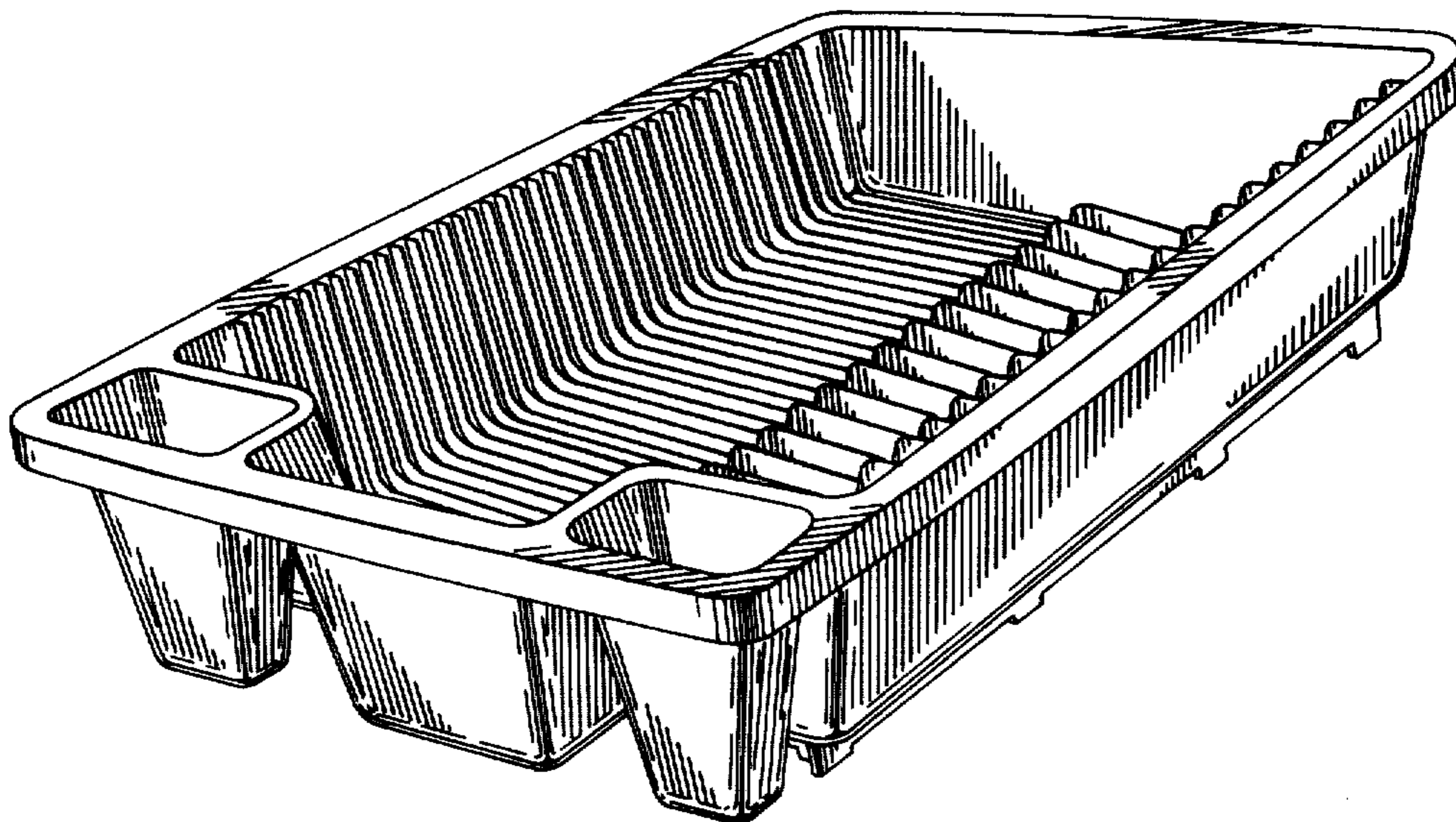

The ornamental design for a molded plastic dish drainer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a molded plastic dish drainer embodying my new design.
 FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof.
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view.
 FIG. 4 is a side elevation thereof.
 FIG. 5 is a rear elevation thereof.
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
 FIG. 7 is a sectional view on line 7-7 of FIG. 3.
 FIG. 8 is a sectional view on line 8-8 of FIG. 3.
 FIG. 9 is a sectional view on line 9-9 of FIG. 3.
 The side opposite to that shown in FIG. 4 is a mirror image thereof.



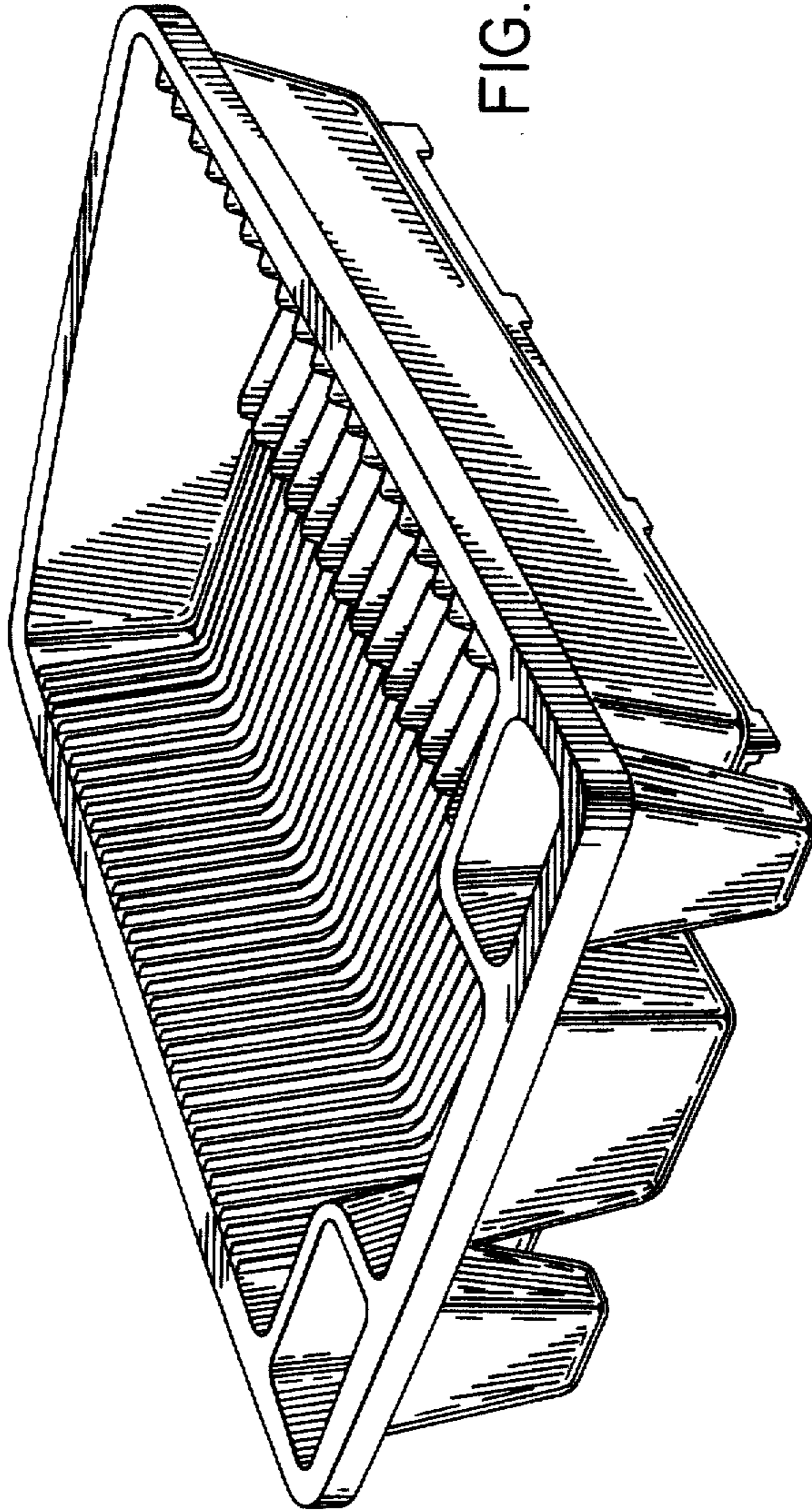

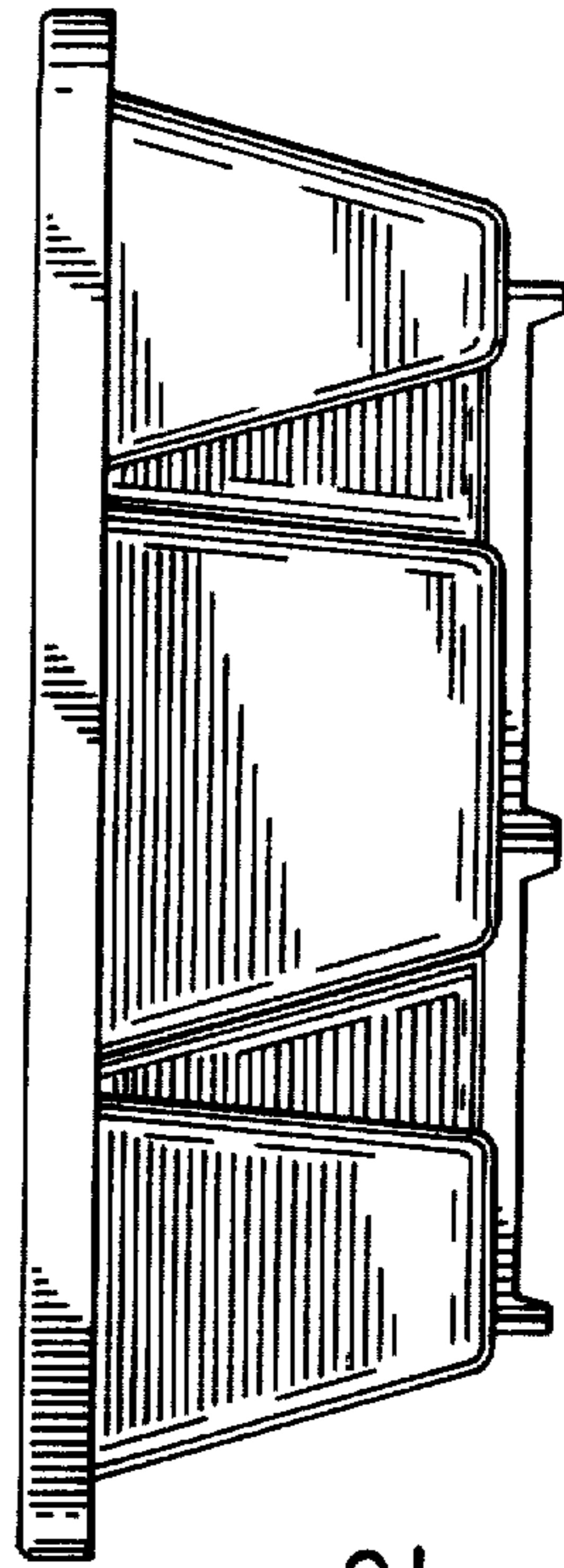
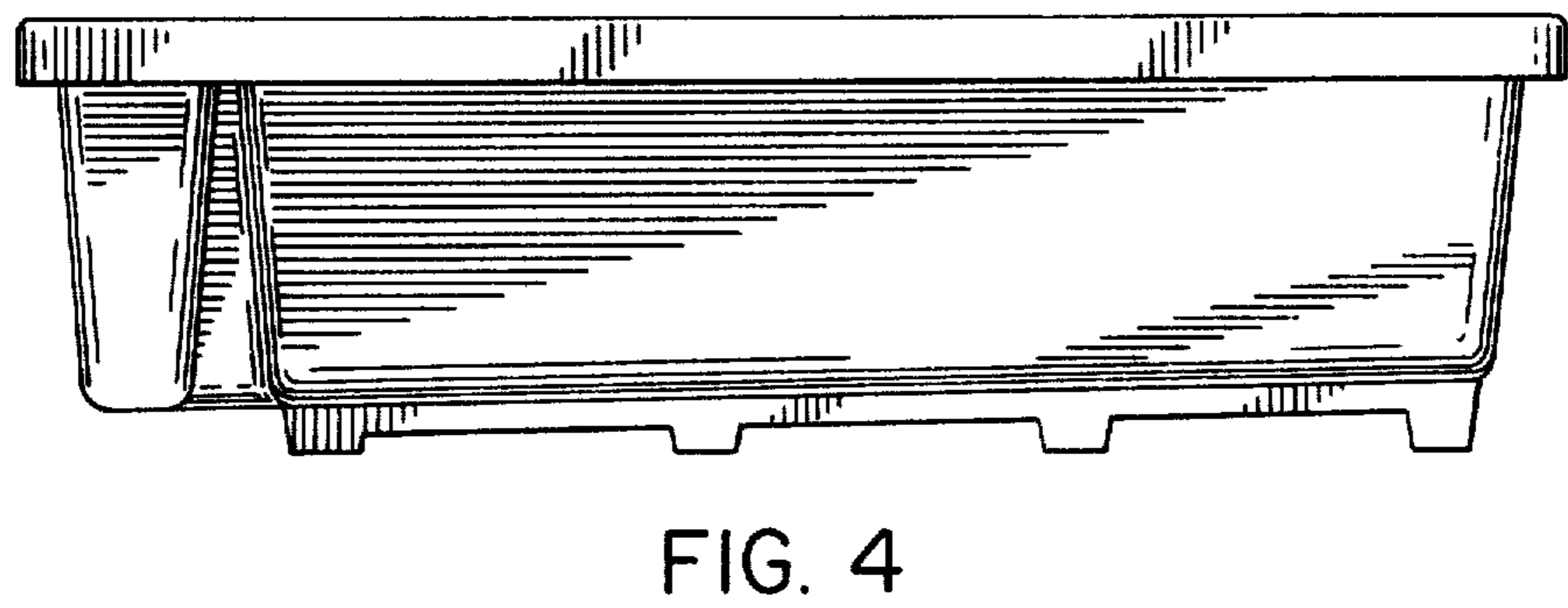
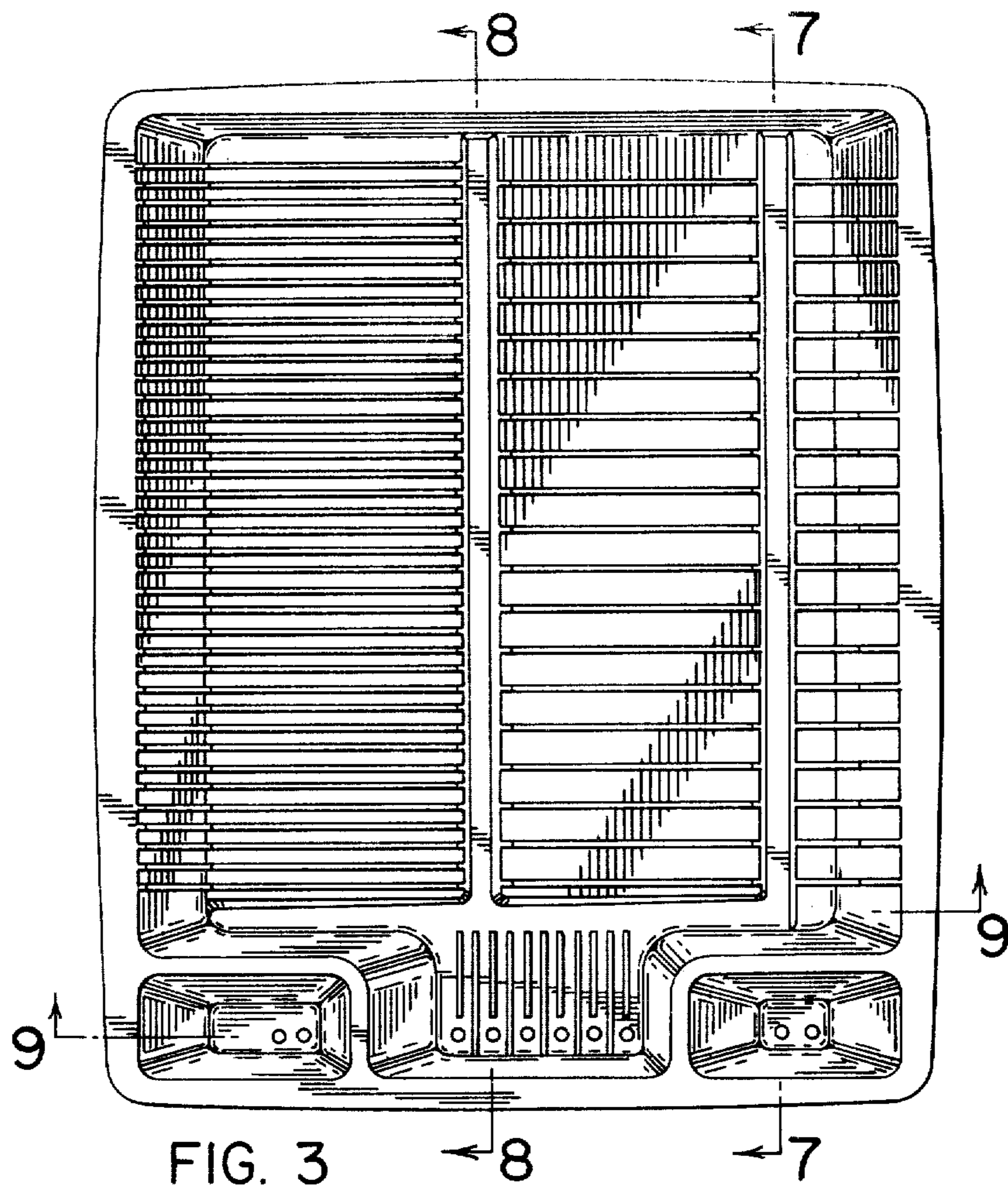

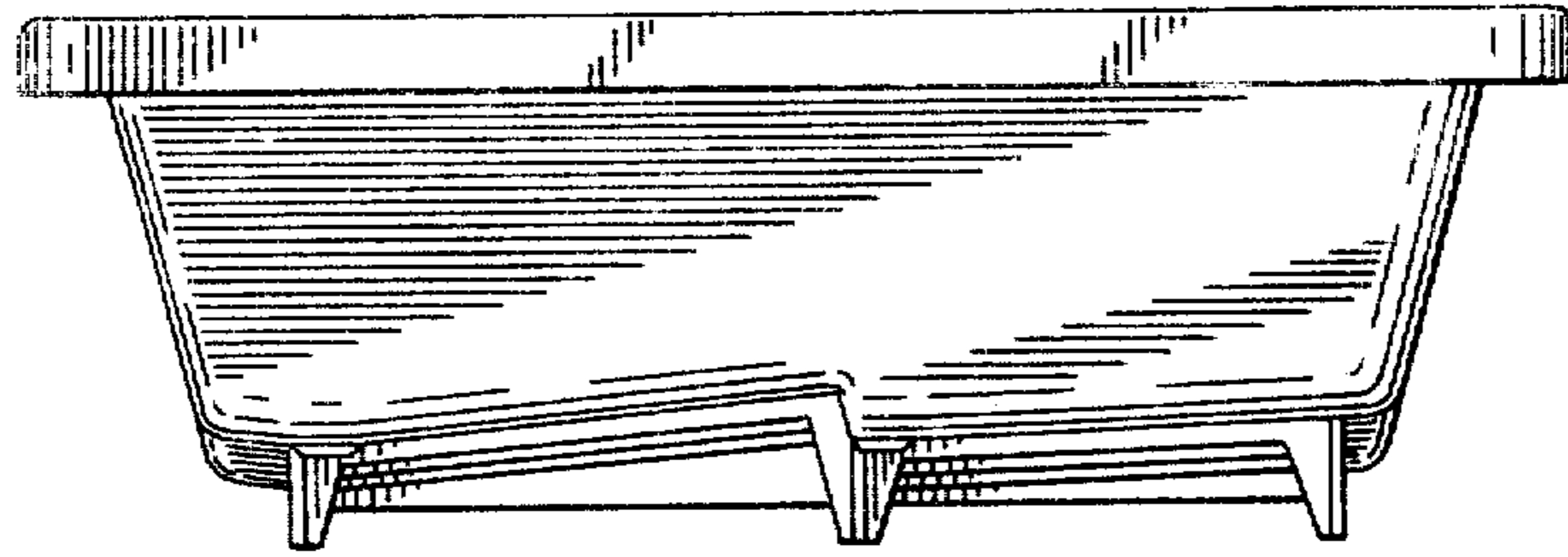

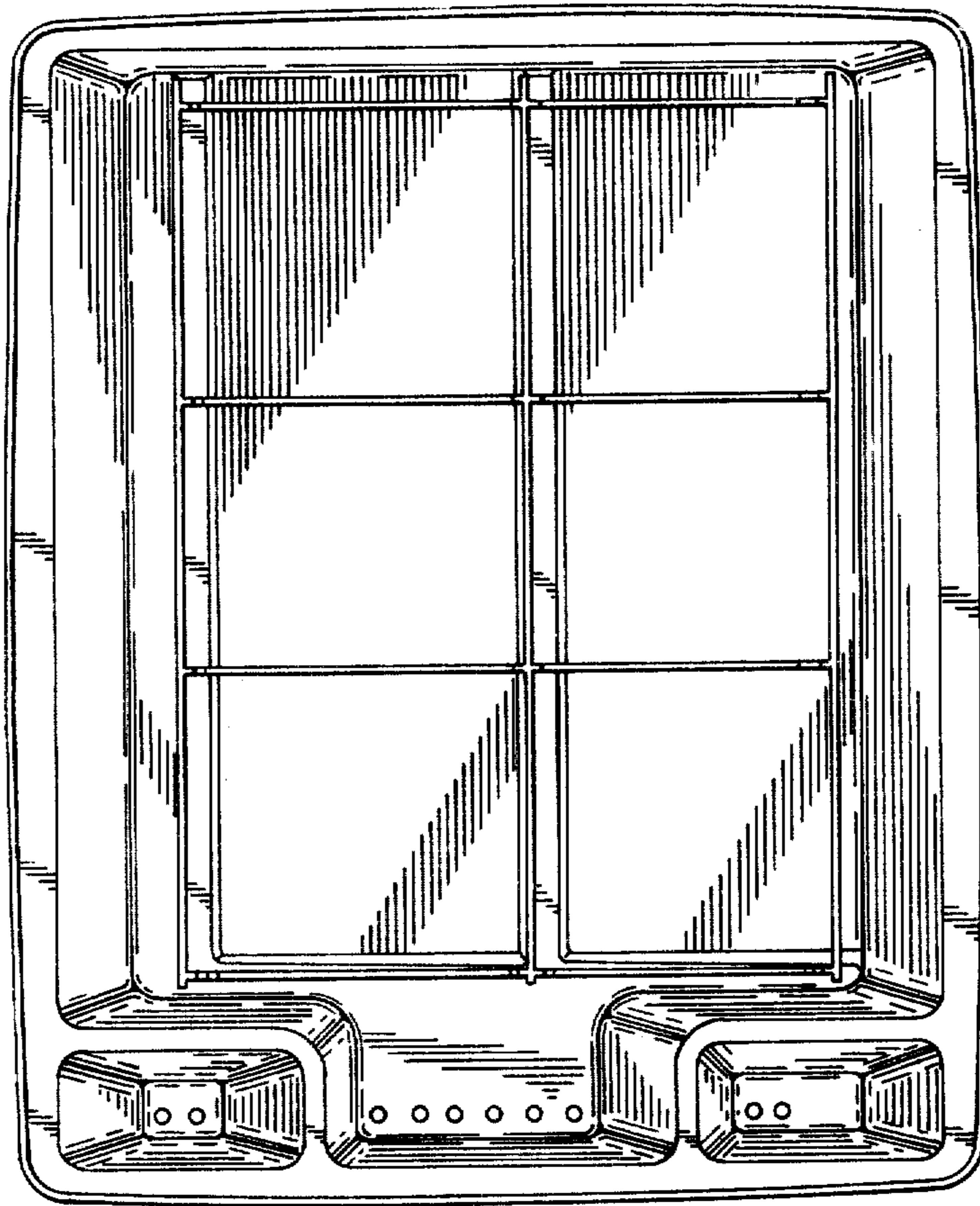

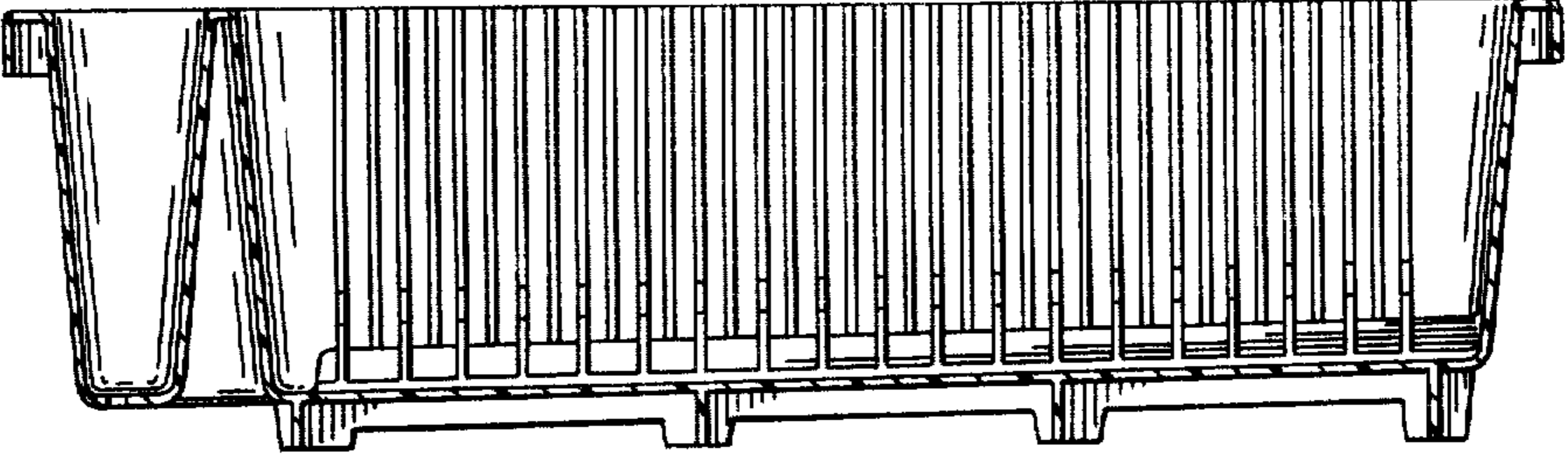

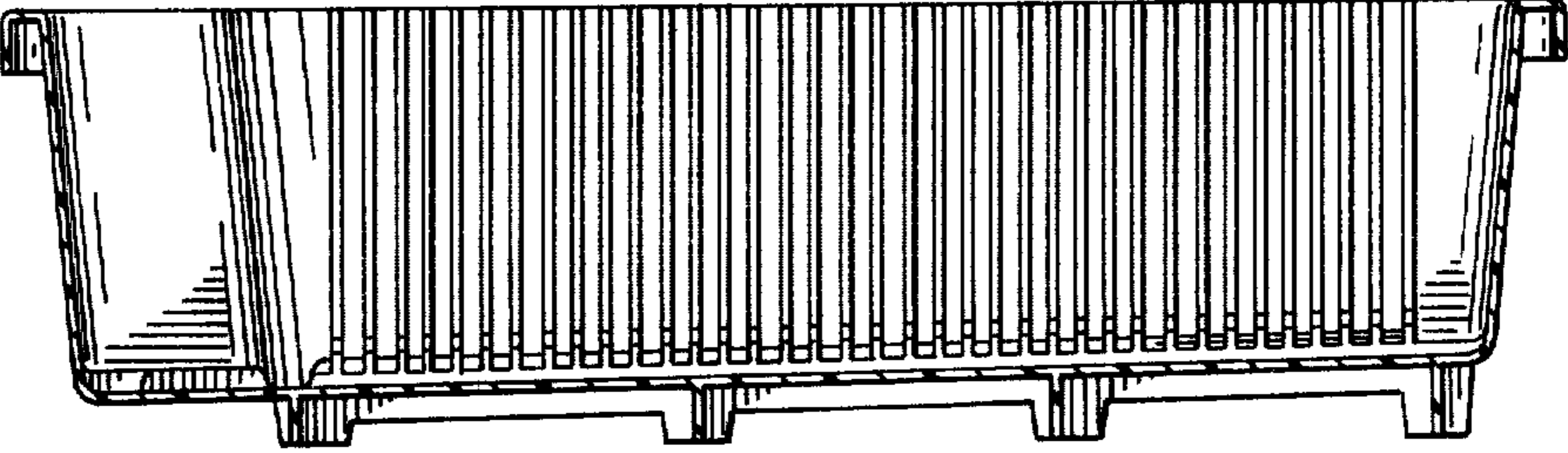

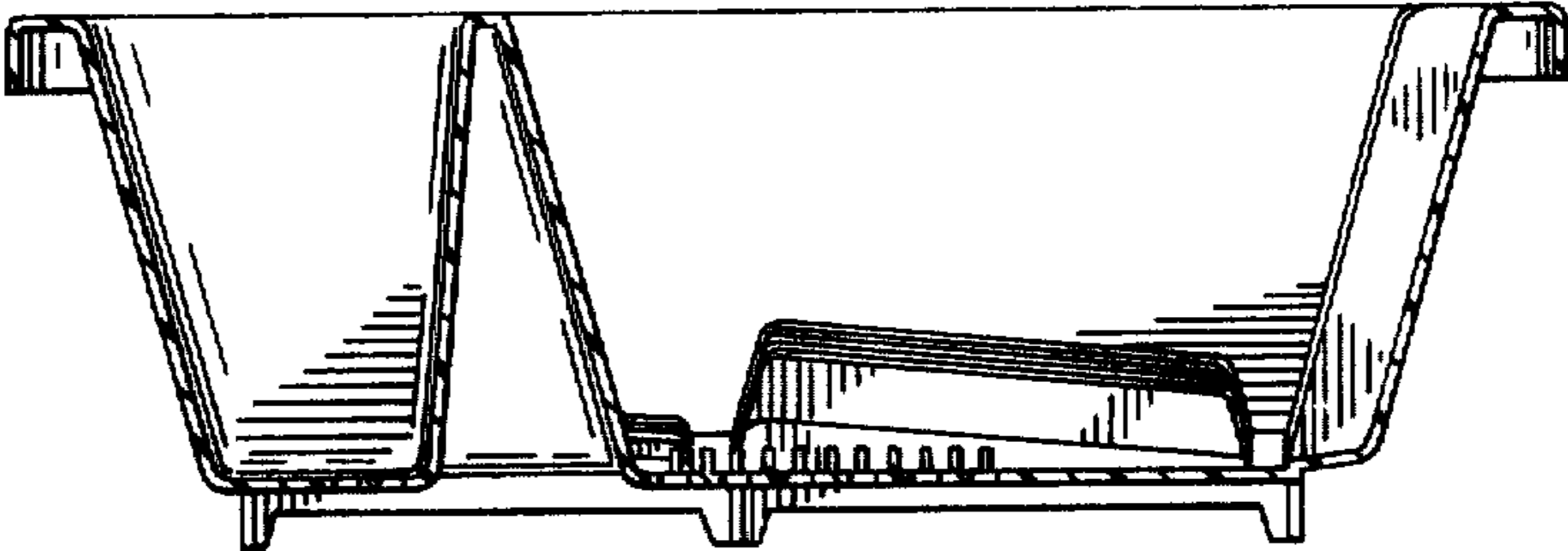
