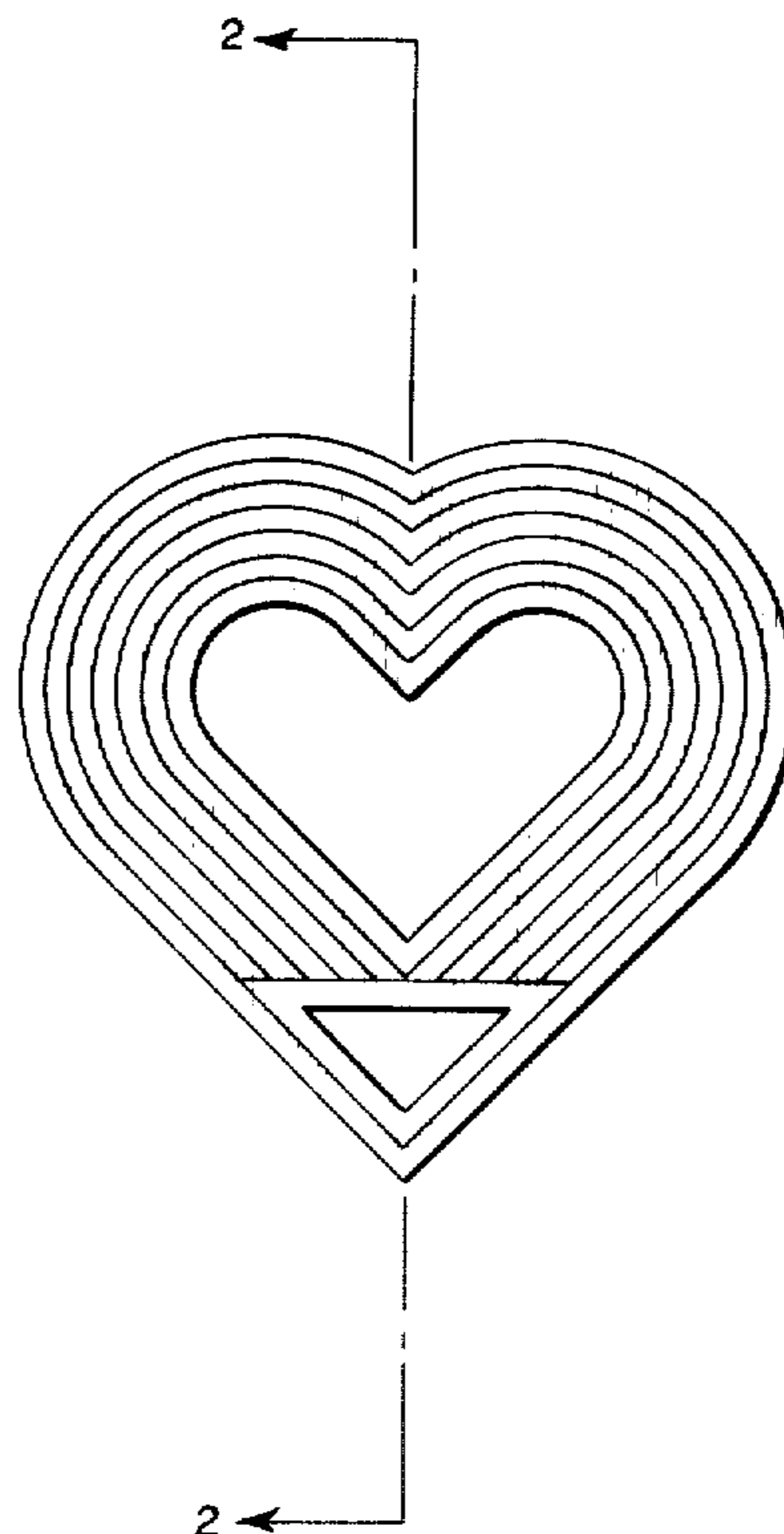

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- [57] **CLAIM**
- The ornamental design for an appliqué for a shirt or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an appliqué for a shirt or the like showing my new design, the rear being substantially plain; and
FIG. 2 is a sectional view taken along the line 2—2 in FIG. 1.



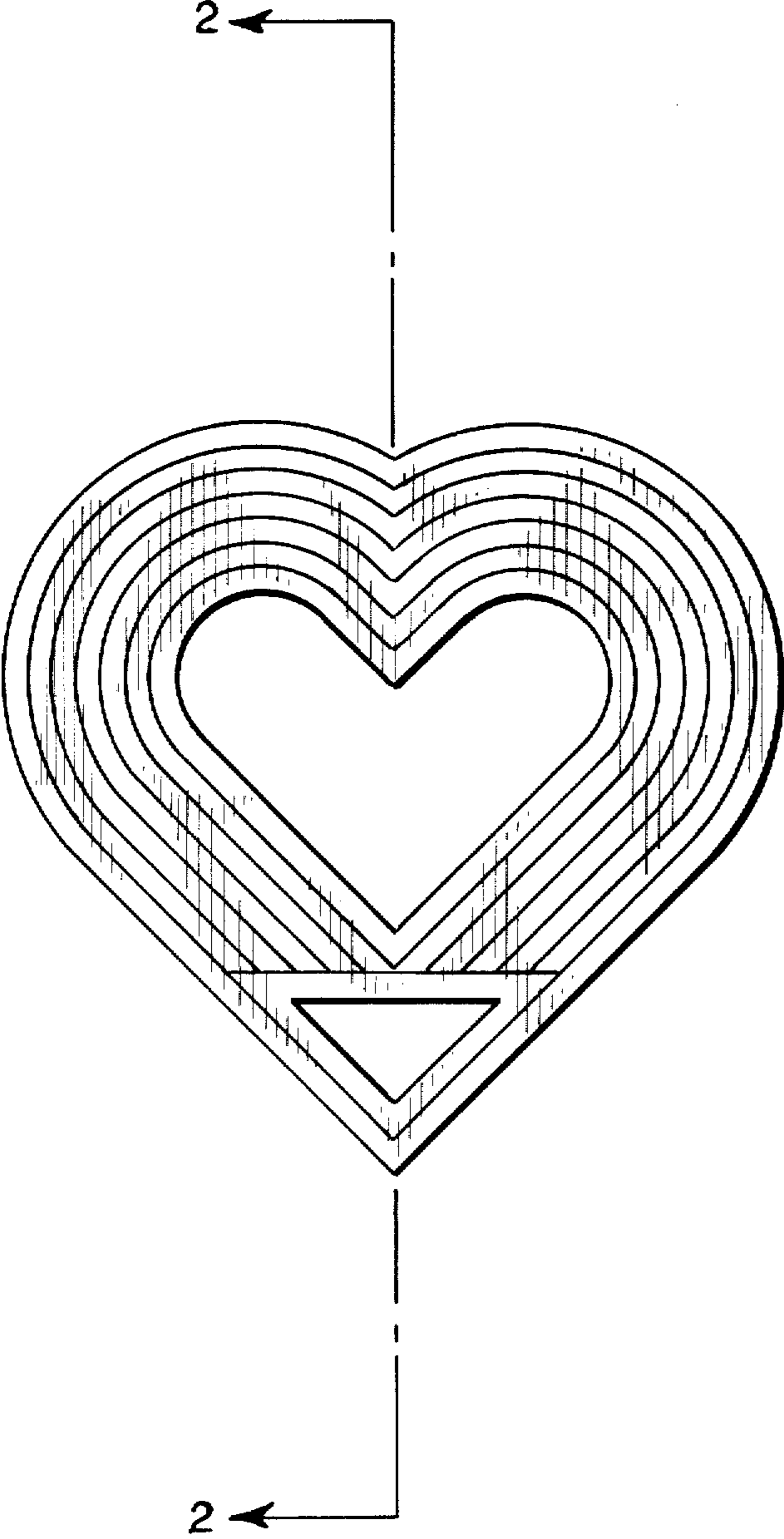
