DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a hand held hair dryer embodying my new design including the top, front and one side thereof;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof showing the side opposite that included in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

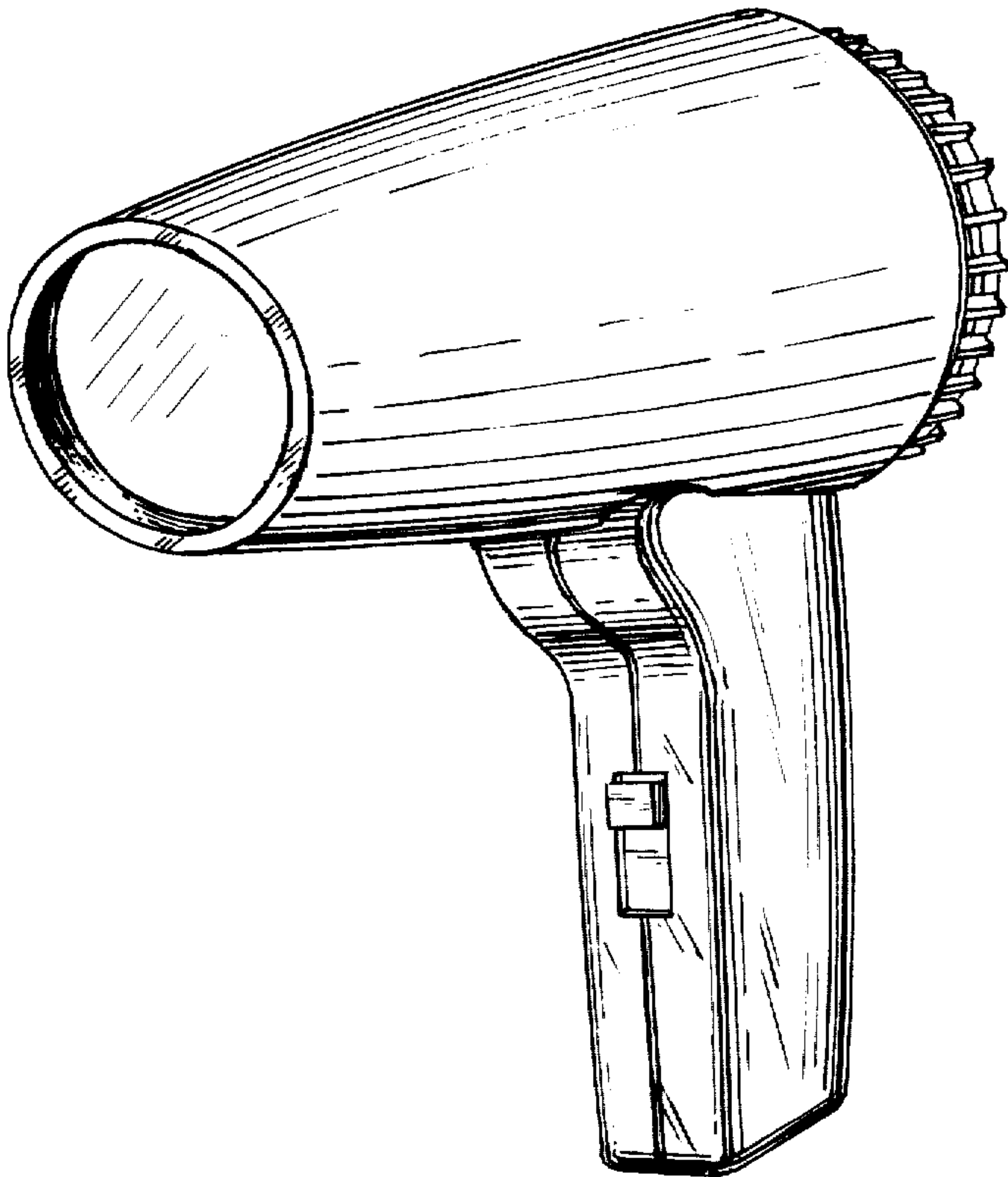

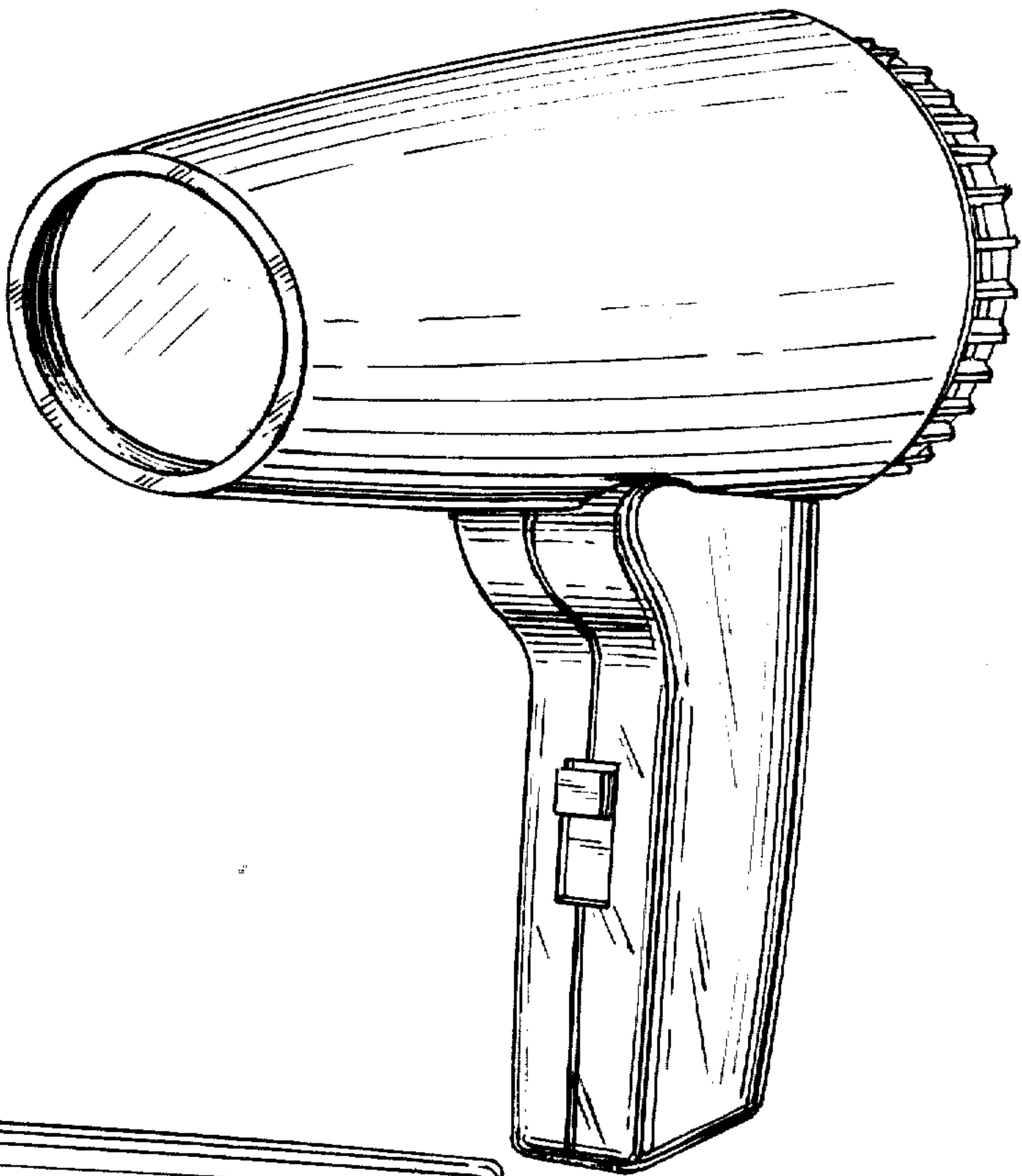

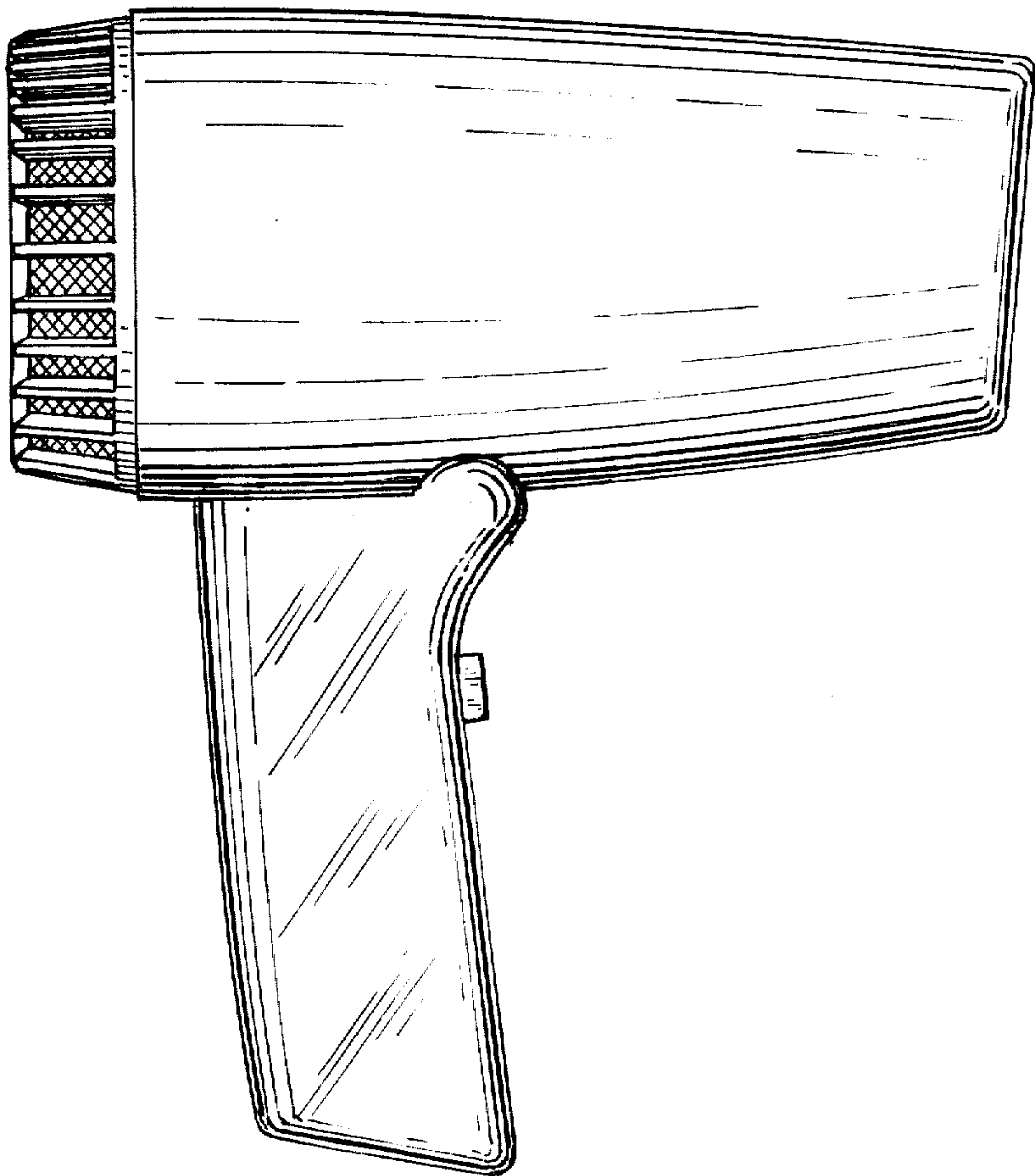

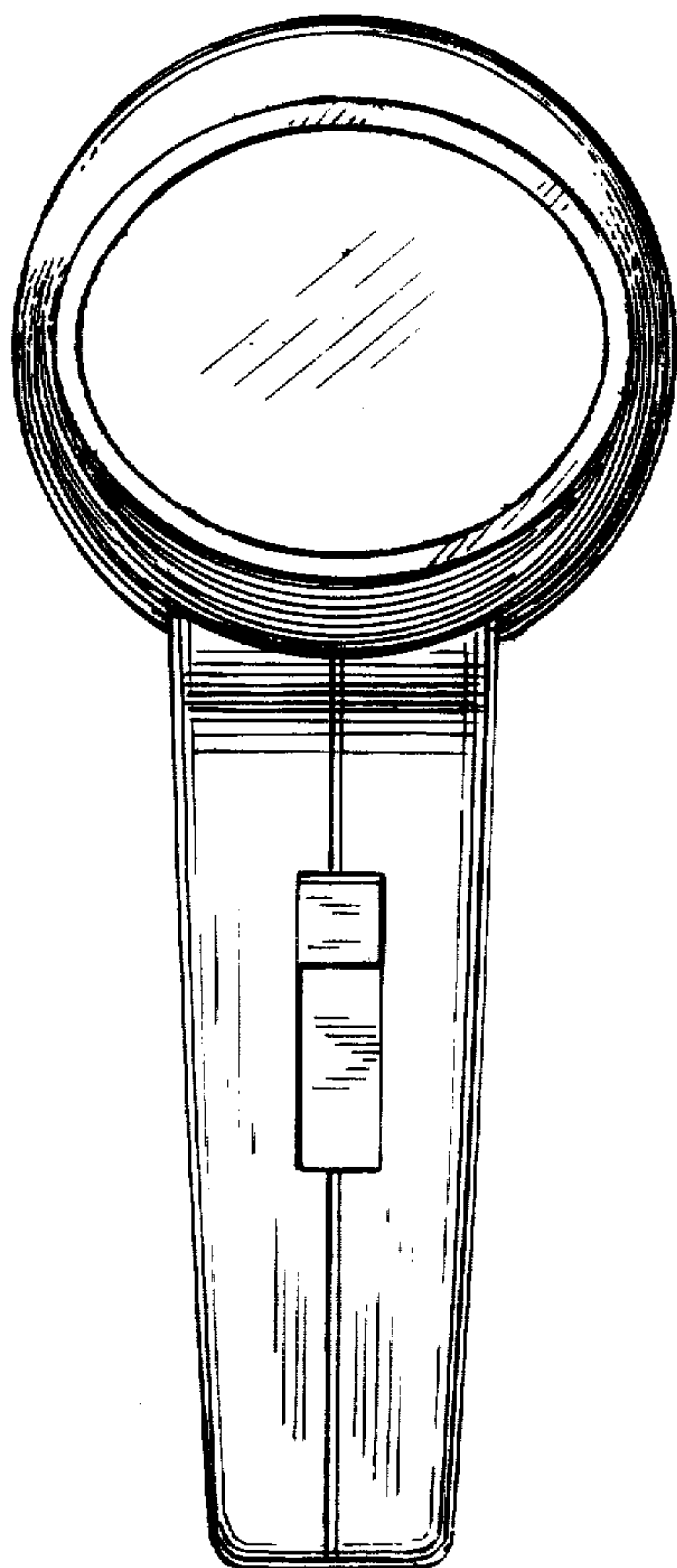

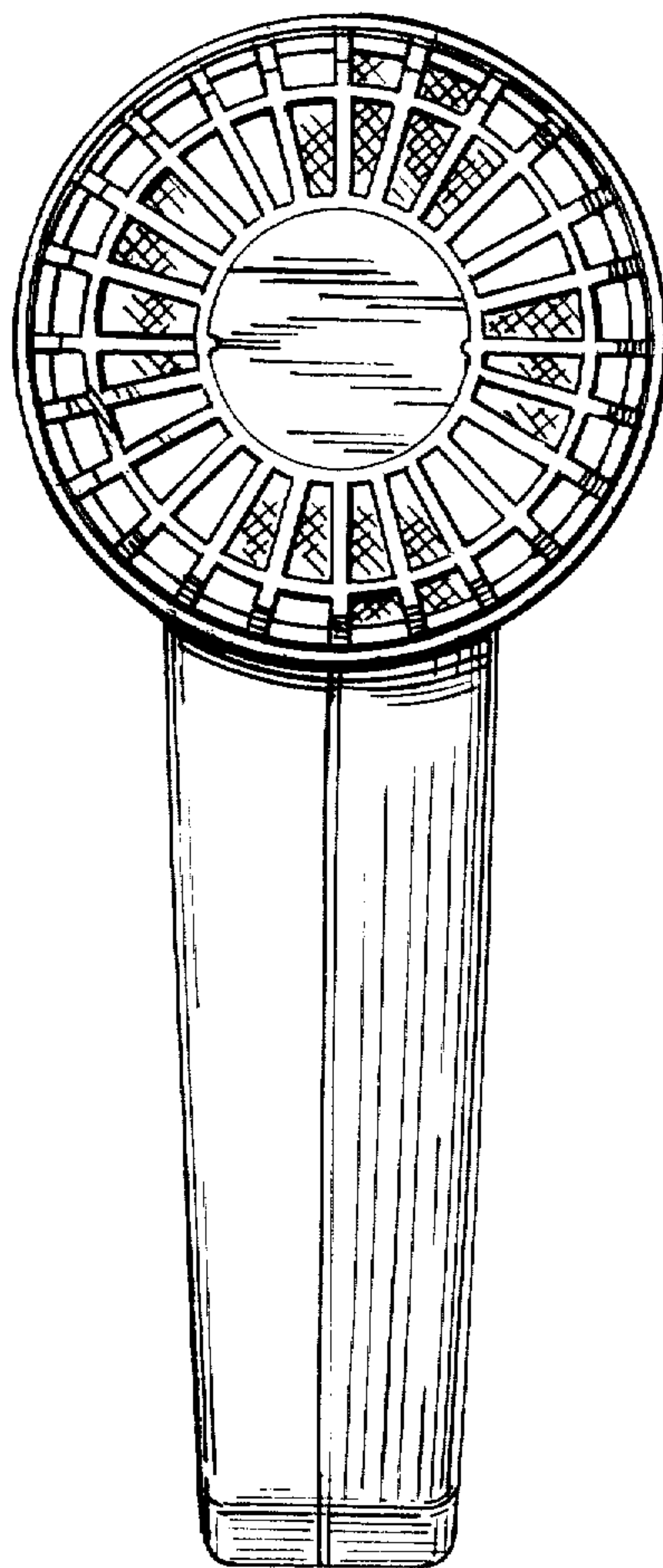
