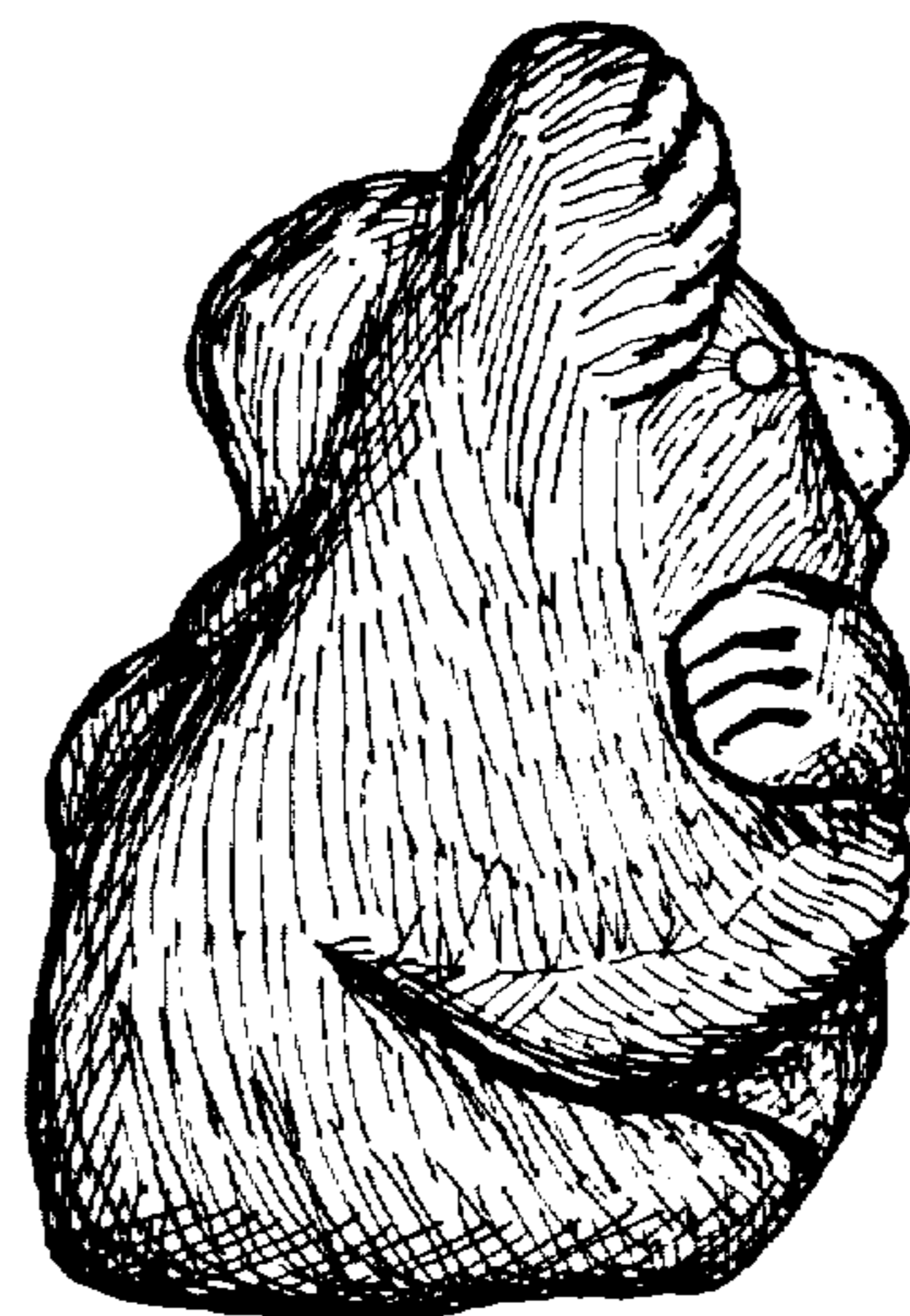

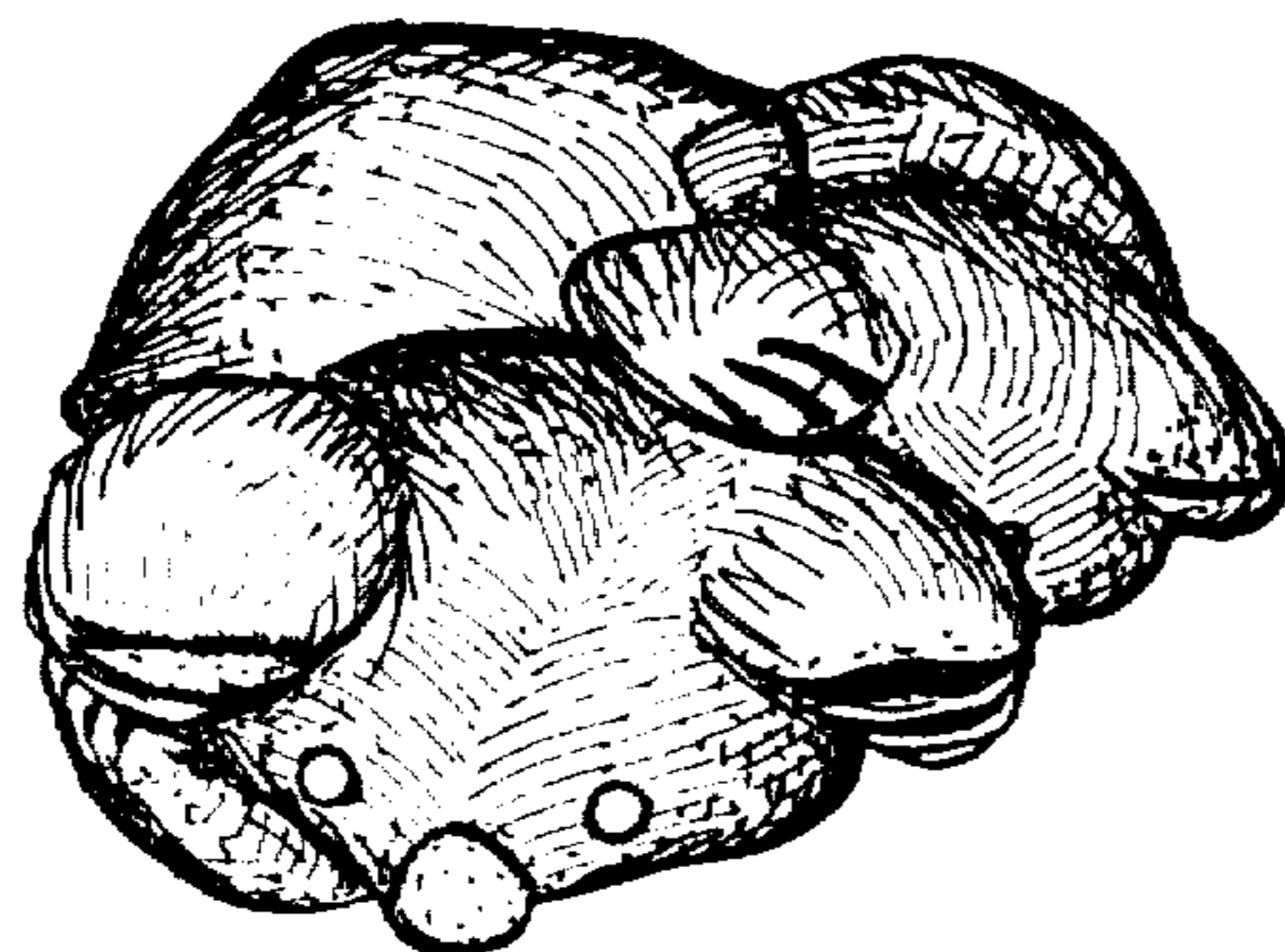
