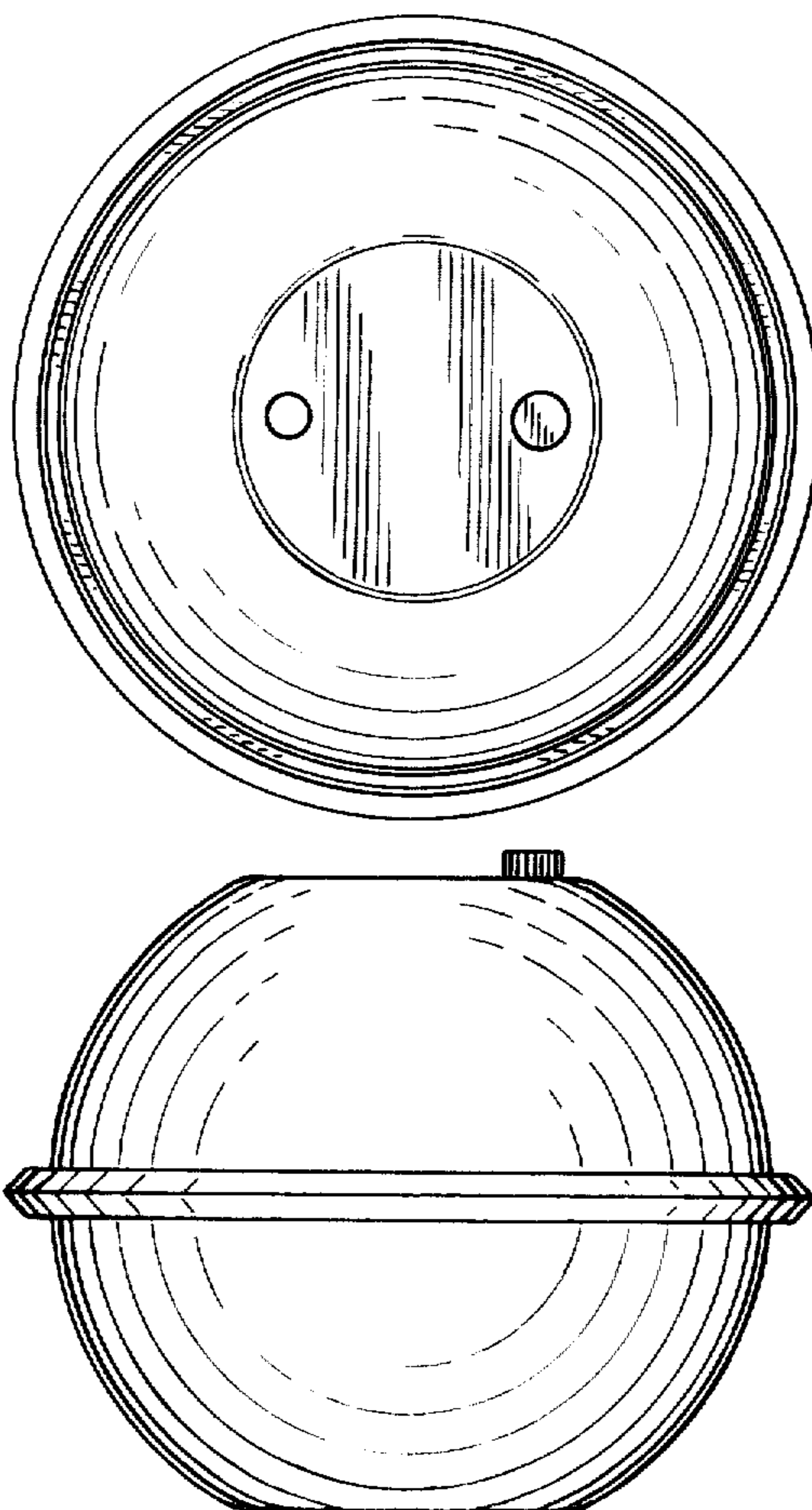

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a canister for liquid medication and water, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof, and is a mirror image of the rear elevation thereof; and FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof.



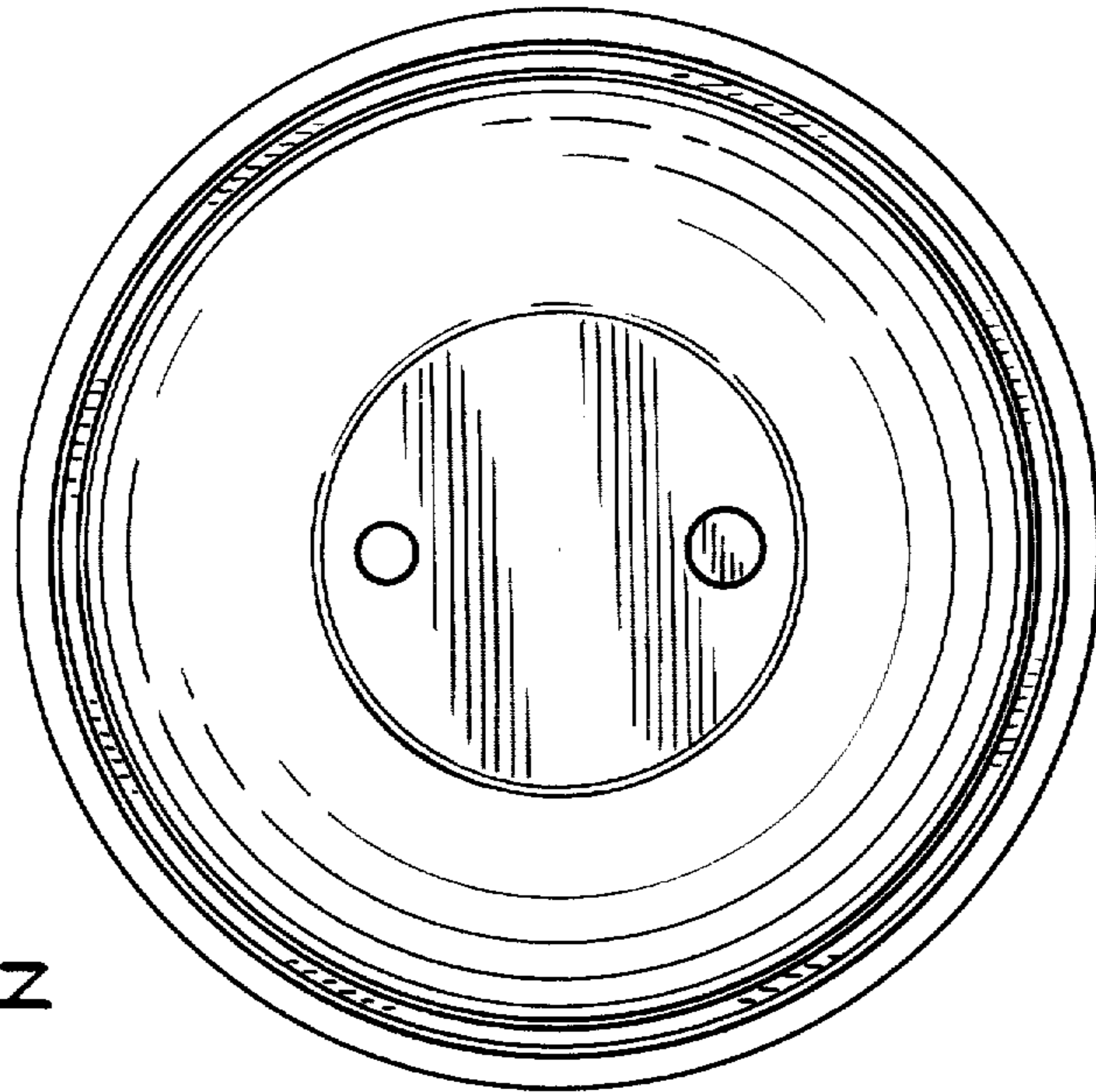

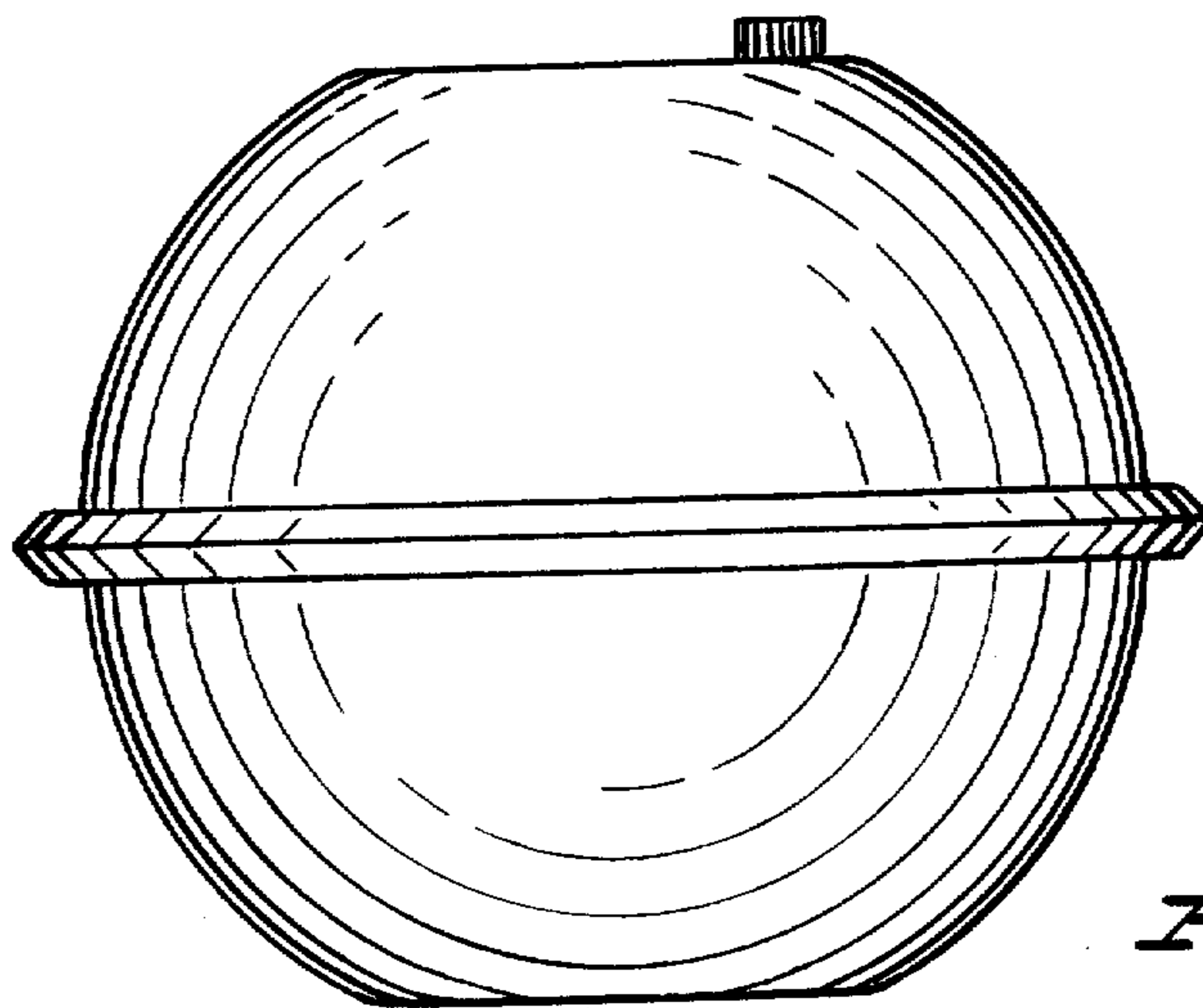

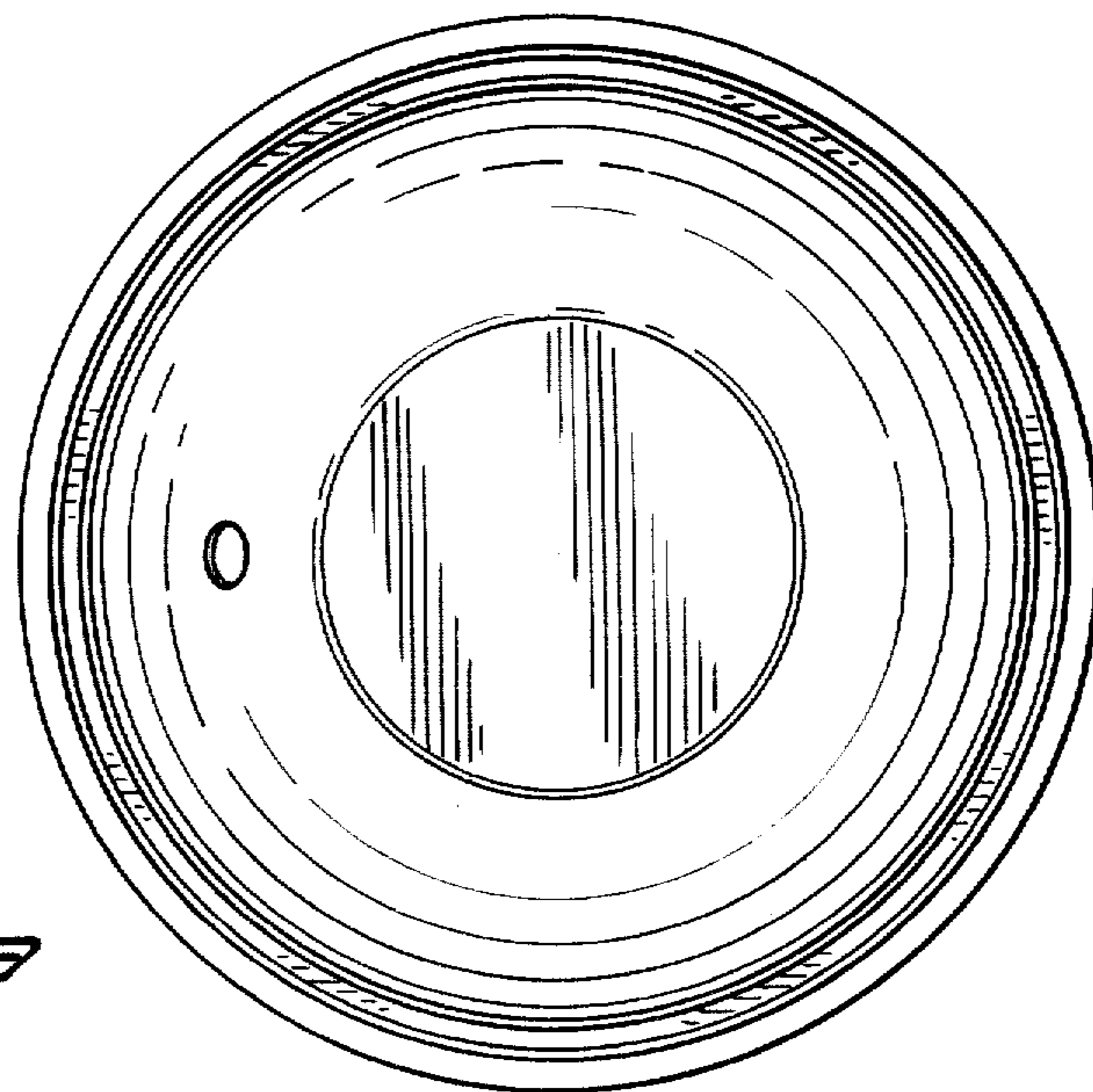
