The ornamental design for a tote bag, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a tote bag showing our new design;

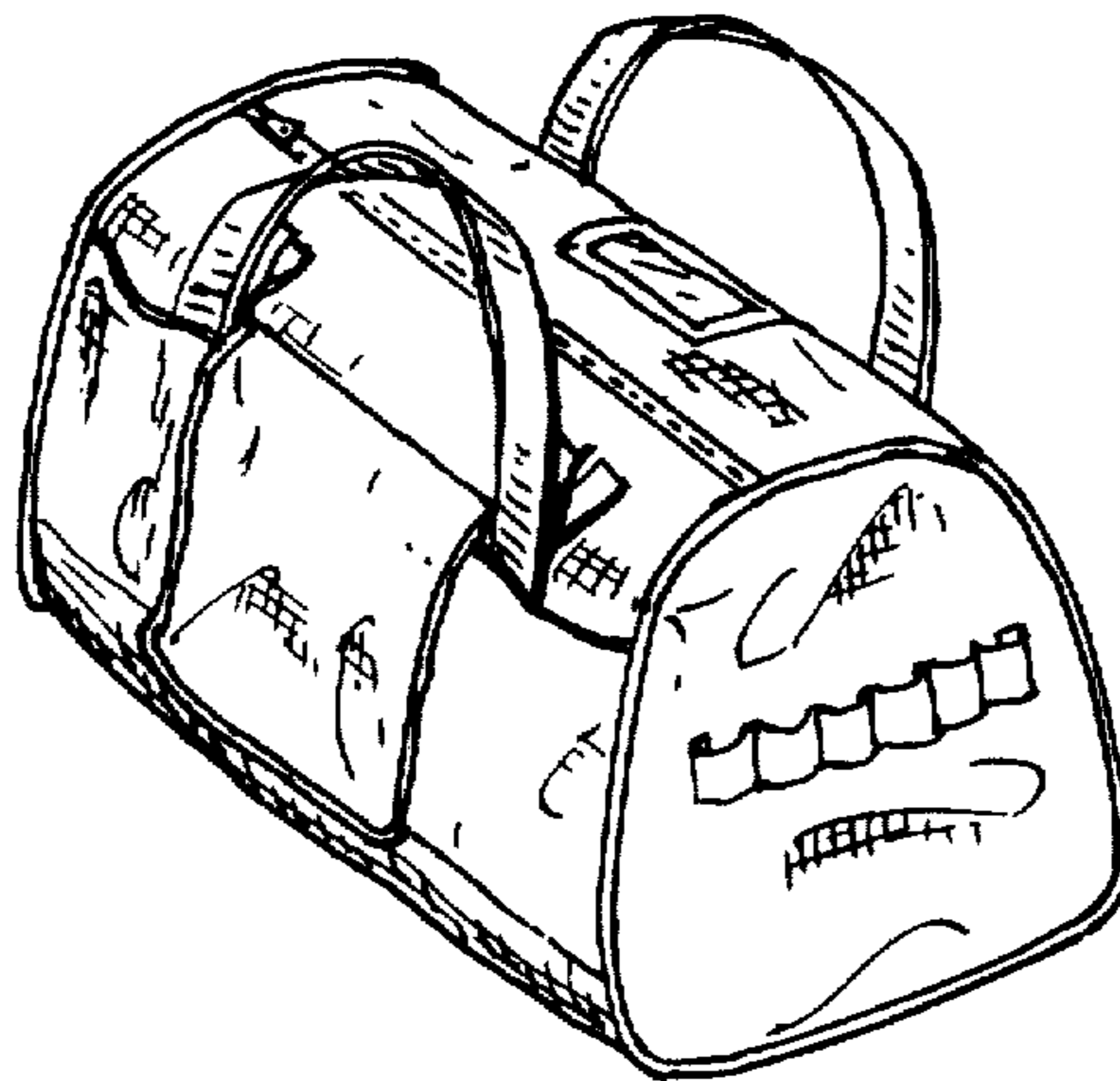
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is an inverted bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view.

The partial showing of a fabric texture in the above-described figures is understood to be continuous throughout the tote bag.



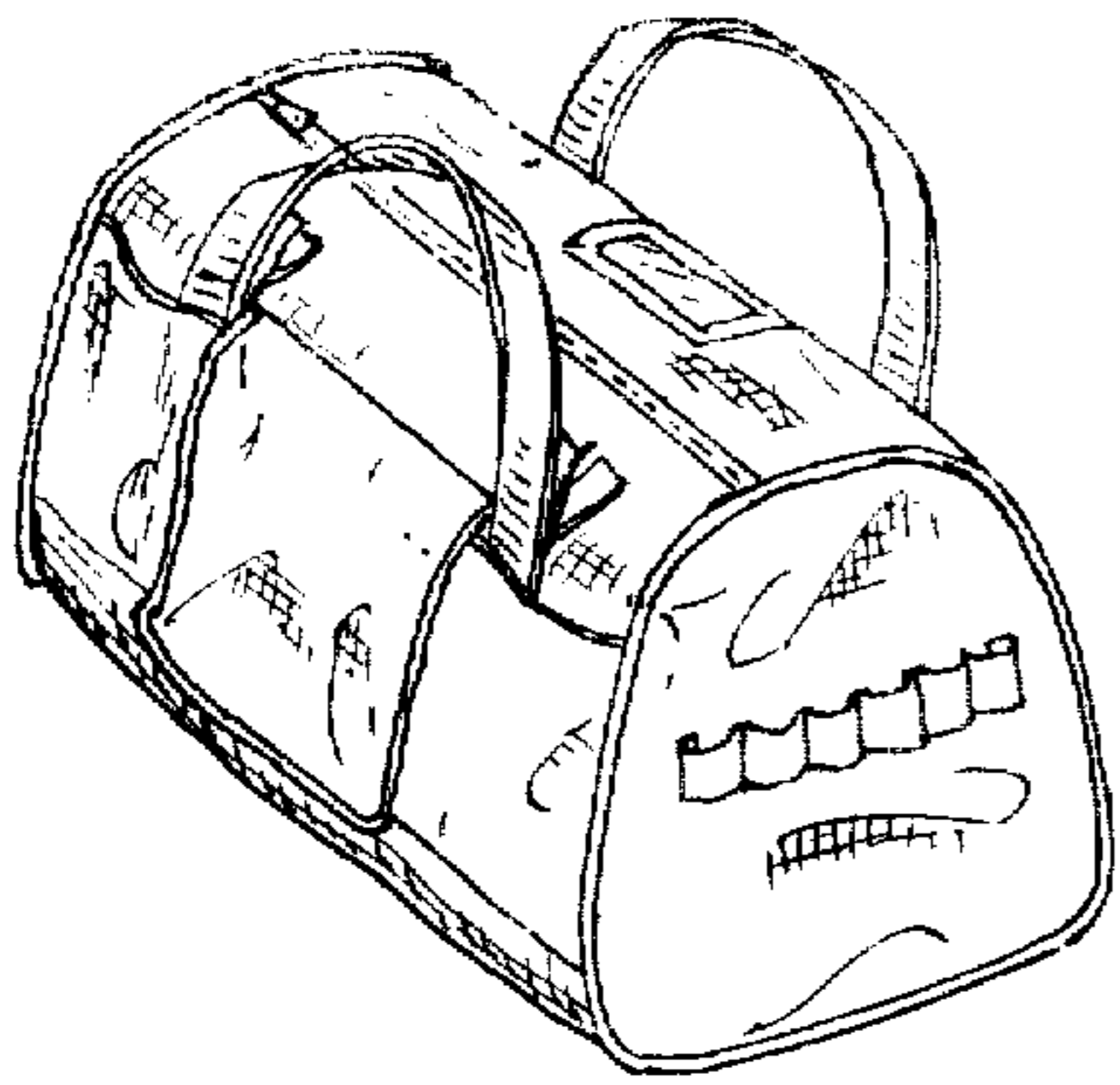

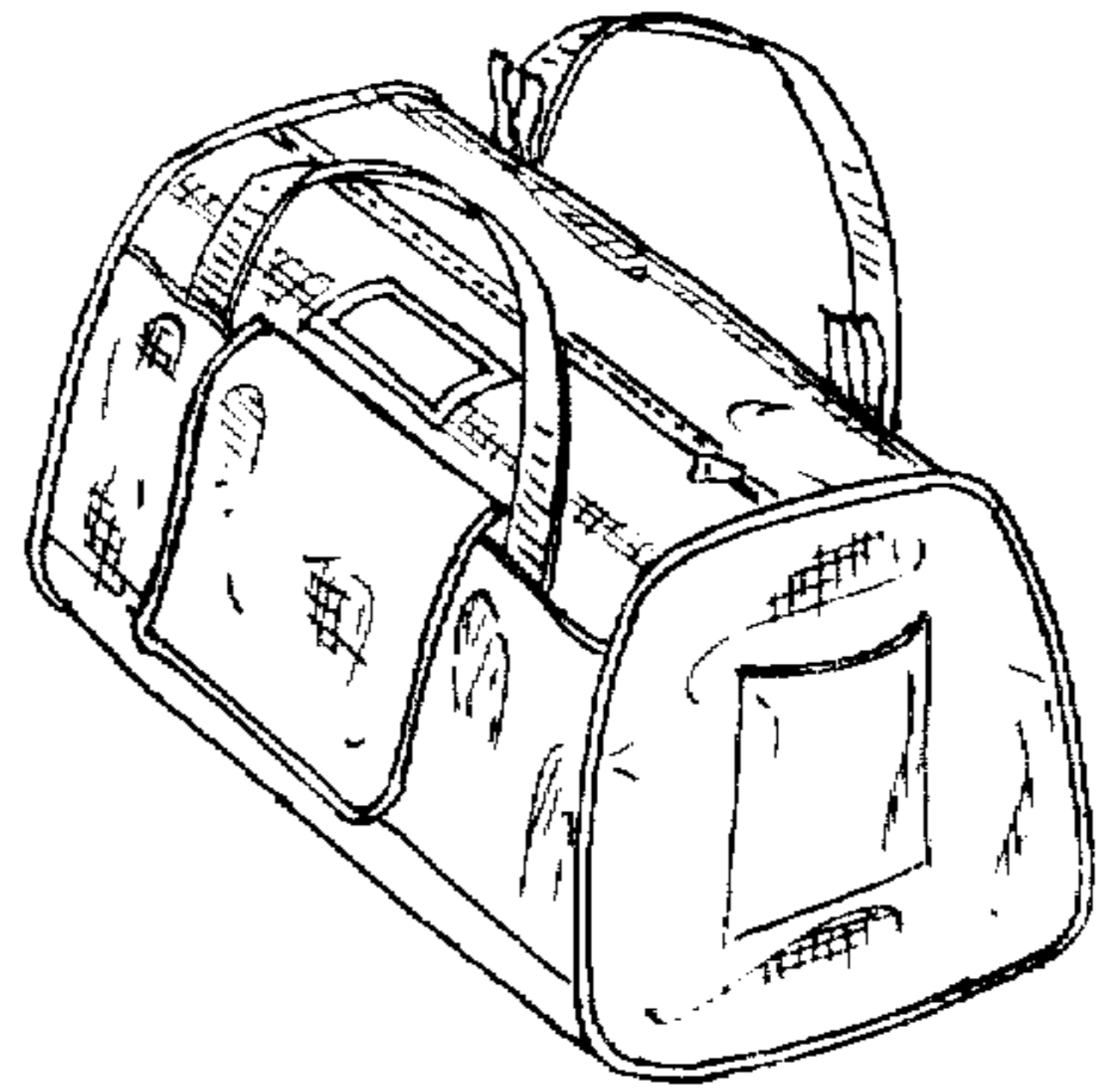

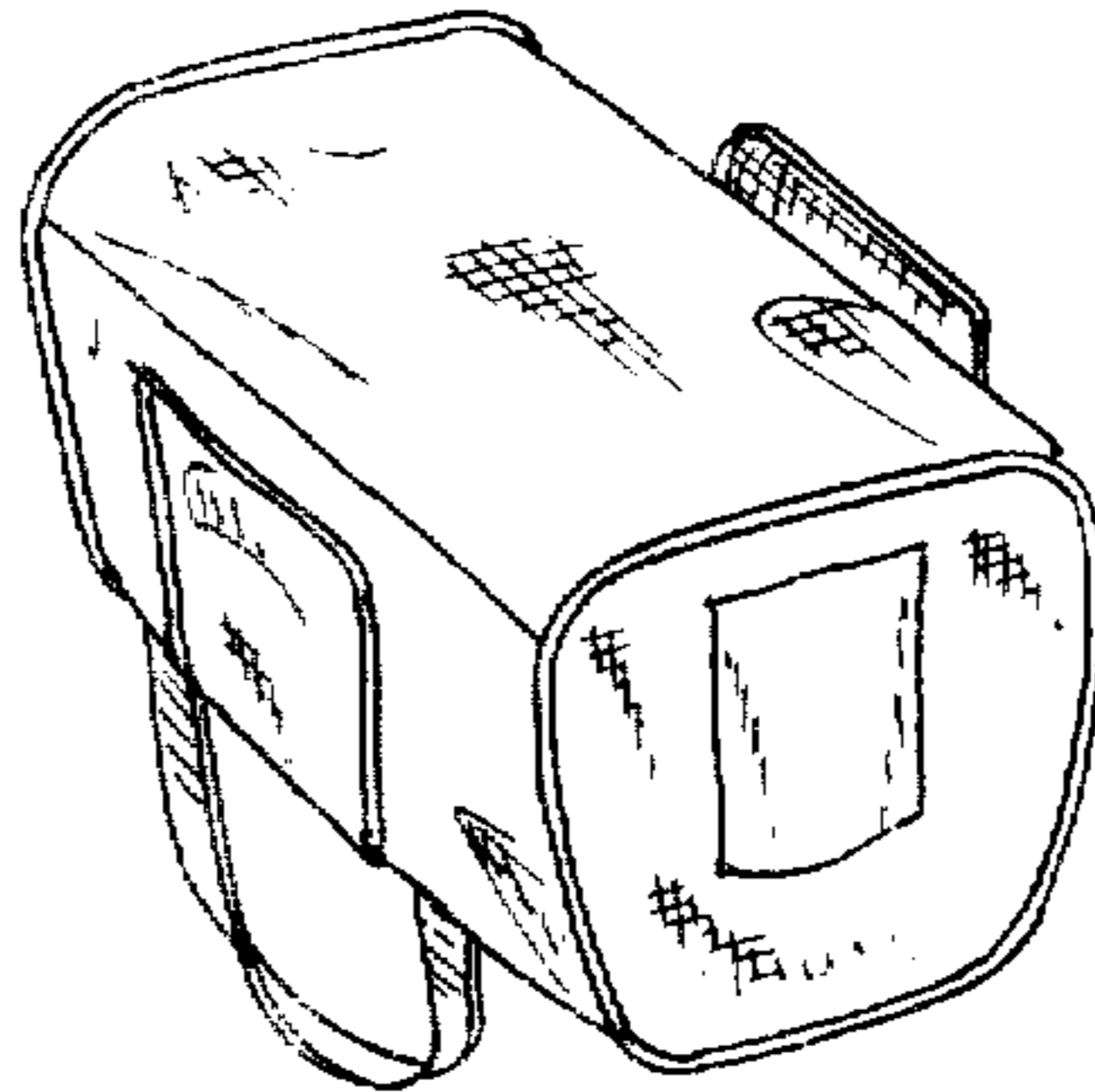

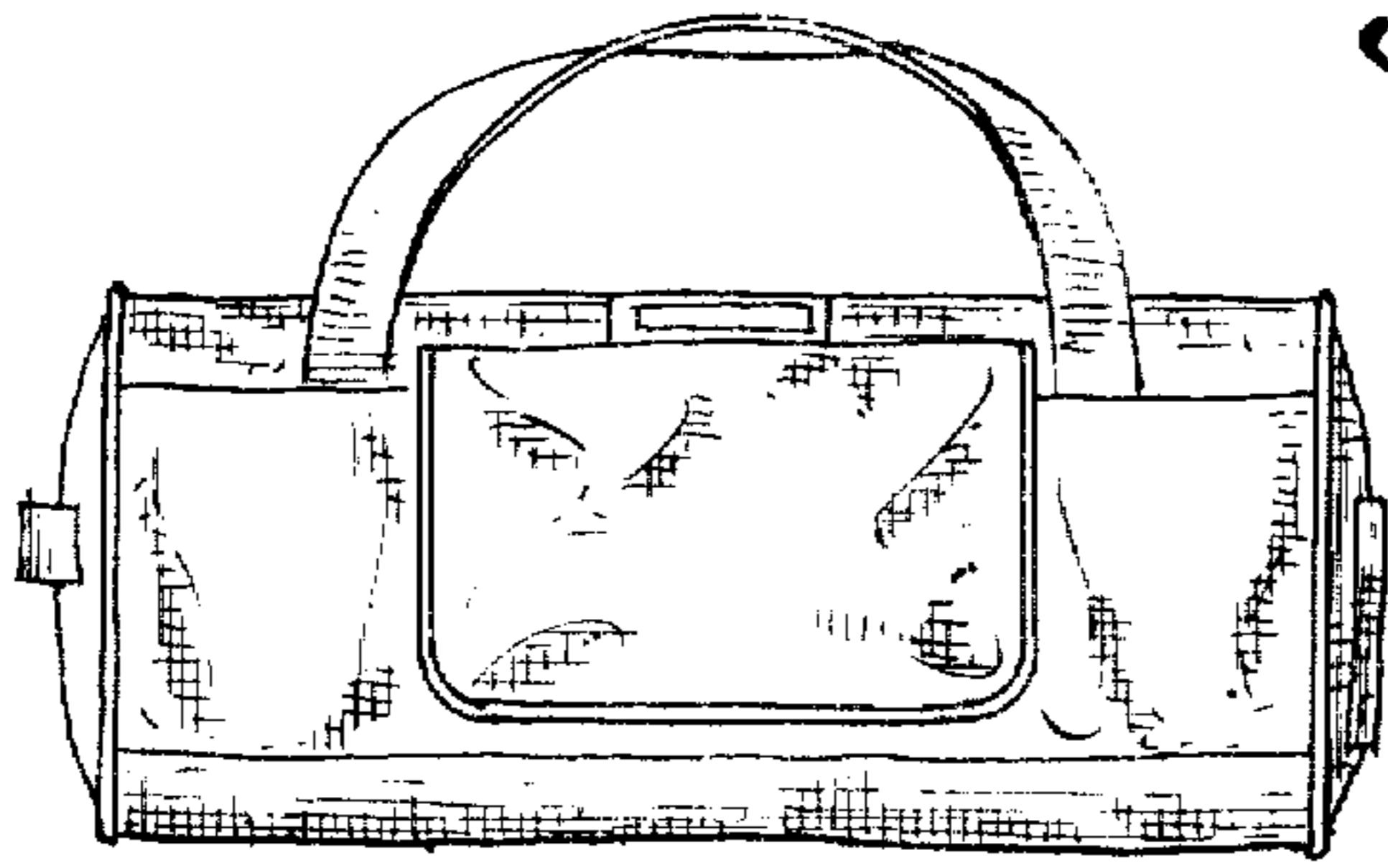

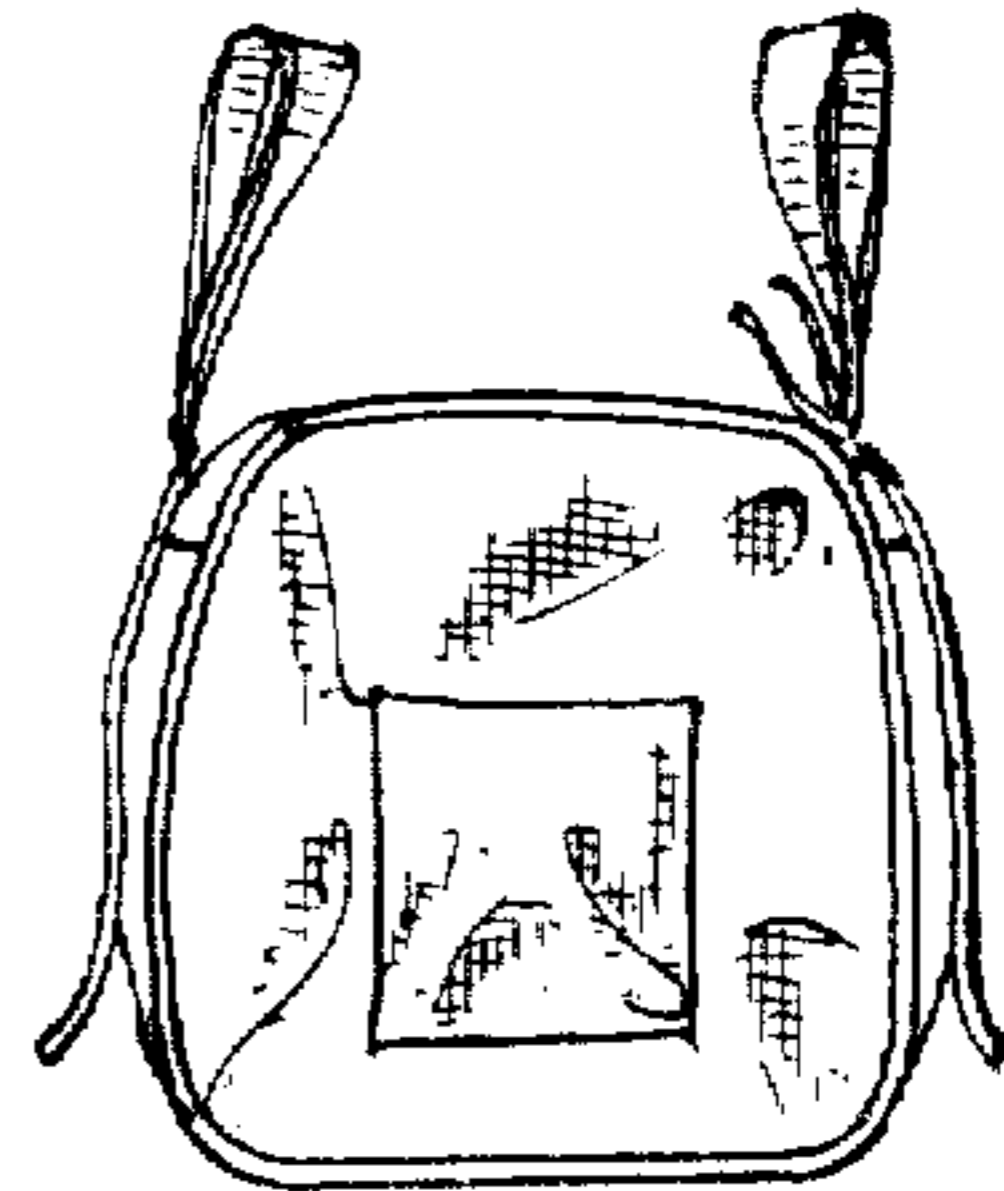
