[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the ottoman, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view illustrating the ottoman of the present design;

FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a side perspective view thereof.

The design is characterized by the combination on the ottoman disclosed being comprised of a pair of wedge-shaped pillow tops of substantially the same dimensions in association with a base member of substantially greater dimensions, all as best illustrated in FIGS. 1 and 3.

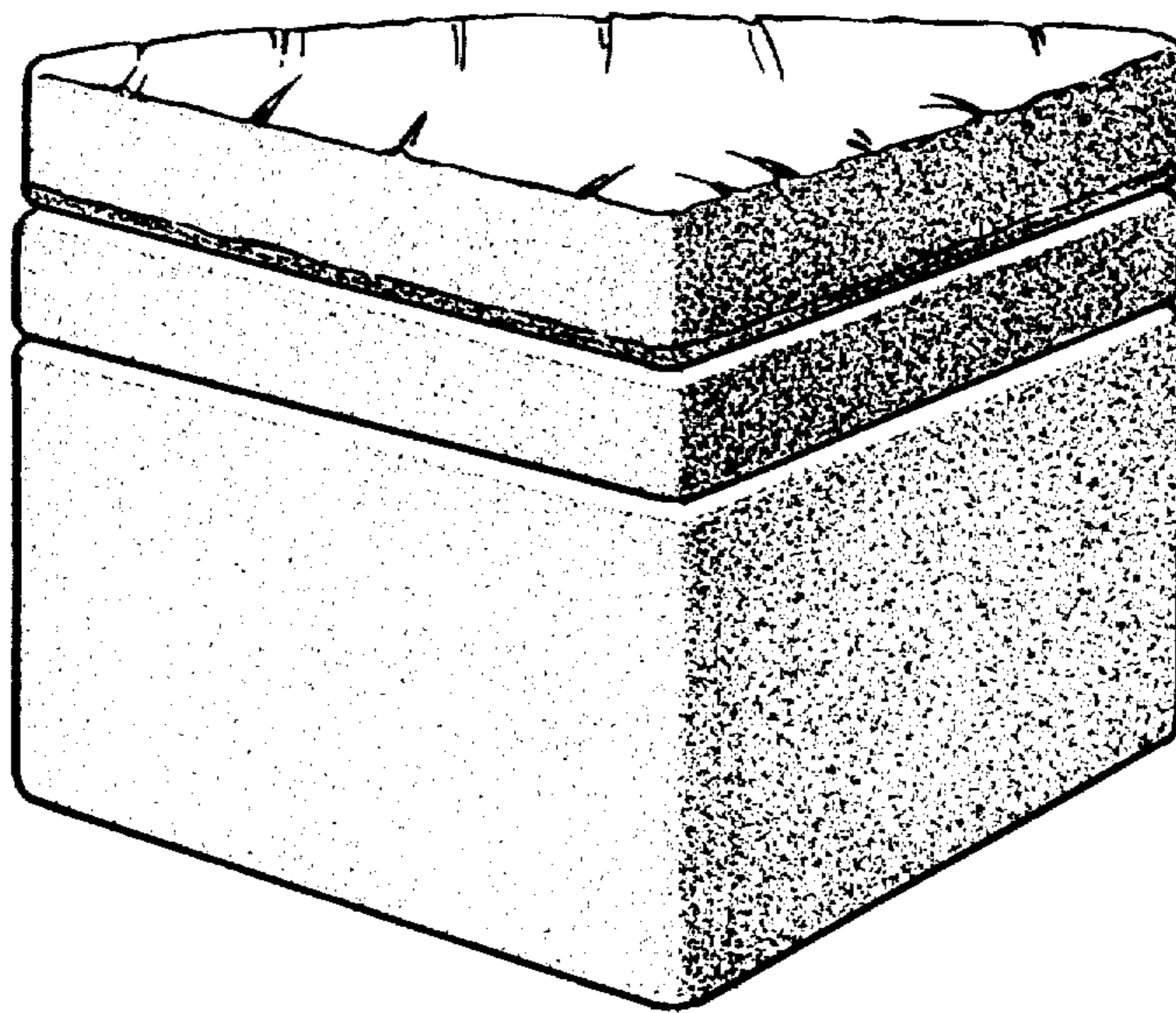

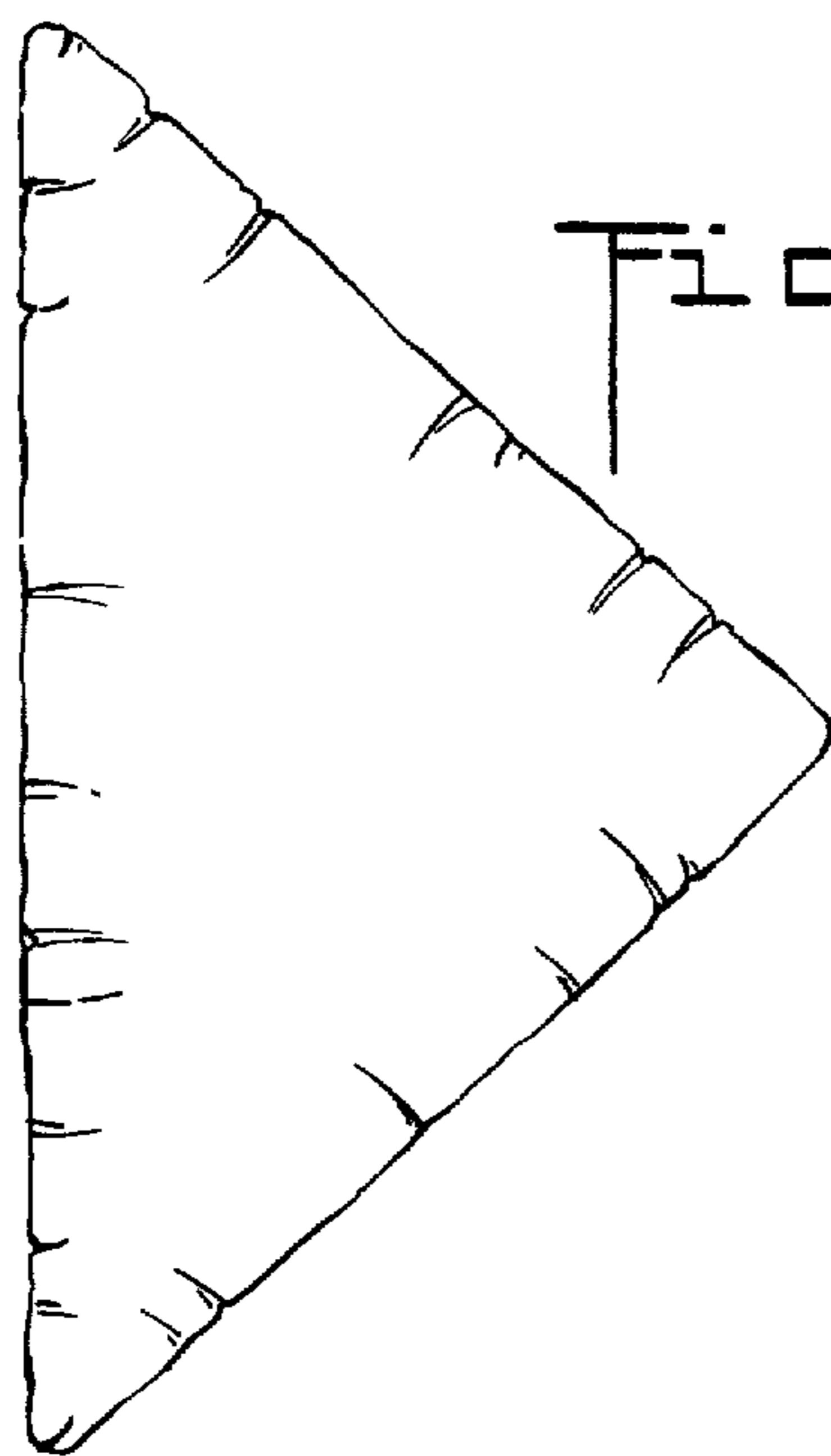
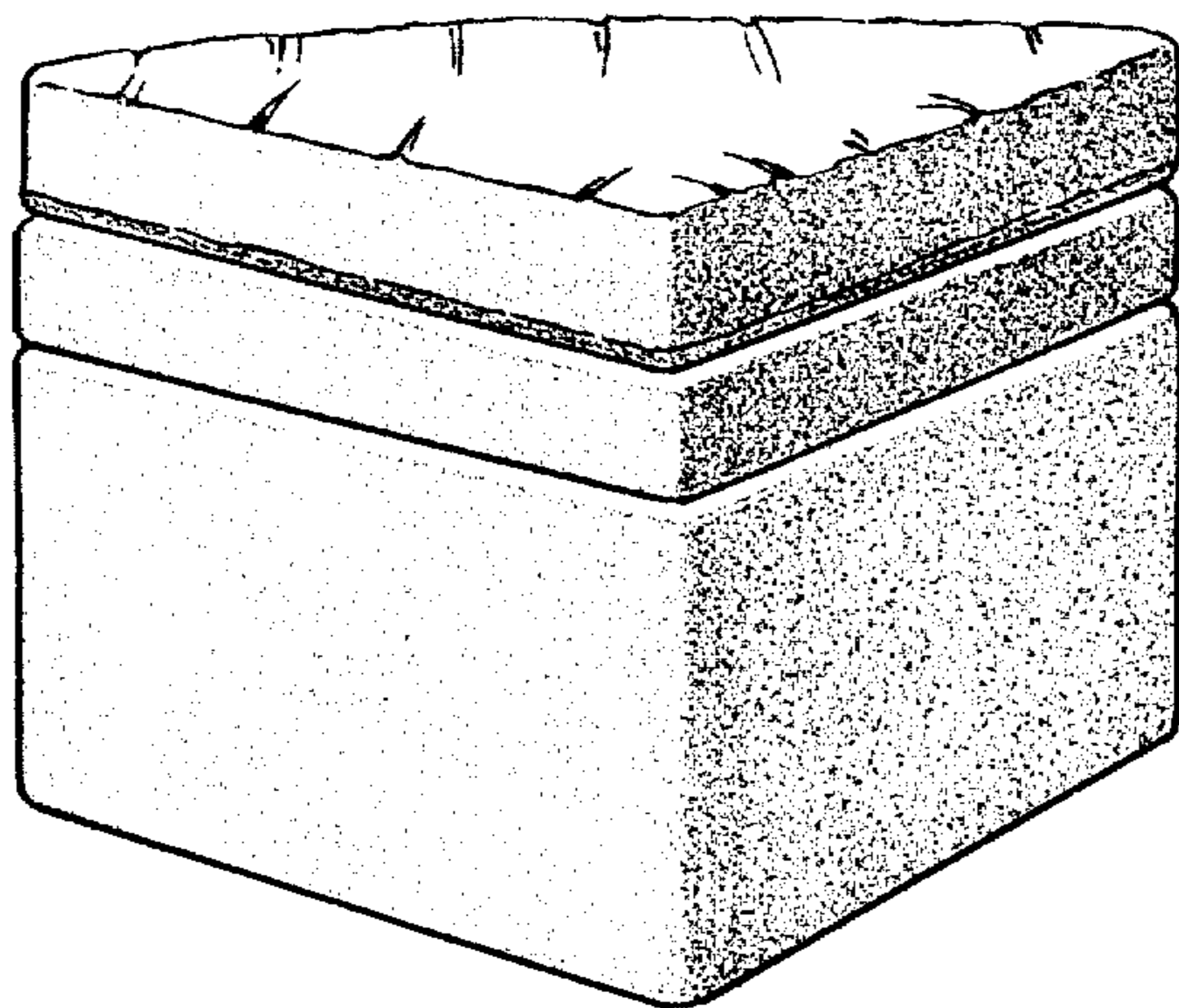

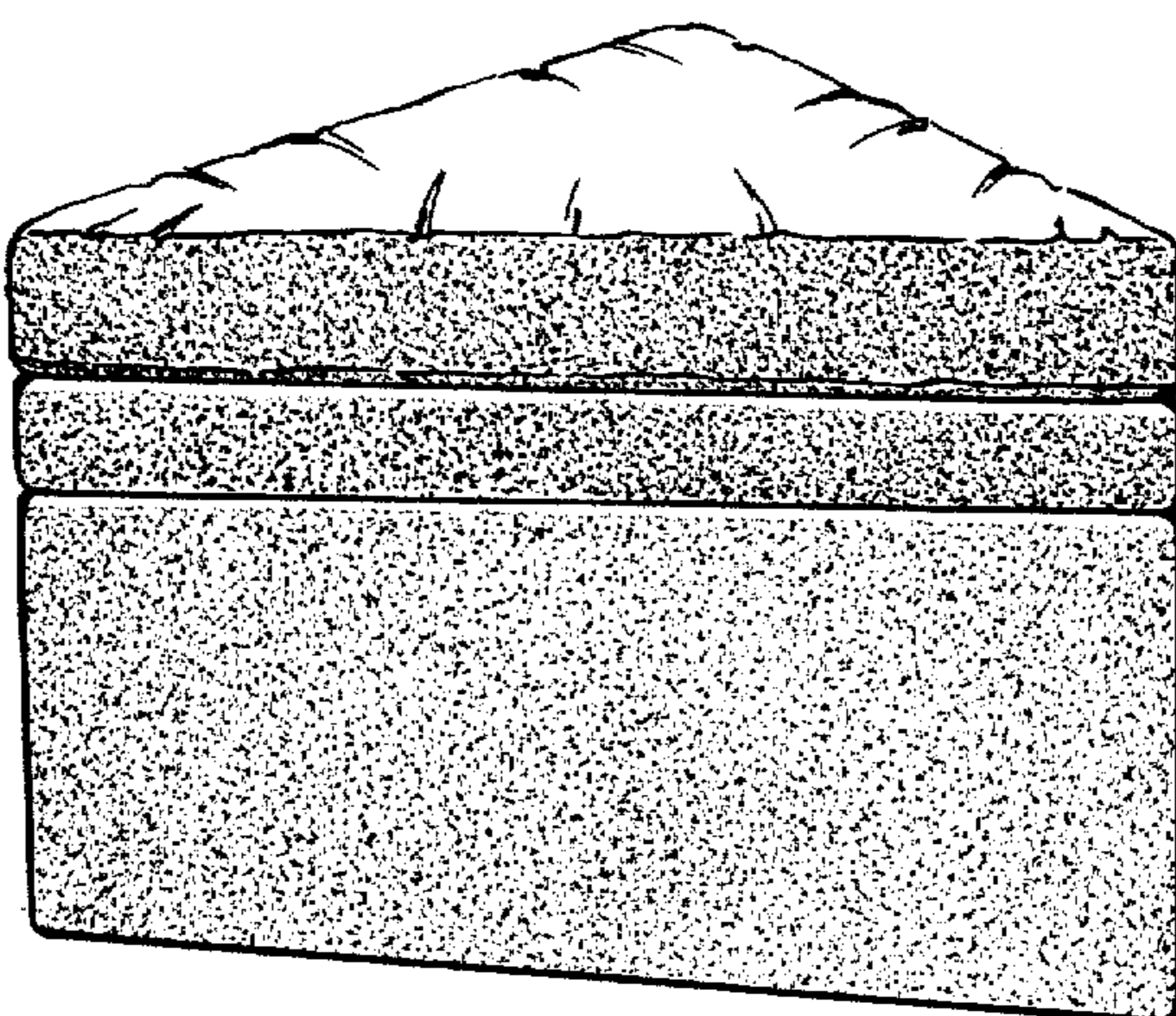
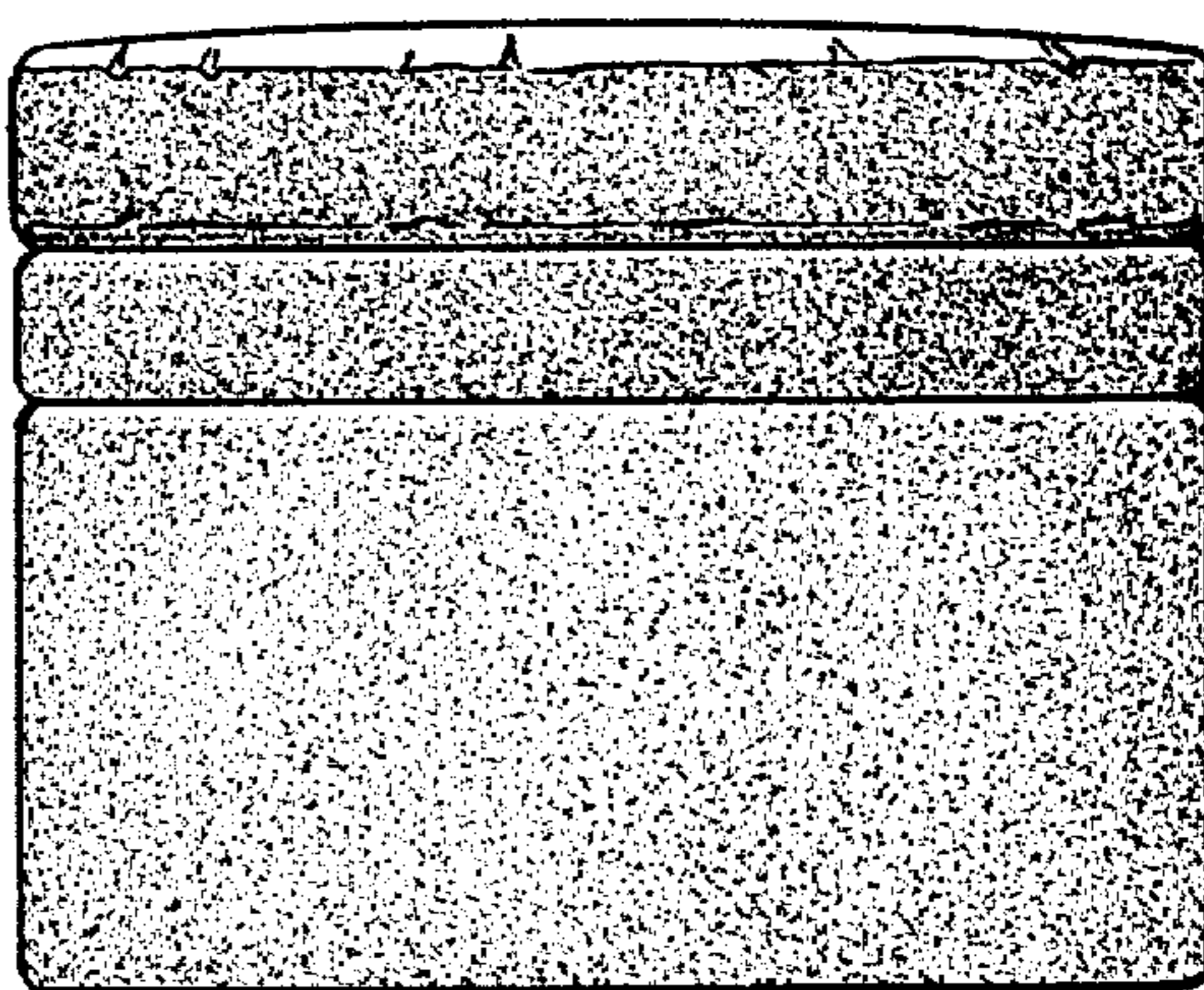
