FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a facsimile electrostatic copier showing my new design;

 FIG. 7 is a front perspective view thereof.

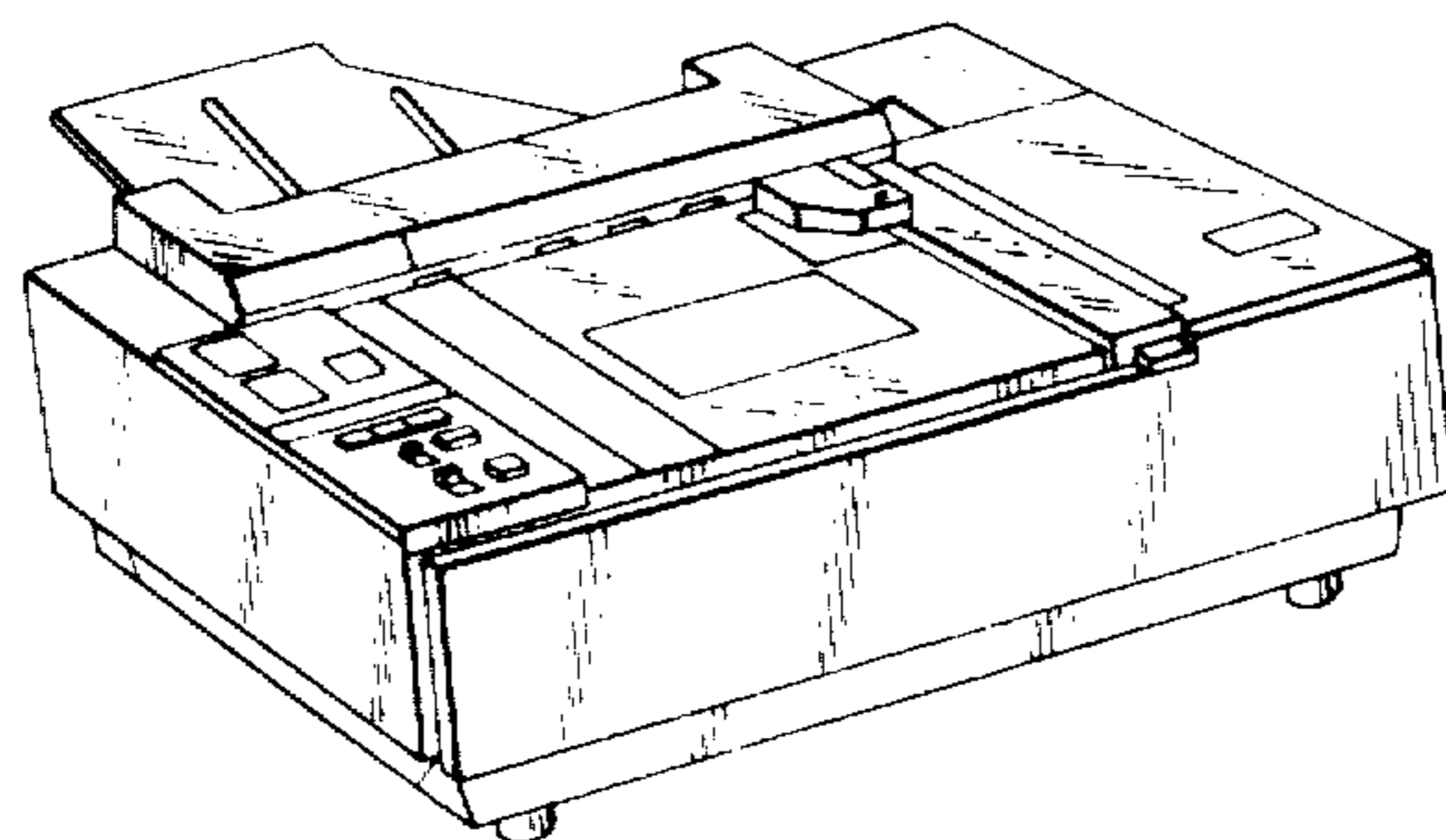

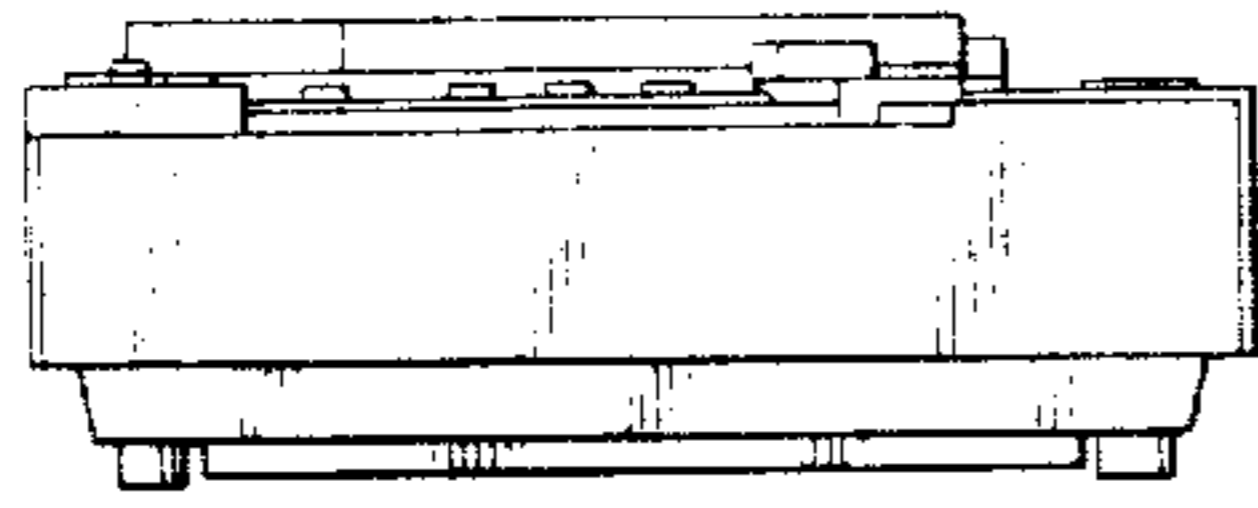

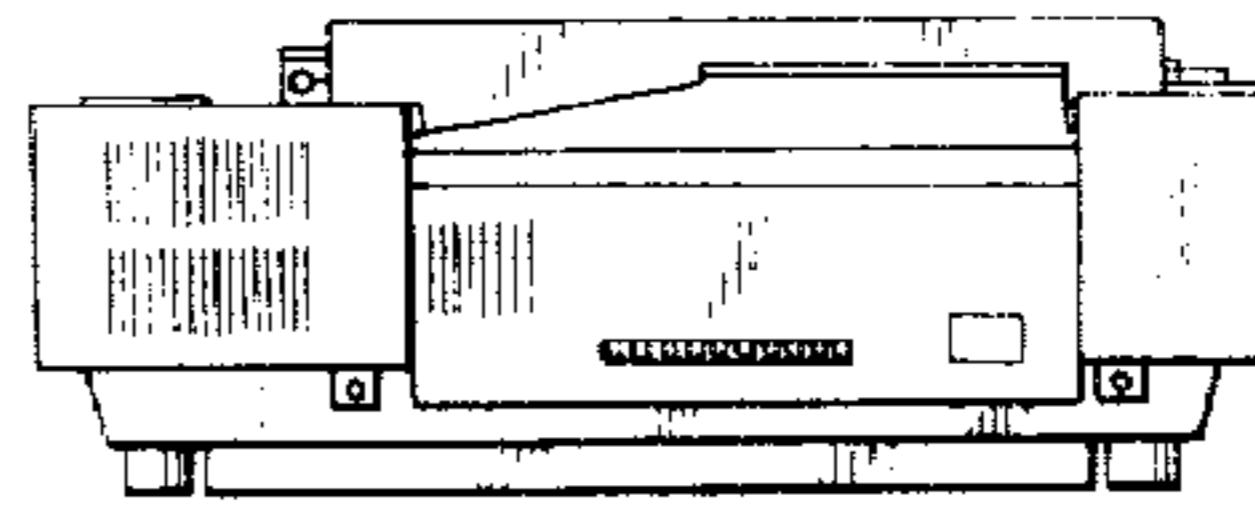

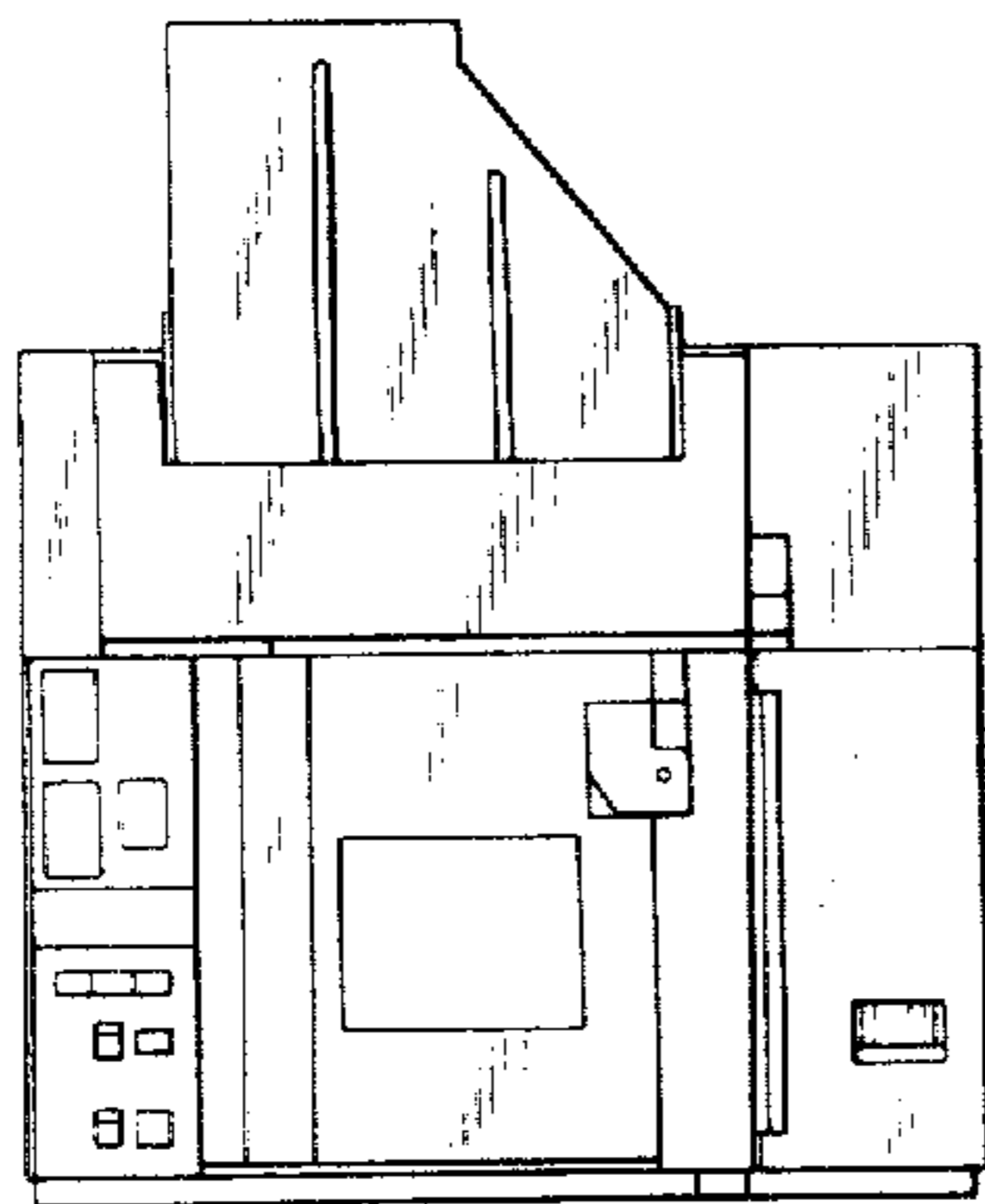

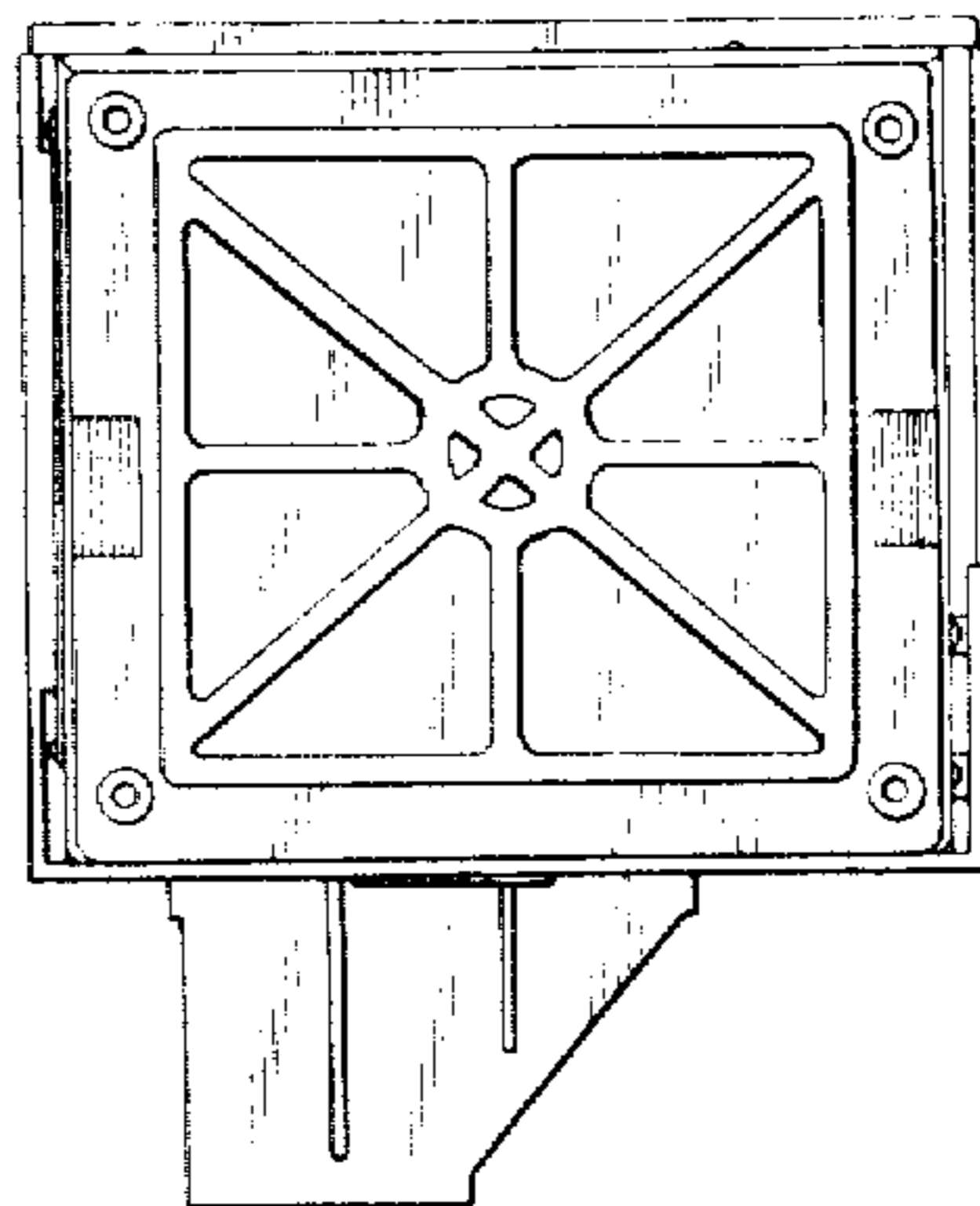

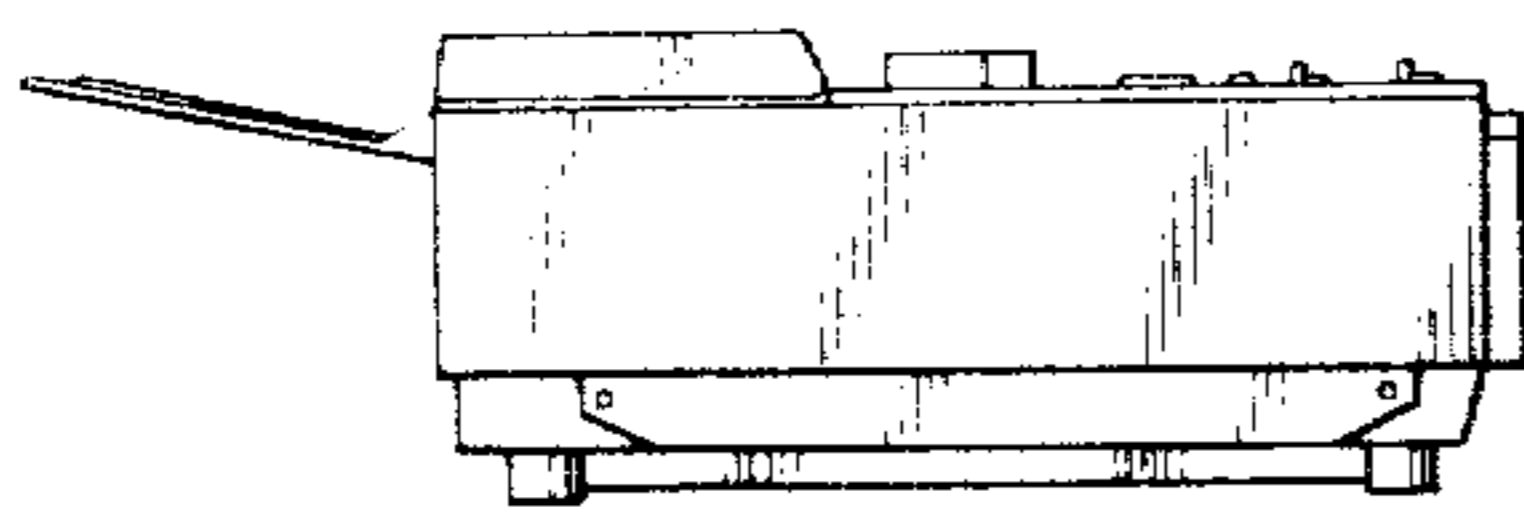

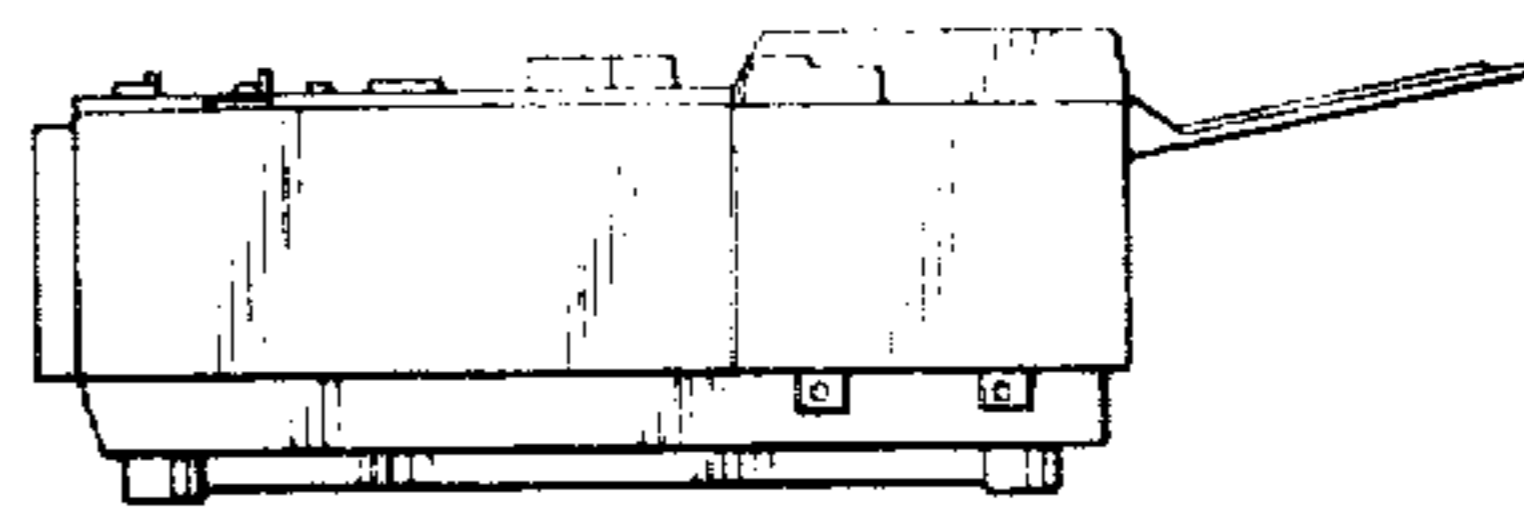
