DESCRIPTION

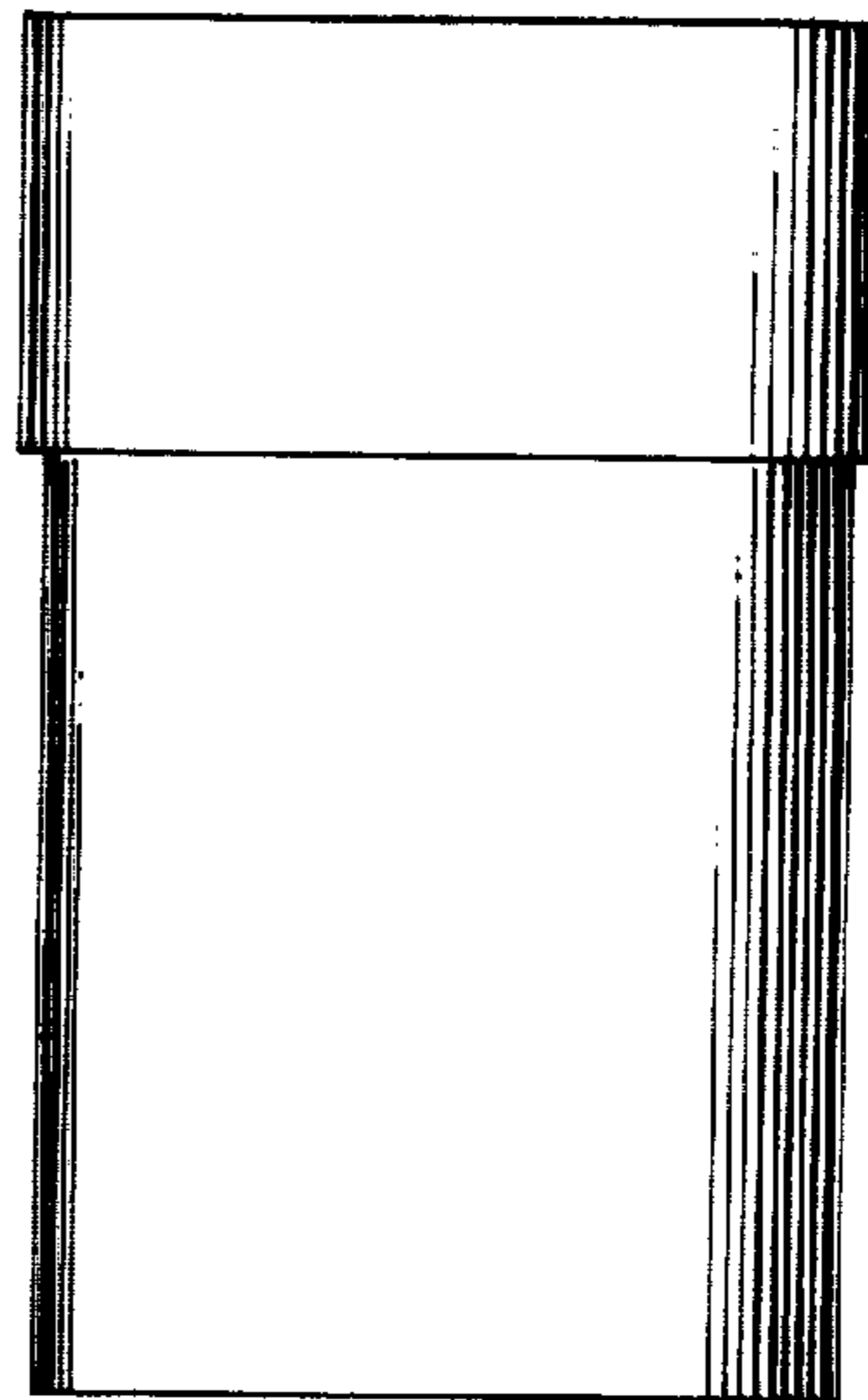
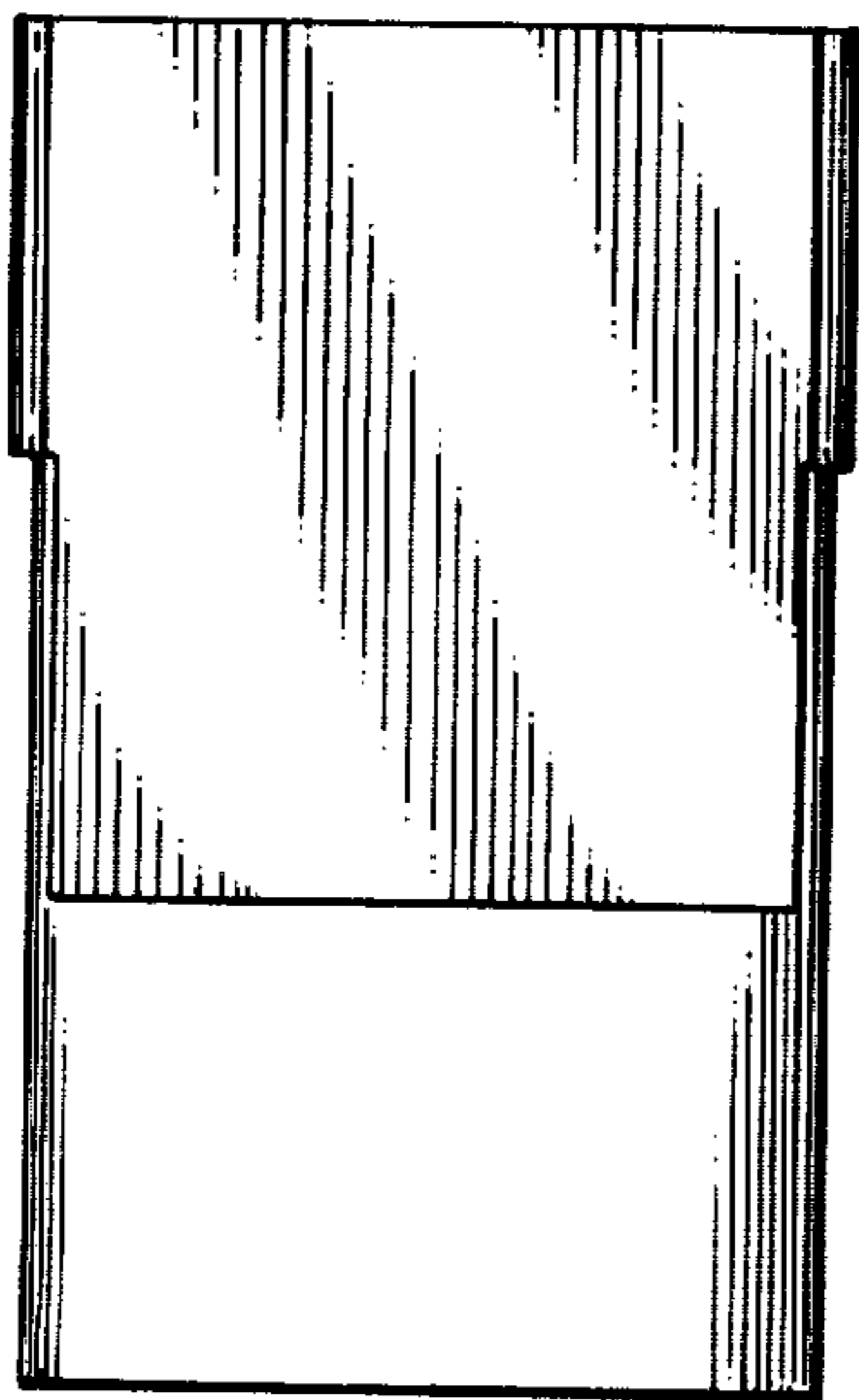
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a reset button extender for computers or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



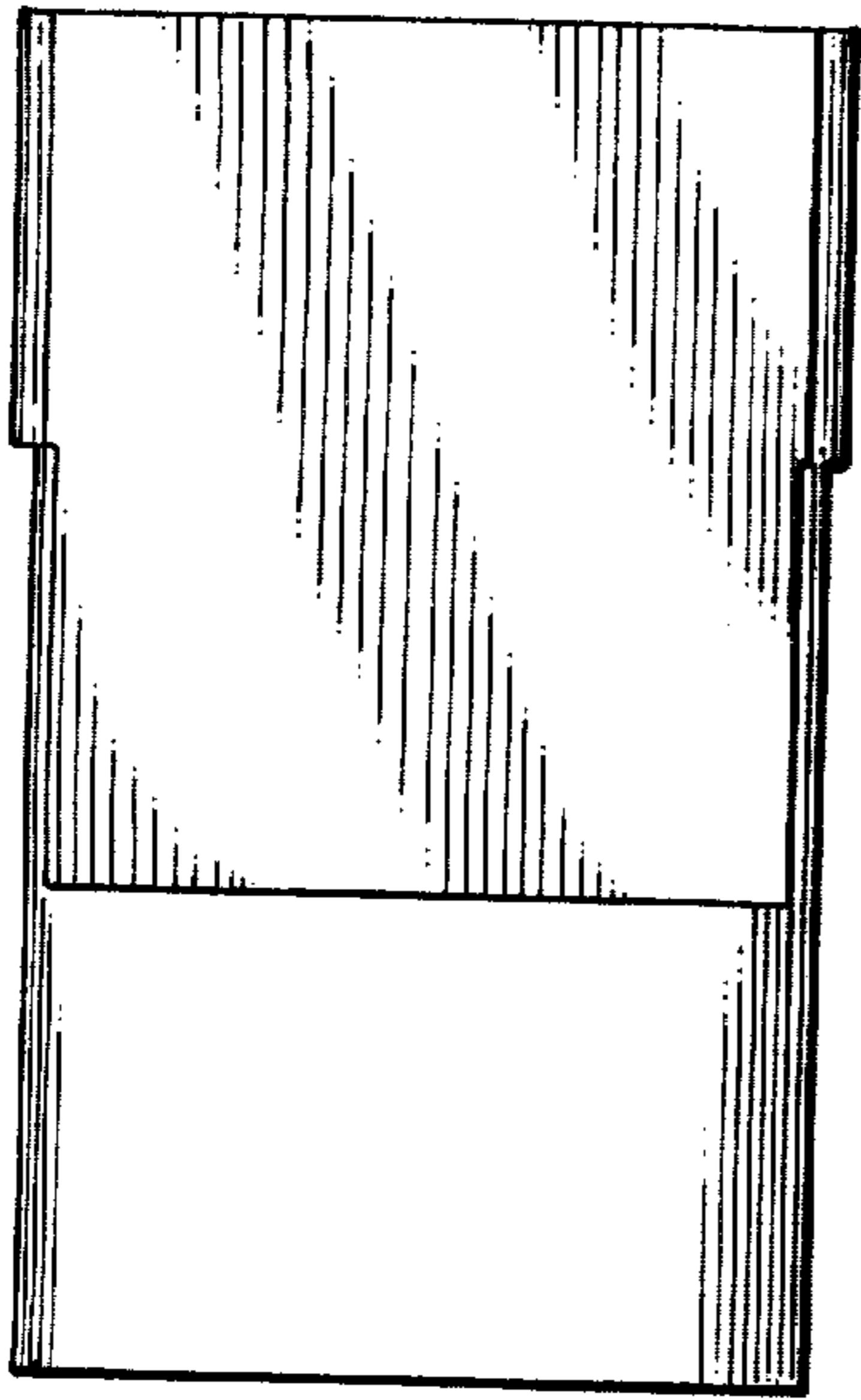

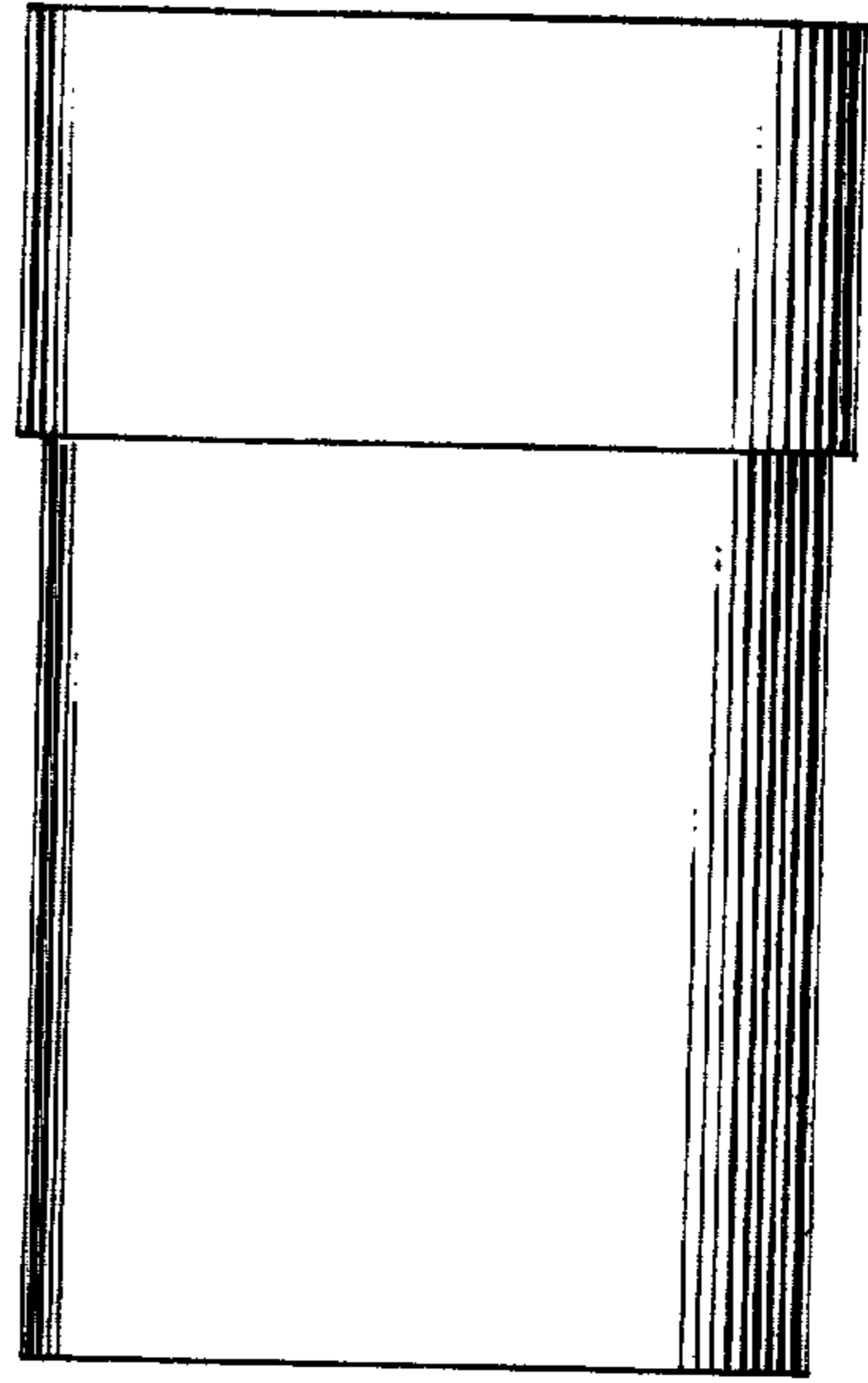

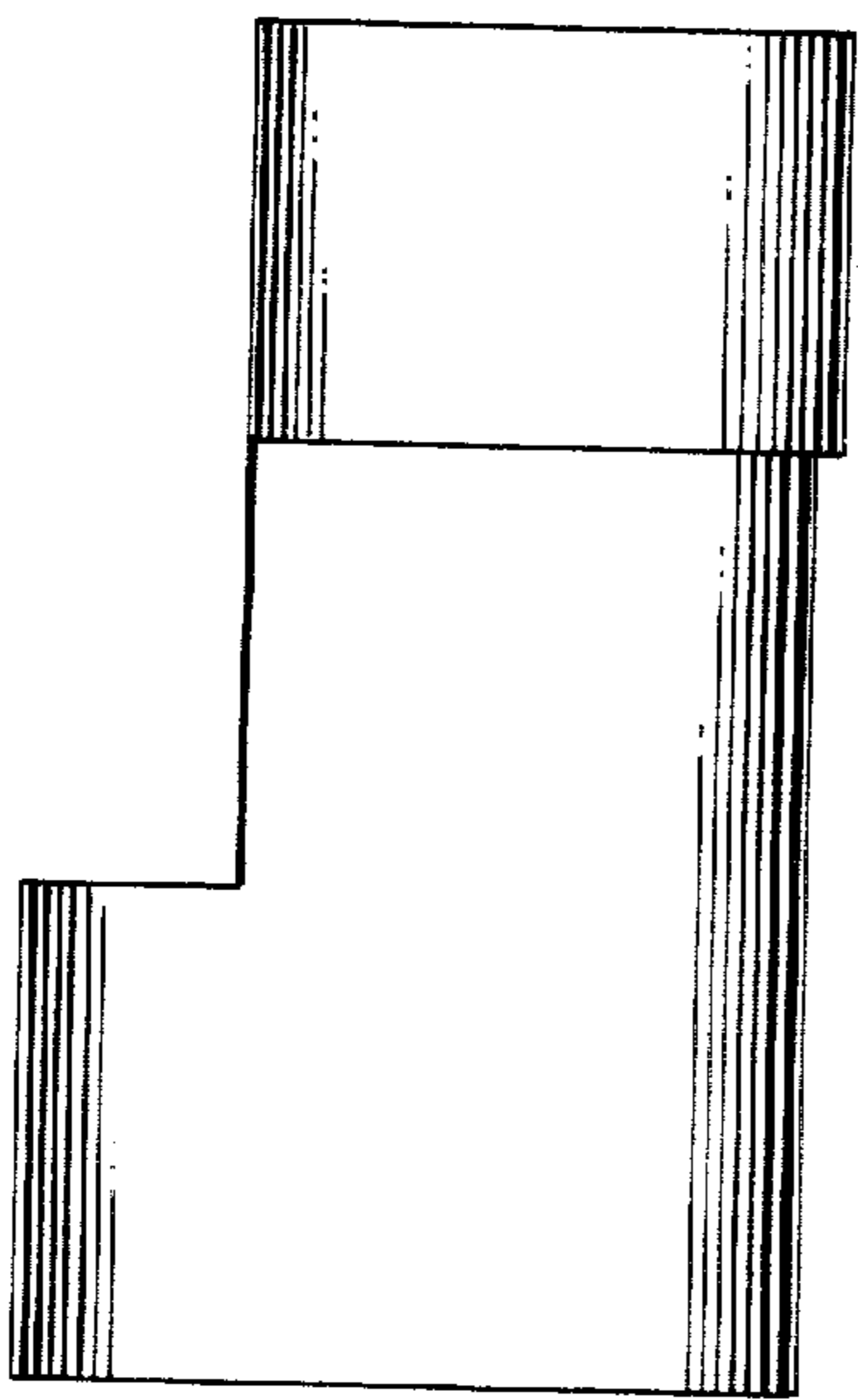

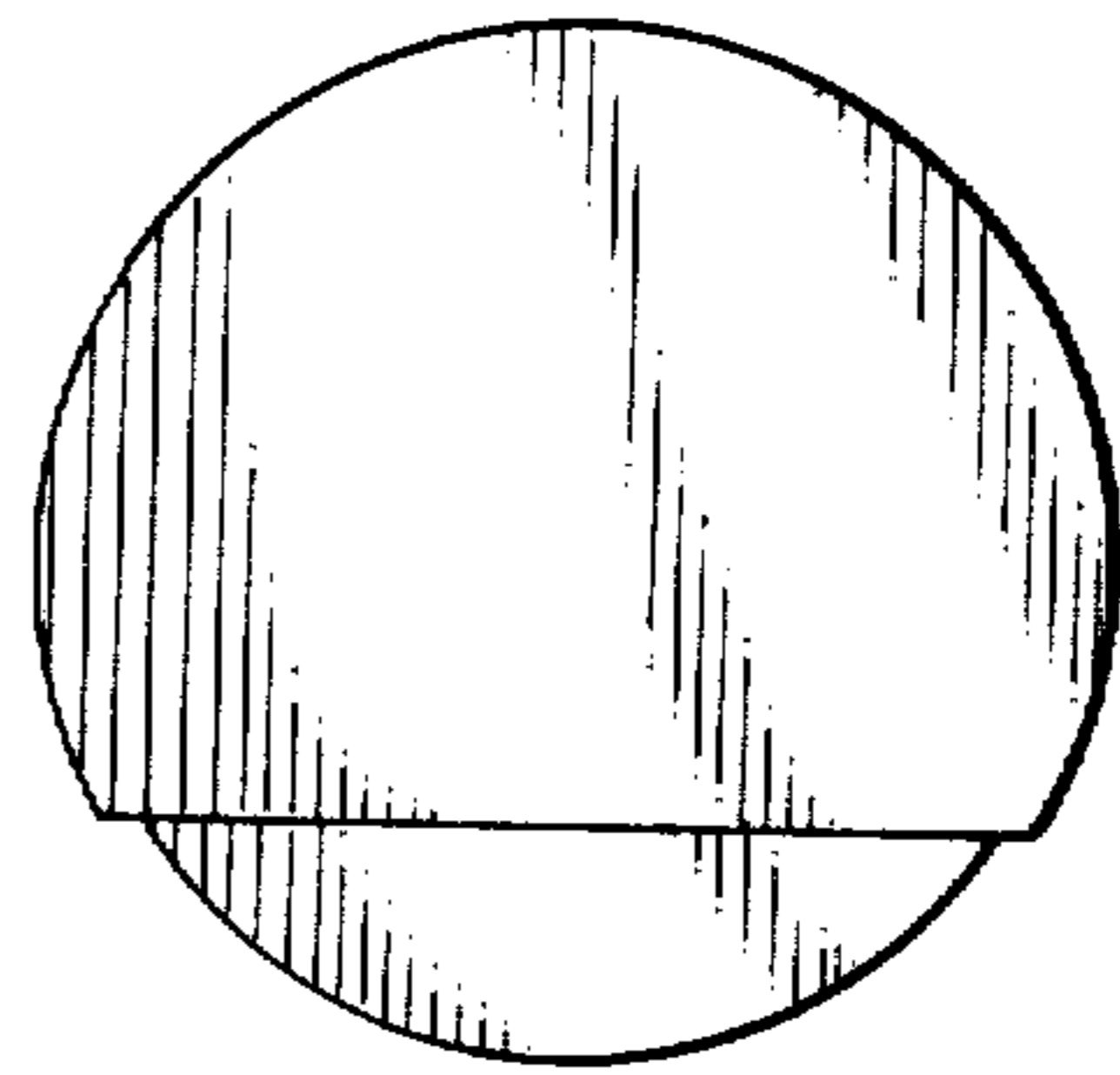

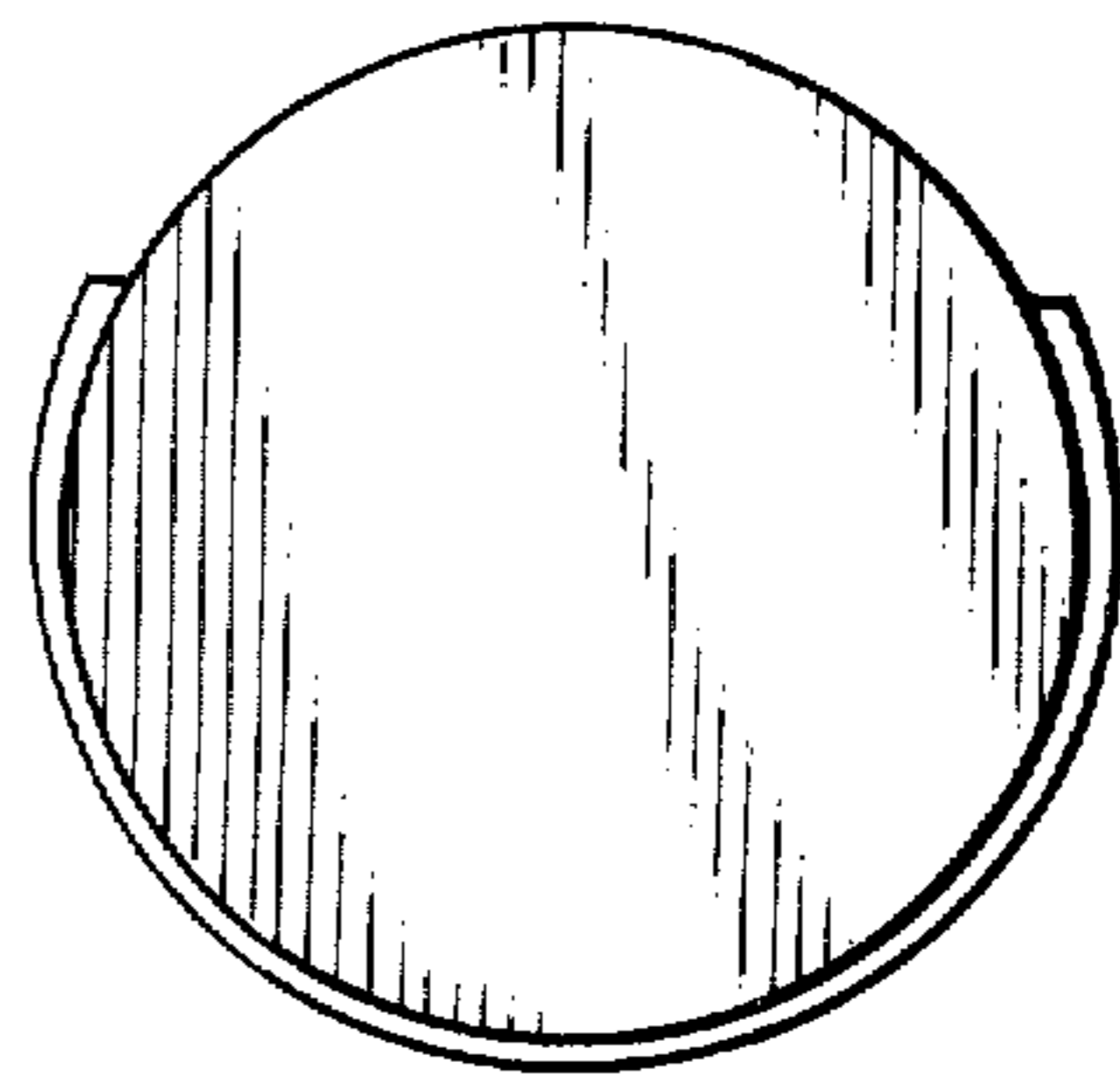
