The ornamental design for an athletic shoe, substantially as shown and described.

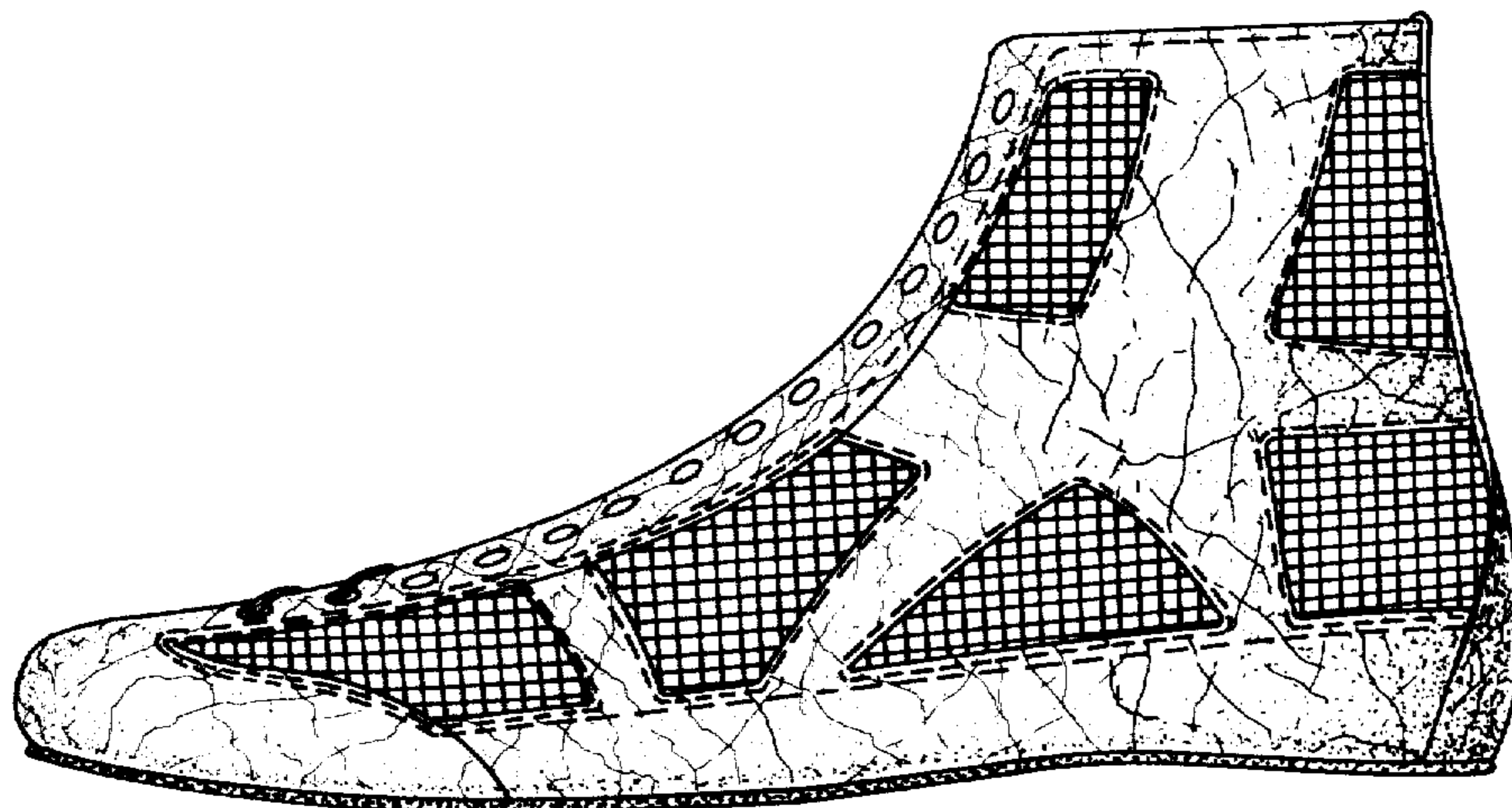
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of an athletic shoe showing my new design, the left side being substantially a mirror image thereto;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being plain and unornamented;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.



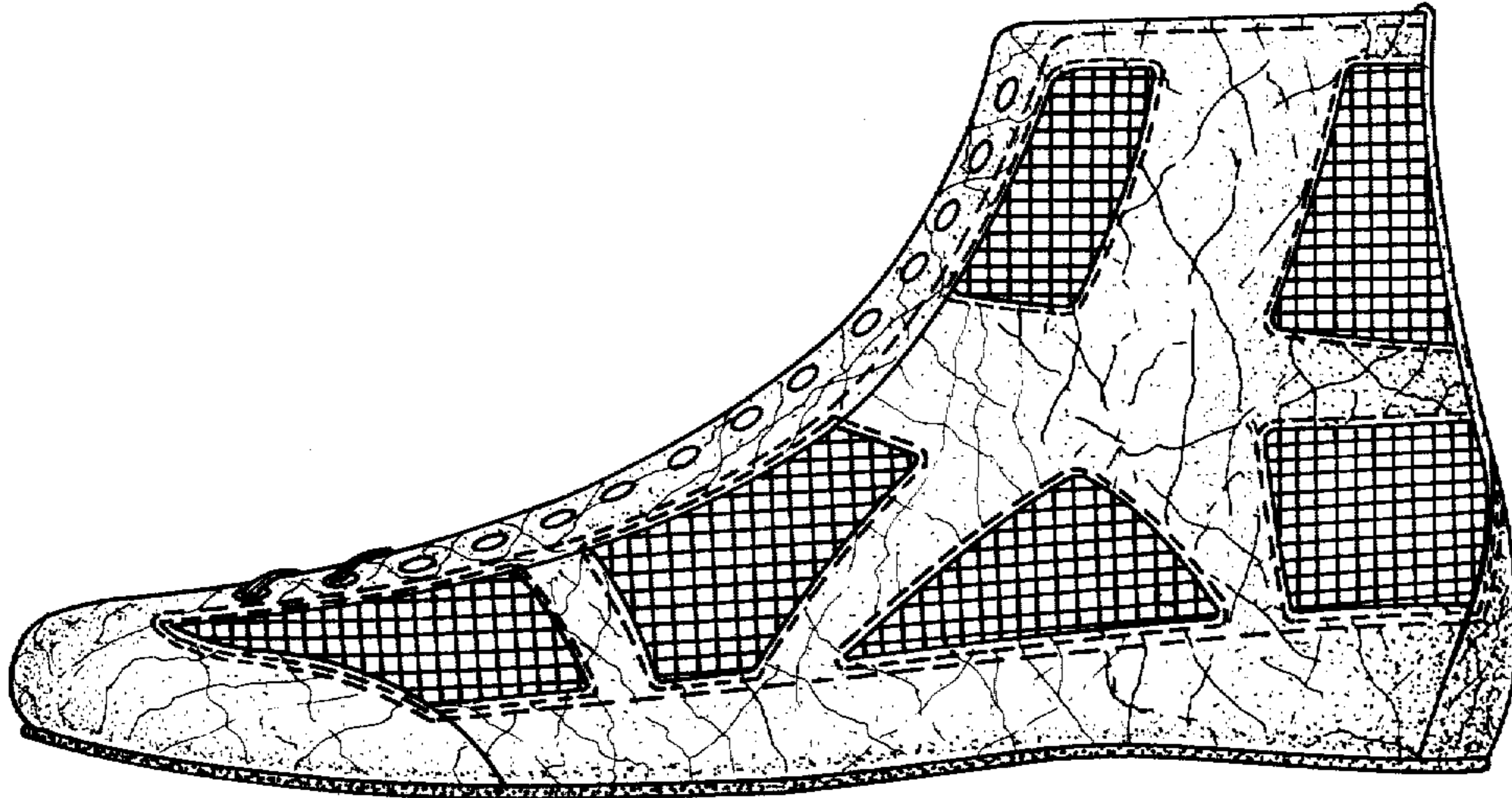

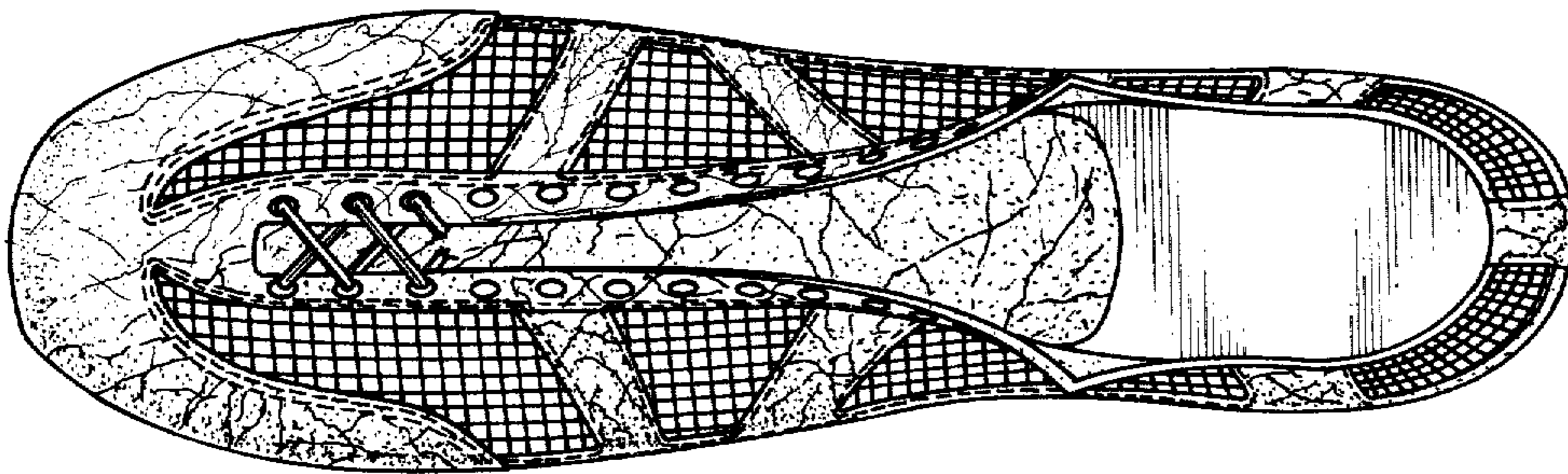

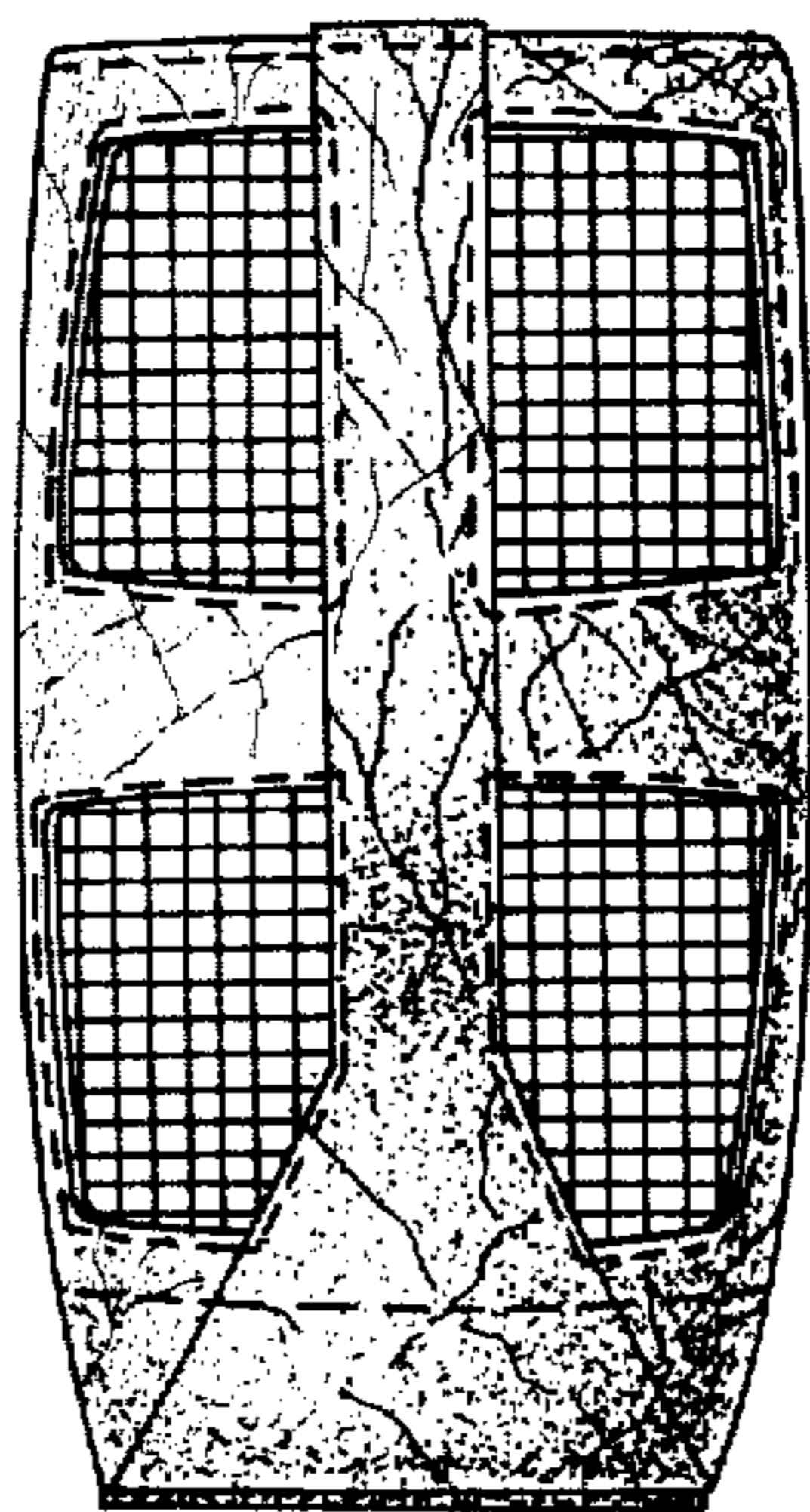

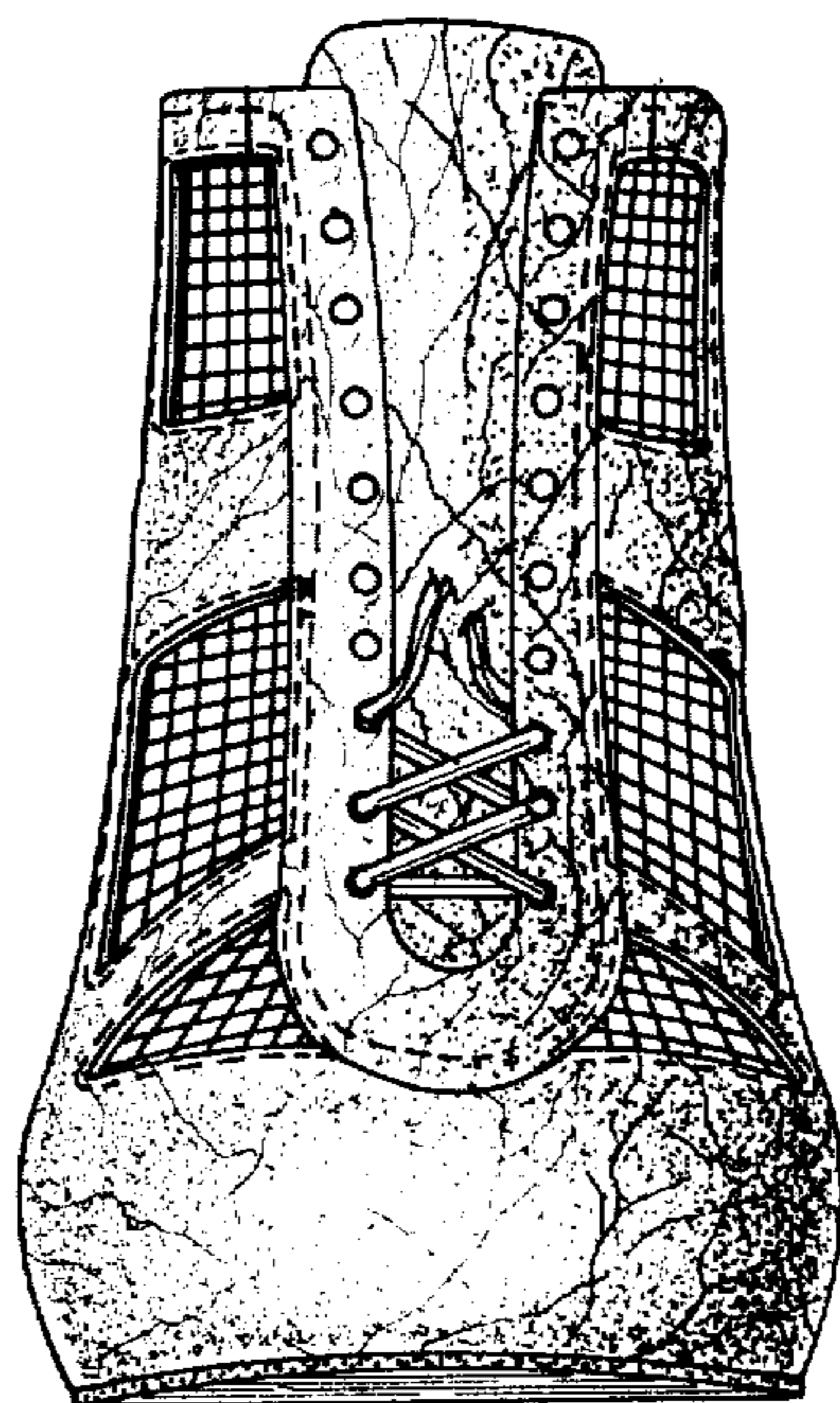
