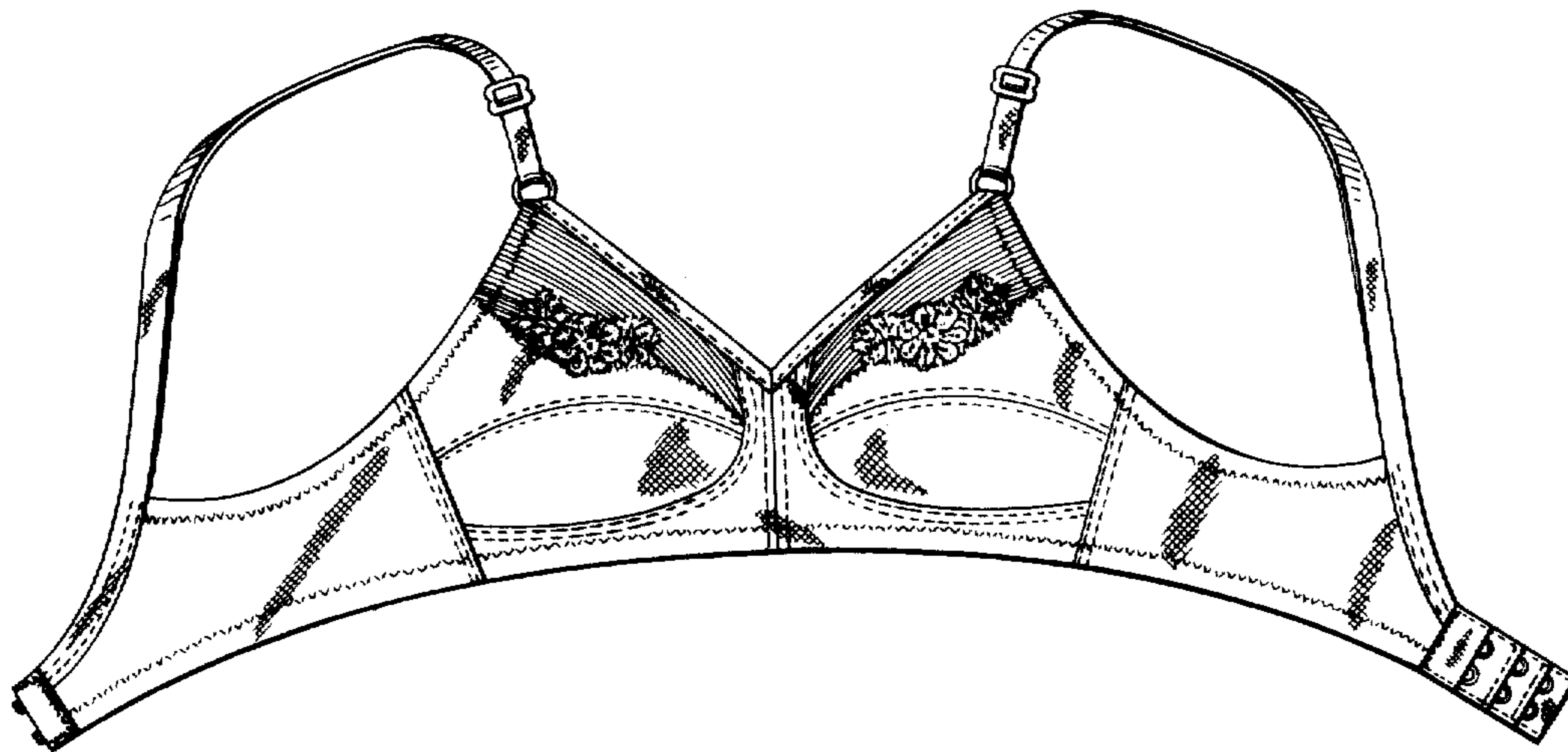

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view.



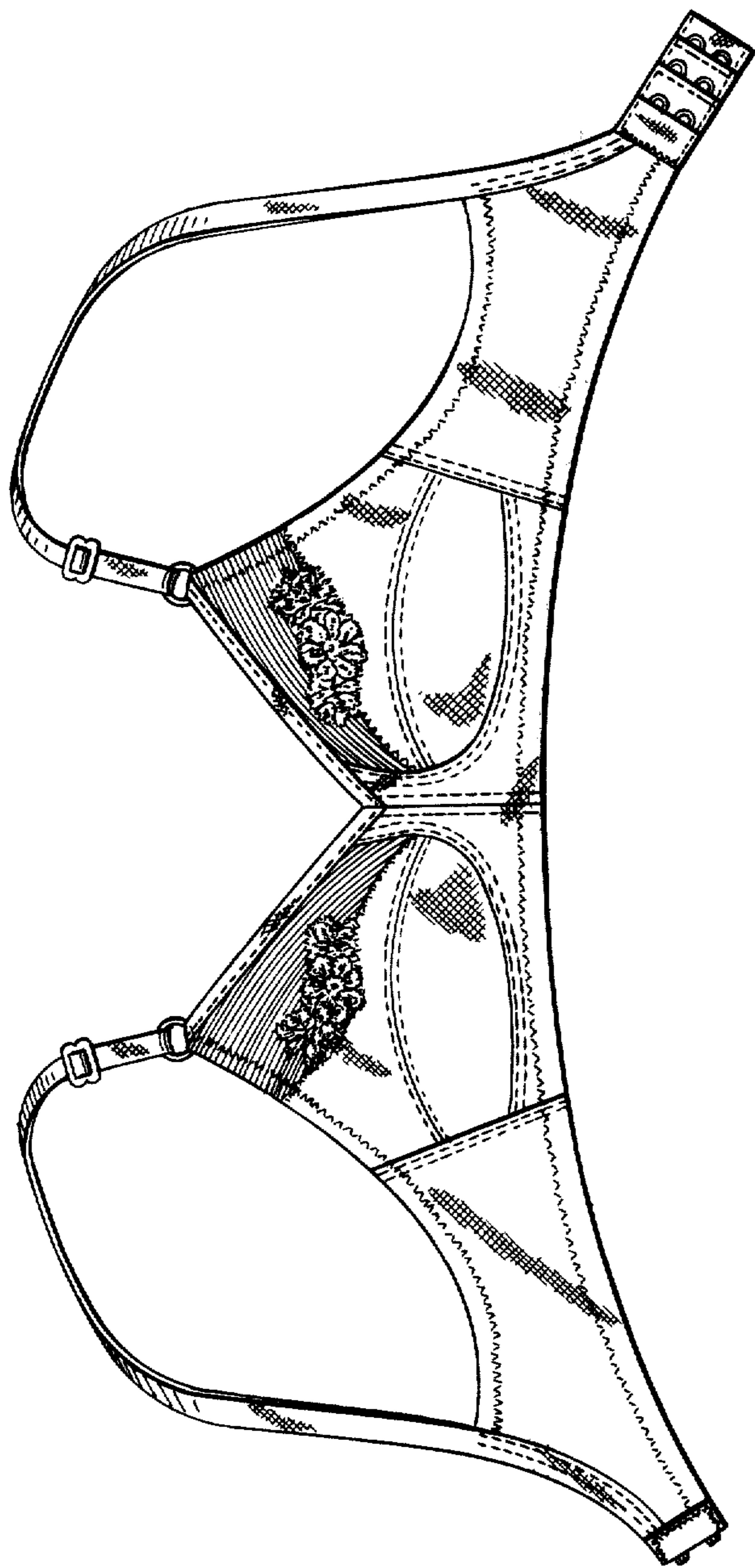

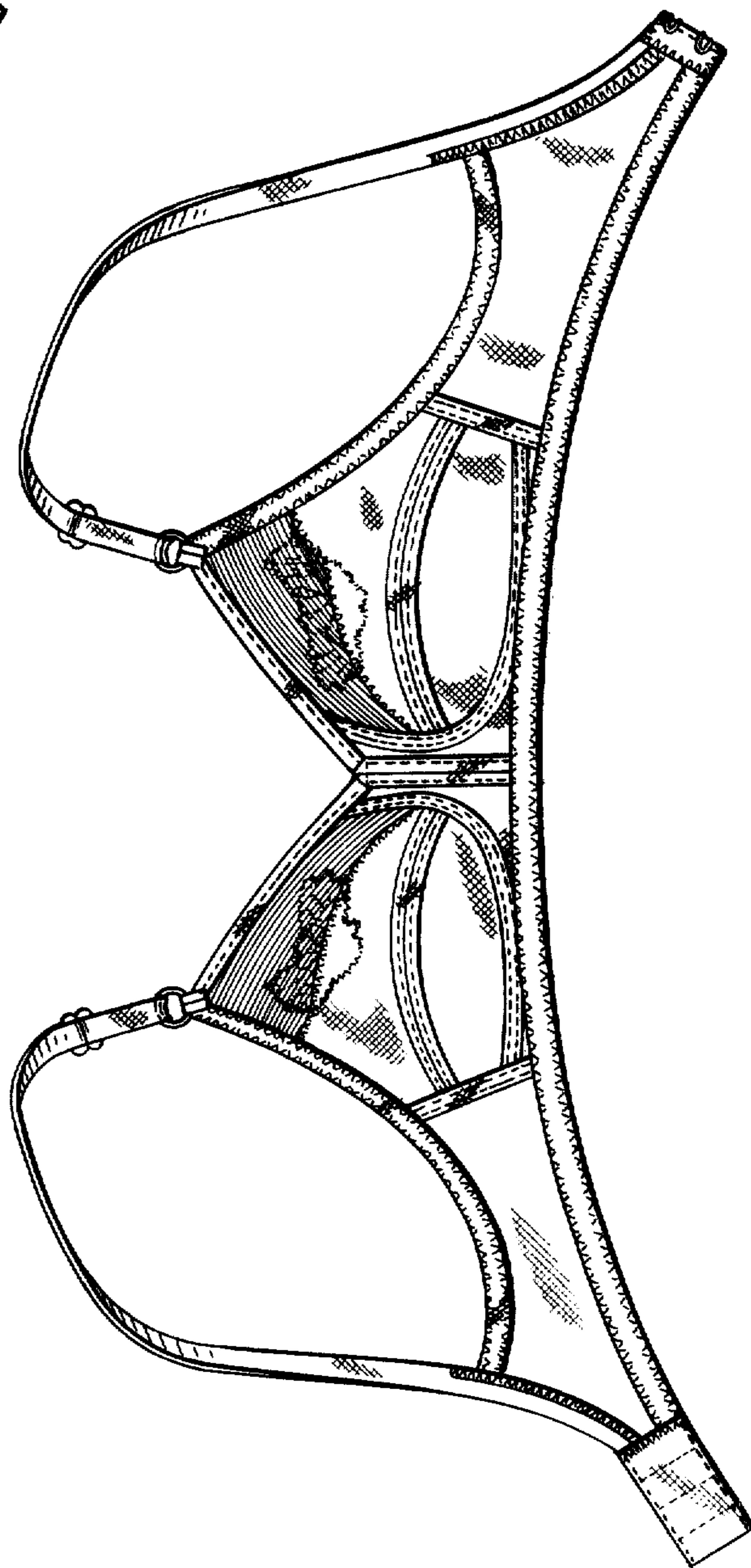
