The ornamental design for the massager, shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation of a massager showing my new design, the top attachment being removed for clarity of illustration;
 FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevation thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevation thereof;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom perspective view with the massager attachment in an assembled condition;
 FIG. 7 is a front elevation of the massager attachment shown separately for ease of illustration;
 FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 9 is a side elevation thereof;
 FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 11 is a cross-section taken on line 11—11 of FIG. 8.

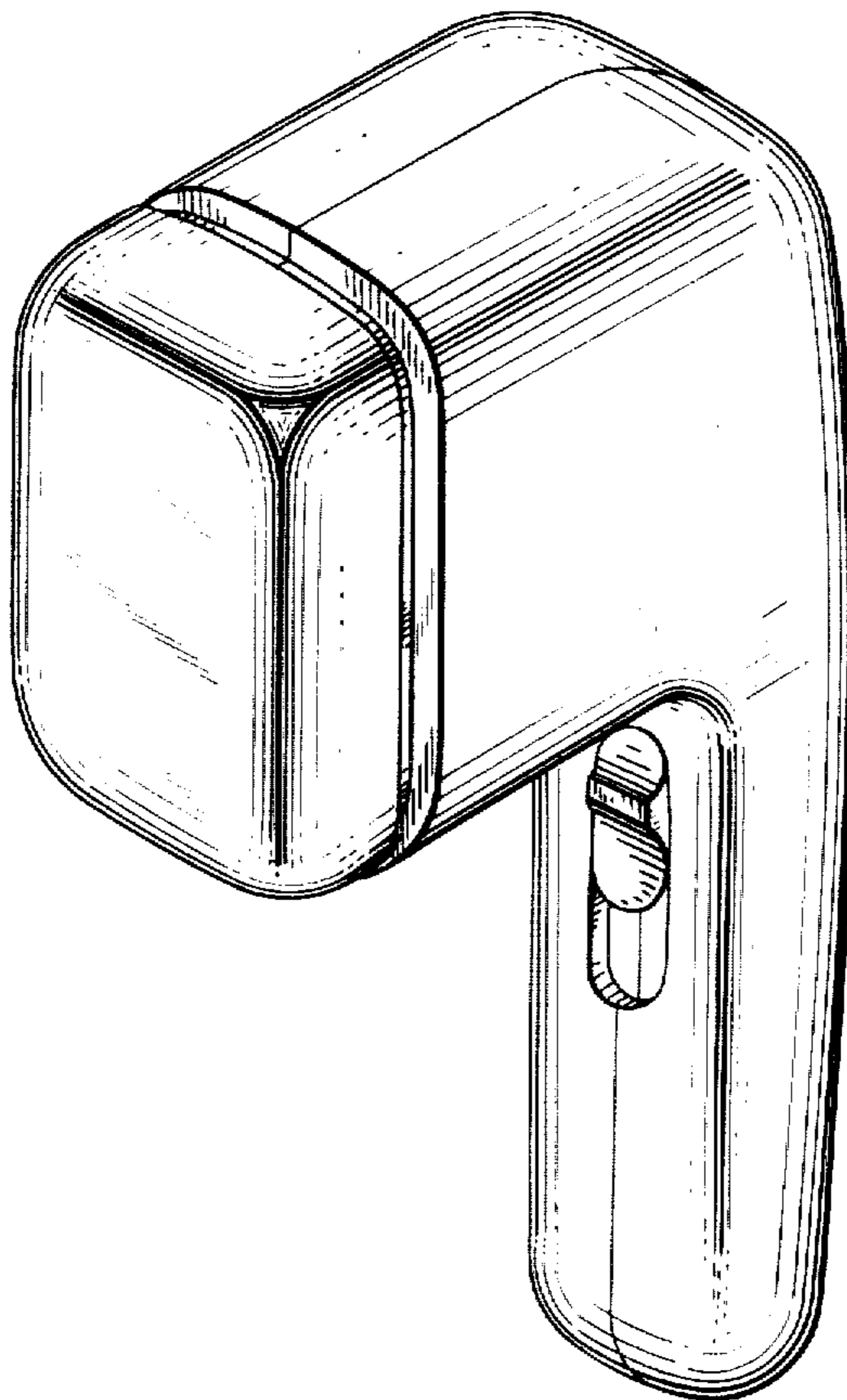

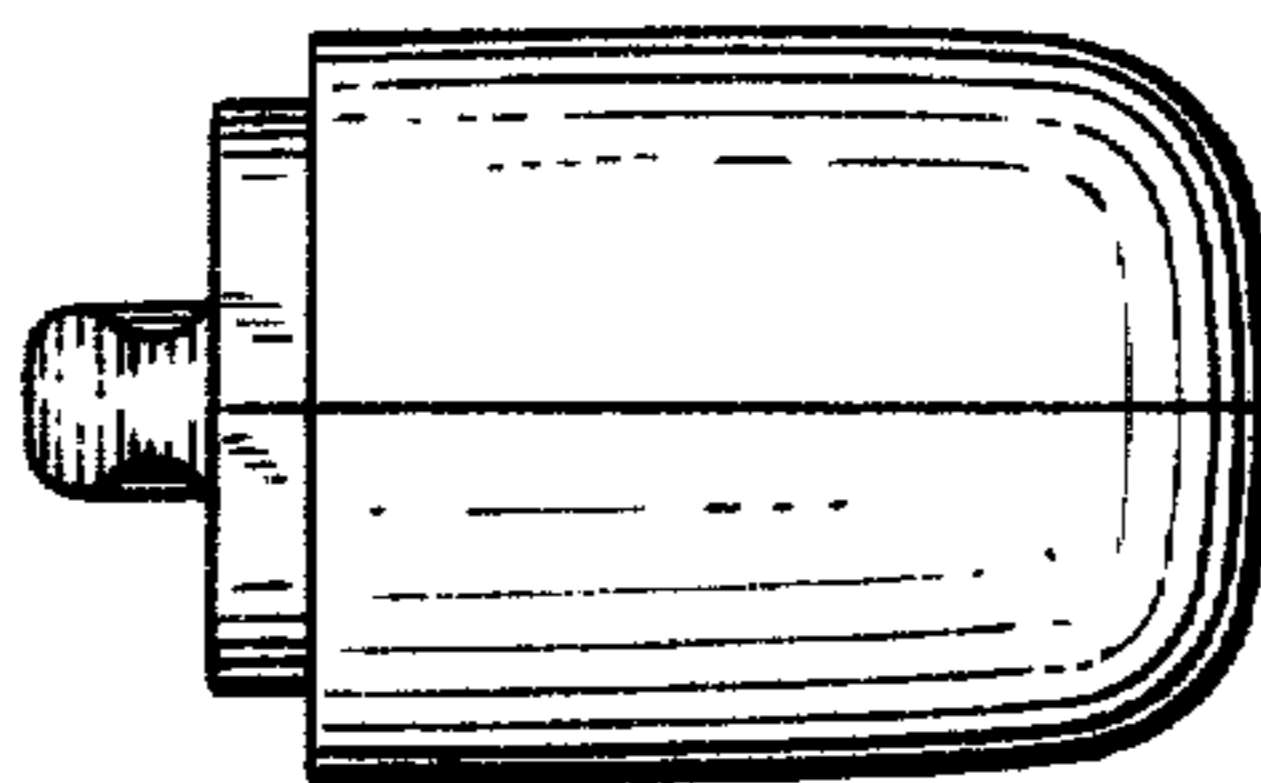

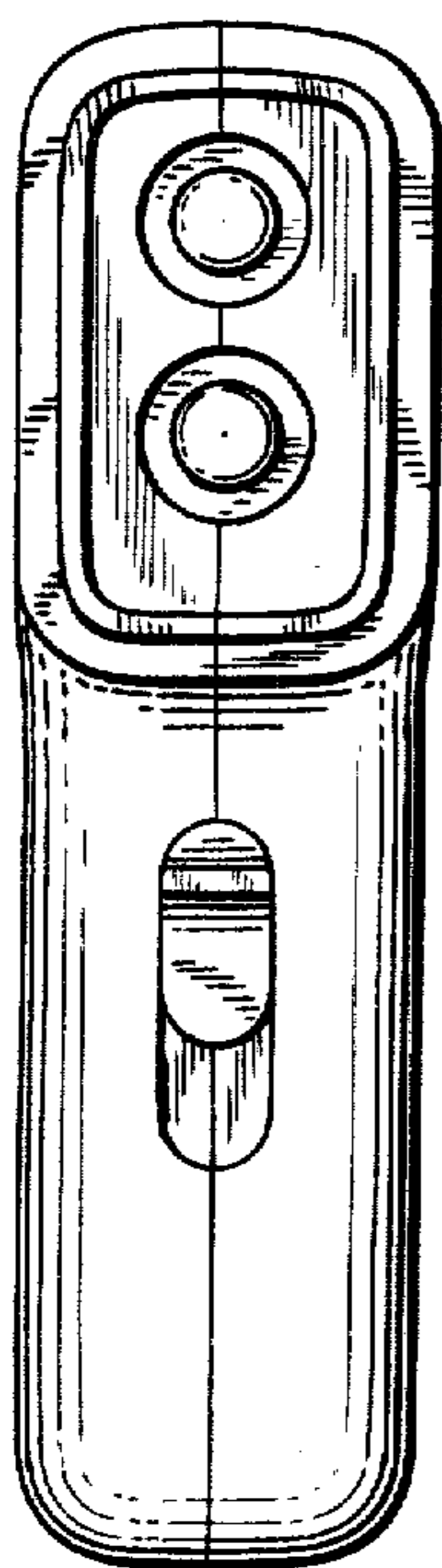

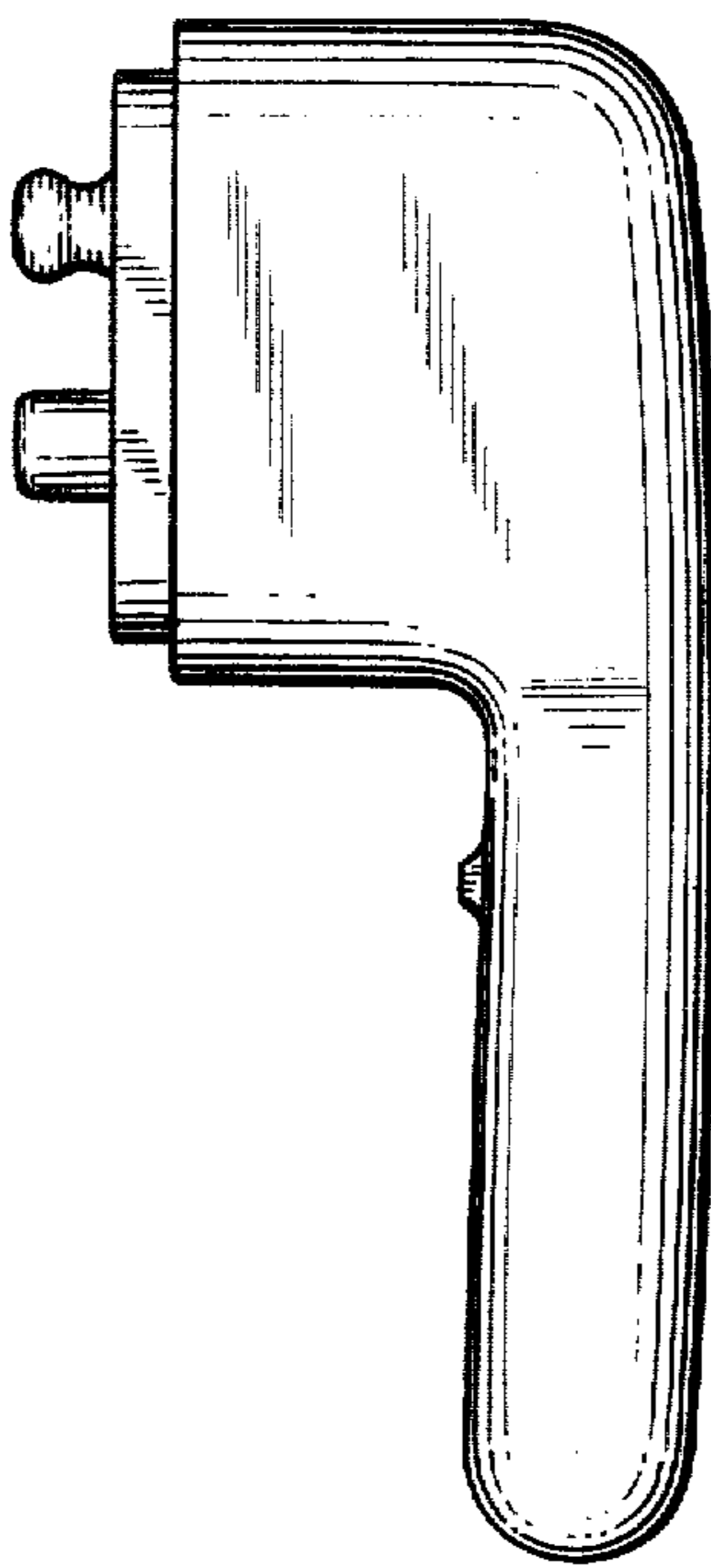

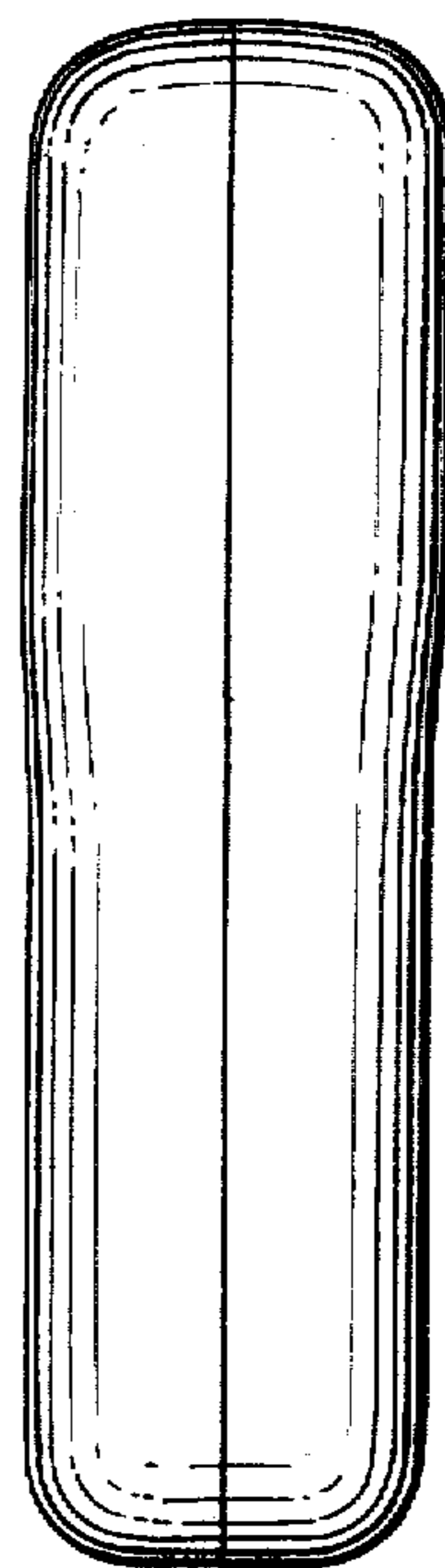

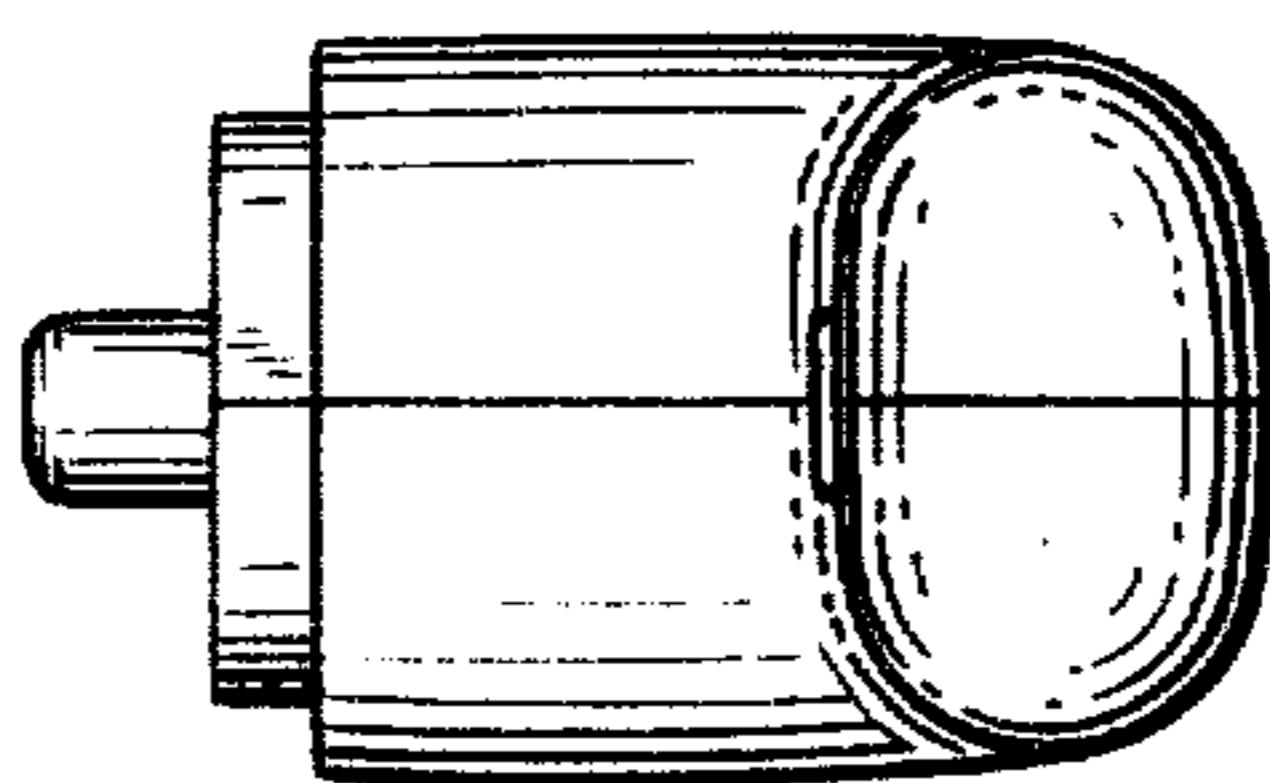

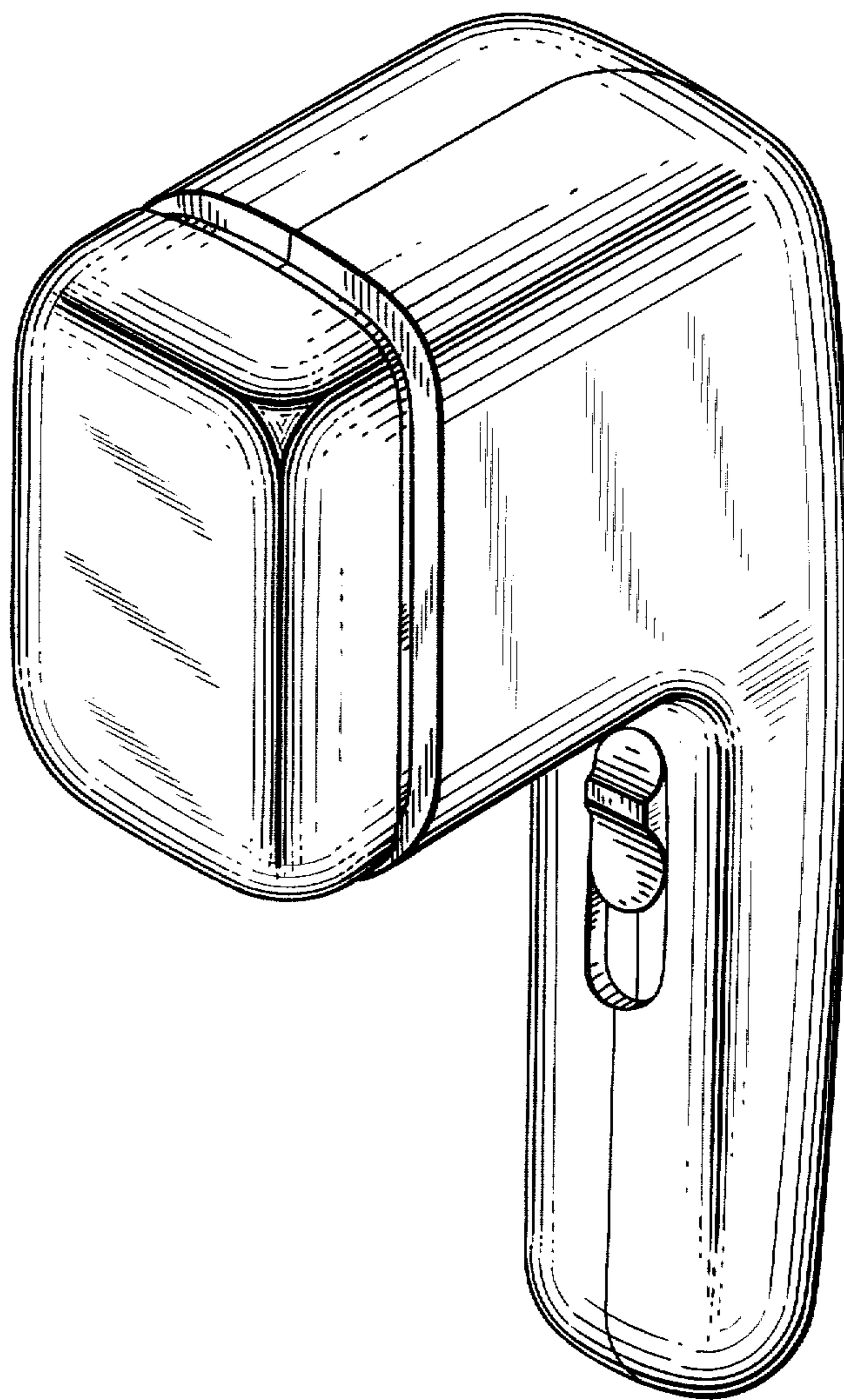

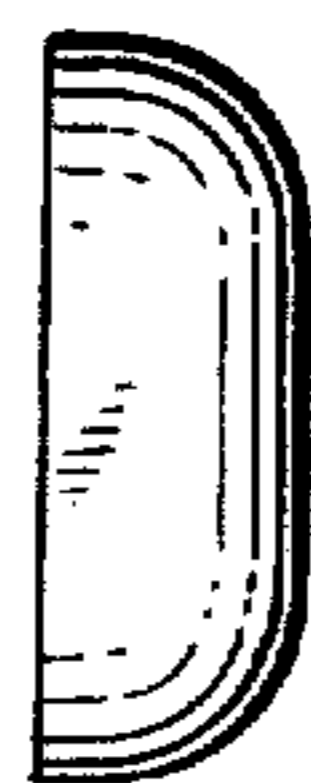

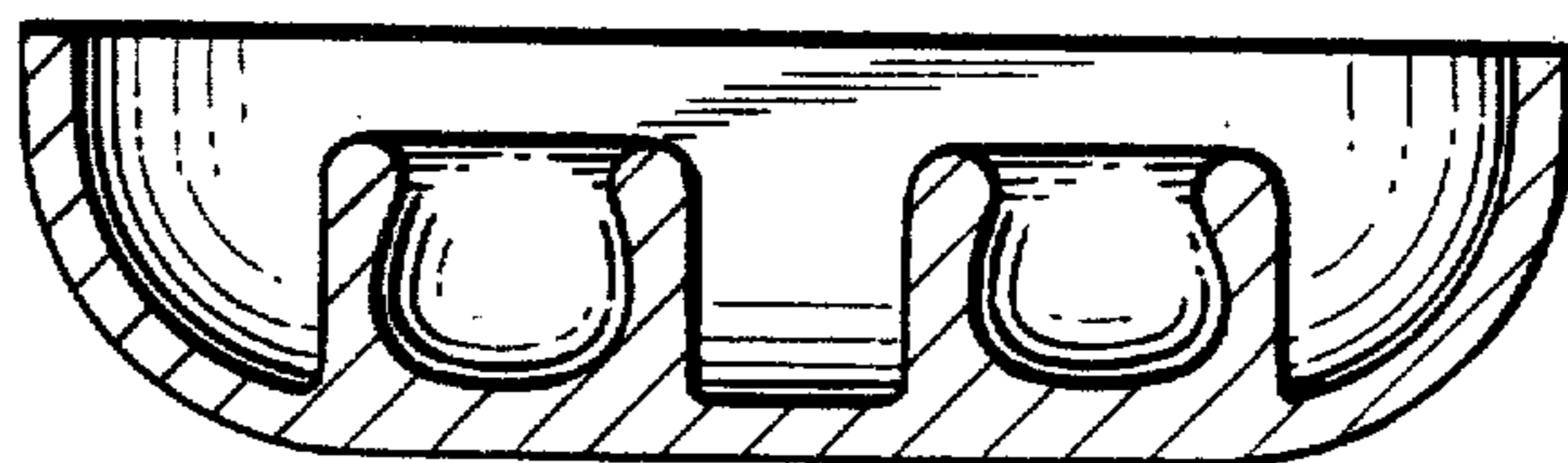

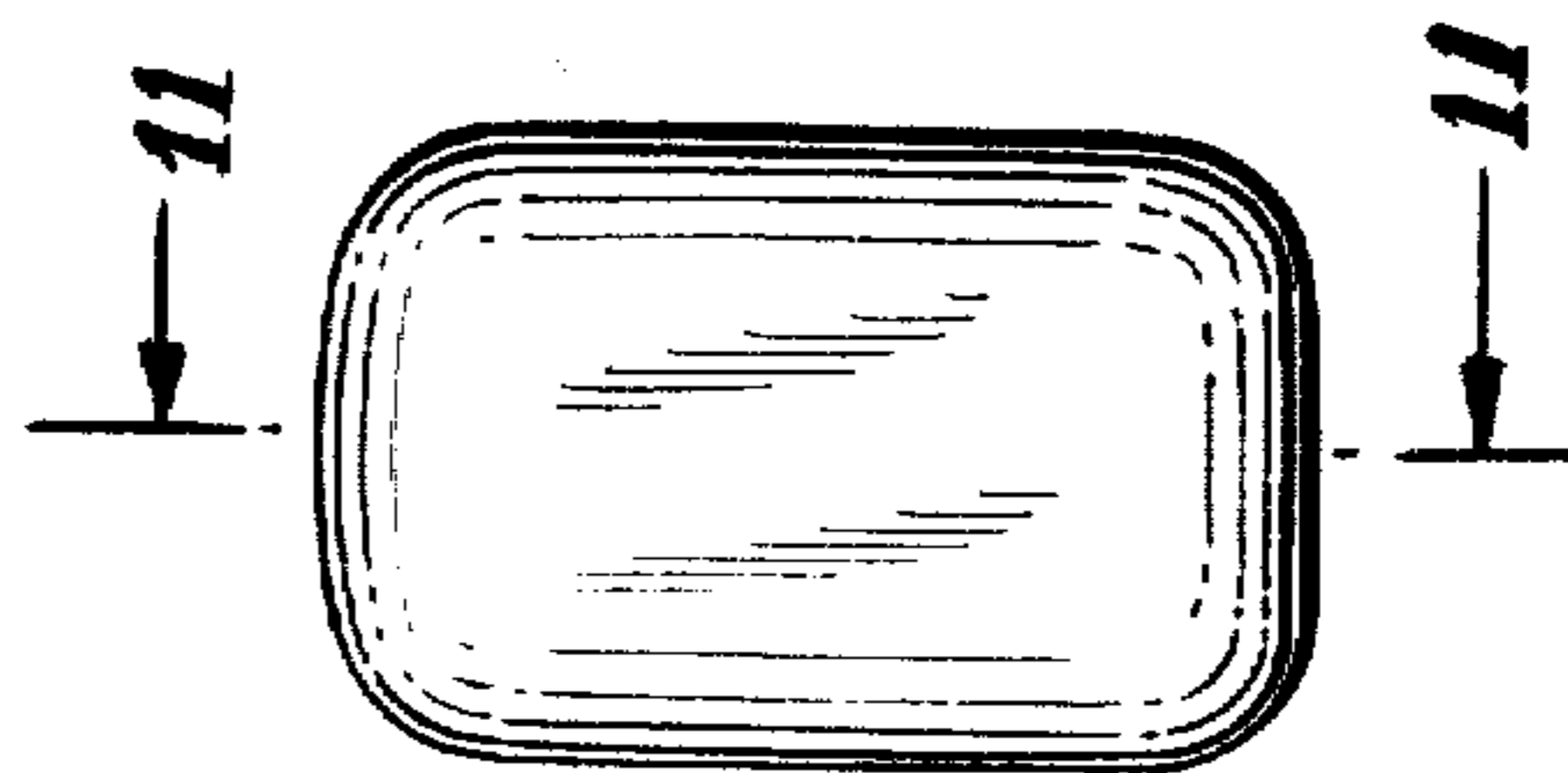

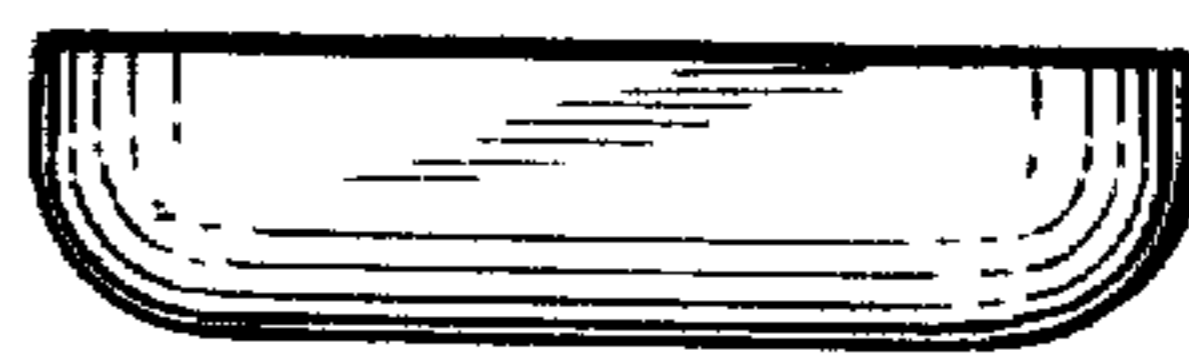
