## **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an etagere or the like, substantially as shown and described.

## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of an etagere or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of an etagere or the like as shown in FIG. 2, the shelves removed for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 4 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of an etagere or the like as shown in FIG. 2, the shelves removed for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 5 is a perspective view of a fourth embodiment of an etagere or the like as shown in FIG. 2, the shelves removed for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a fifth embodiment of an etagere or the like as shown in FIG. 2, the shelves removed for convenience of illustration;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a sixth embodiment of an etagere or the like as shown in FIG. 2, the shelves removed for convenience of illustration; and

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a seventh embodiment of an etagere or the like as shown in FIG. 2, the shelves removed for convenience of illustration.







