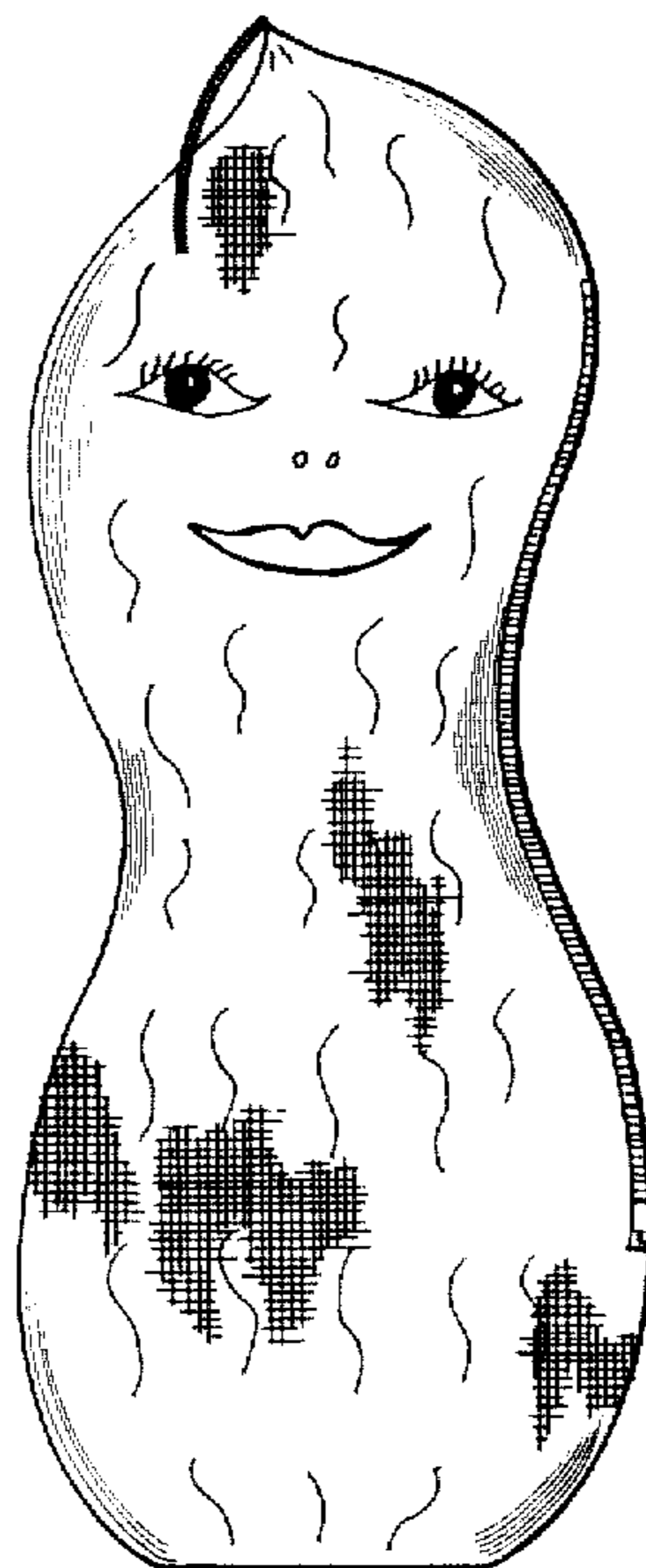

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view.



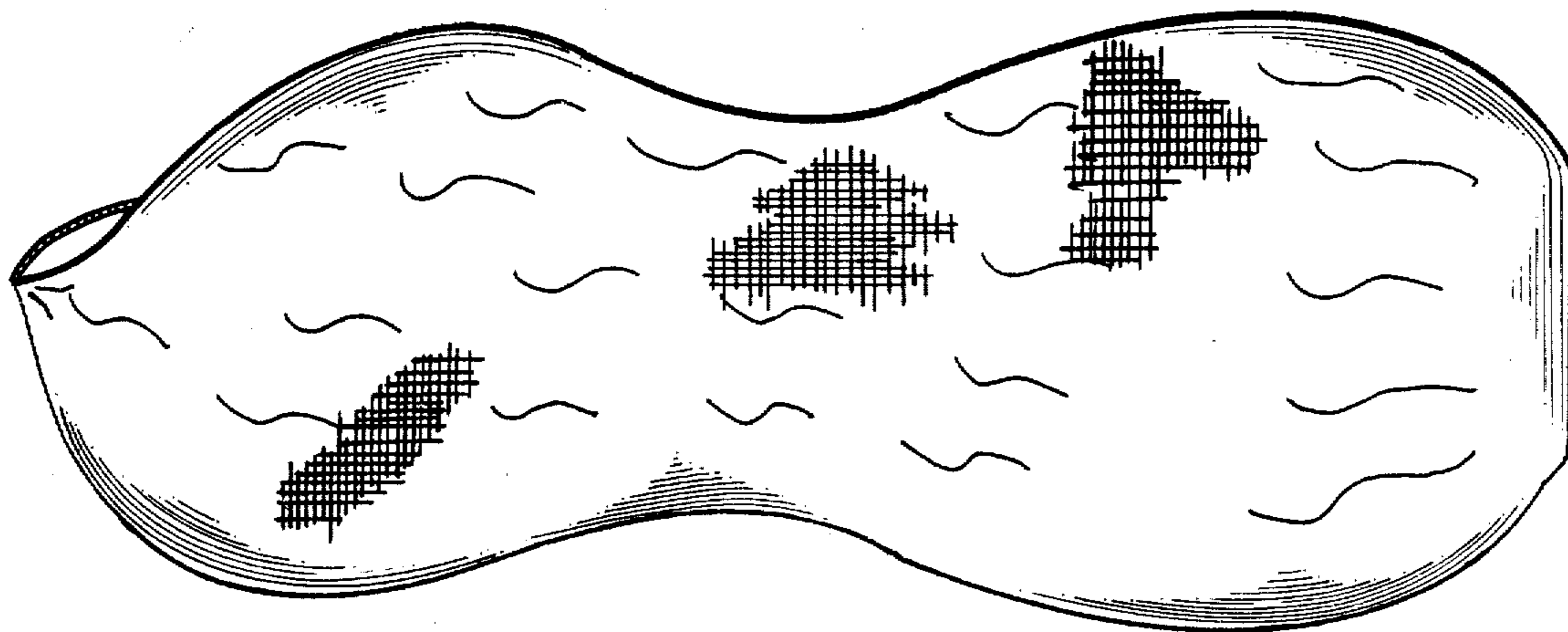

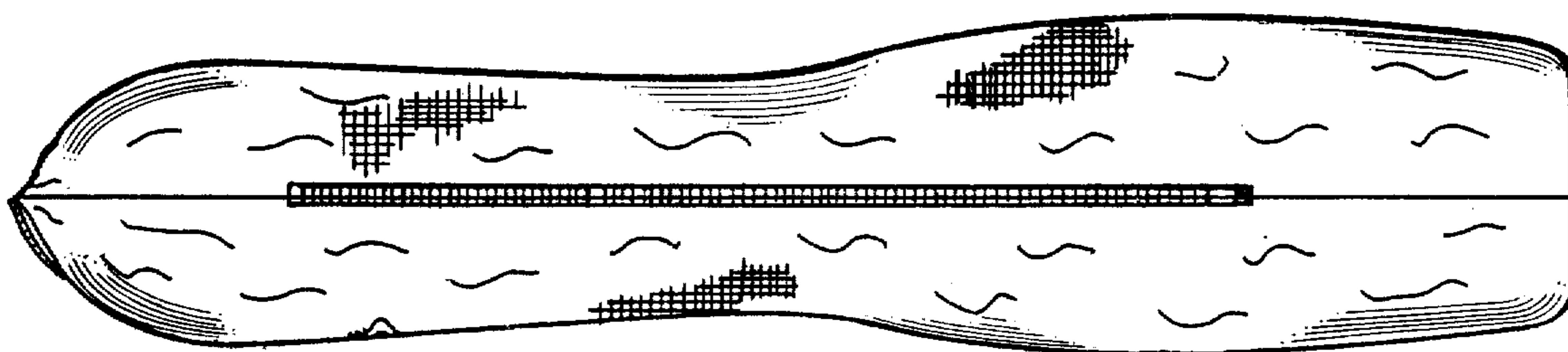

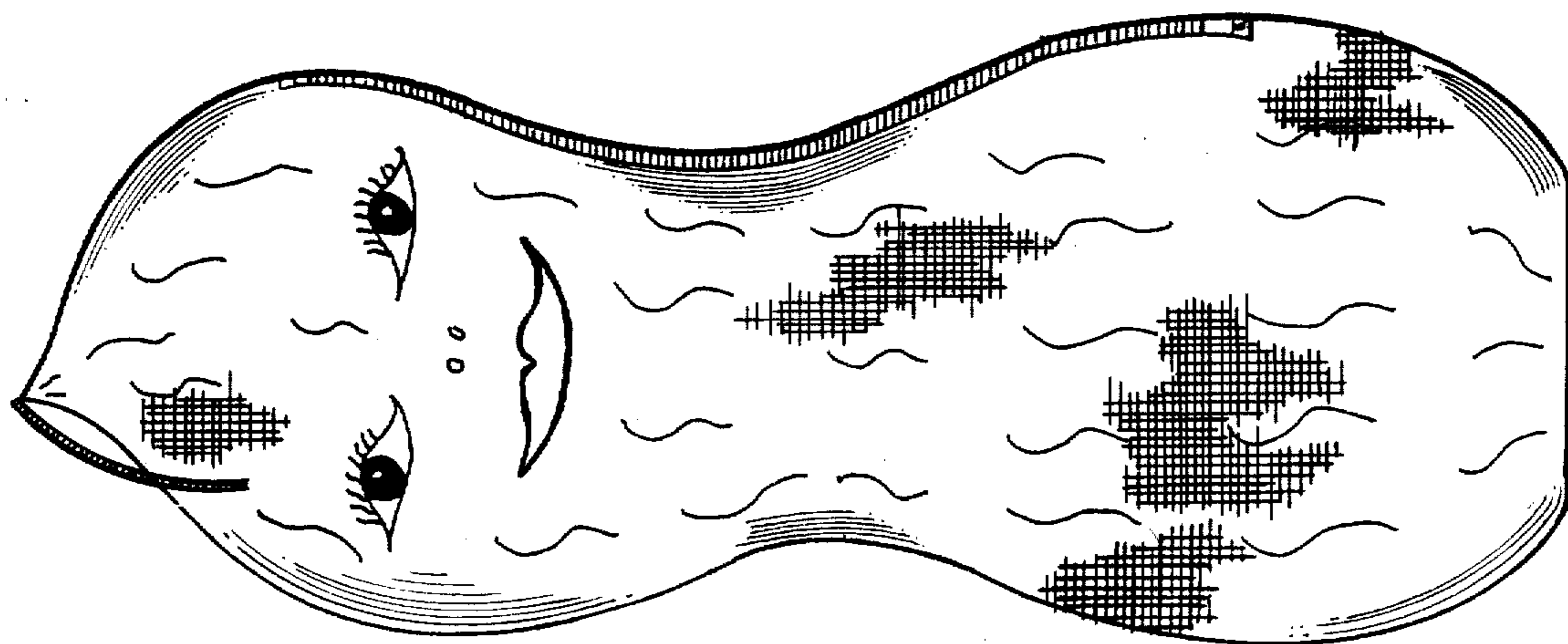

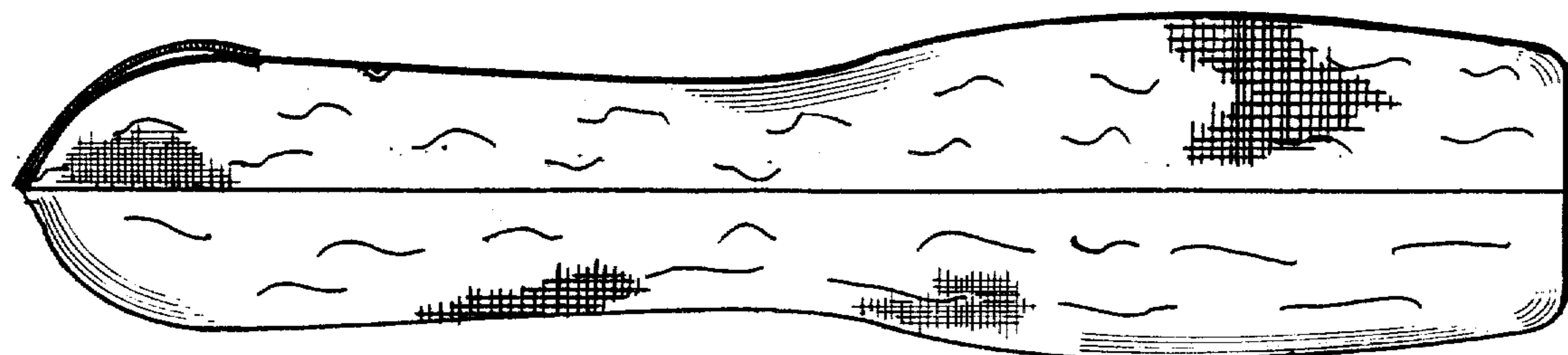

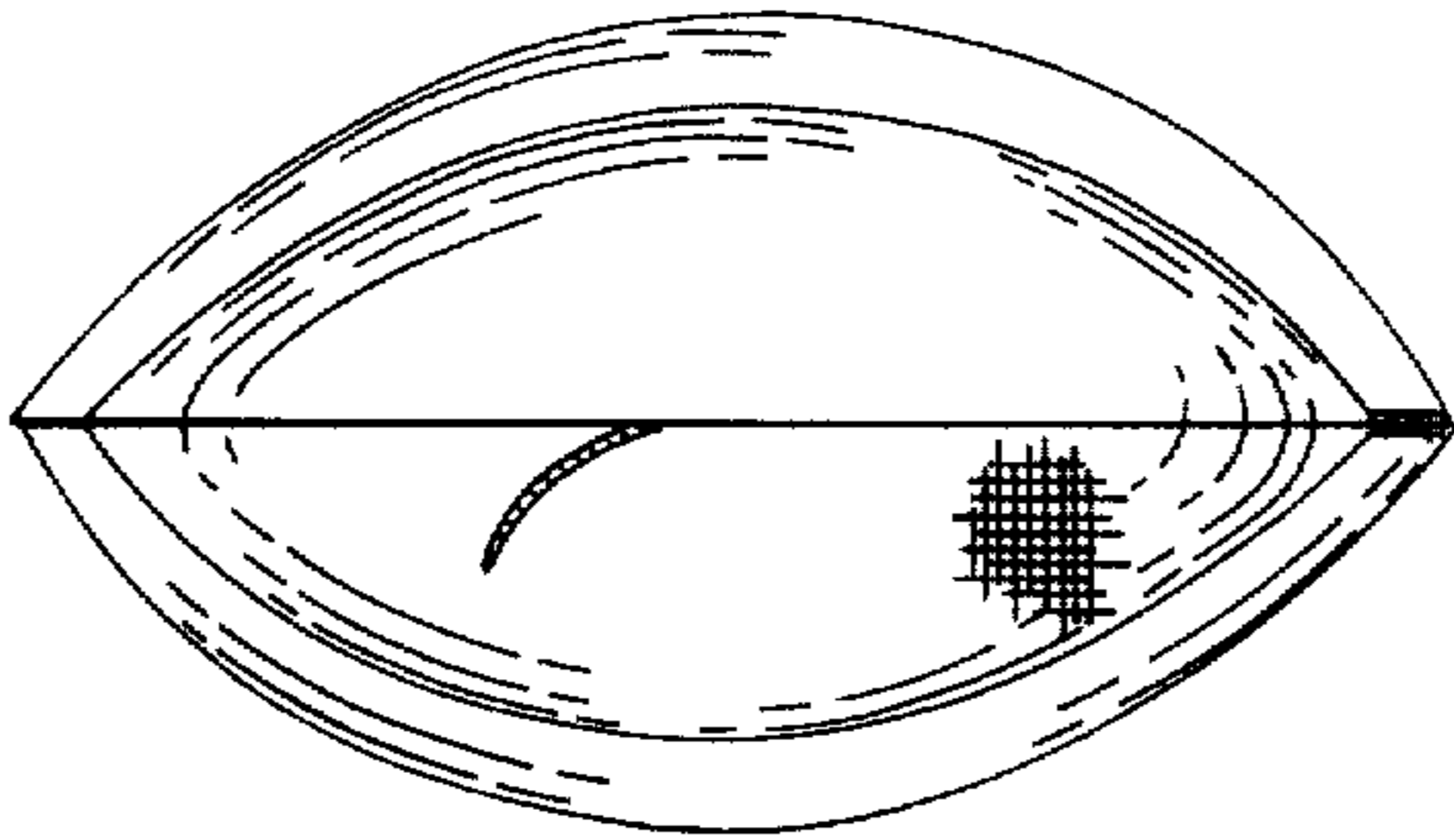

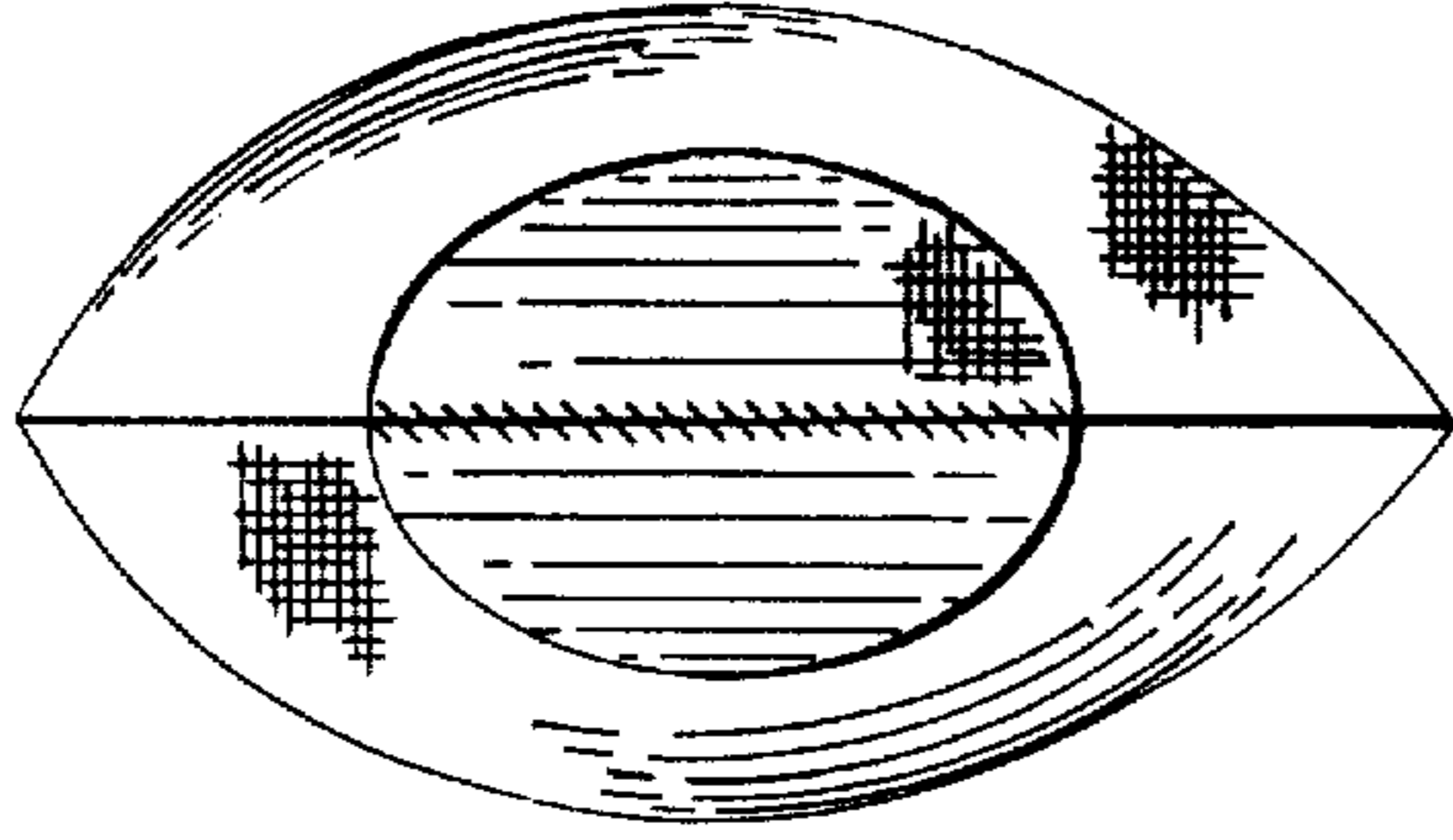
