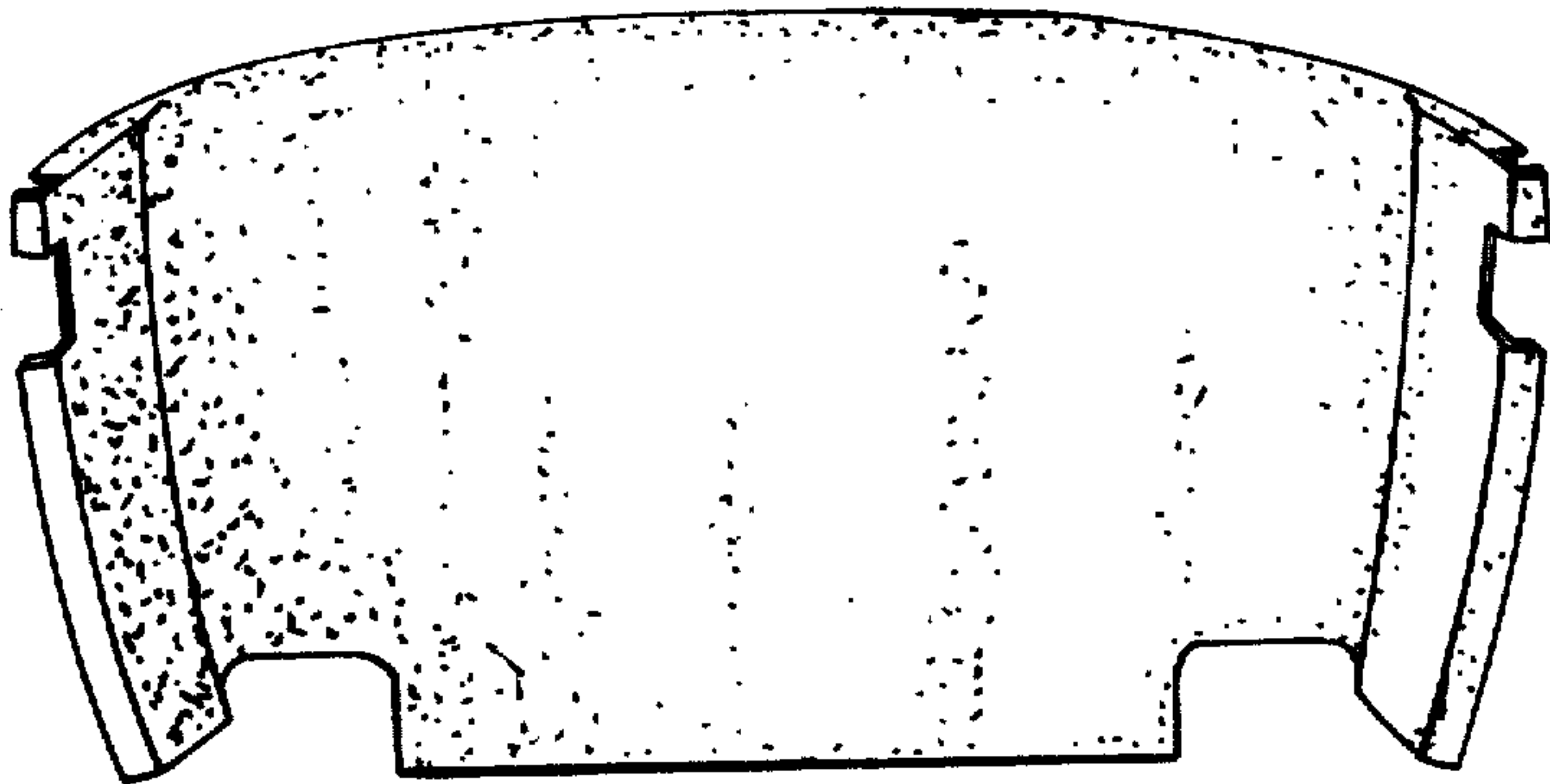

FIG. 6 is a bottom elevational view thereof.



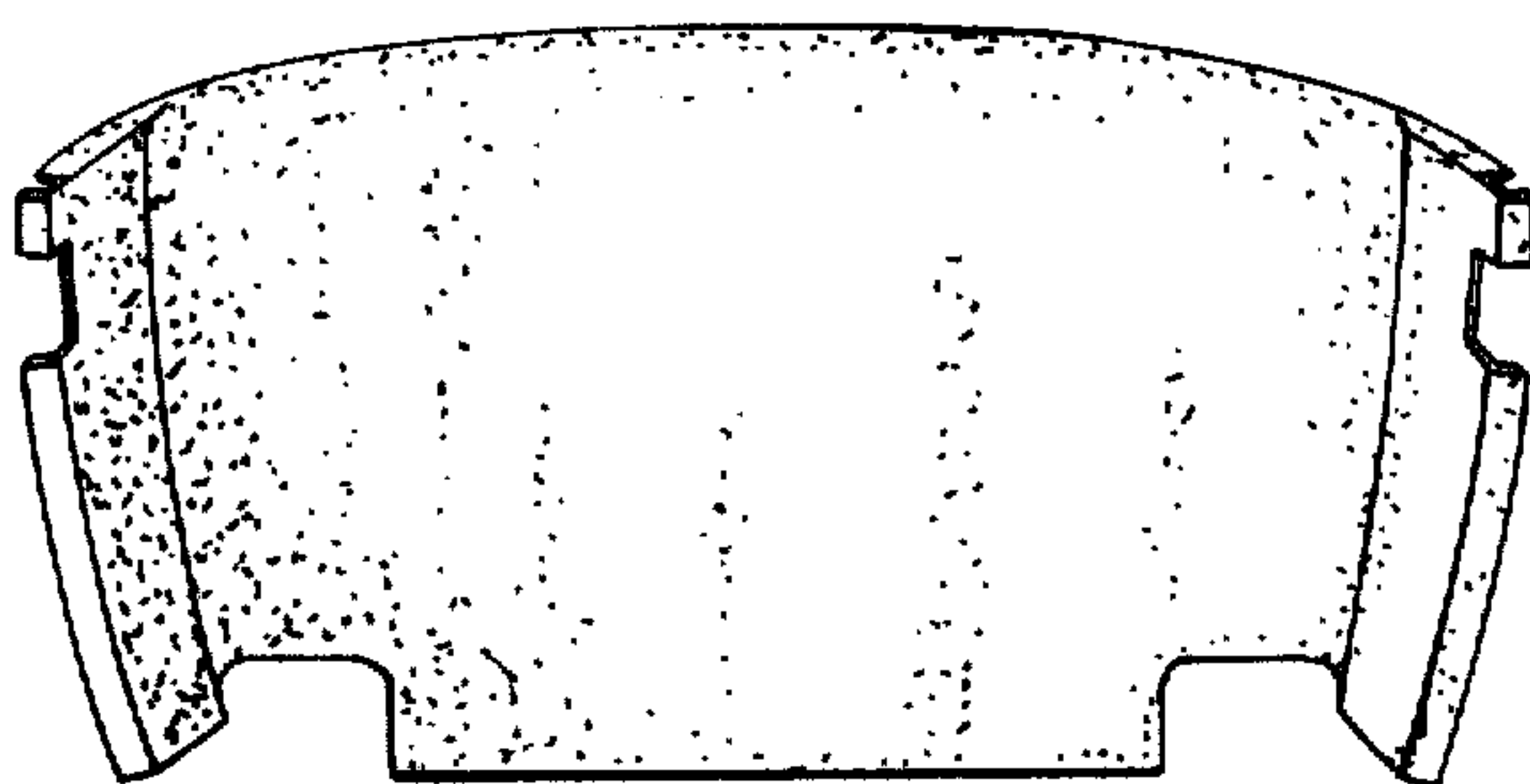

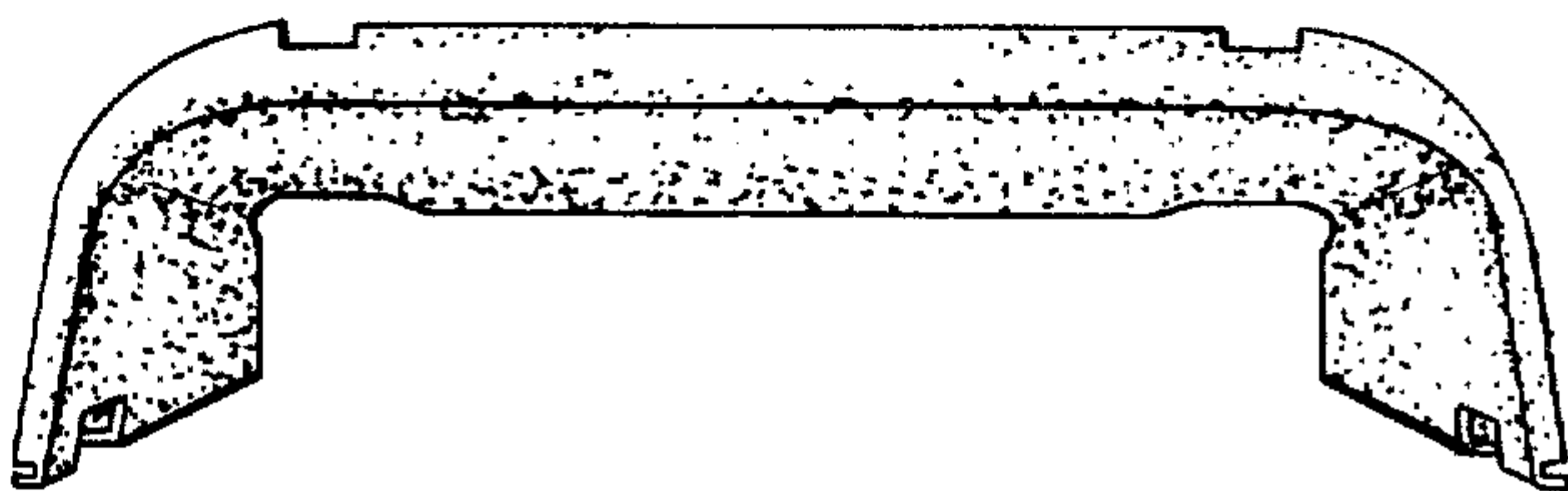
