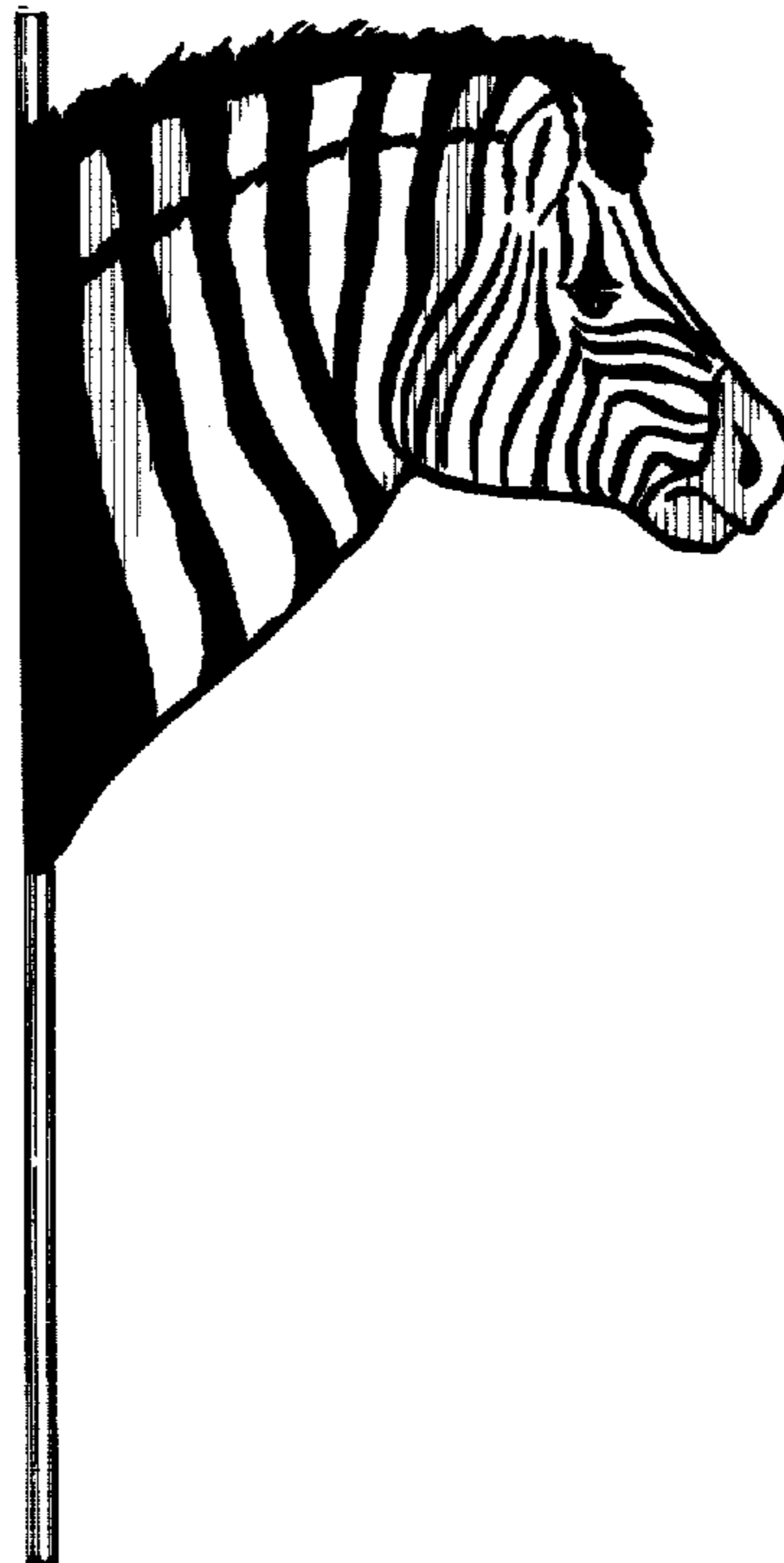
CLAIM
