line 1—1 of FIG. 1.

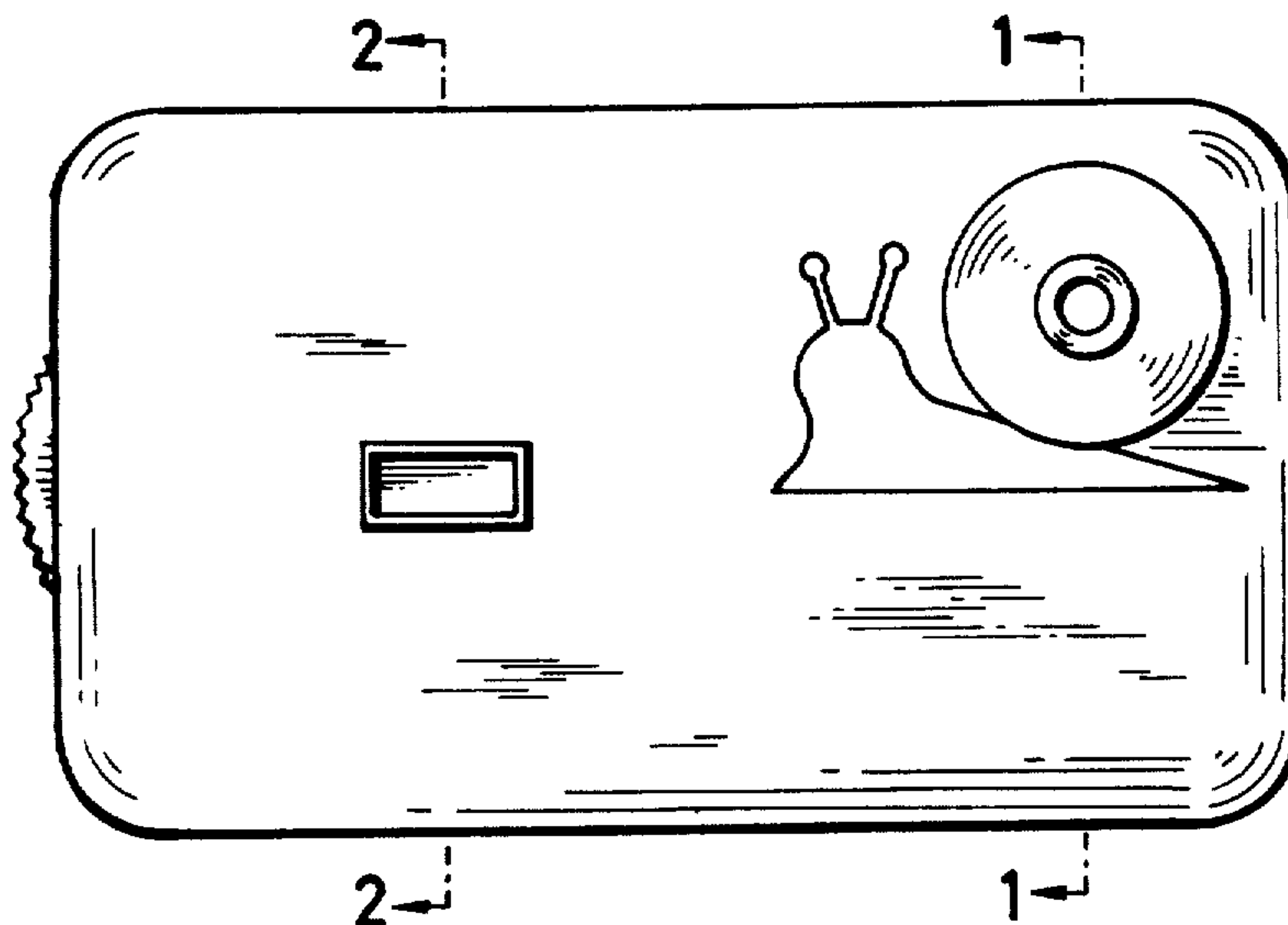

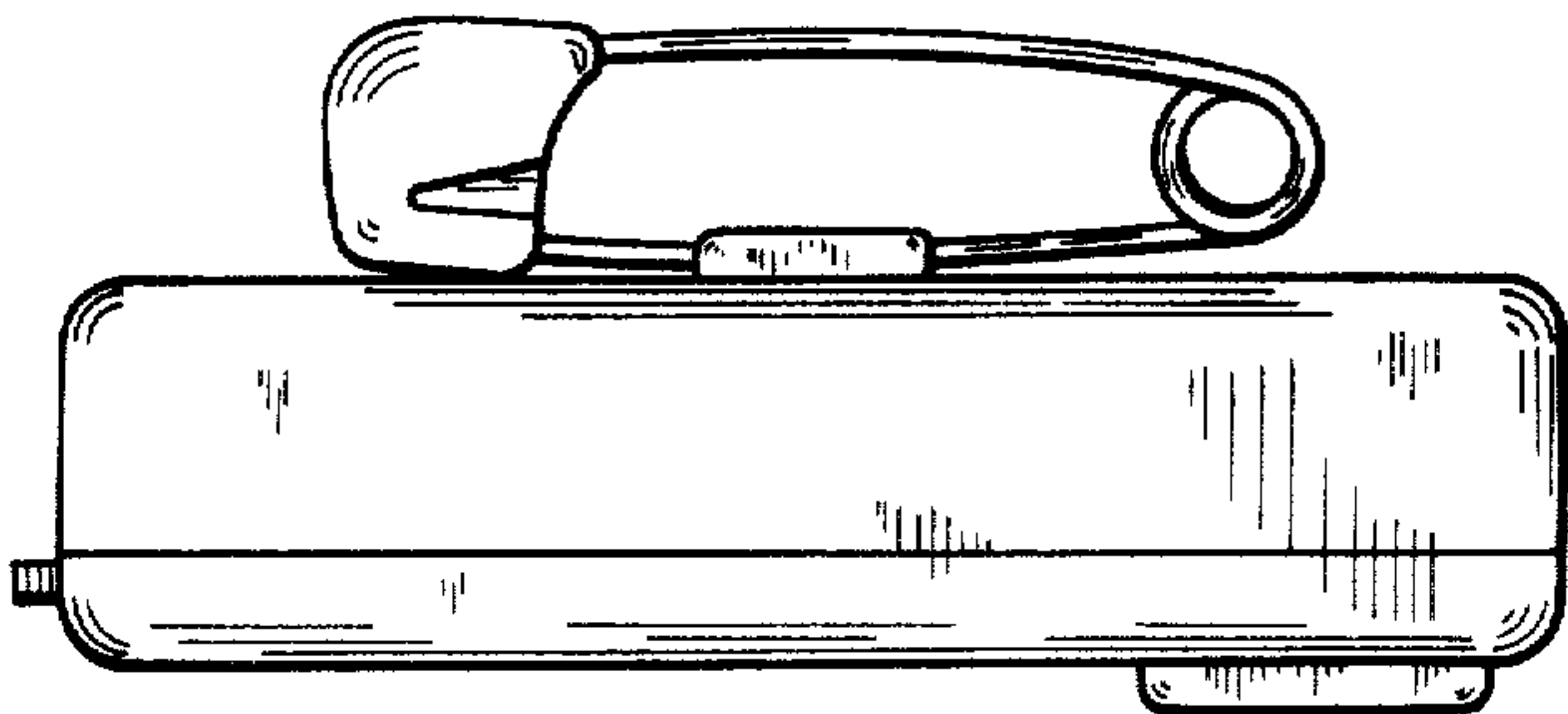

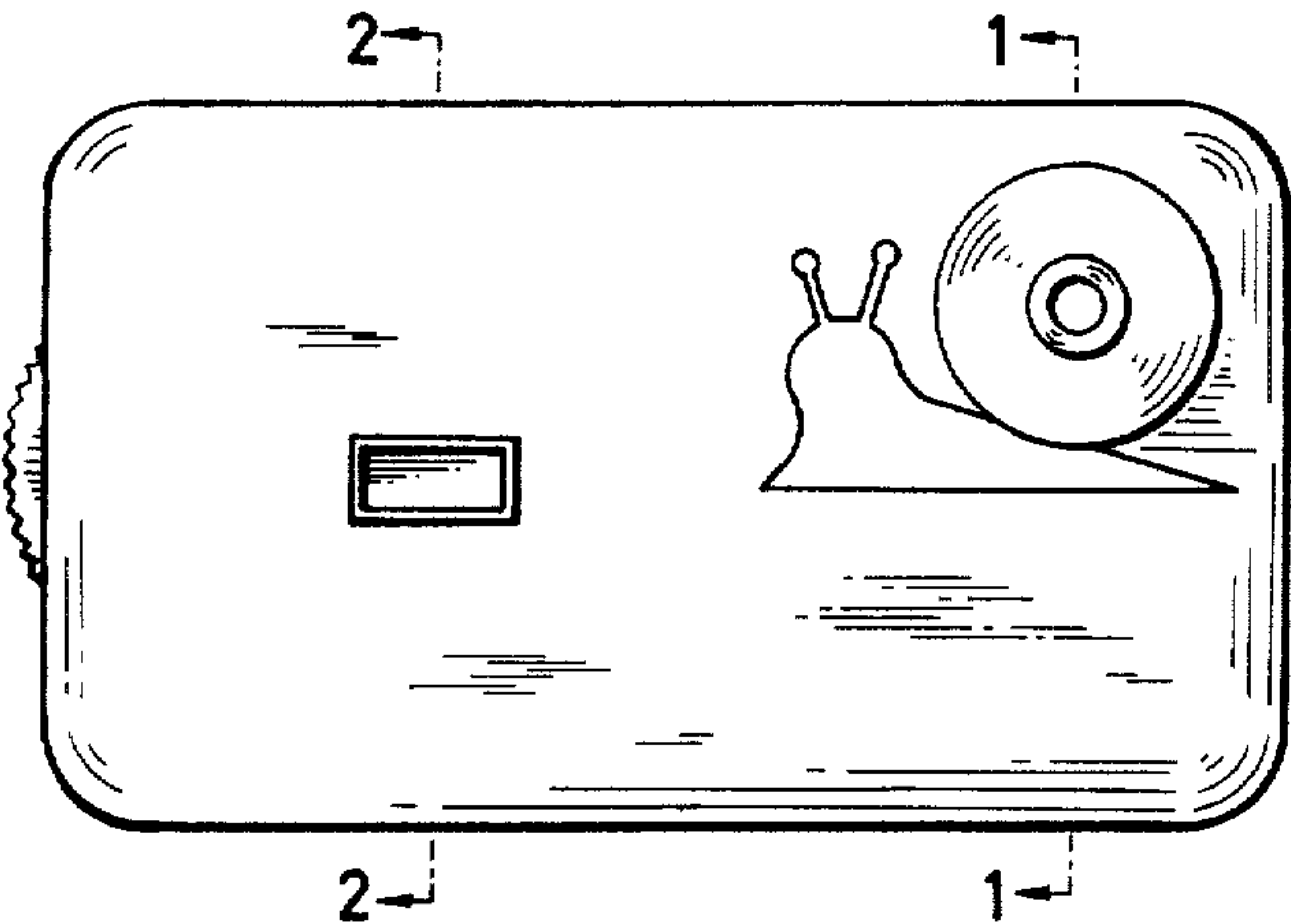

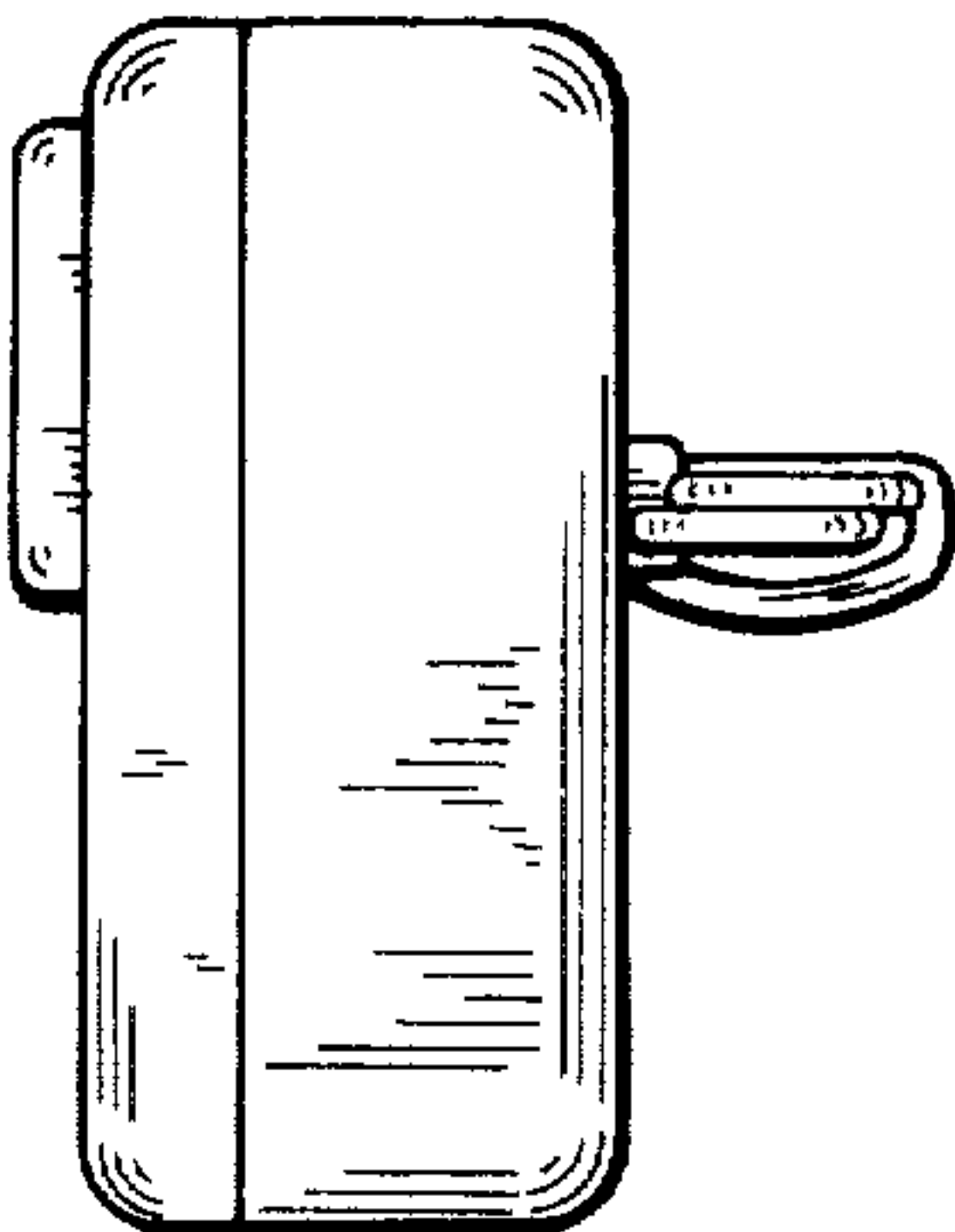

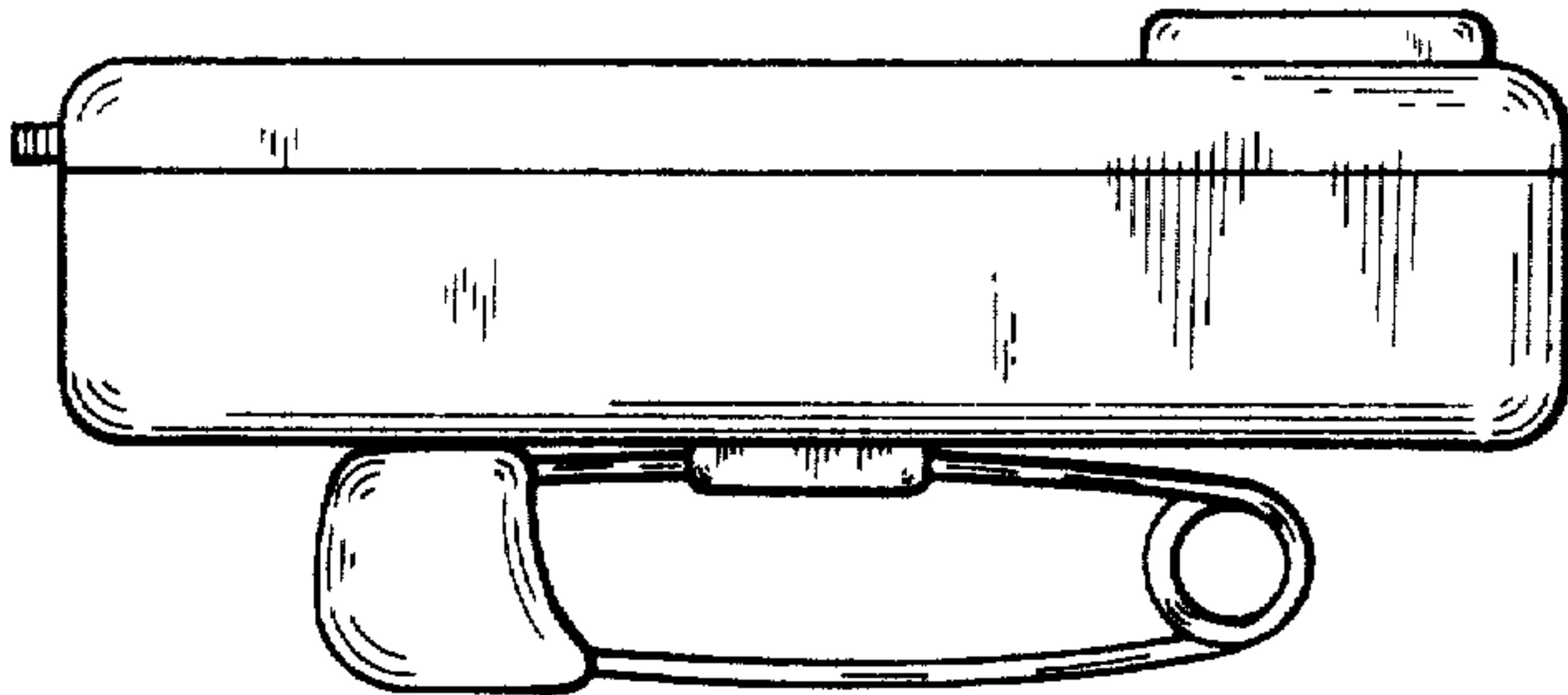

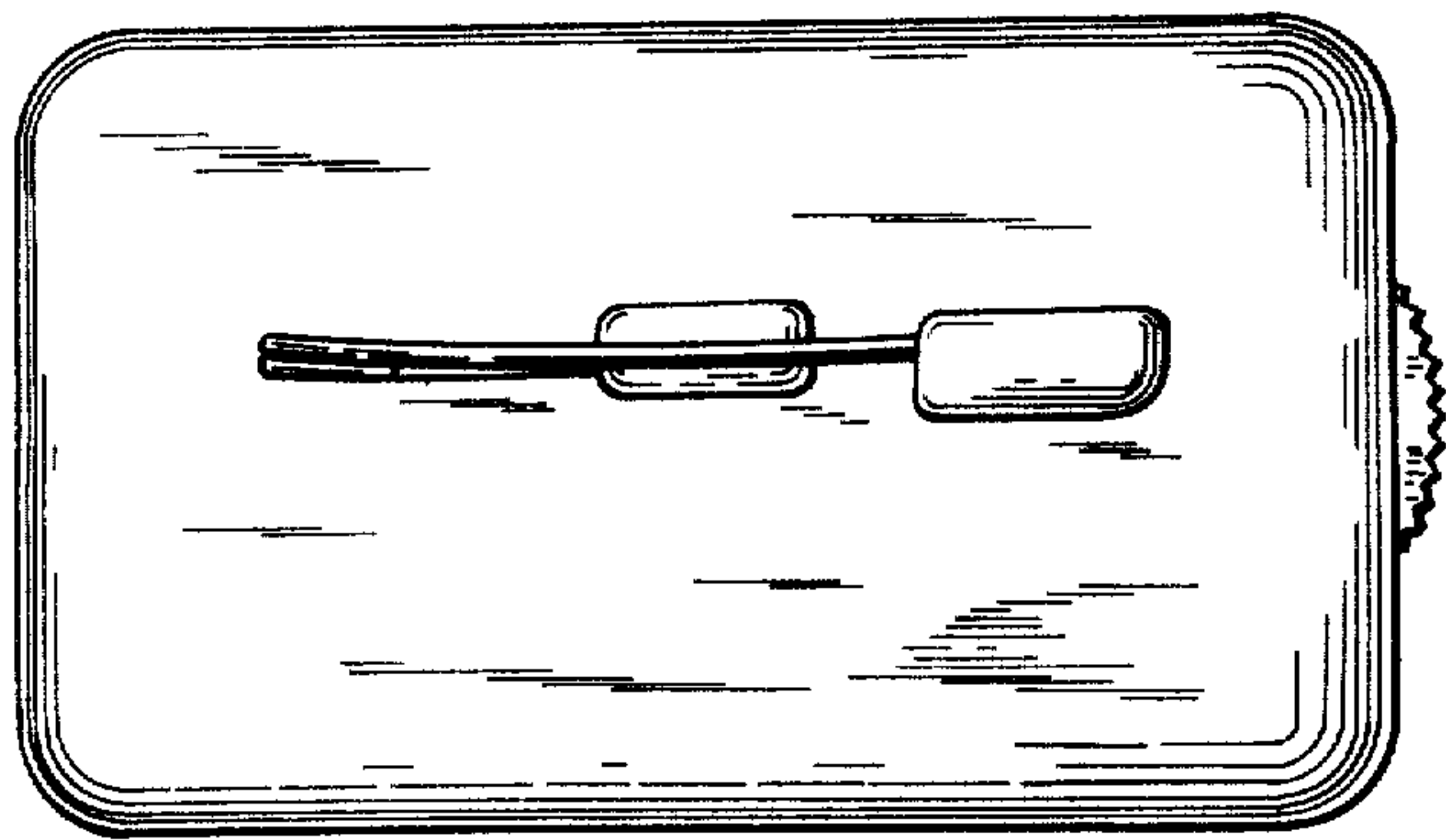

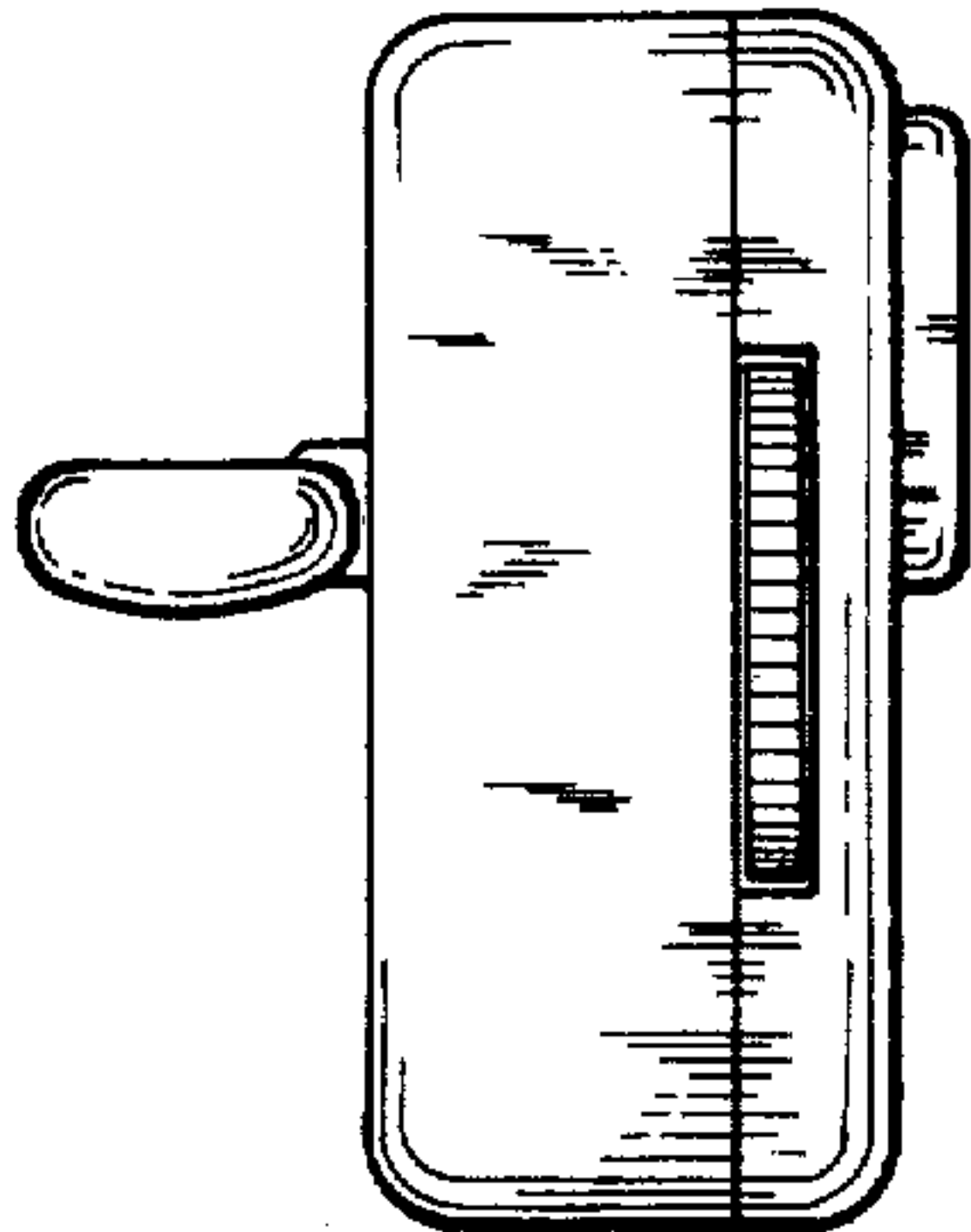

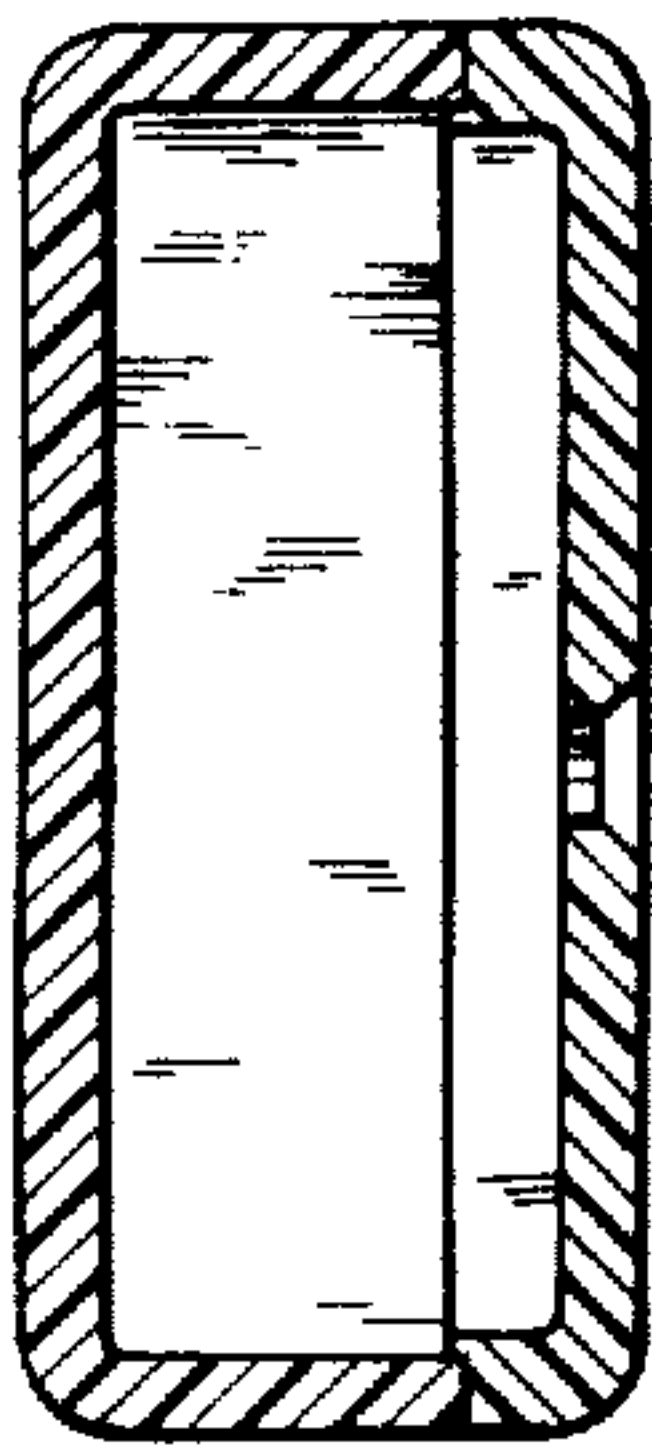
