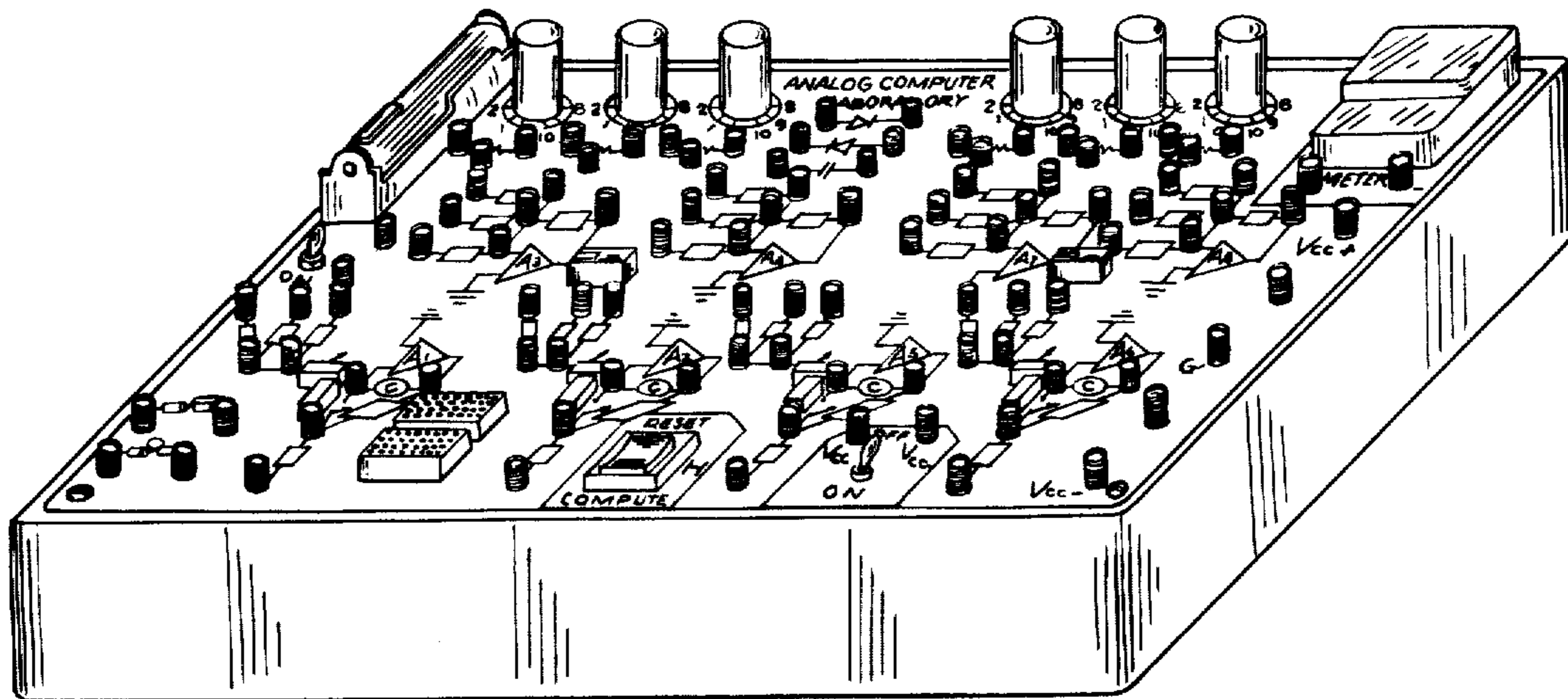

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an electronic analog computer laboratory showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof.



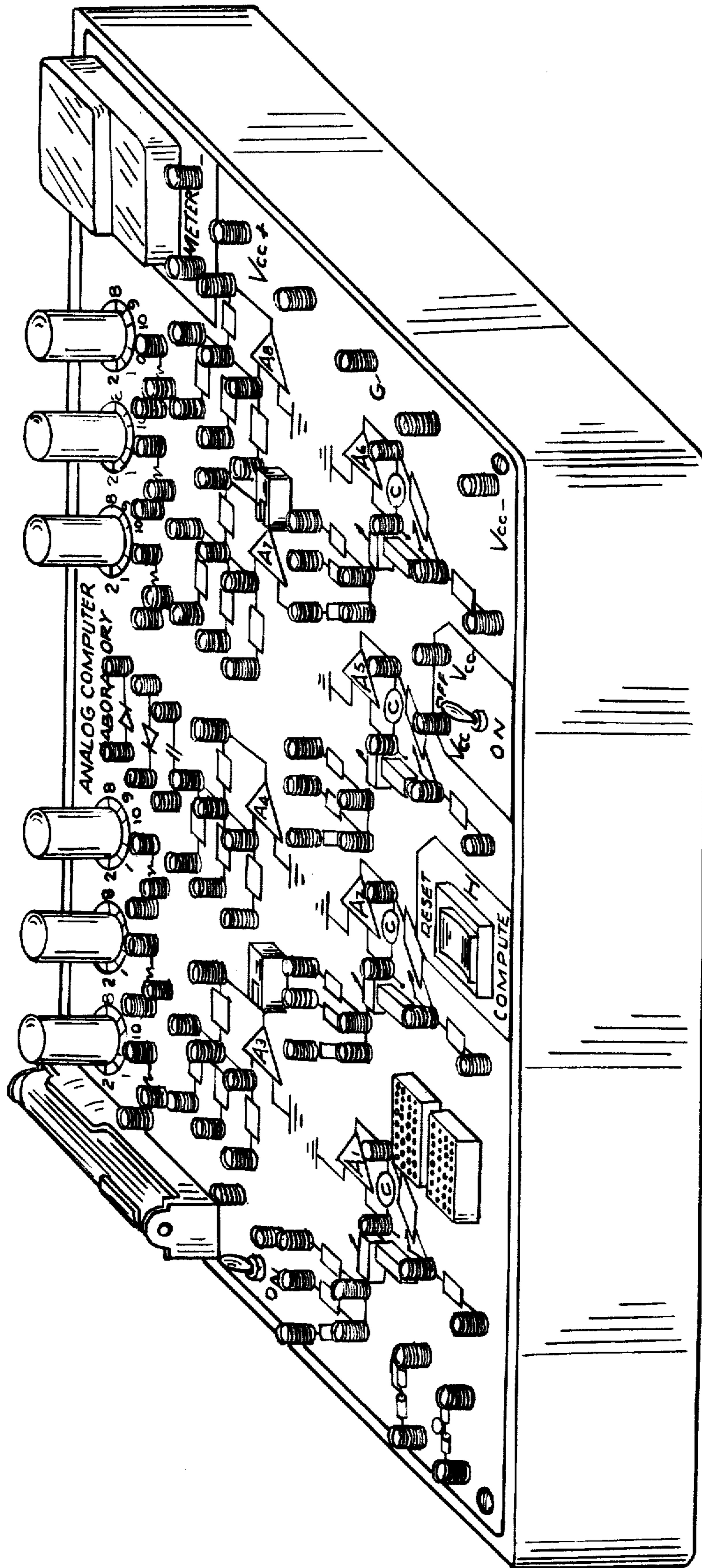

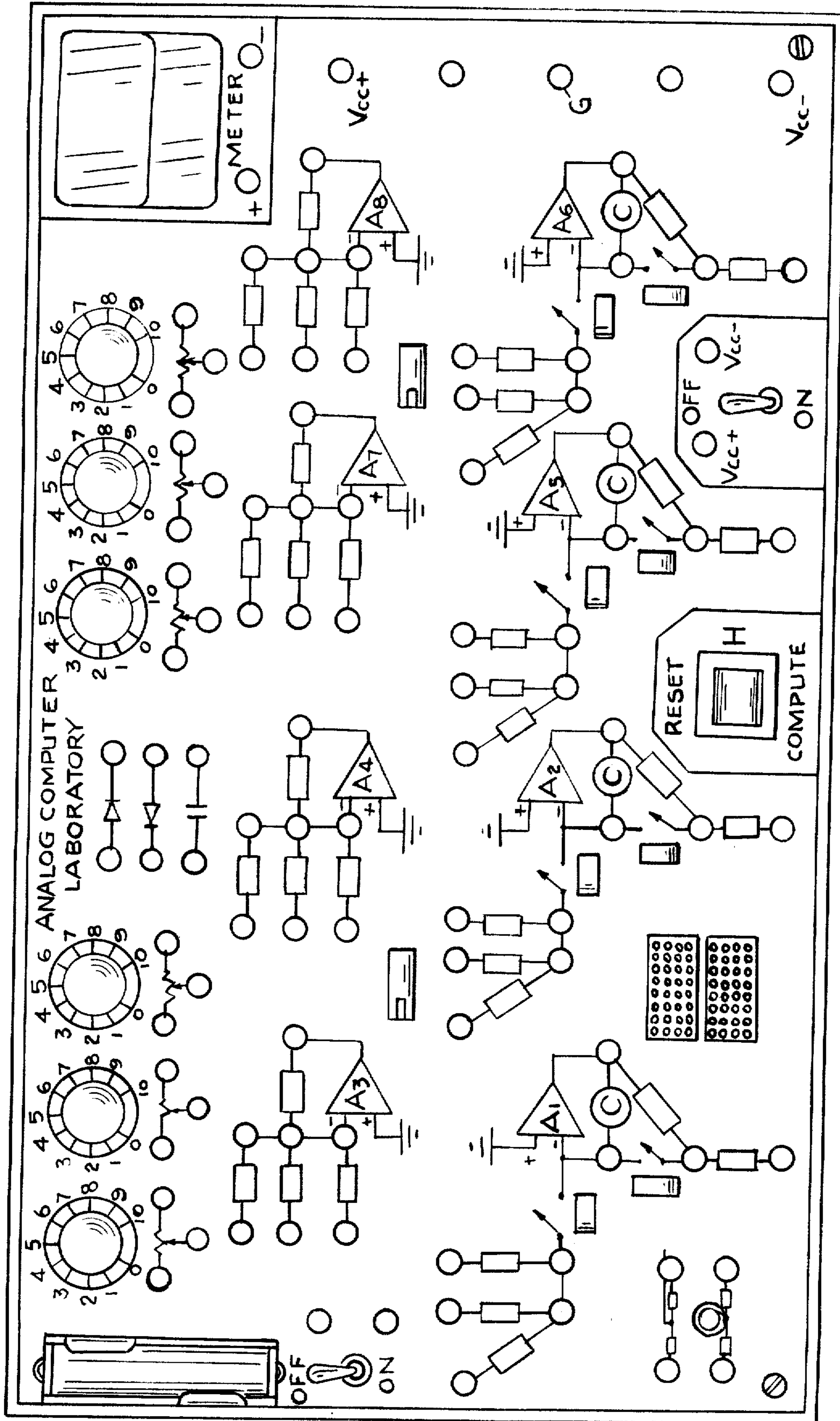
