DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a mammary bandage showing my new design;

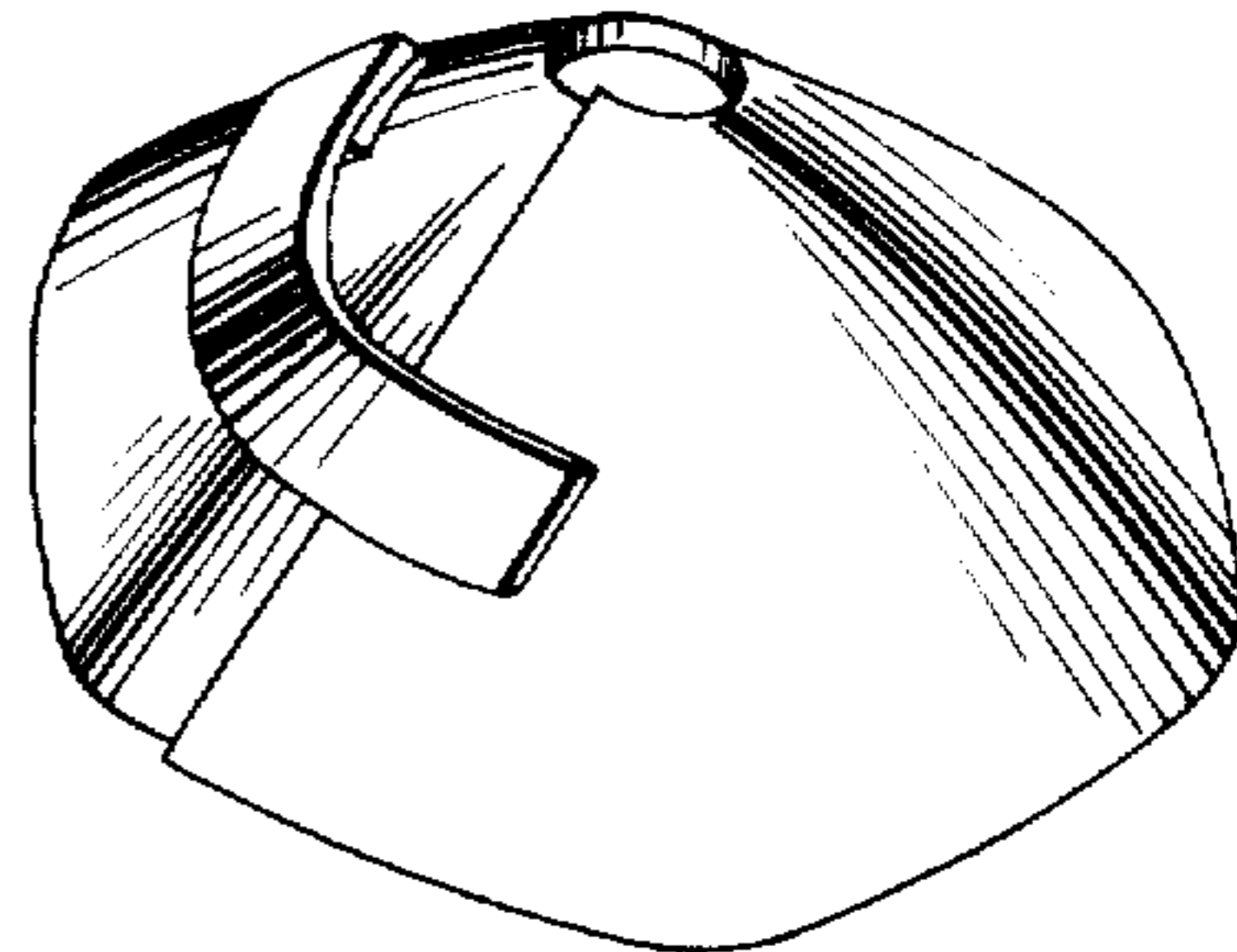
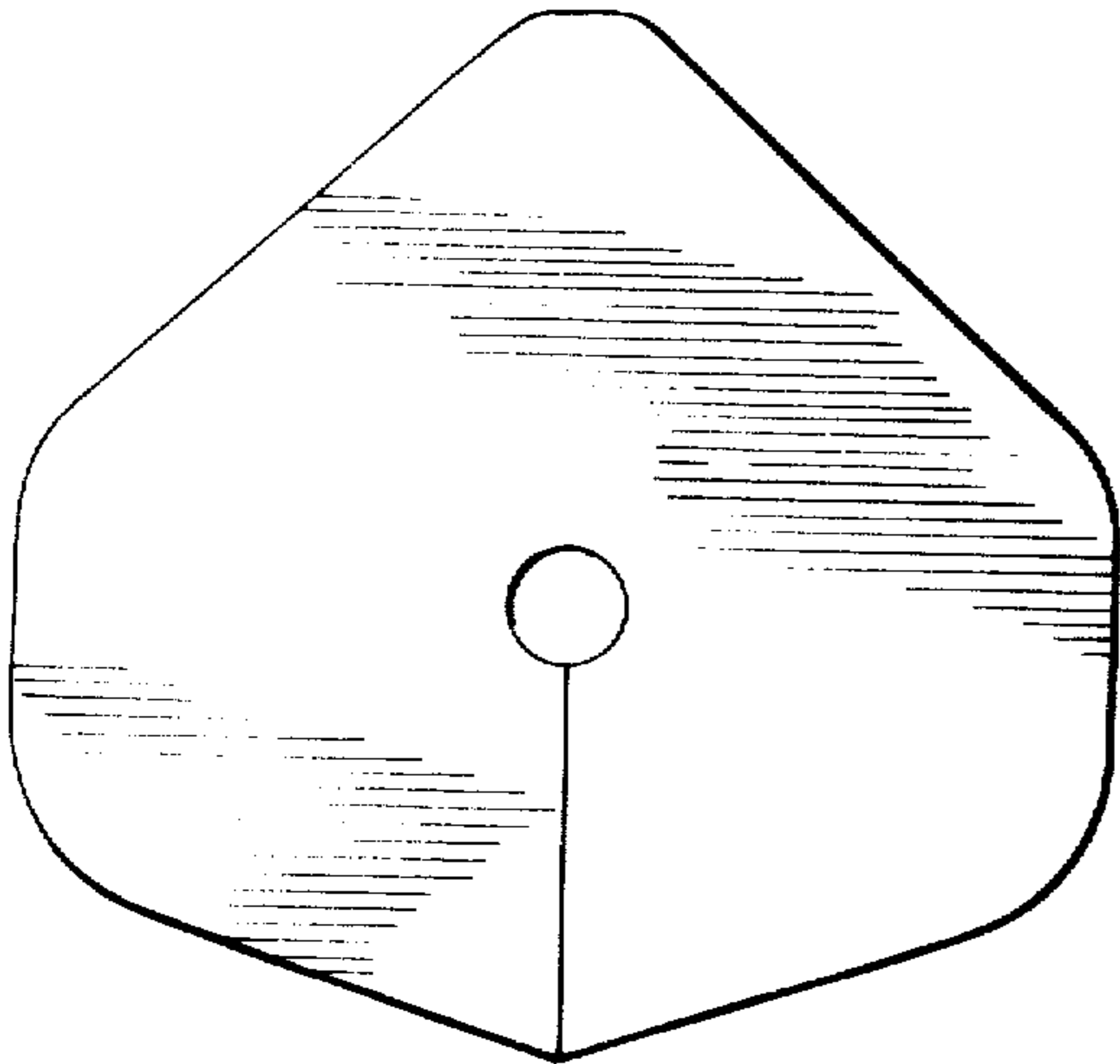

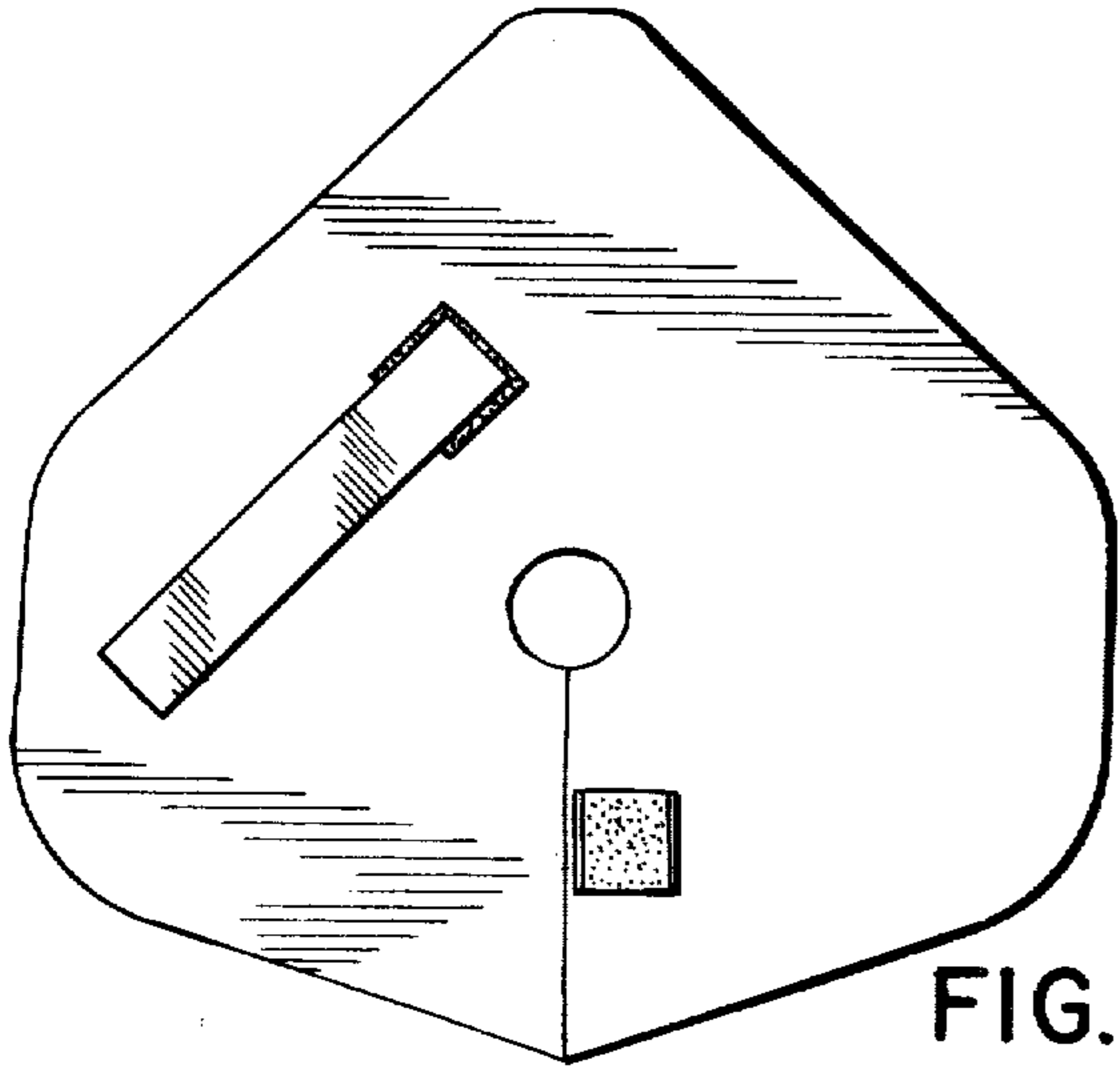

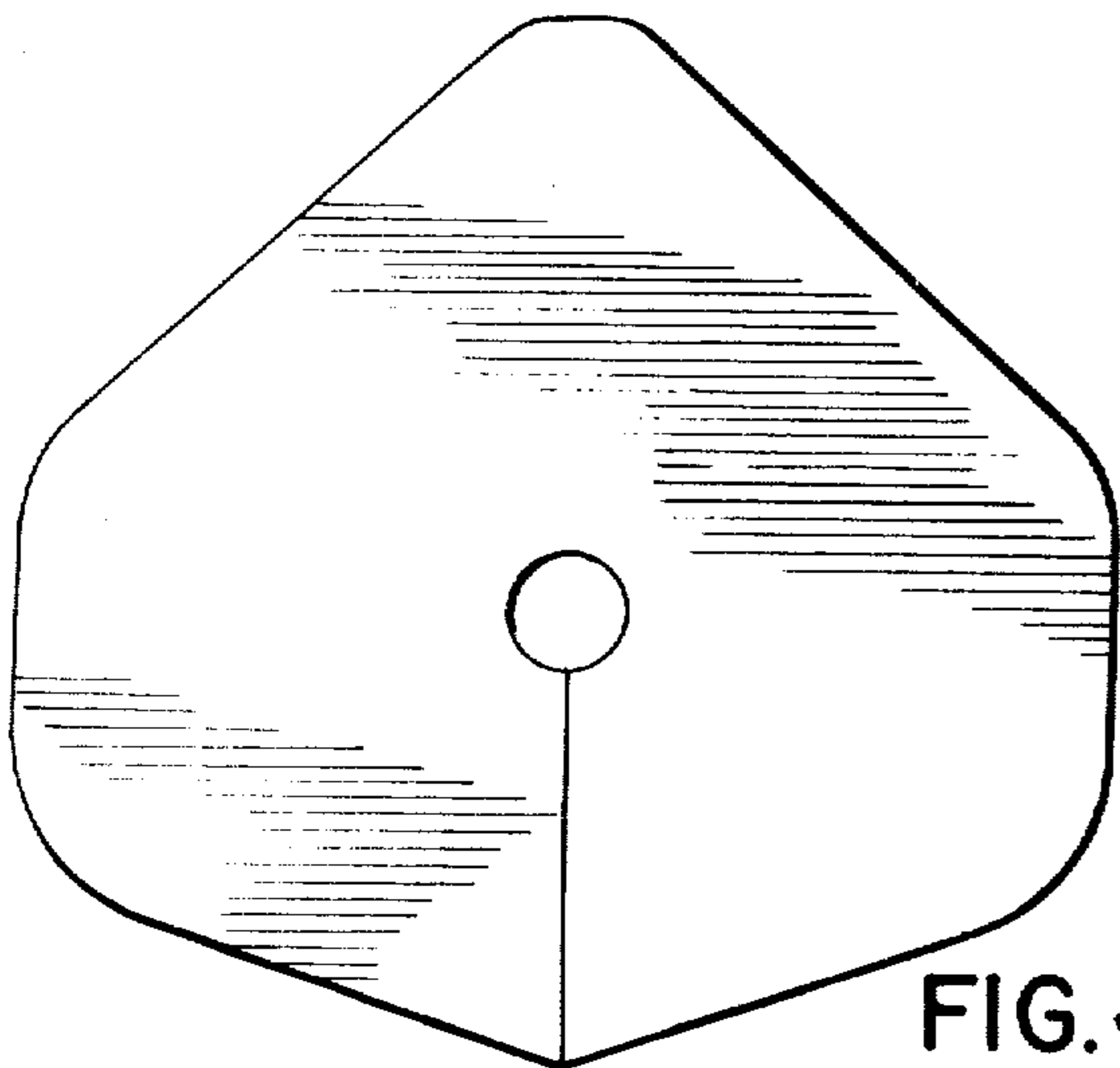

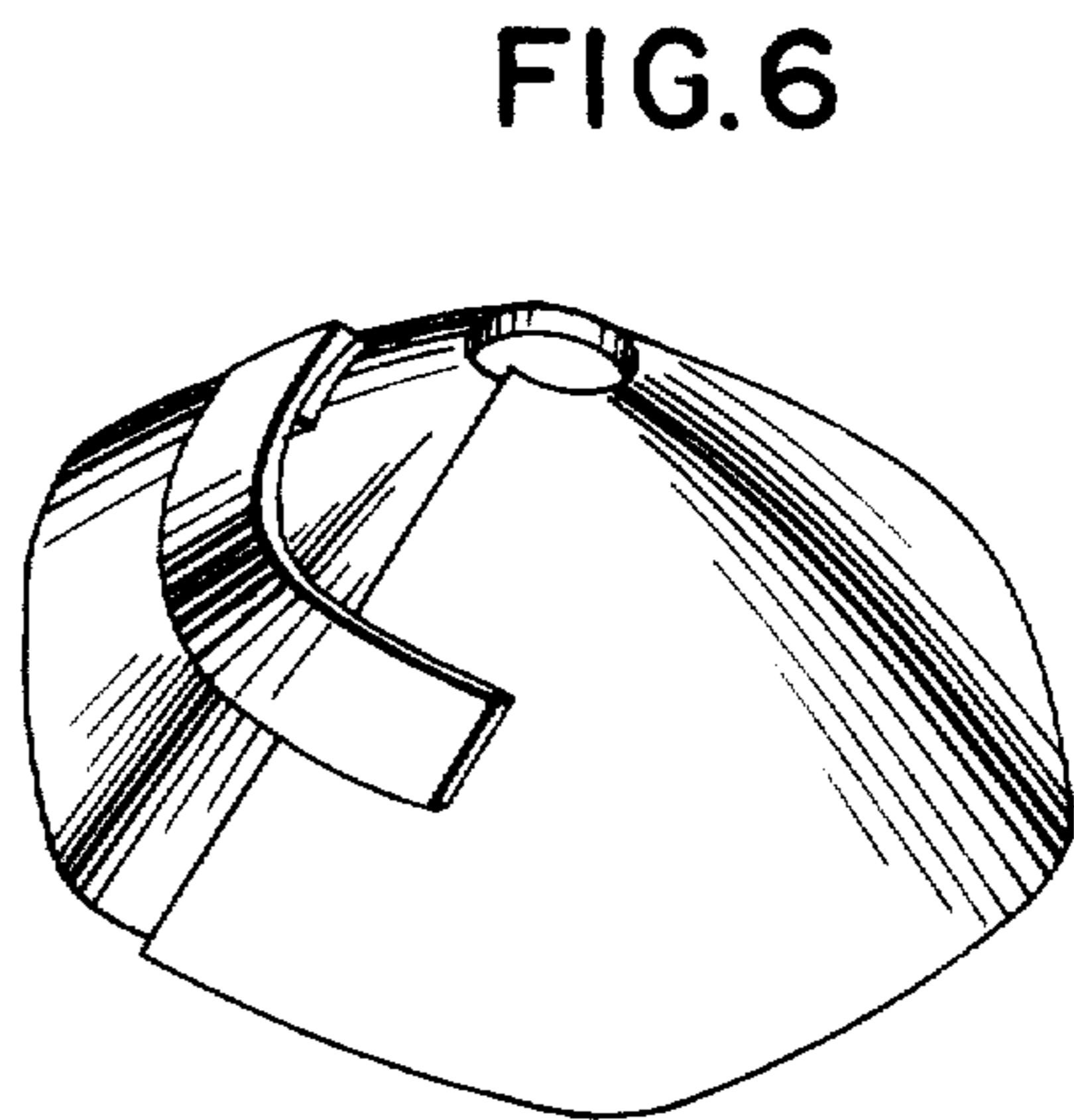
