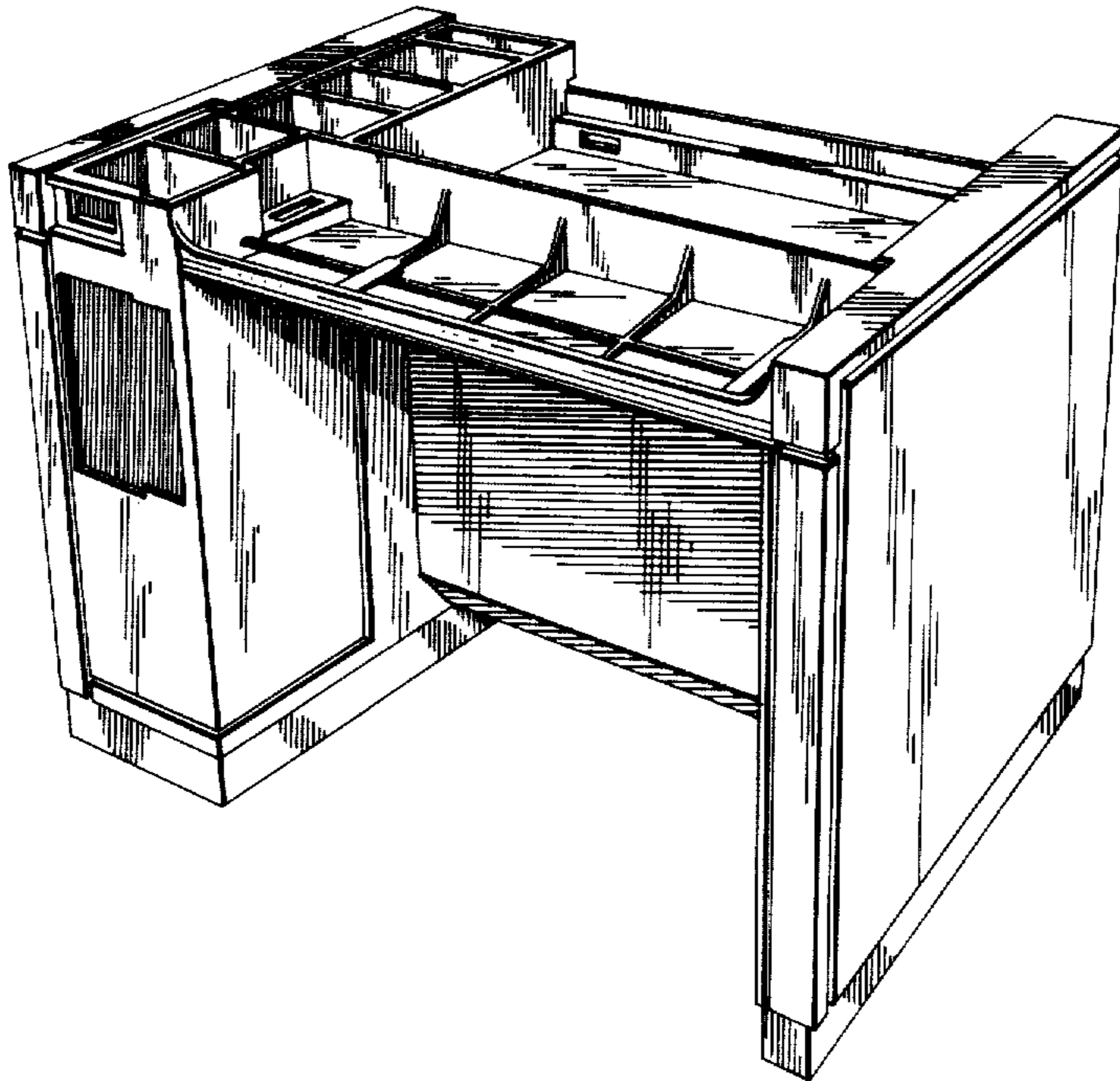

FIG. 3 is a bottom, rear perspective view thereof.



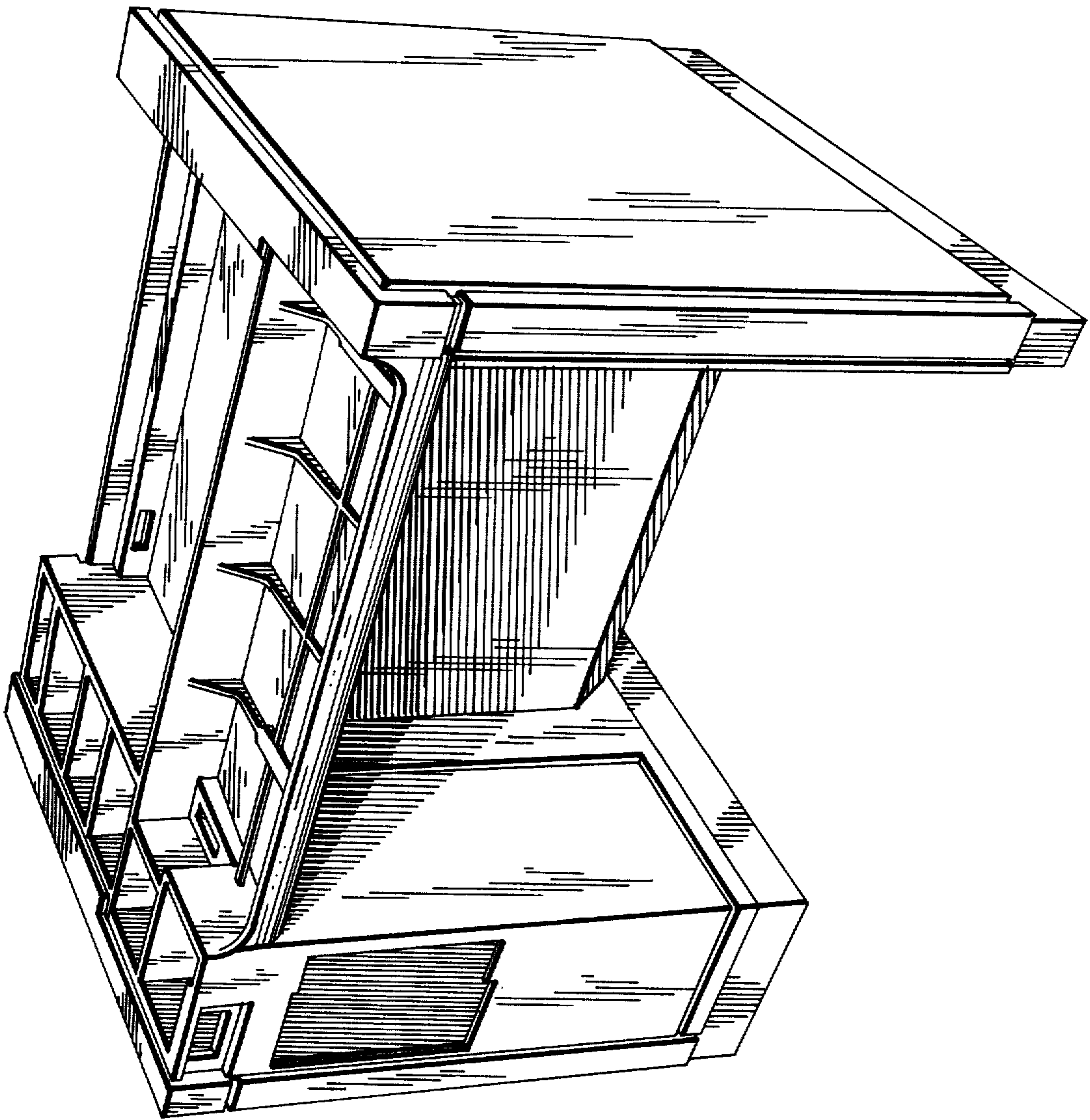

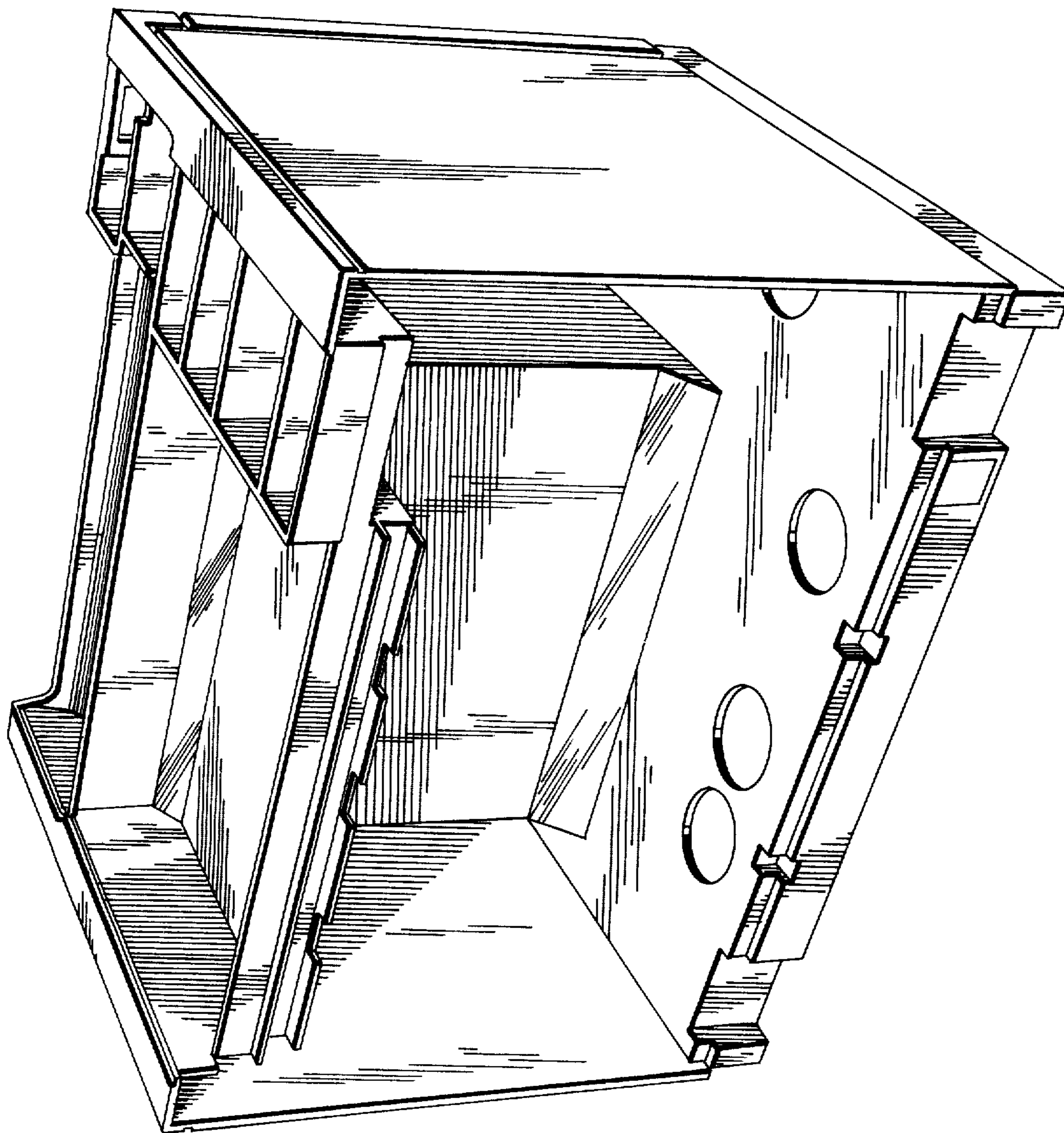

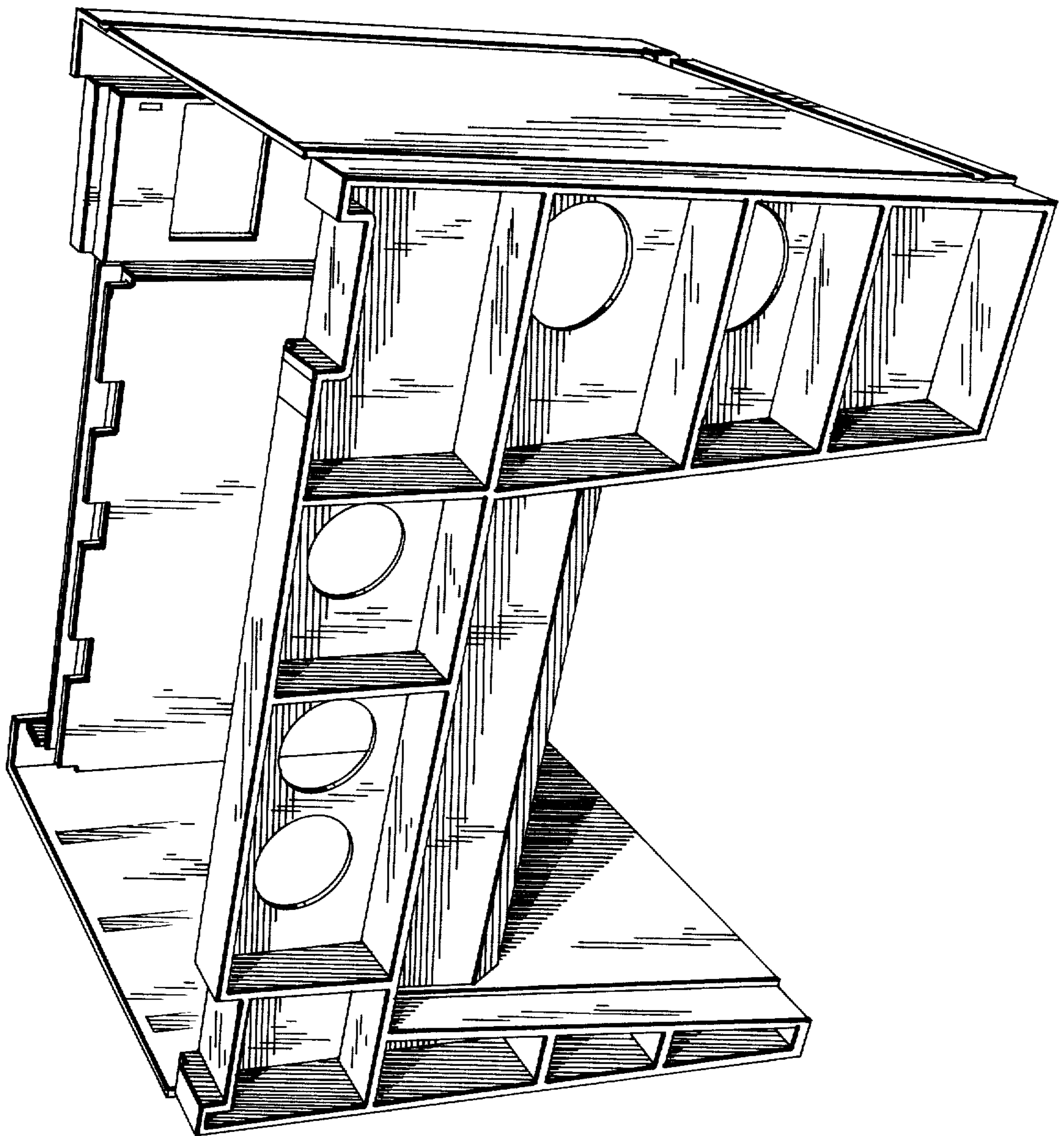
