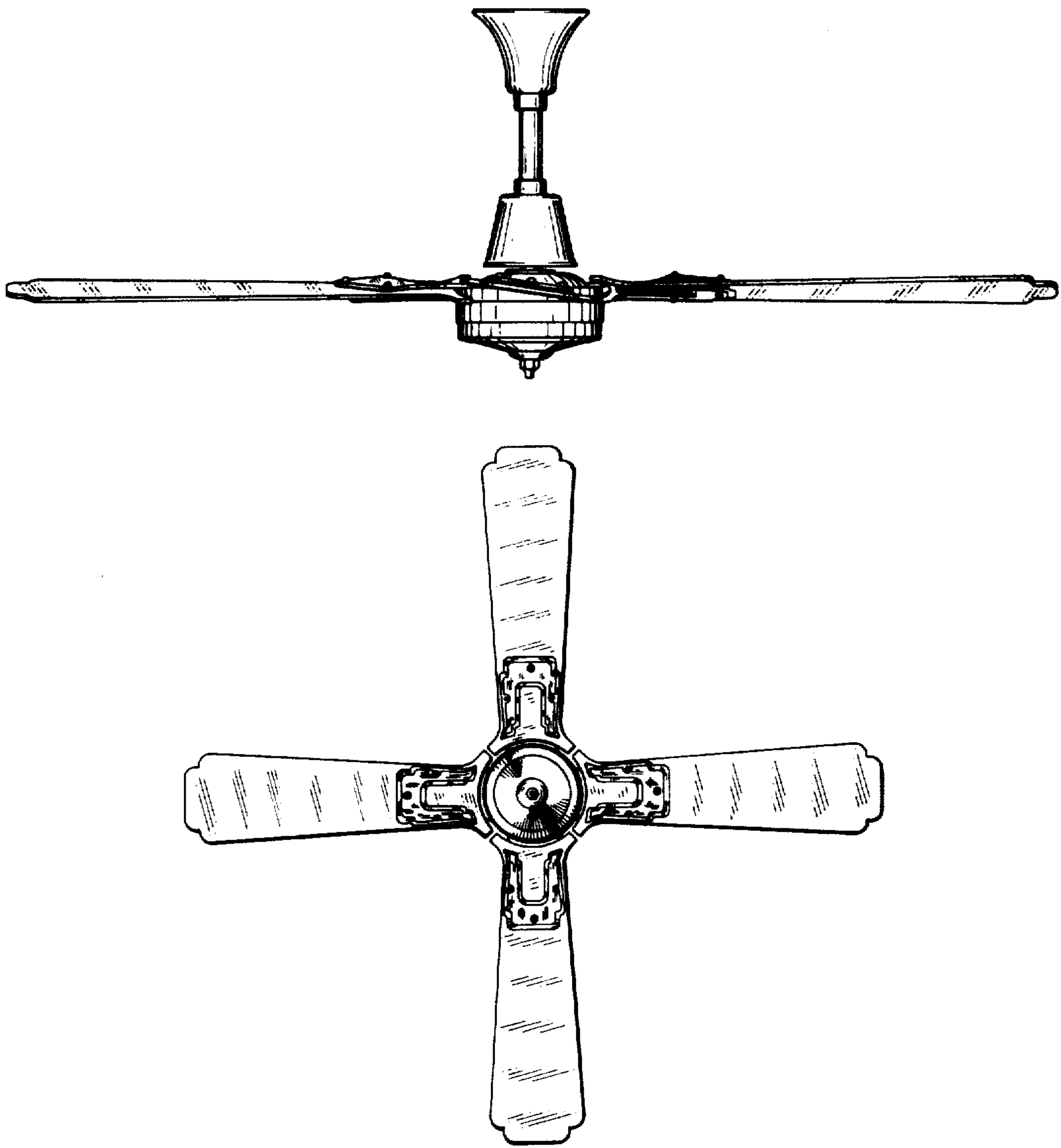

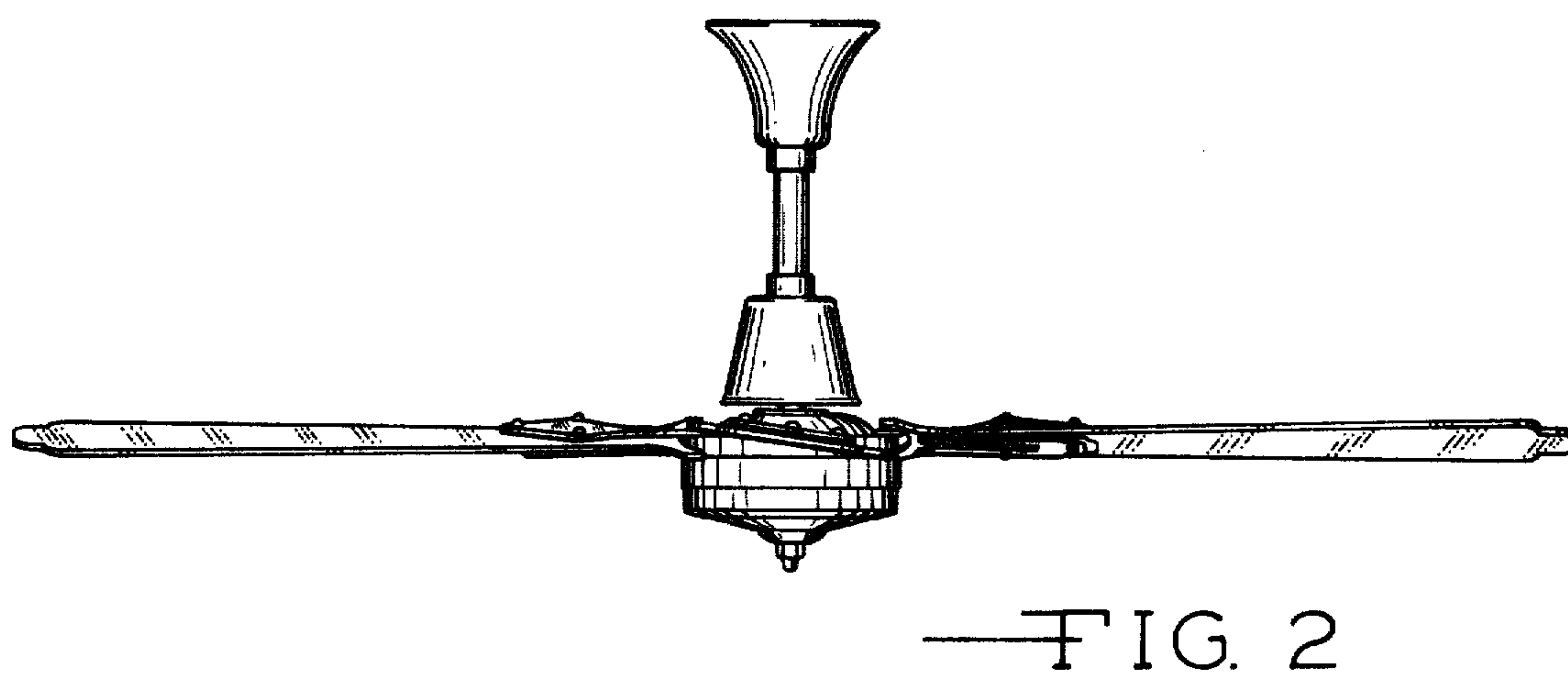
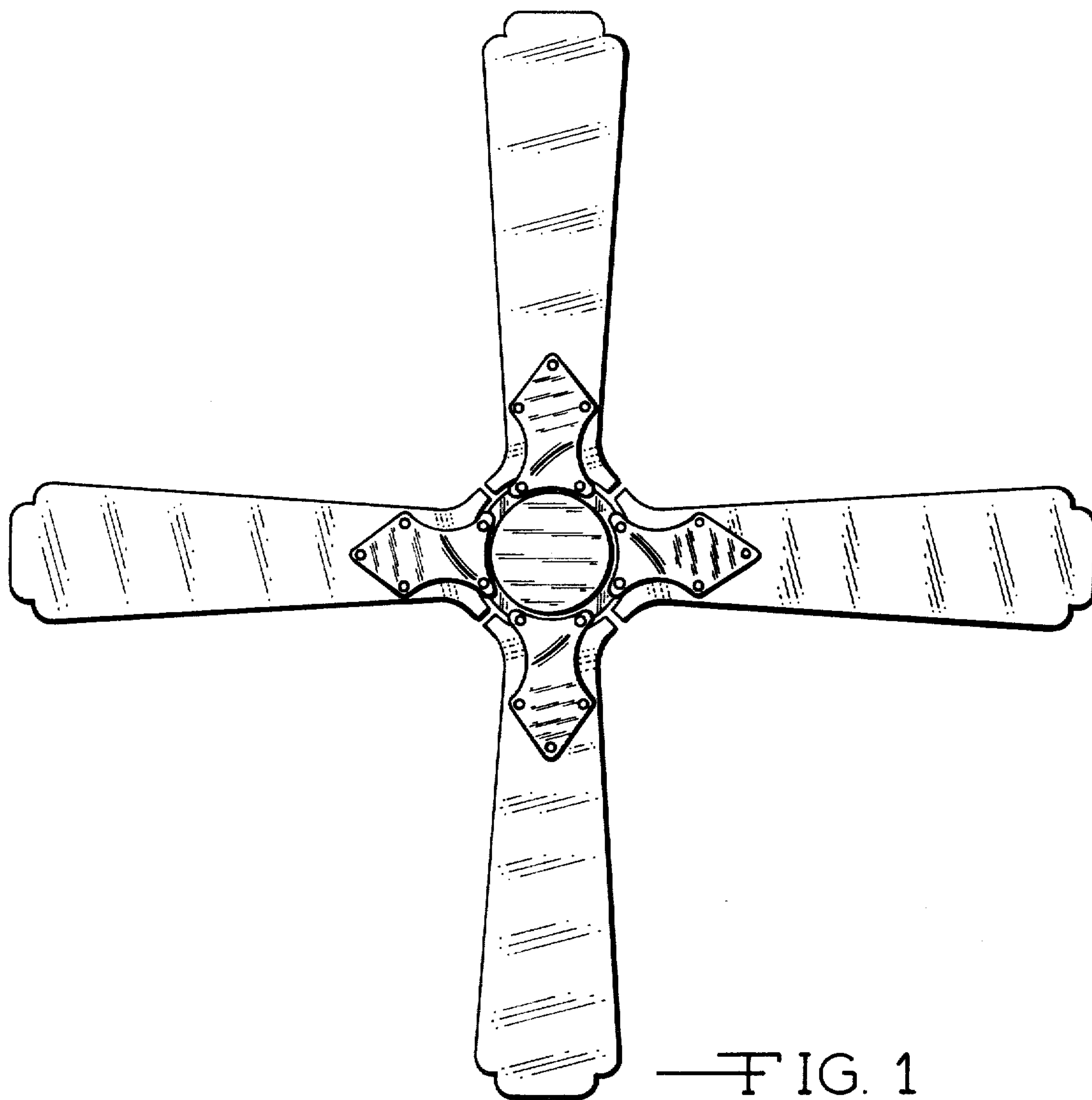

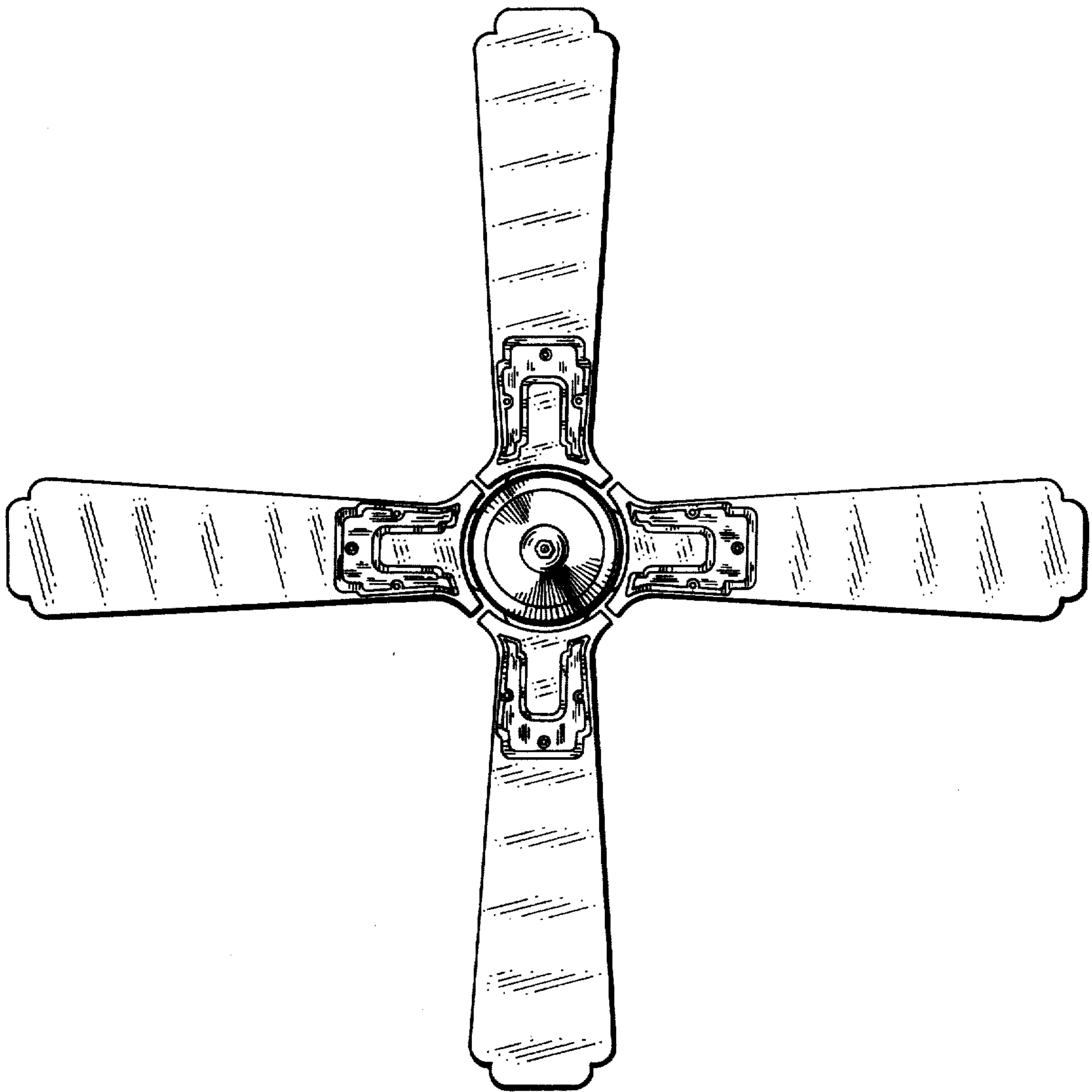
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FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a ceiling fan showing my new design;
