



The ornamental design for a record player, as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a record player showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view with the transparent cover plate removed for convenience of illustration;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view with the cover plate attached and in closed position;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.










