[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a cat biscuit, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a cat biscuit showing my new design;

FIG. 4 is a cross sectional view taken along line 4-4 of FIG. 1.

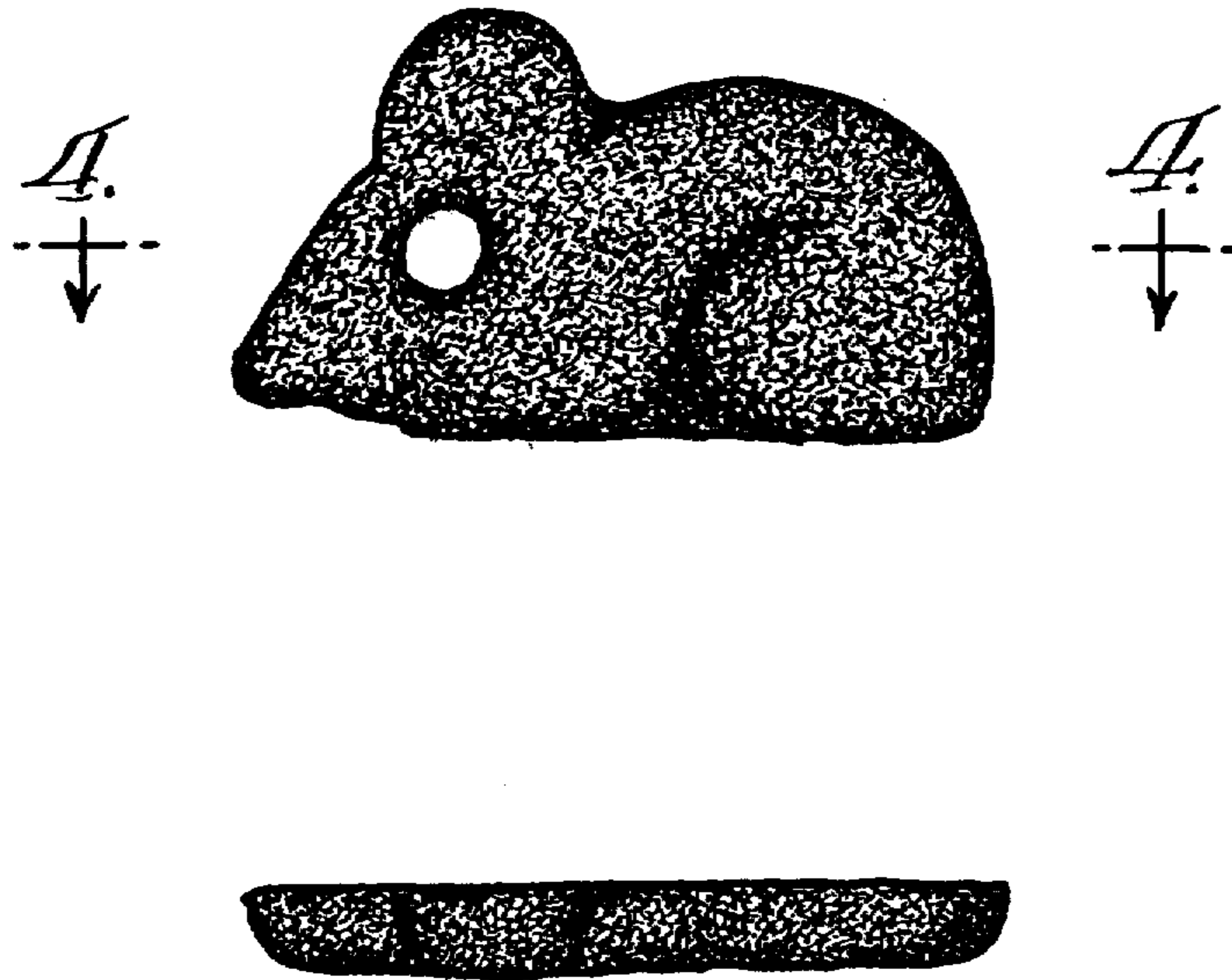

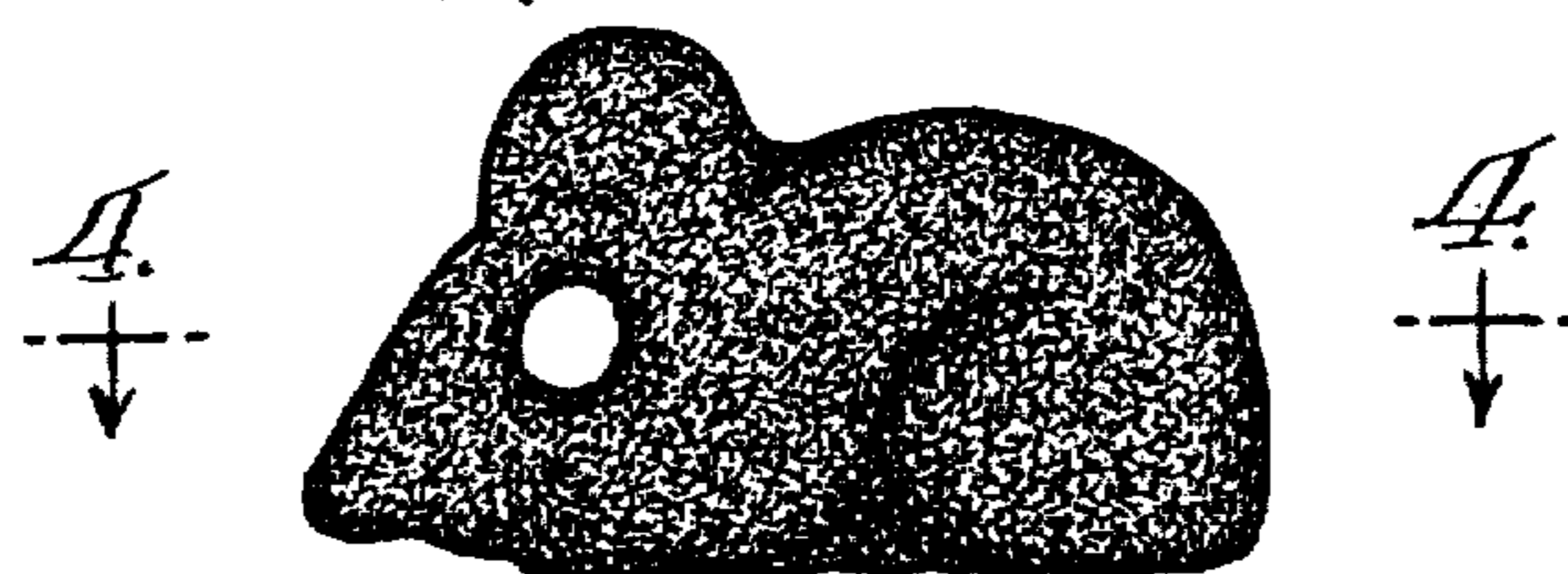
