## **DESCRIPTION**


FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a body-mounted basketball ball shooting aid in strapped position showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof, viewed from the right of FIG. 2, the opposite side elevation being the mirror image thereof;
