DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a packaging drum for food showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a fragmentary, enlarged sectional view taken on the line 5—5 of FIG. 3; and
FIG. 6 is a fragmentary, enlarged sectional view taken on the line 6—6 of FIG. 4.

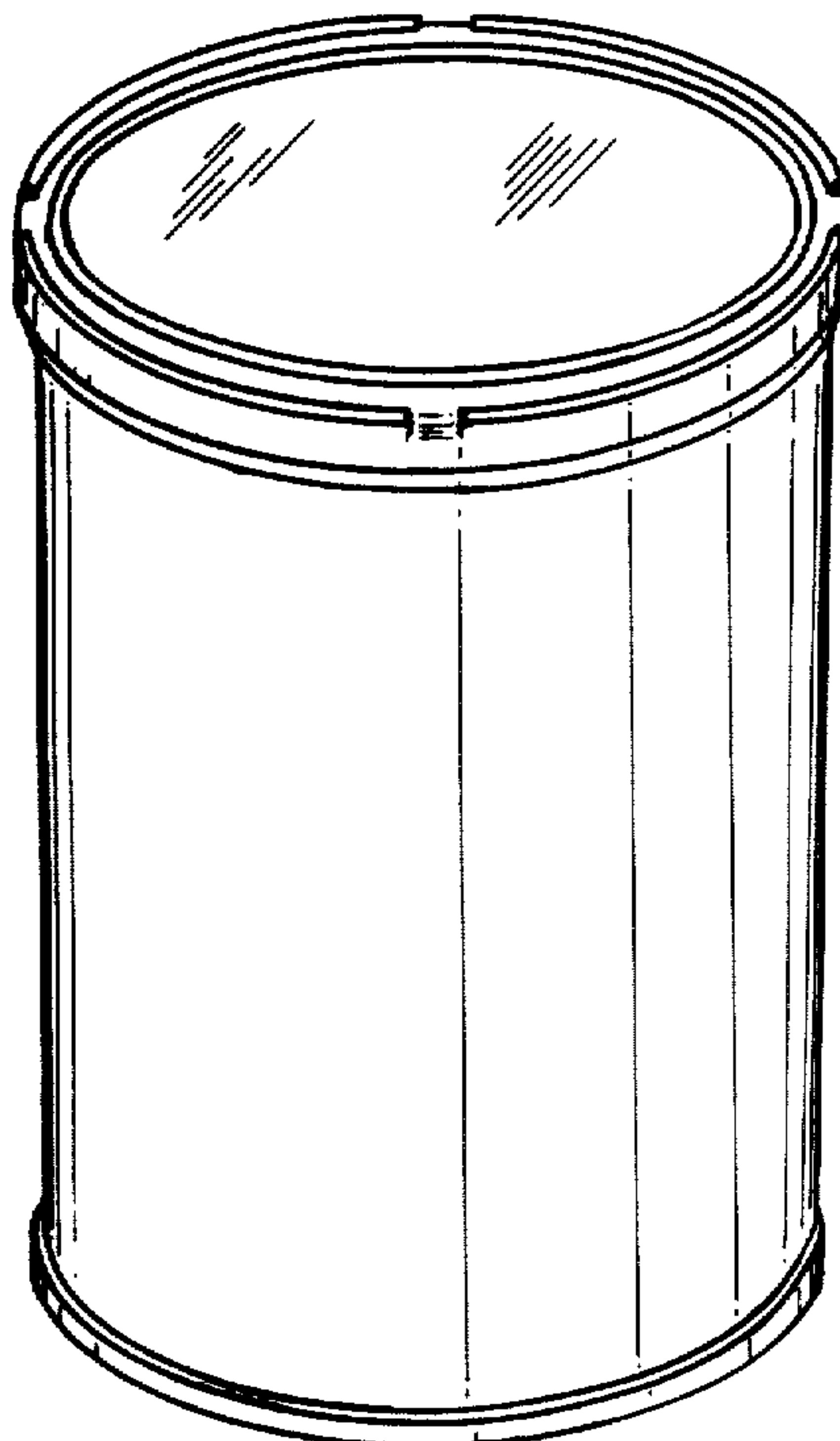

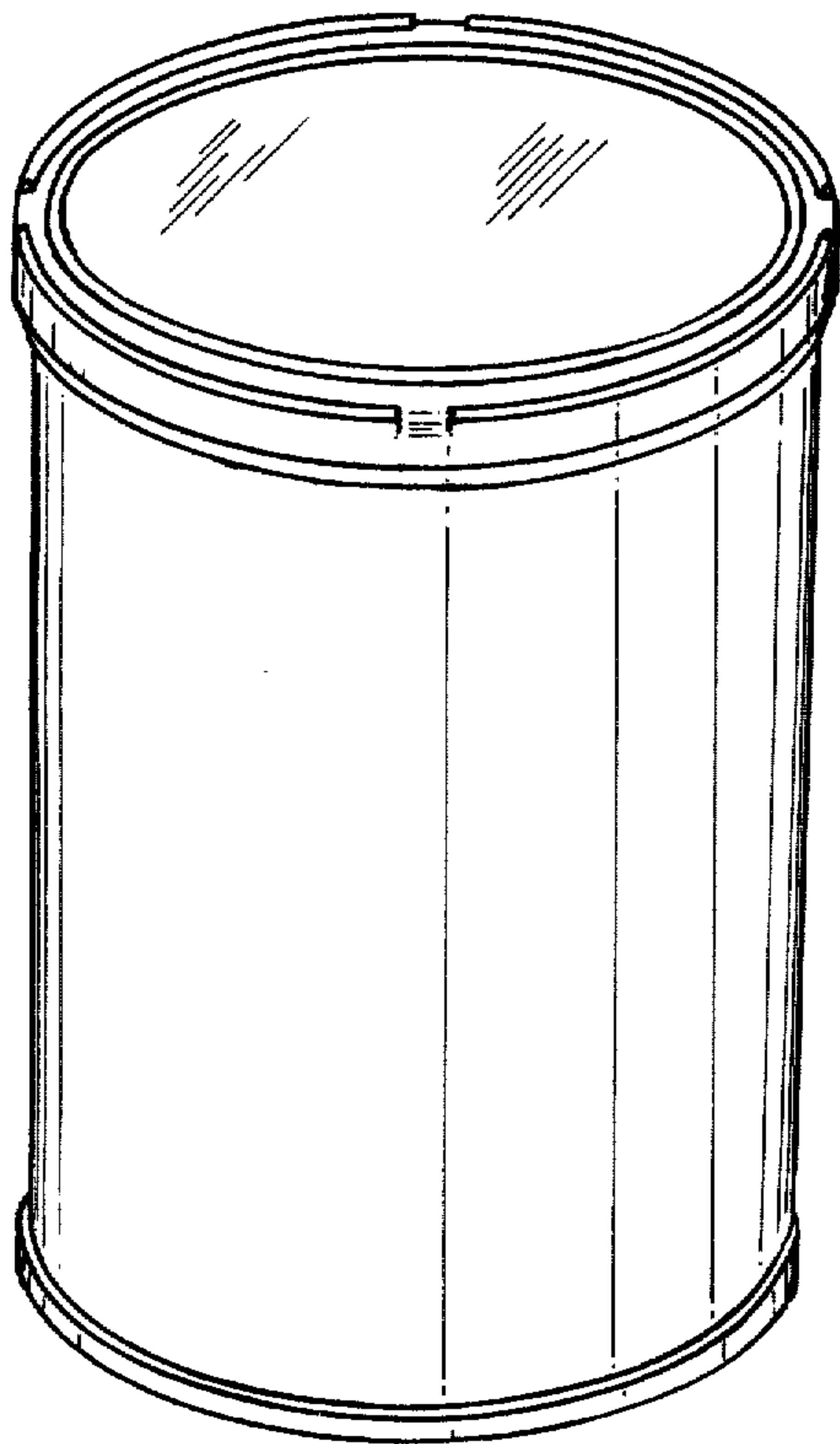

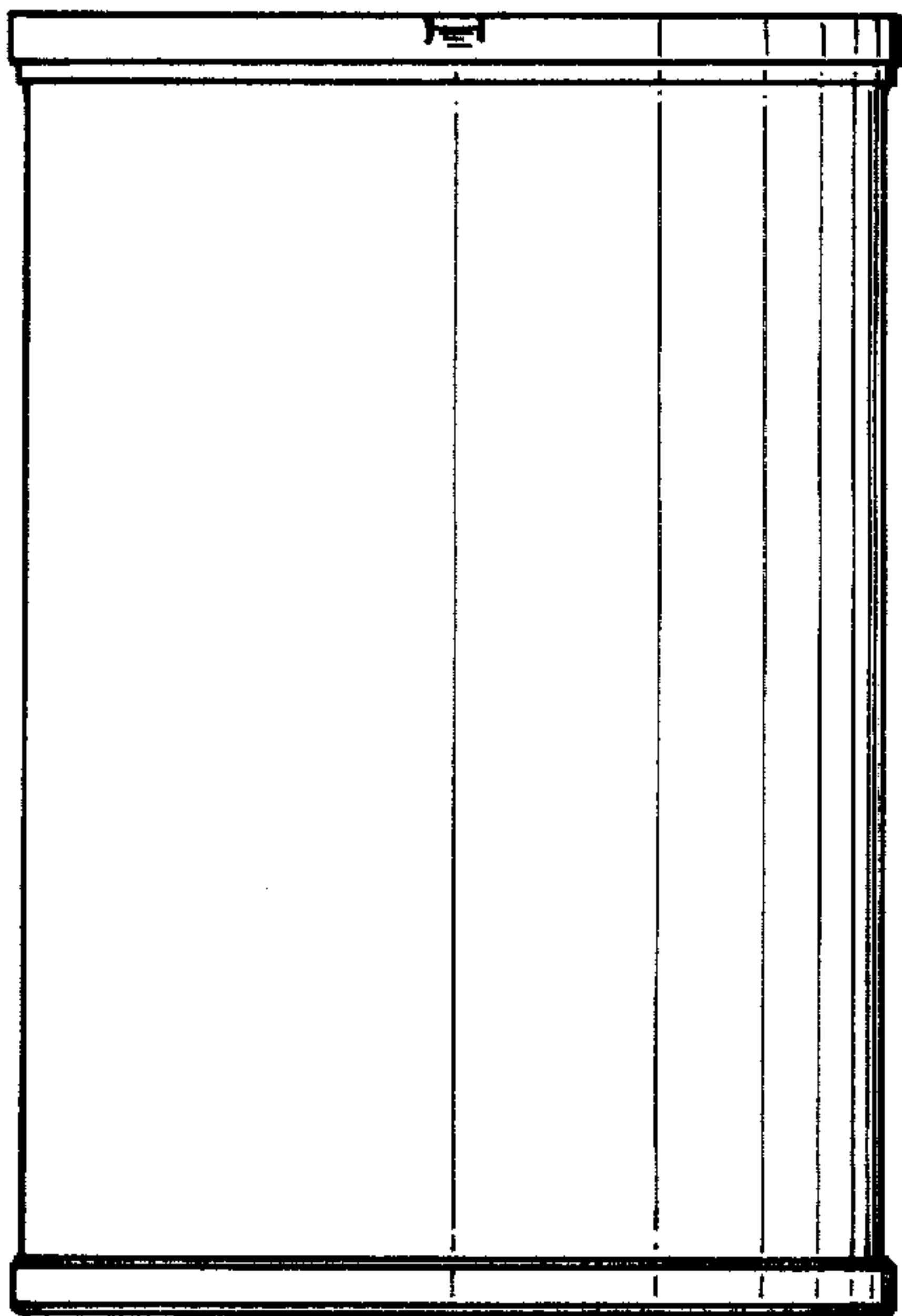

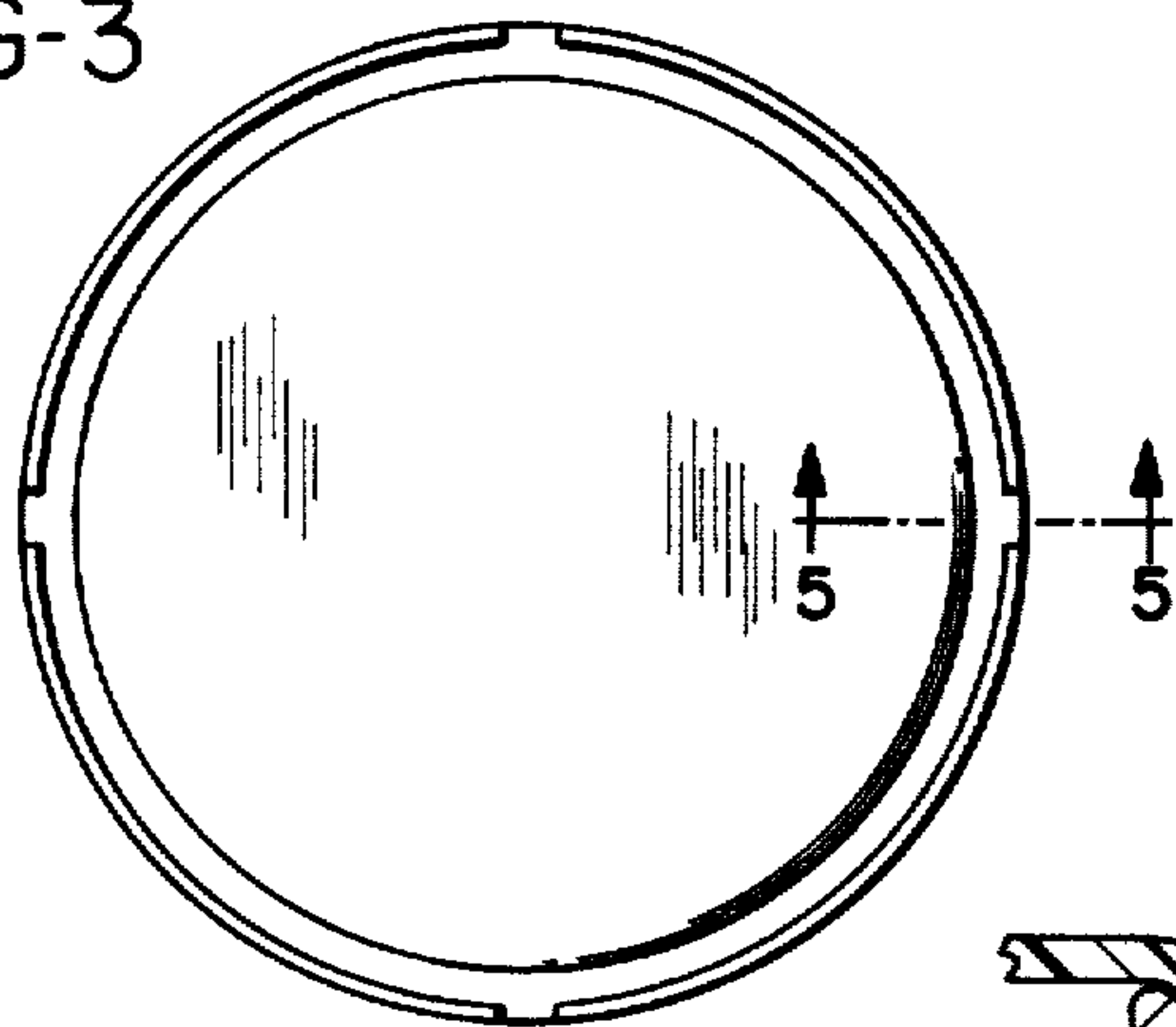

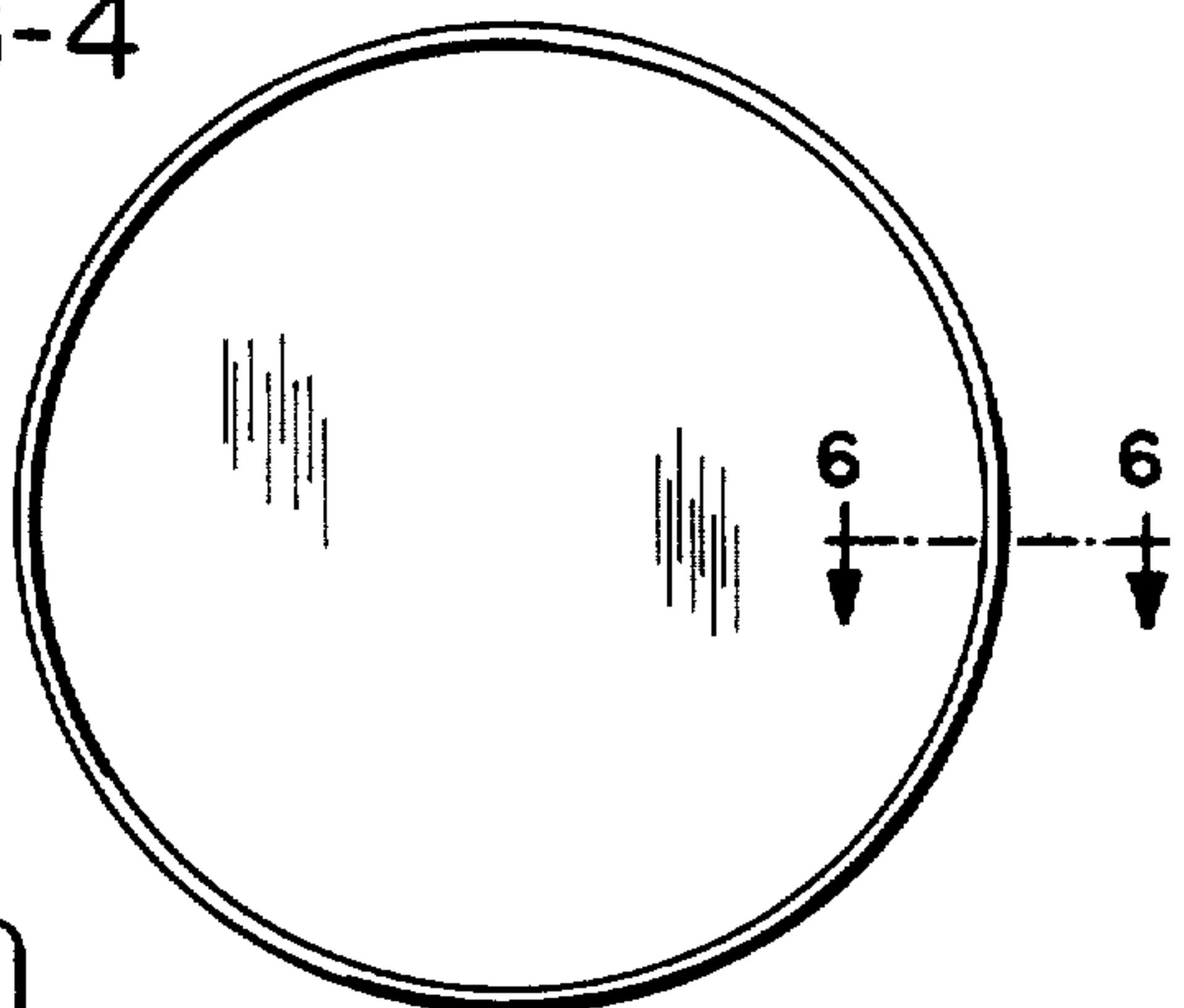

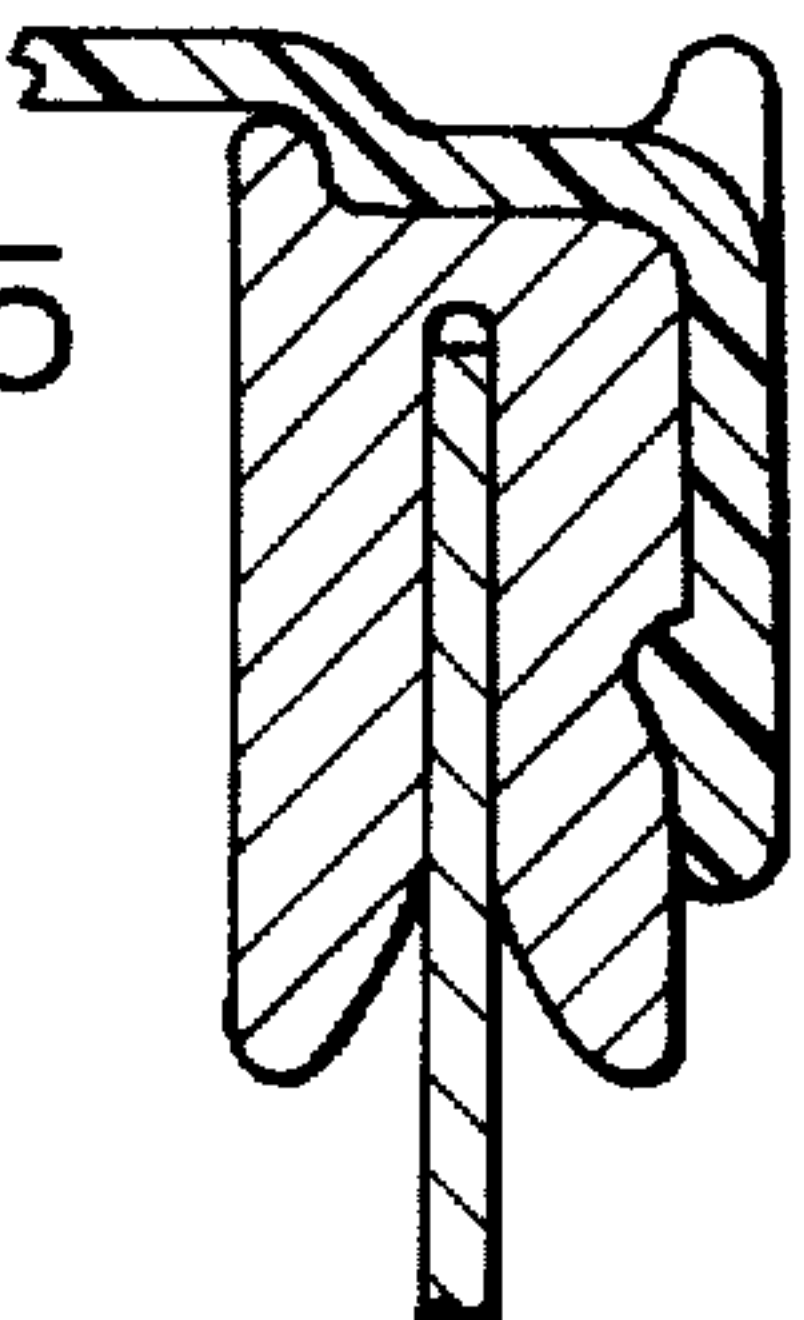
