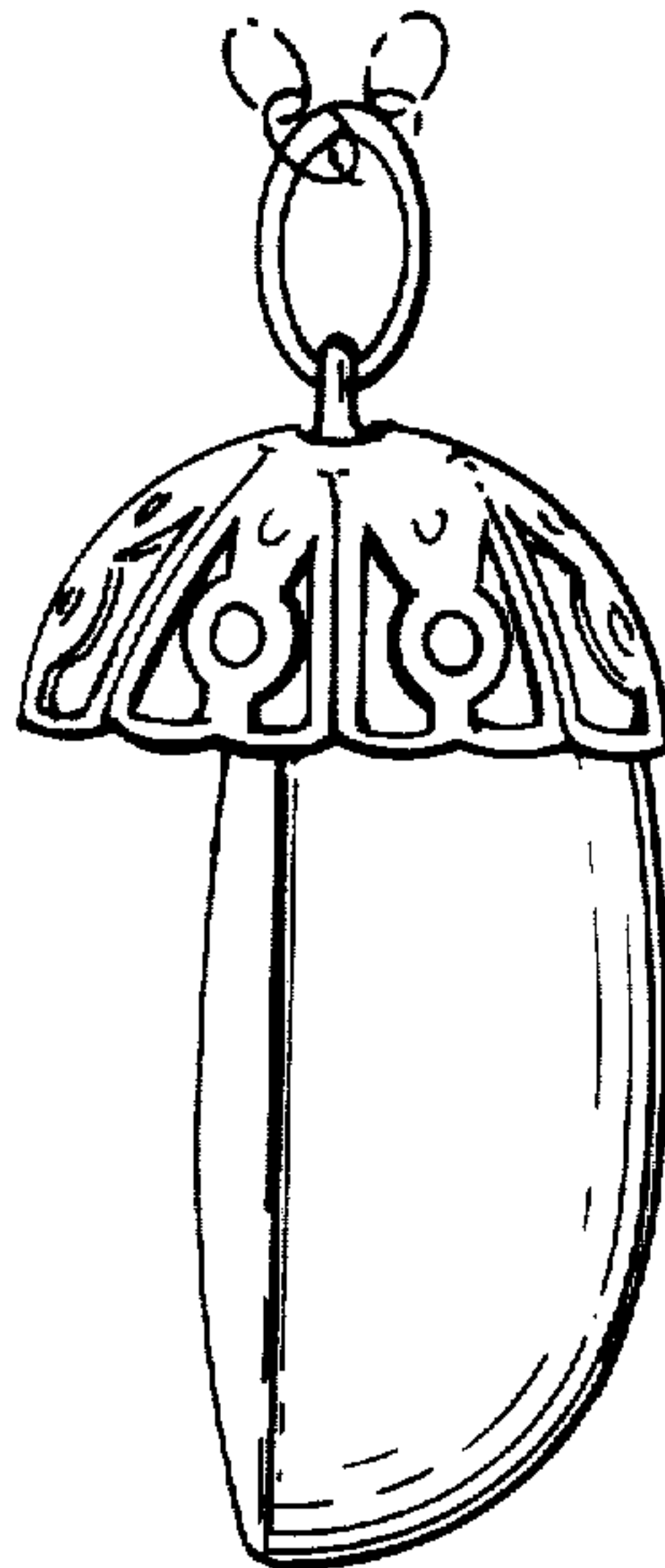

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for coffee bean pendant, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a coffee bean pendant showing our new design, the broken line chain being for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.



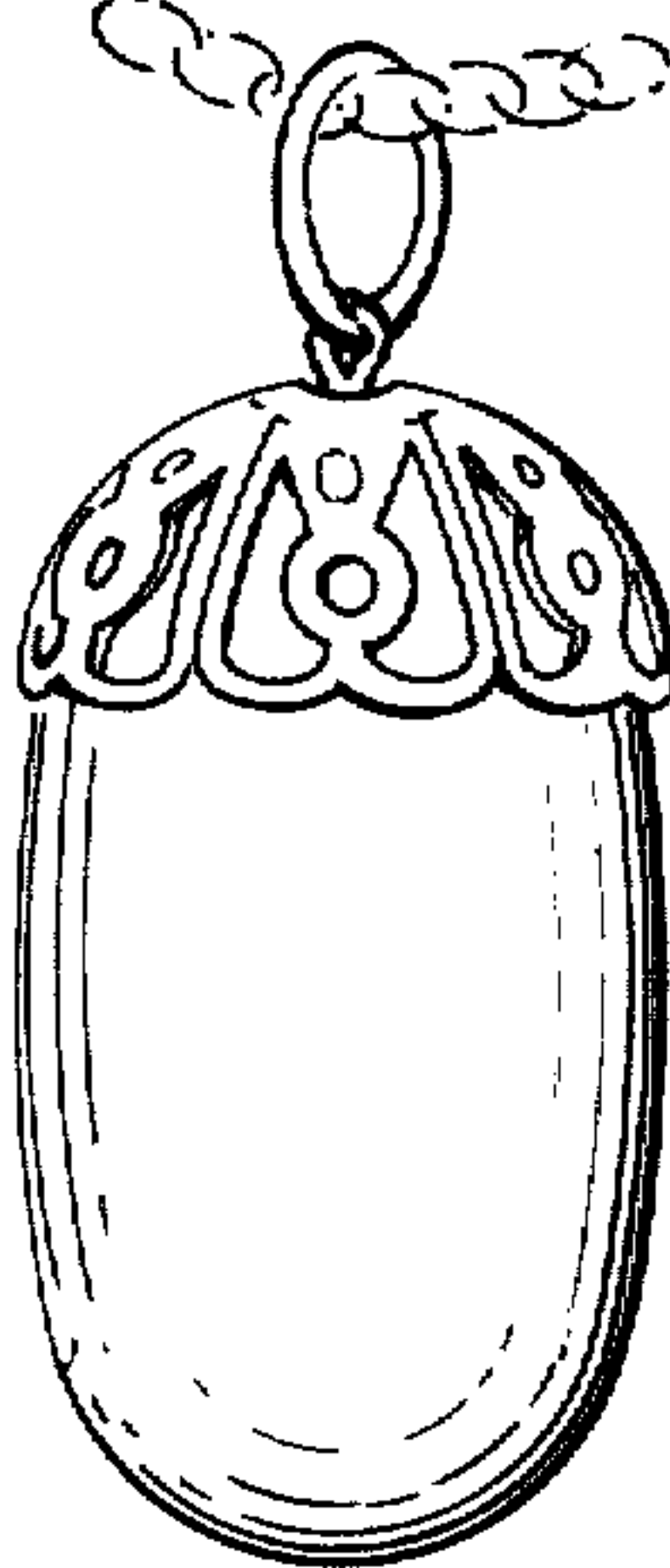

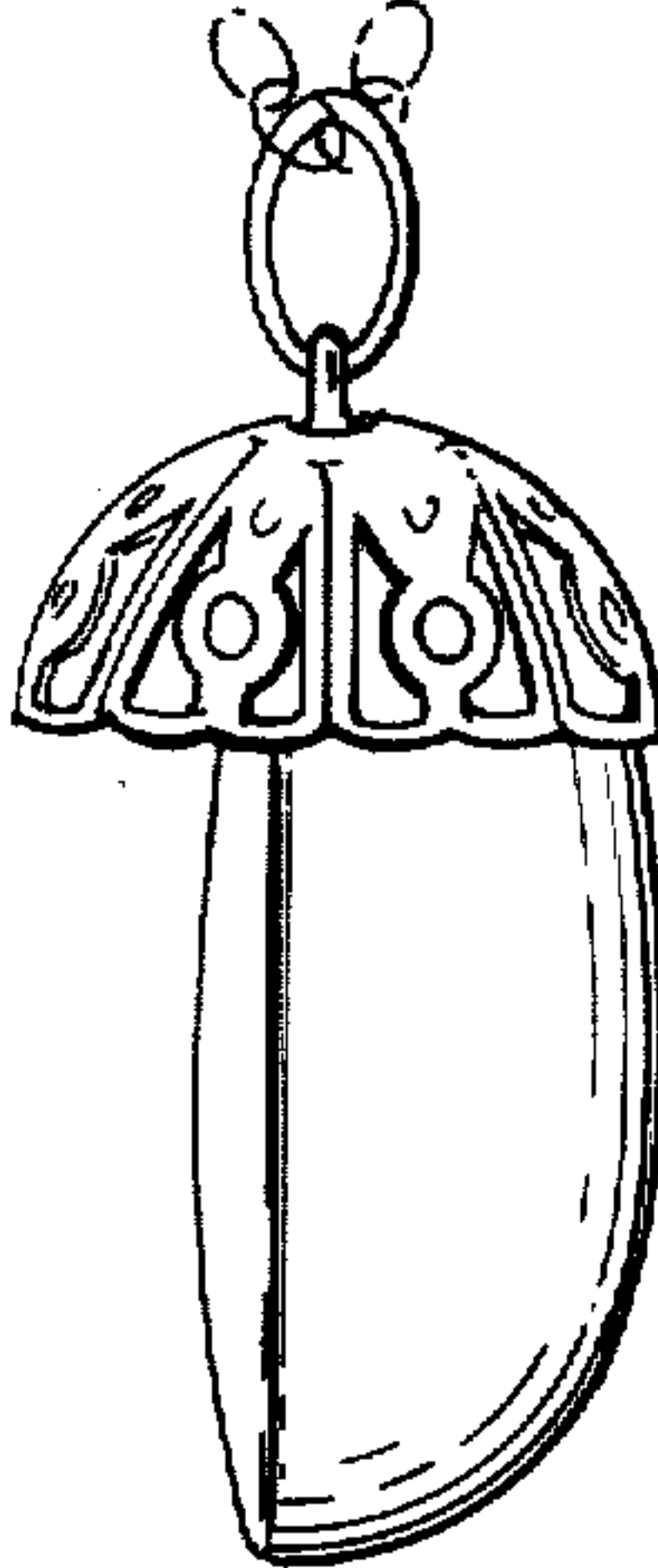

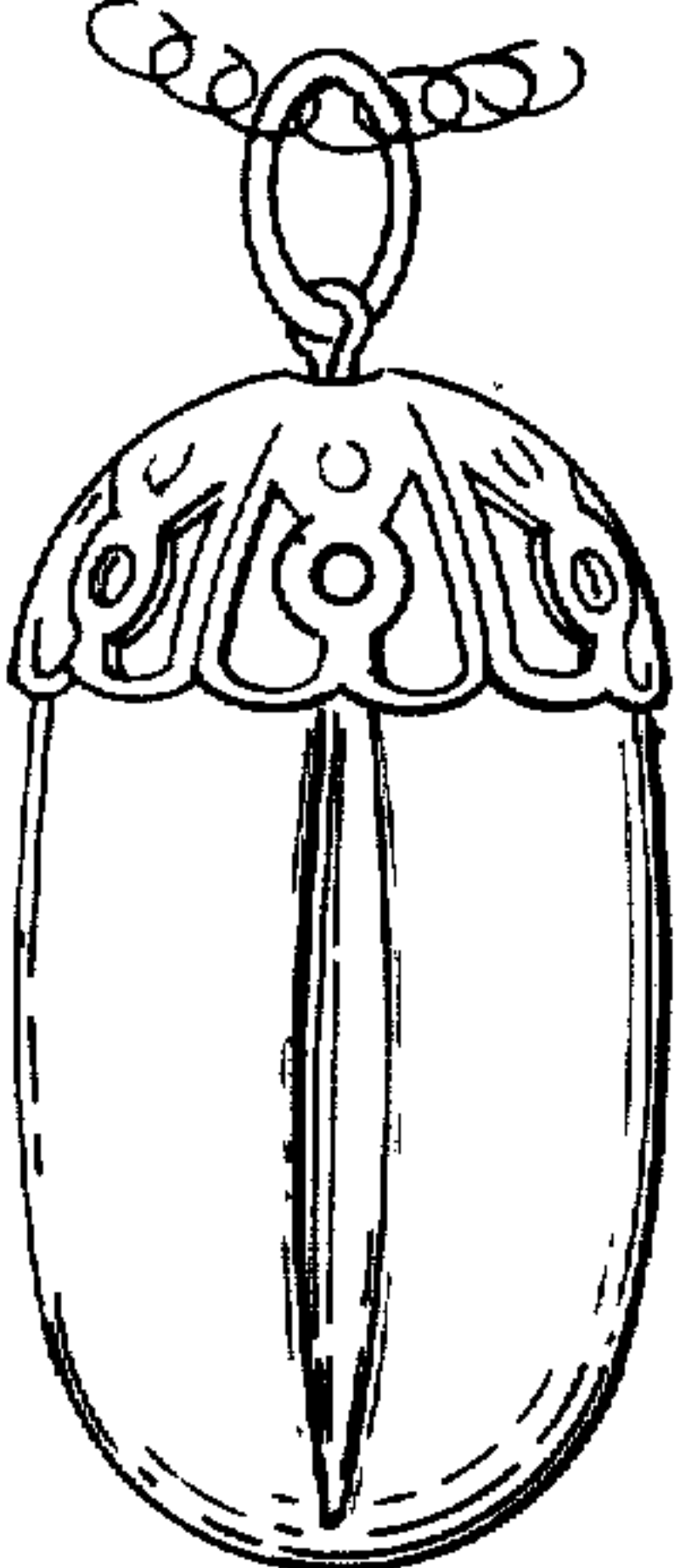

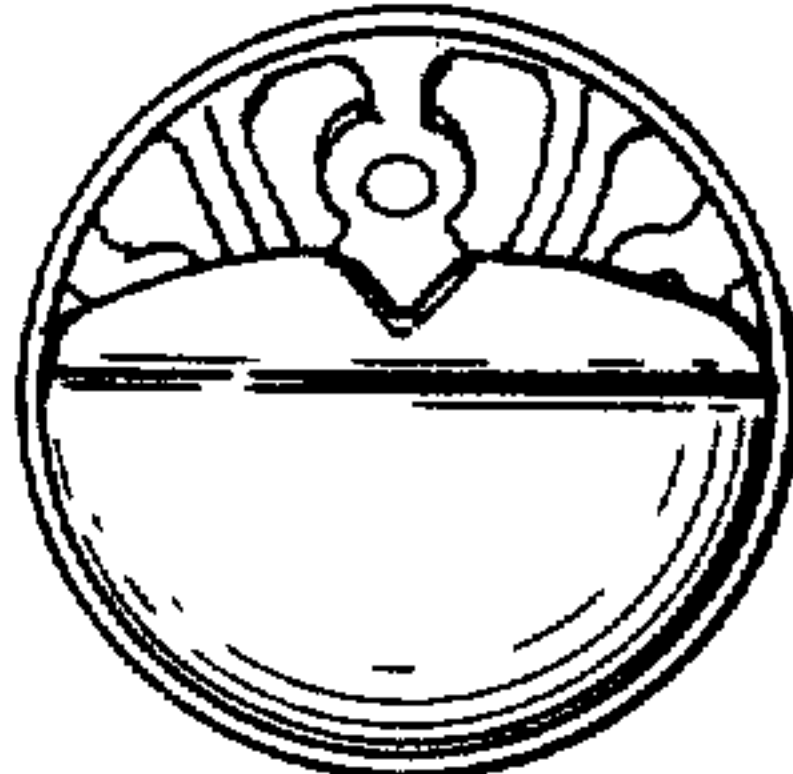
