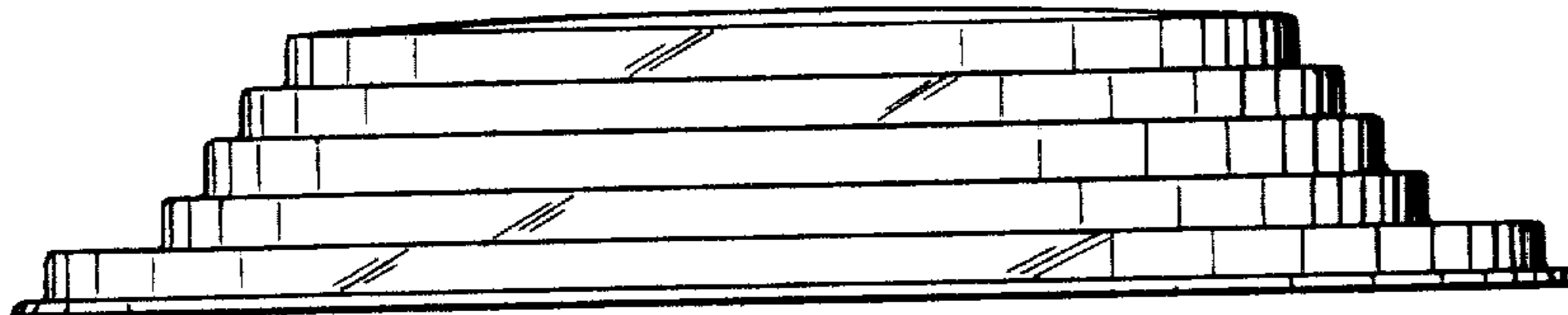

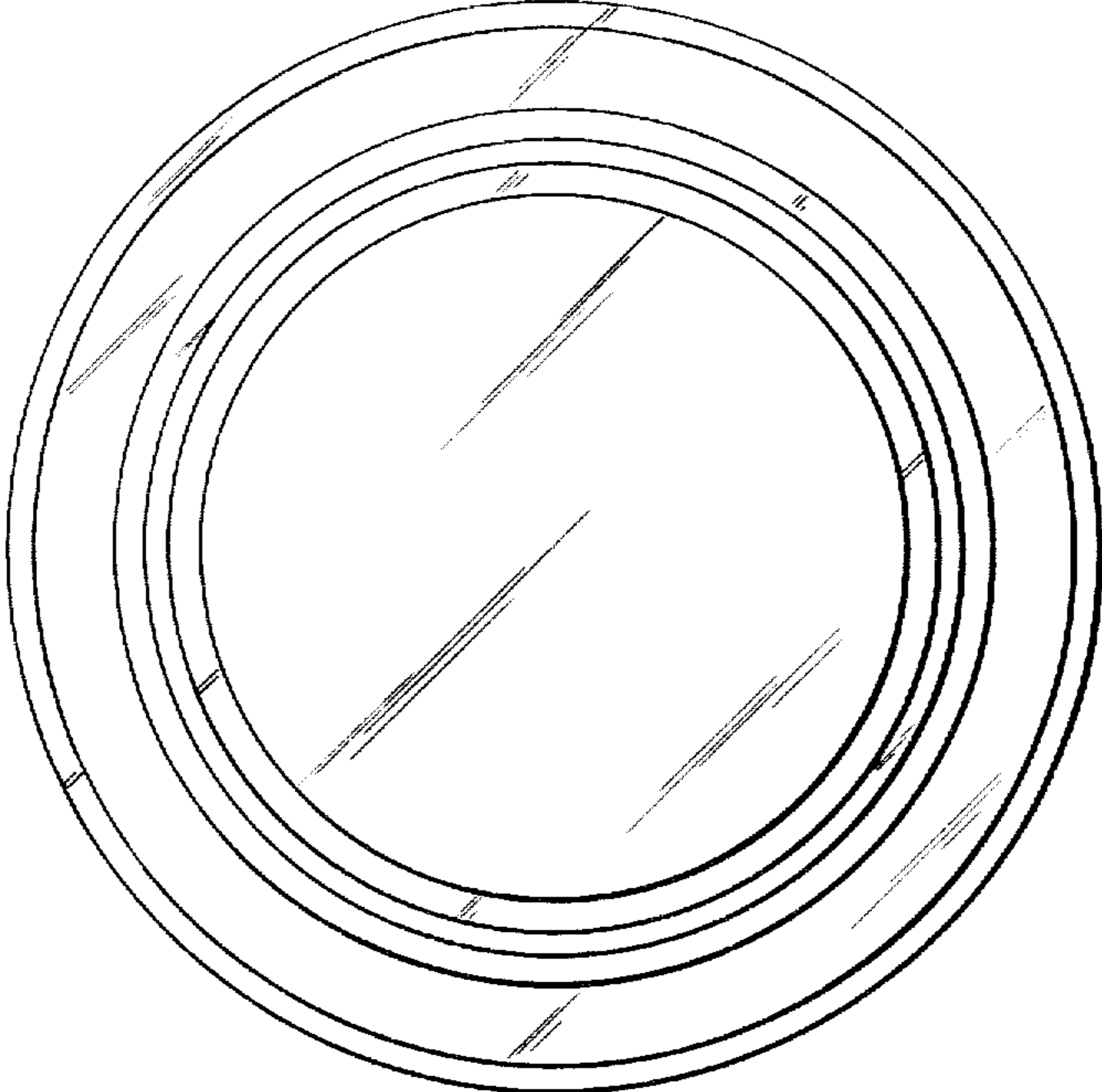
The ornamental design for a can lid, as shown.

**DESCRIPTION**

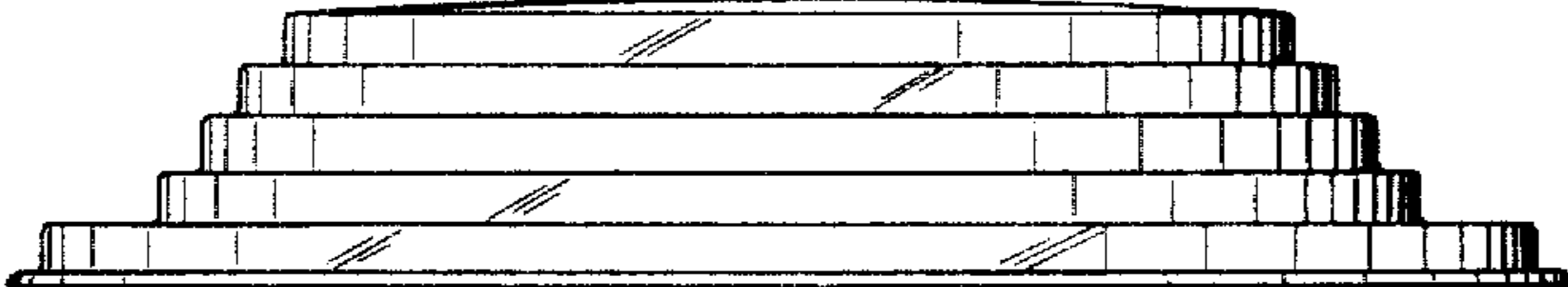
**FIG. 1** is a top plan view of a lid showing my new design;
