[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for an electronic tennis game housing, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an electronic tennis game housing showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof (the left side being a mirror image thereof); and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

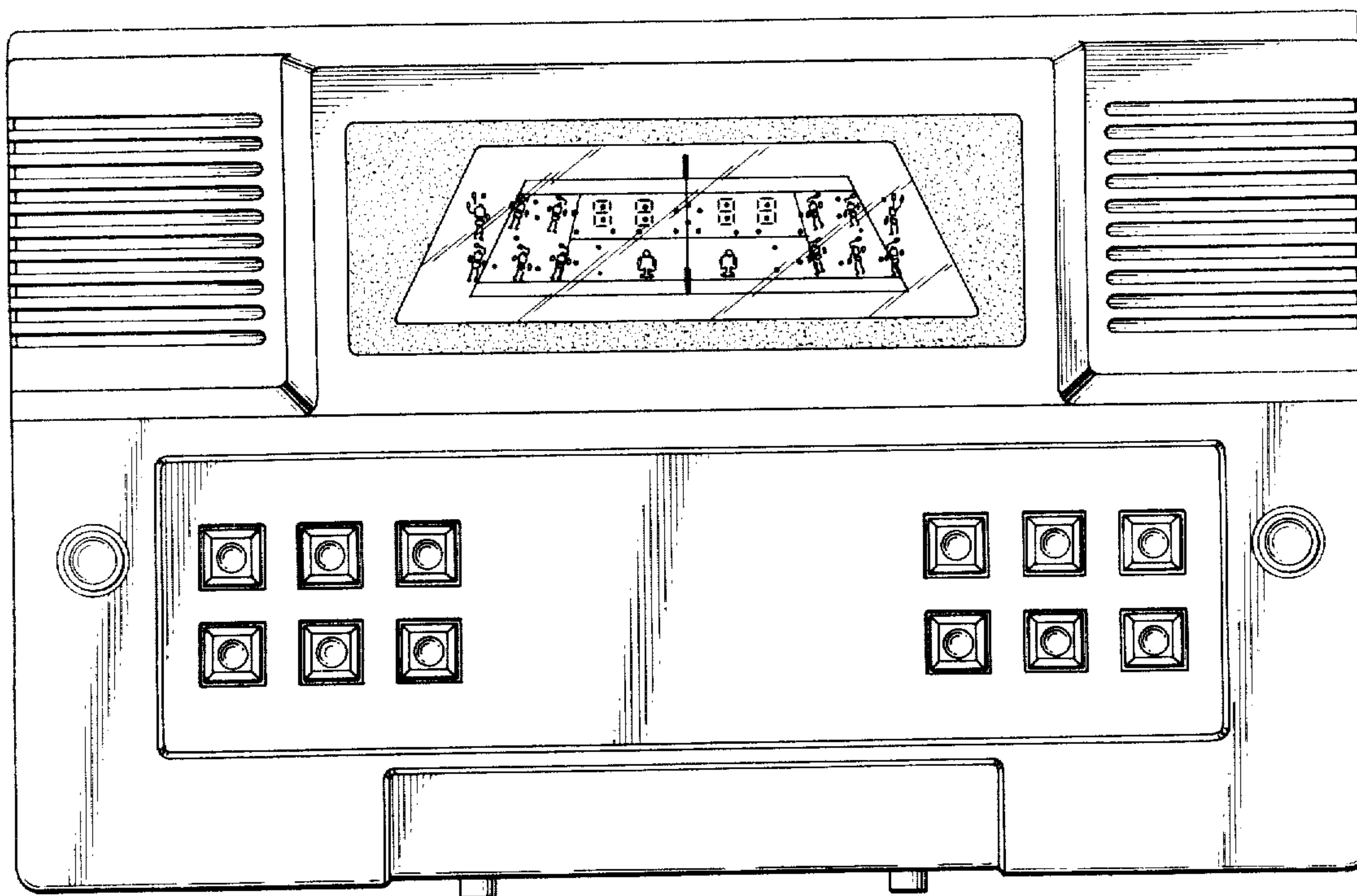
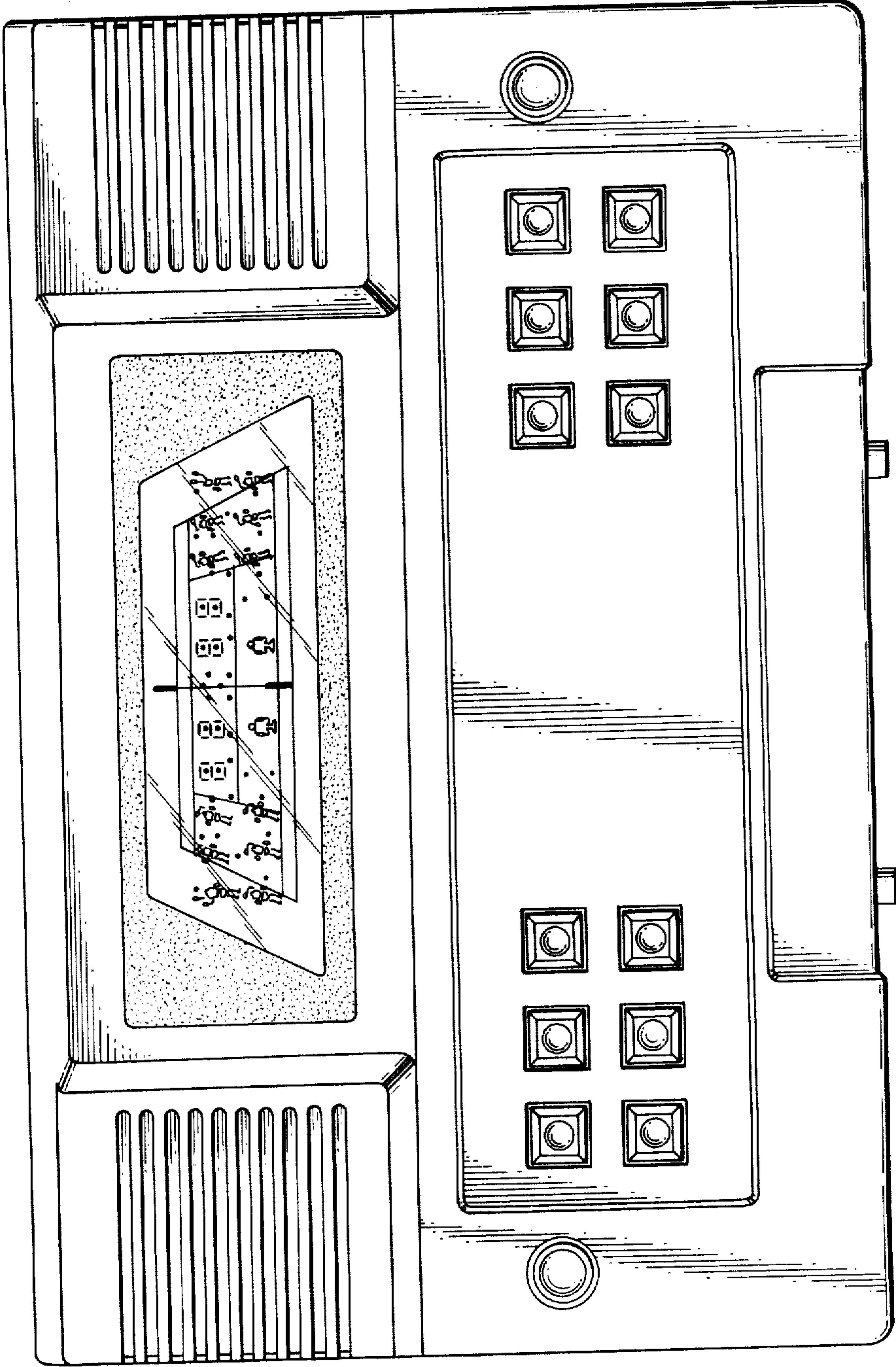

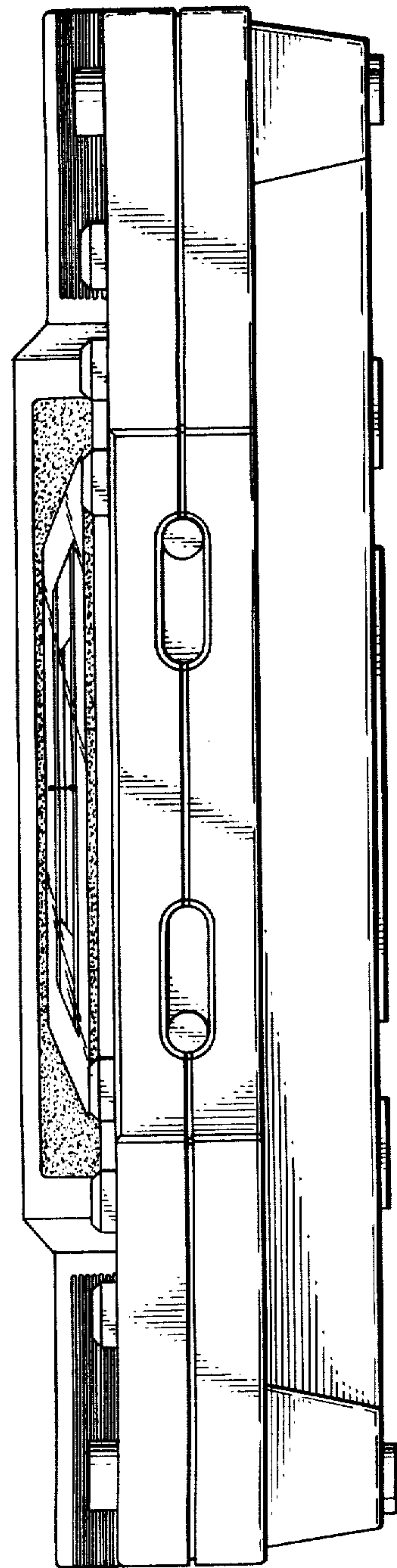

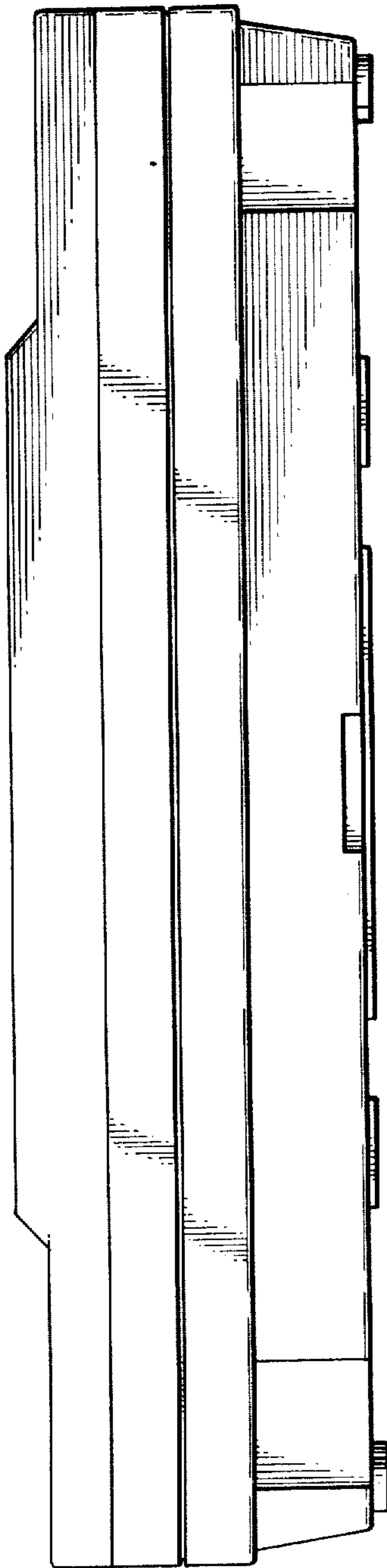

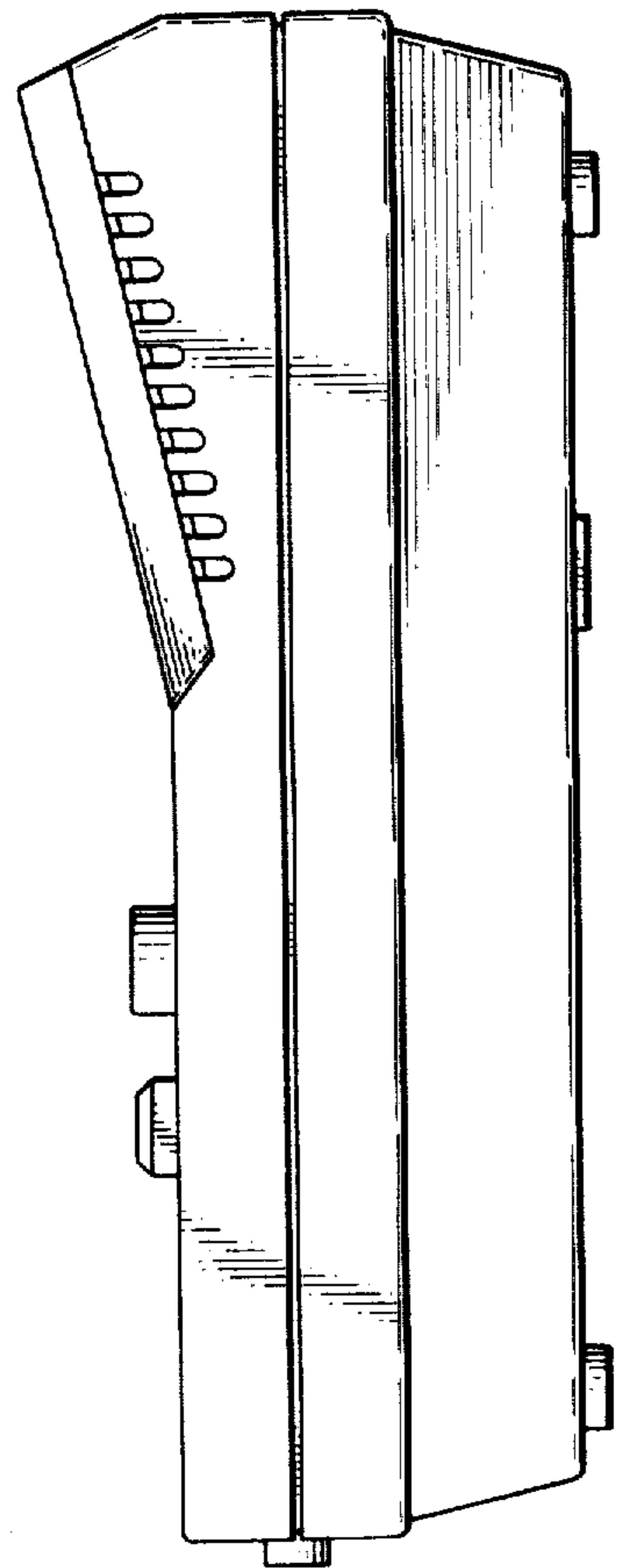
