FIG. 1 is a top-plan view of a stepping pad for a game, showing my new design;

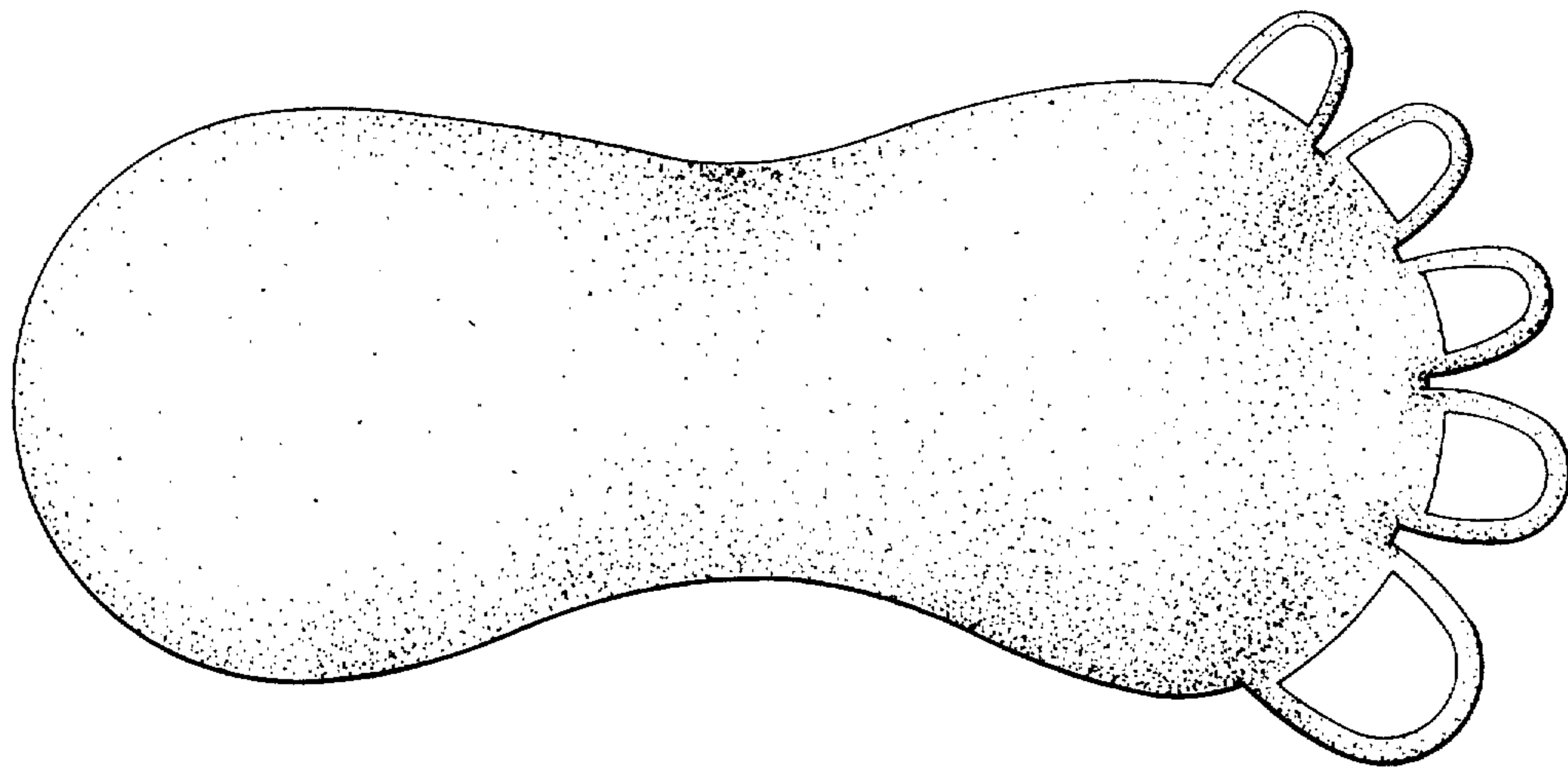
FIG. 2 is a bottom-plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear-elevational view thereof.



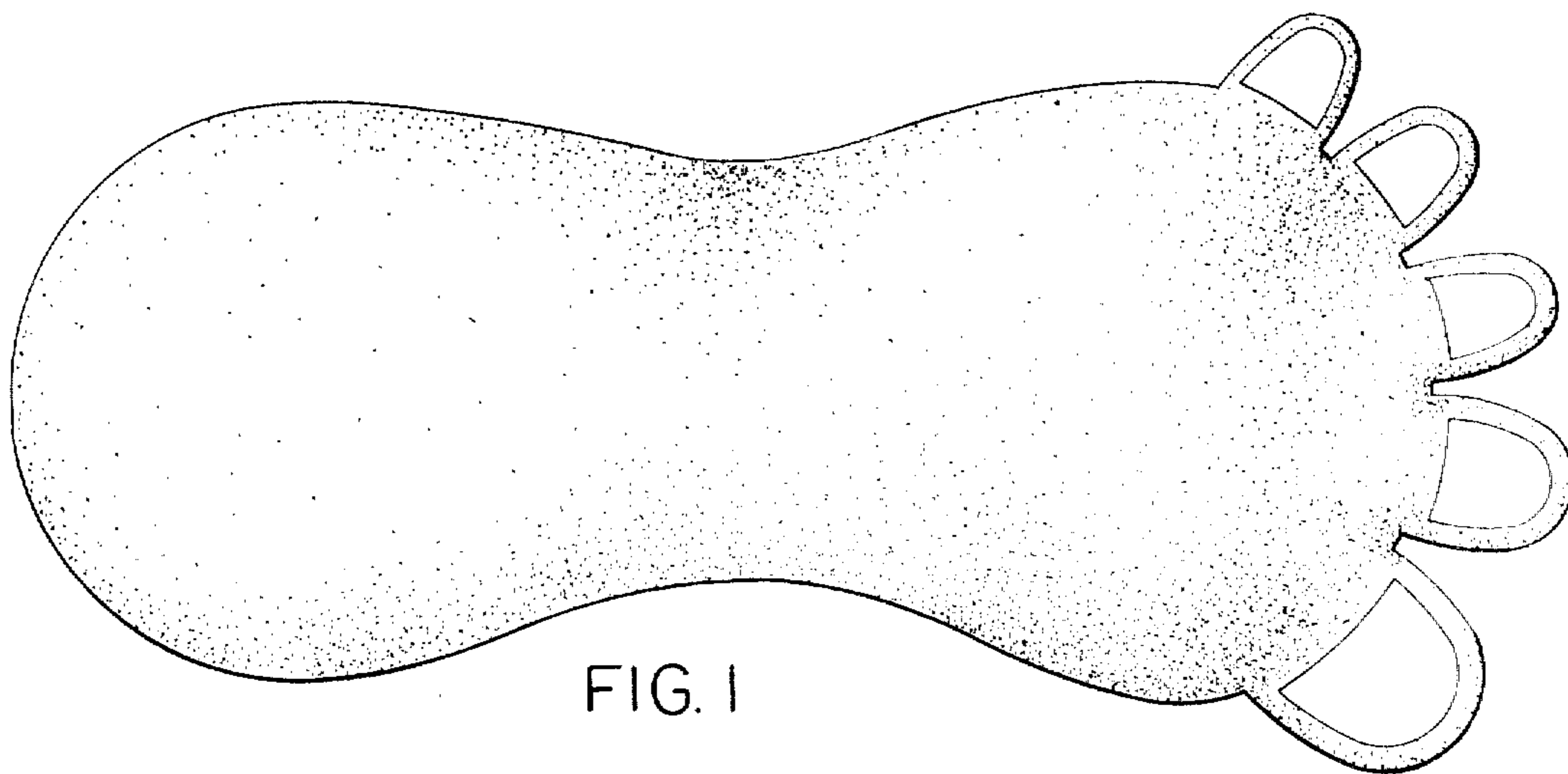

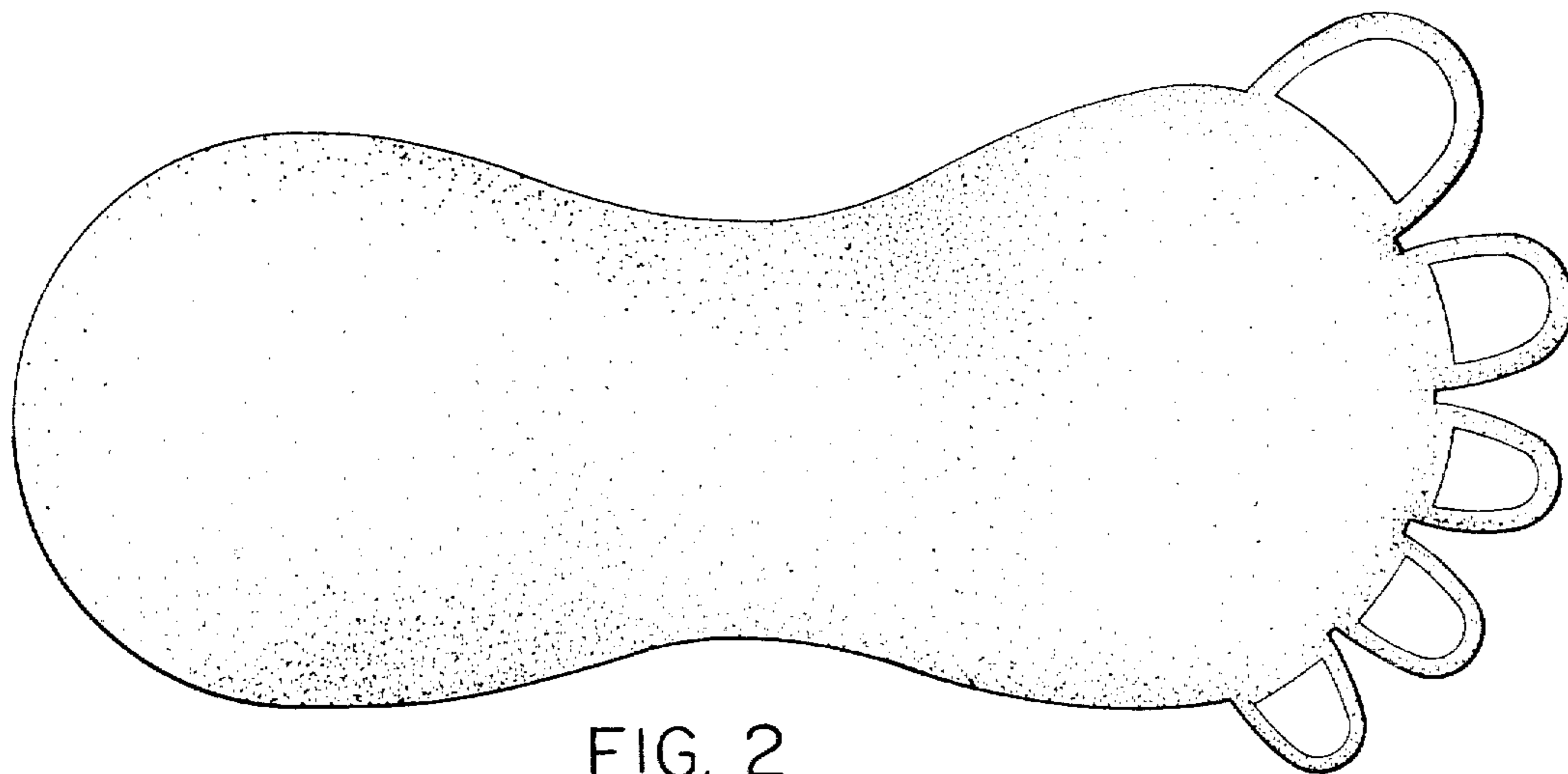

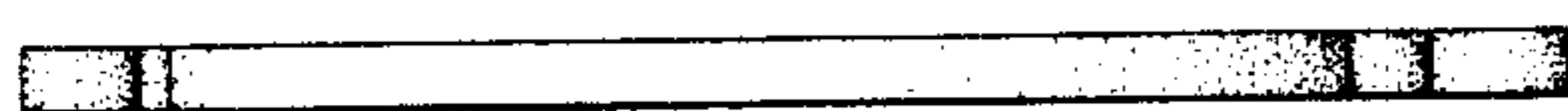
