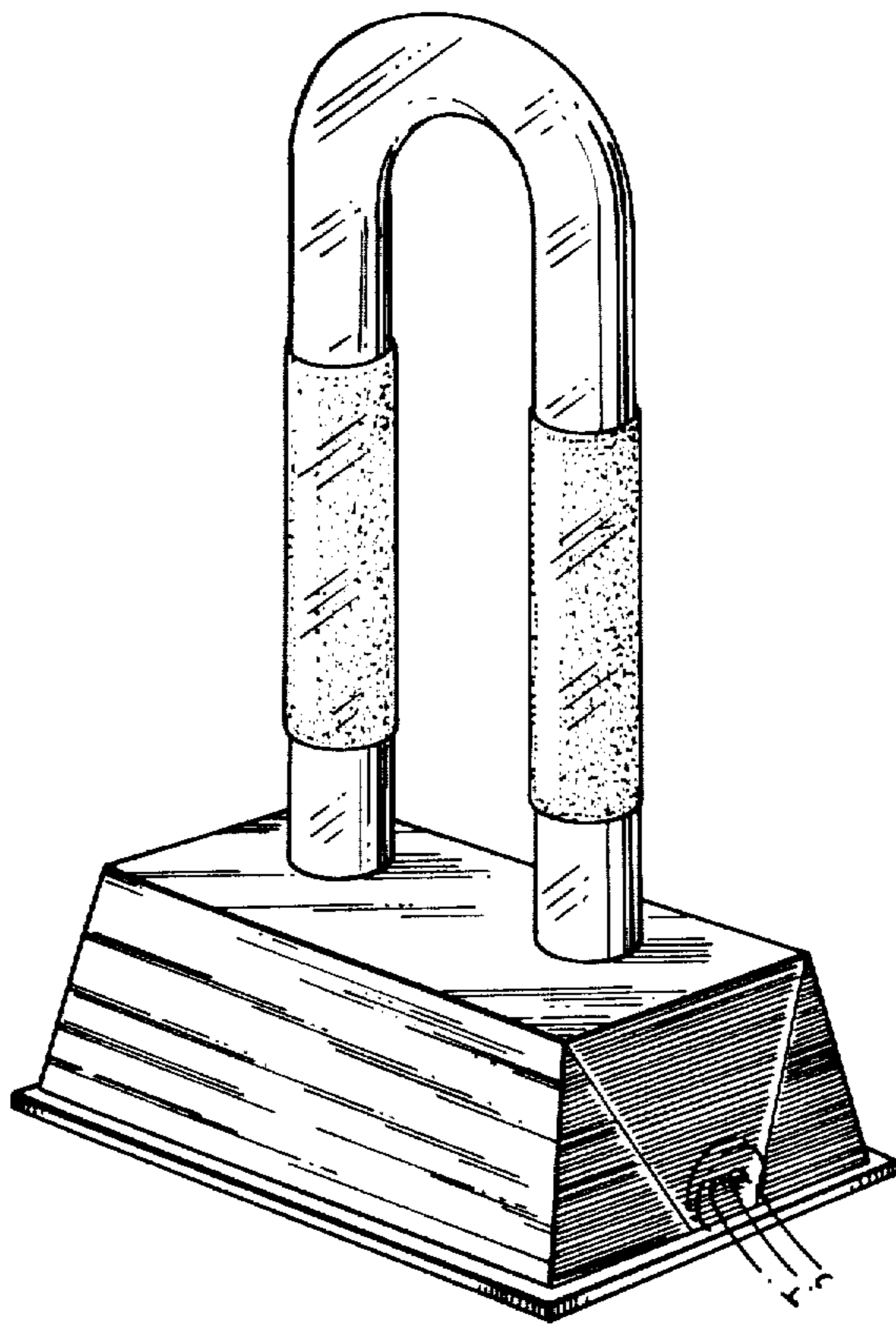

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a lamp, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a lamp illustrating our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a plan view thereof.
The lamp is shaded to indicate contrast. The grommet and electric cord are shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.



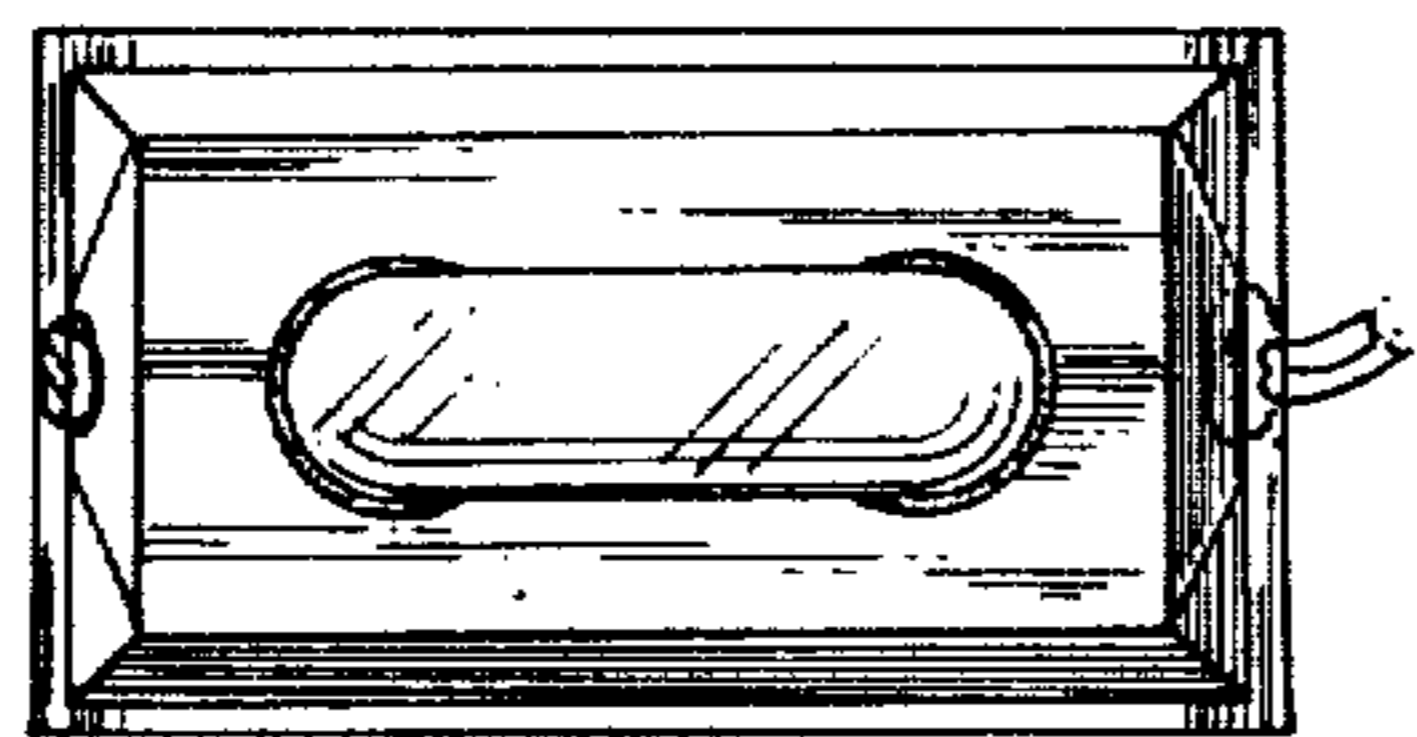
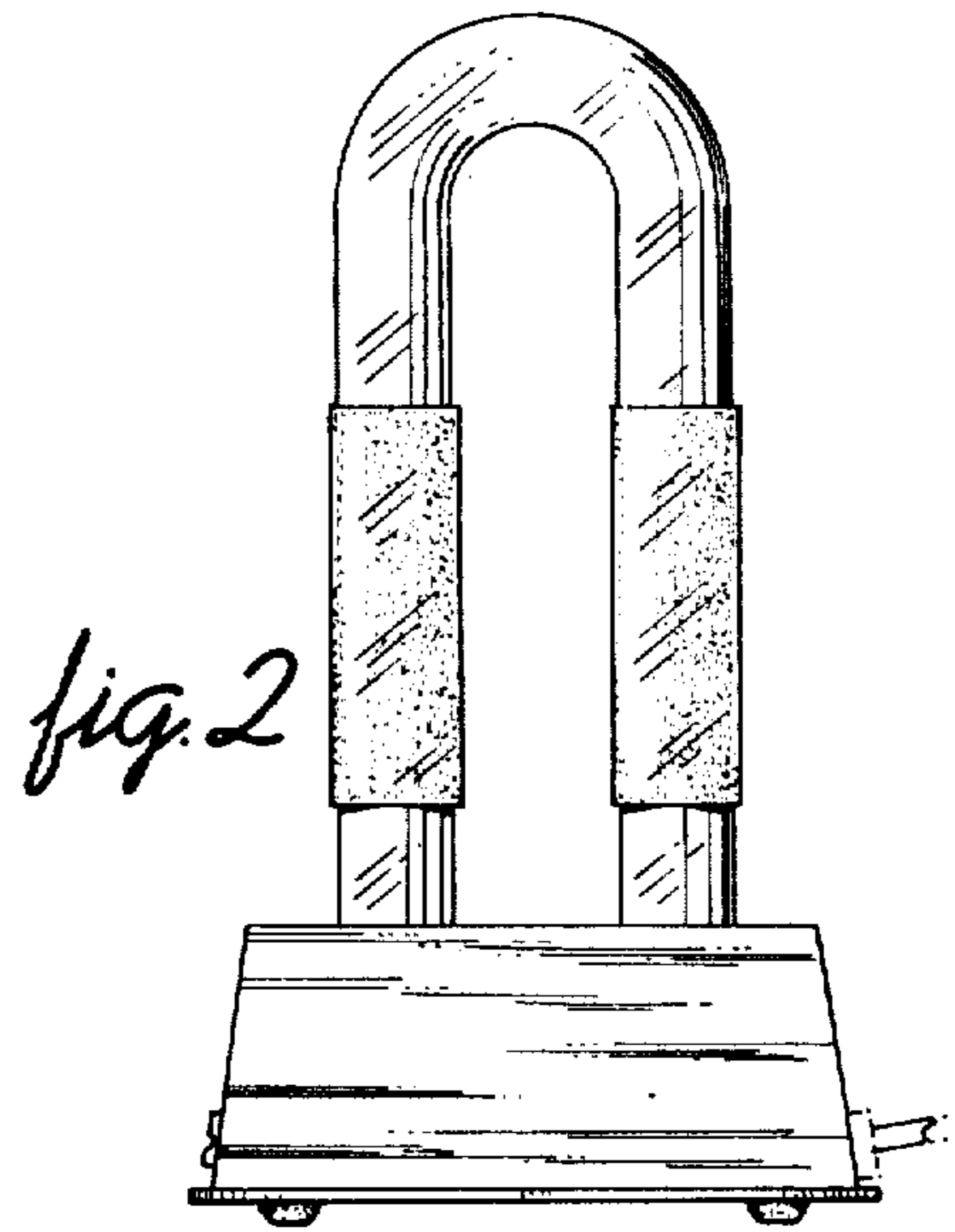
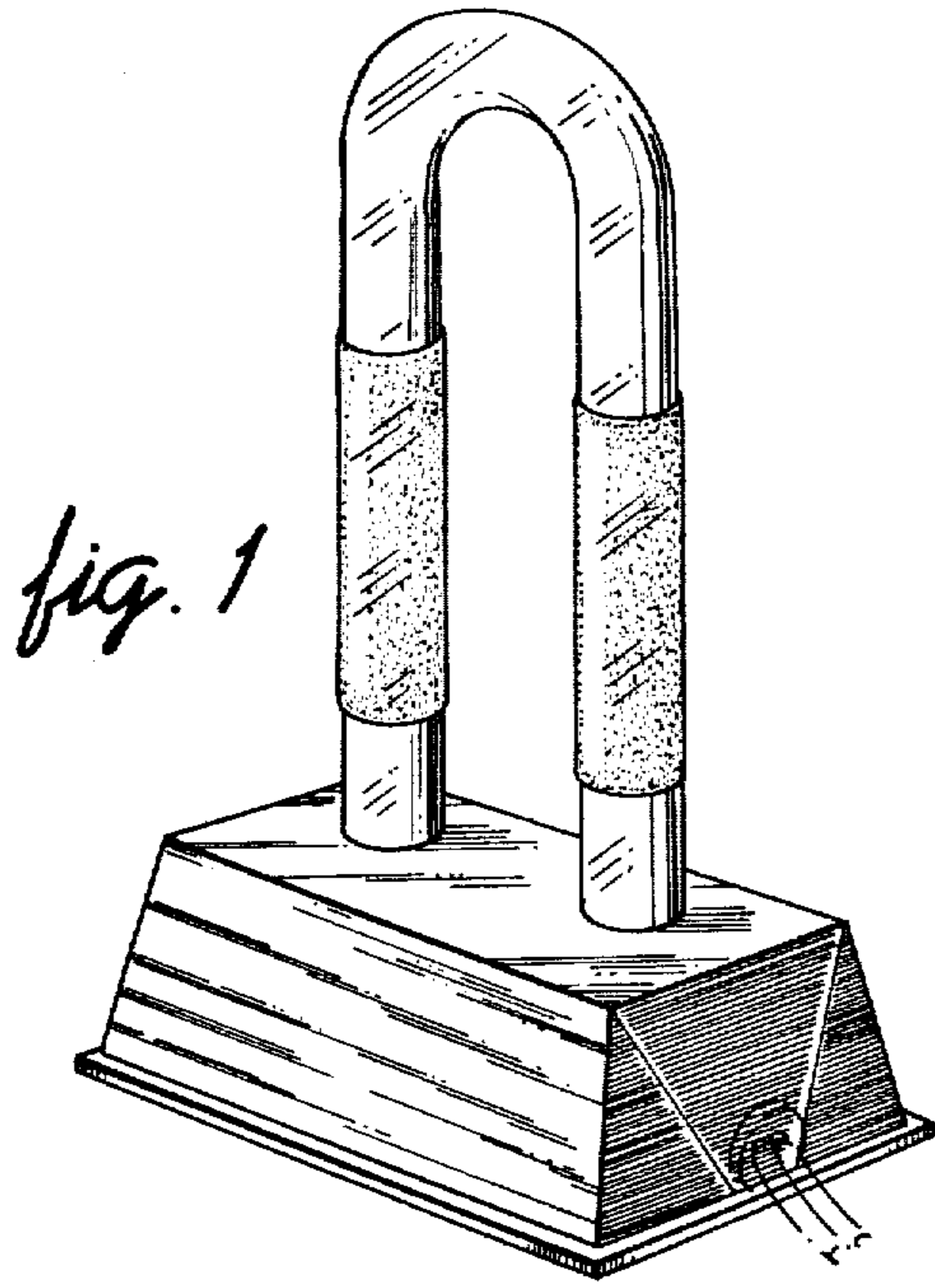
