FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a floppy disk reader/recorder or the like, showing my new design;

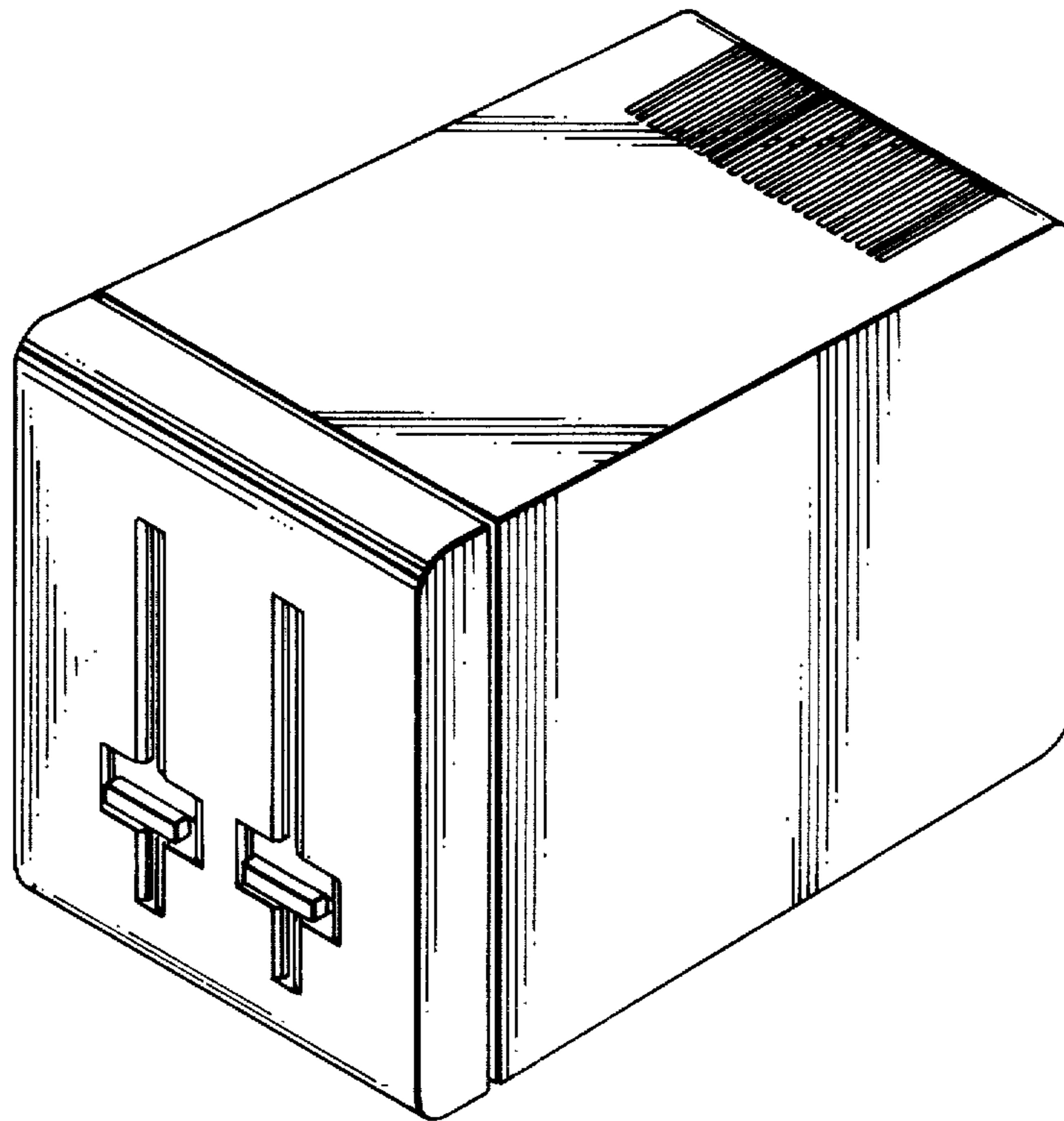
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side view thereof. The left side, not shown, is a mirror image of the right side.



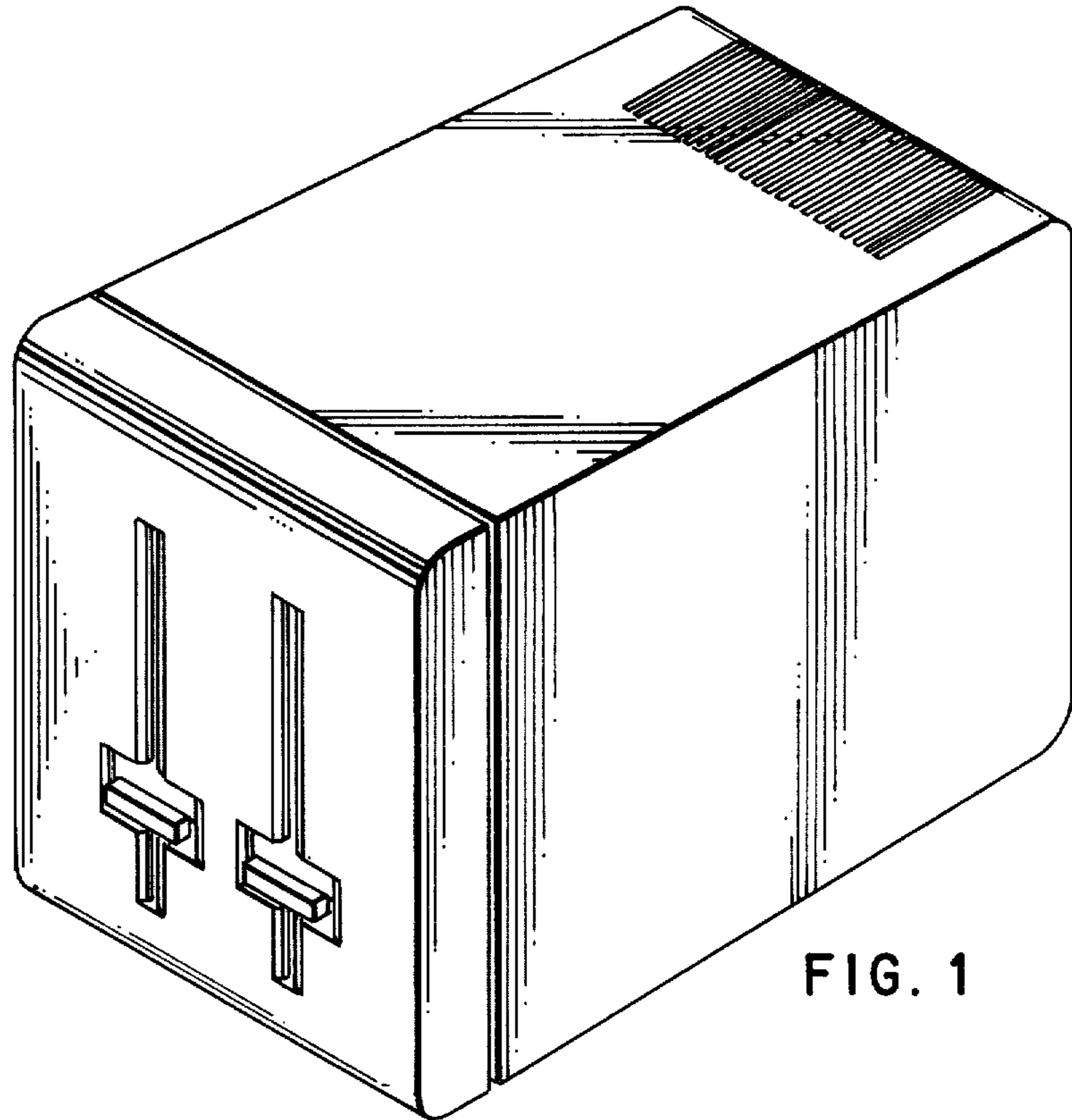

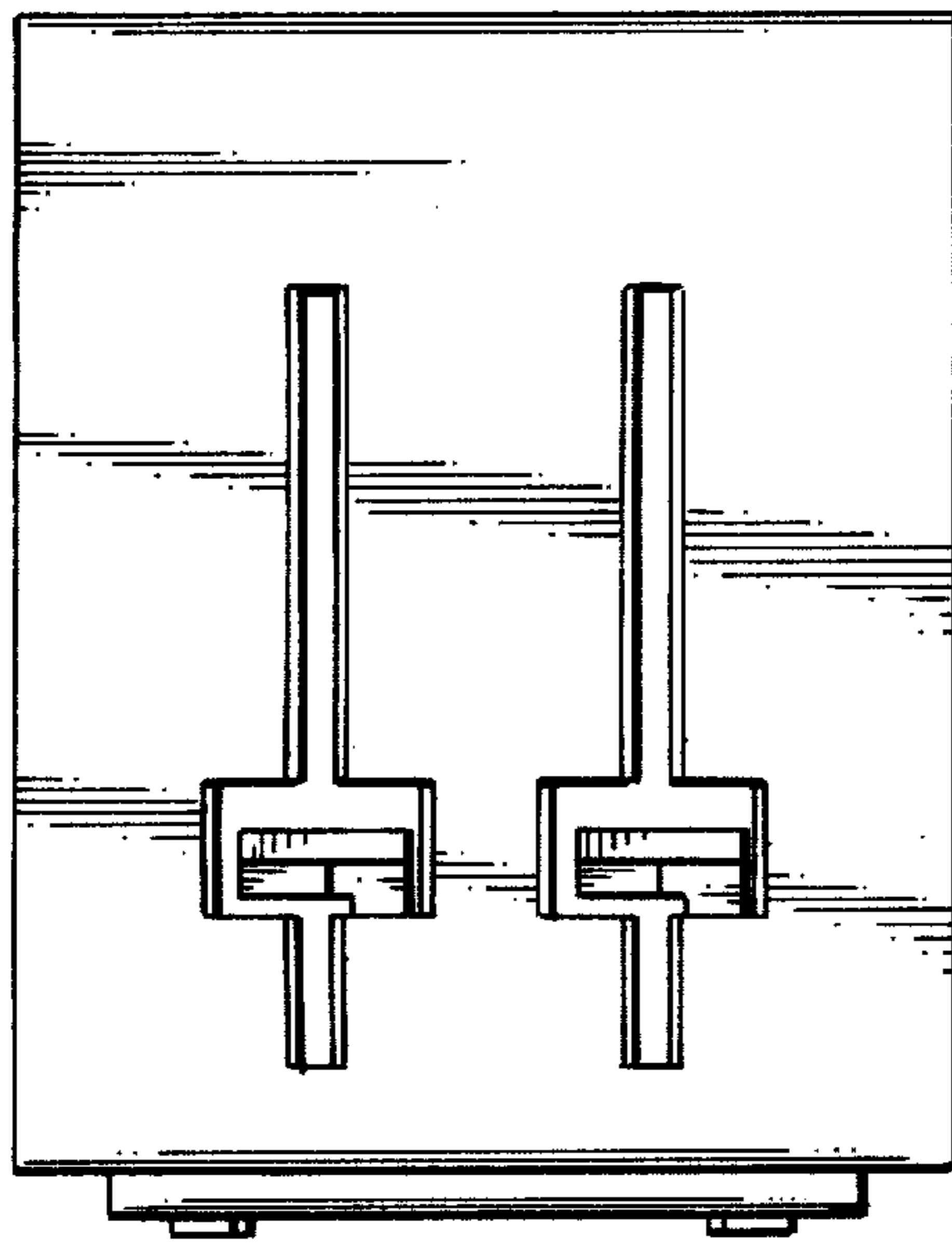

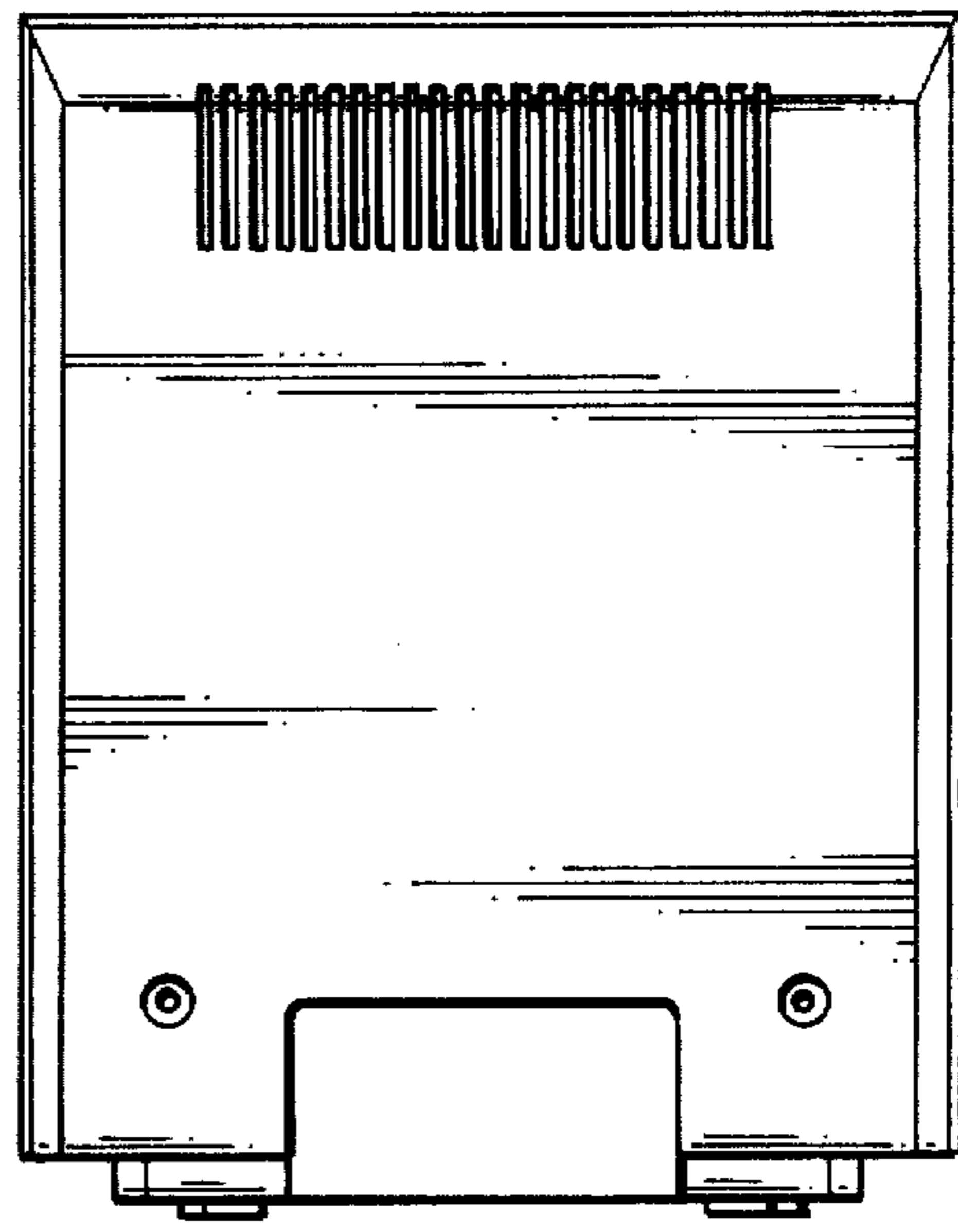

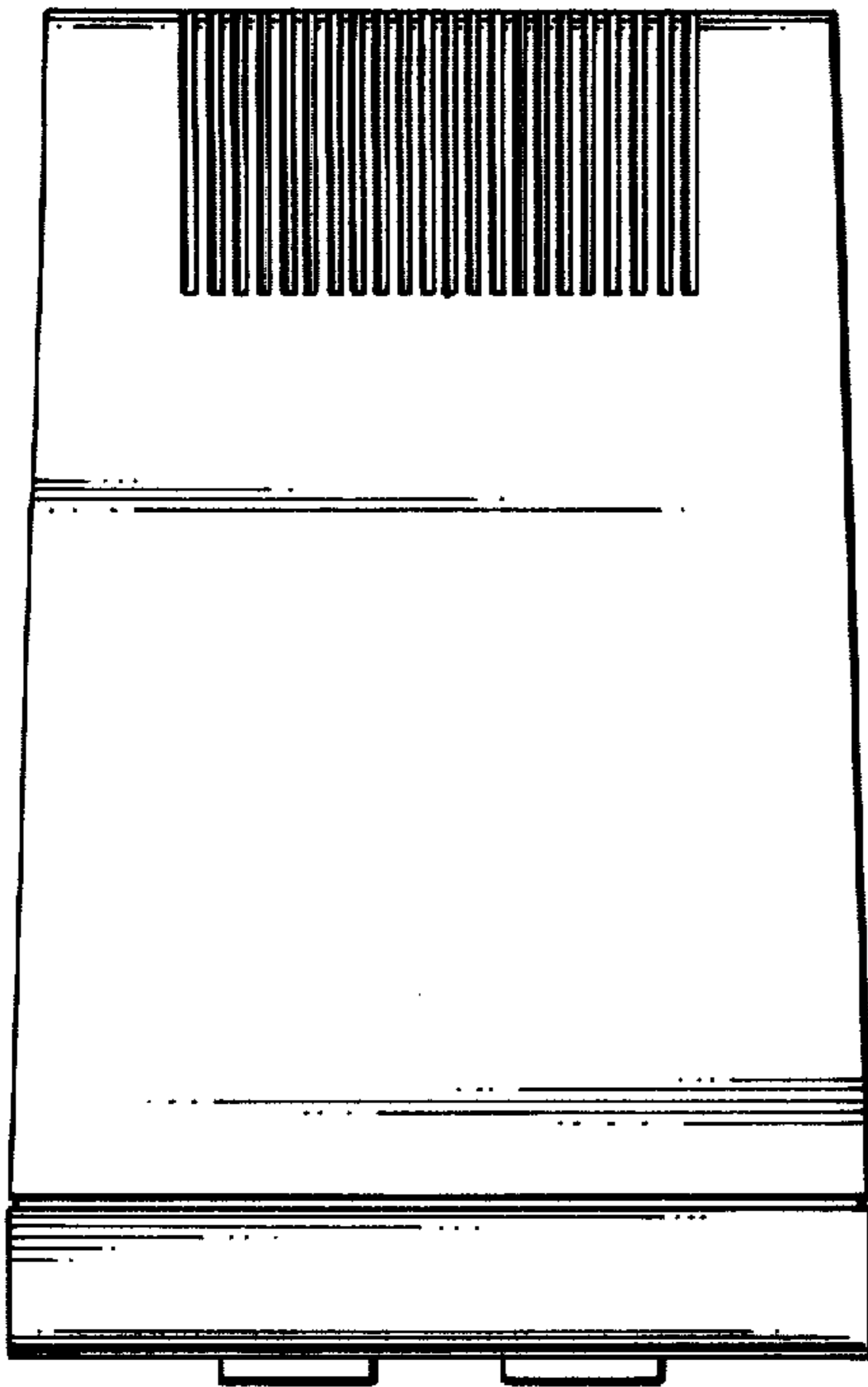

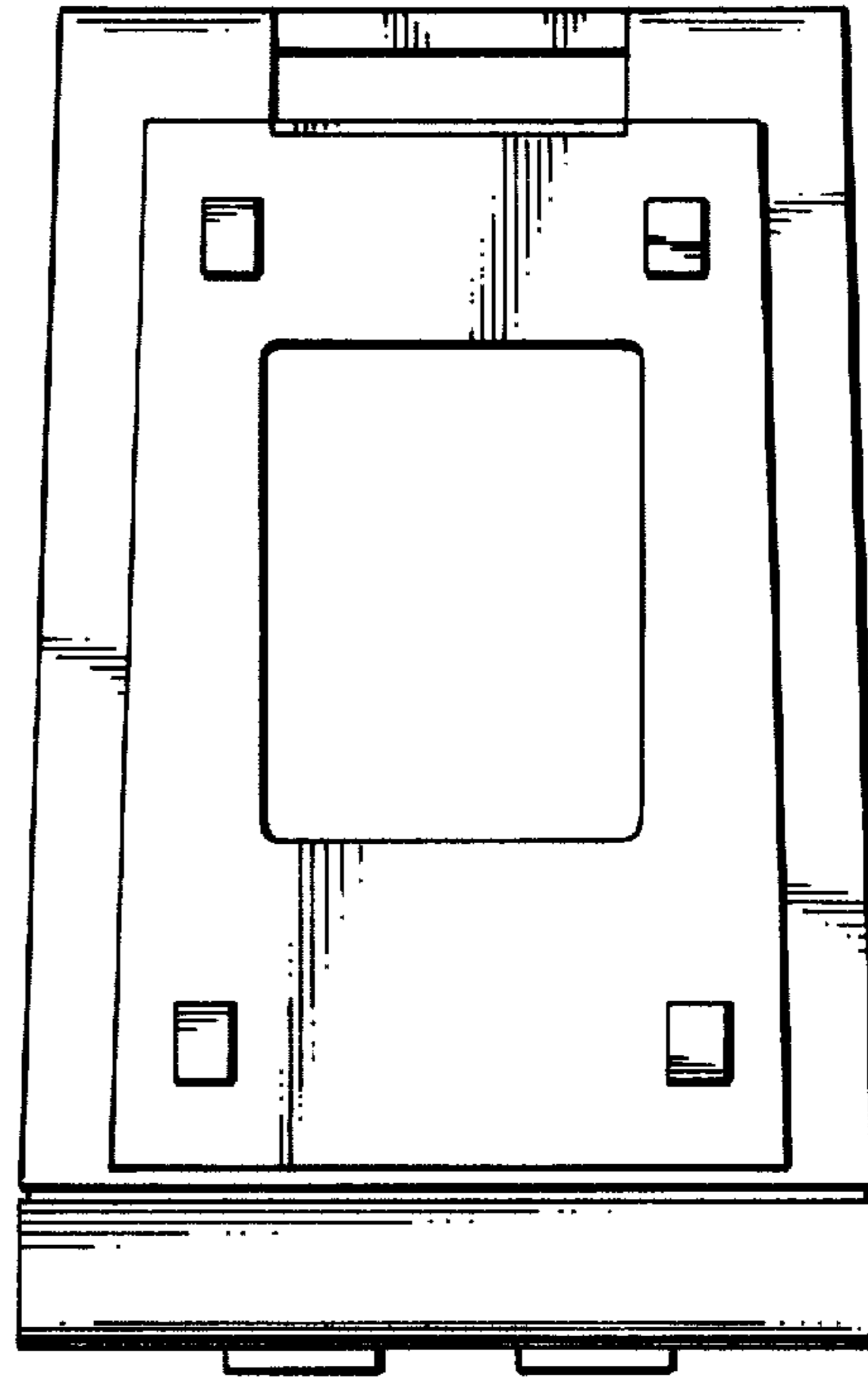

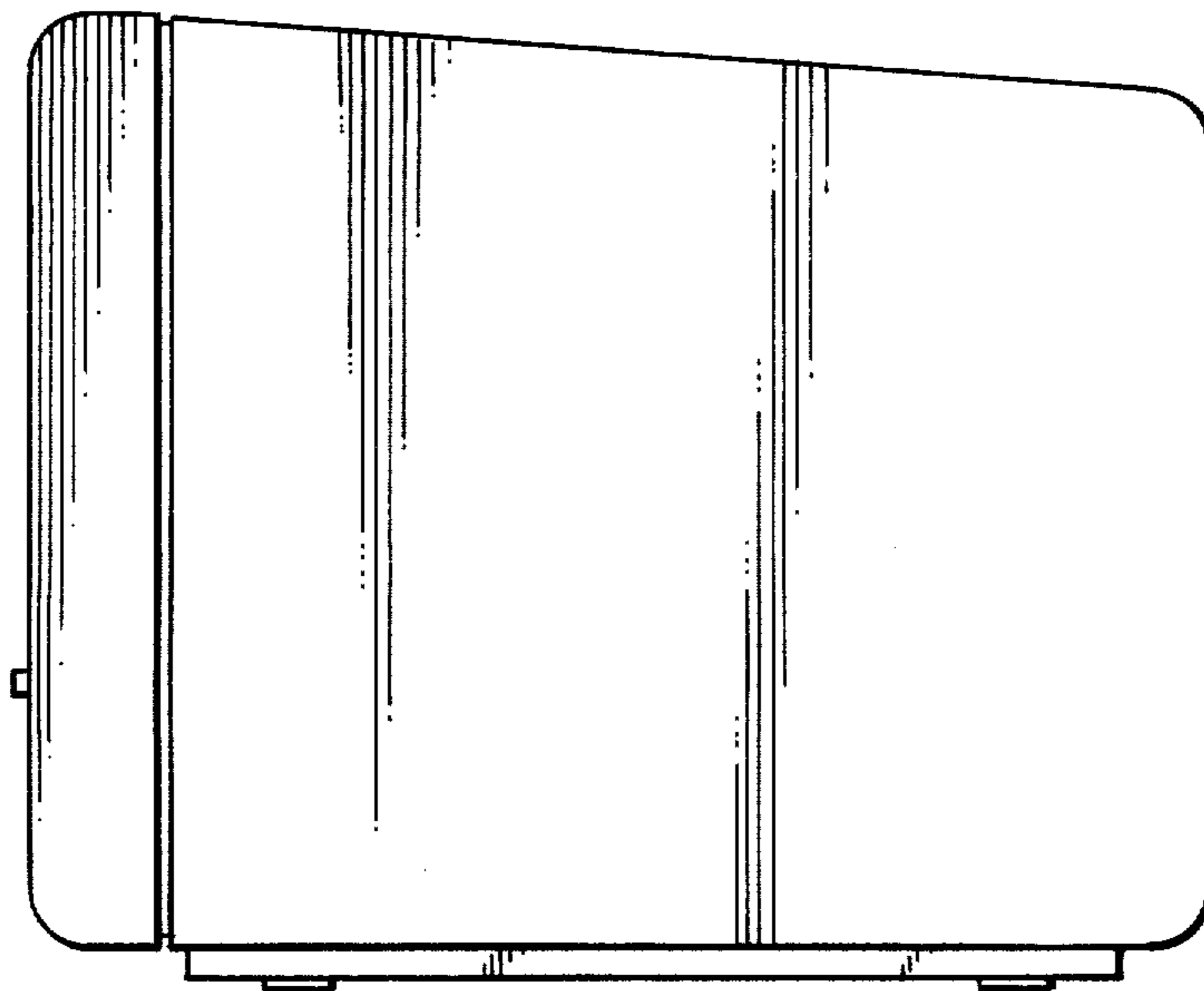
